

# LHSAA DIVISION I STATE CHAMPIONSHIP



### A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAMS

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 10-0 overall record after a thrilling 14-13 win over the John Curtis Patriots in the Division I Semifinals. The Jackets captured the District 1-5A title with a 6-0 record and are the No. 3 seed in the Div. I Playoffs. It was the first district championship for Byrd since 2015, and the sixth for head coach Mike Suggs. The Catholic High Bears are the No. 4 seed and own an 8-2 overall record after their 49-31 win over the No. 1 seed Brother Martin Crusaders in semifinals.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

The No 3-seed Byrd Yellow Jackets edged the No. 7-seed John Curtis Patriots, 14-13, in the Div. I semifinals on Dec. 11 in Shreveport. Trailing 13-7 in the fourth quarter, the Yellow Jackets went on a 9-play, 69-yard drive, which was capped off by a Jason Little 1-yard run. Brayden Hermes' extra-point kick gave the Jackets the lead, and Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense would preserve the one-point victory. The No. 4-seed Catholic Bears went on the road and defeated the No. 1-seed Brother Martin Crusaders 49-31. Senior running back George Hart rushed for 126 yards and a touchdown, while freshman quarterback Daniel Beale passed for 143 yards and three scores to lead the Bears to the 18-point victory.

#### THE SERIES

This will be only the second meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Catholic High Bears, who are members of District 5-5A. In the first-ever meeting, Byrd defeated Catholic, 24-7, in the second round of the 2002 Class 5A Playoffs on Nov. 22 at Memorial Stadium in Baton Rouge. The Bears scored first on a Tasmin Knockum 30-yard pass from Bard Pevey, but the Jackets responded by scoring 24 unanswered points en route to the victory.

#### THE COACHES

Mike Suggs is in his 23rd season as the head coach at C.E. Byrd. Suggs, who is the school's all-time winningest coach, owns a 167-88 (.655) record as the top Jacket. After guiding Byrd to the Division I title game in 2013, Suggs was named the 2013 Class 5A Coach of Year by the La. Football Coaches Association. An All-State end for the Southwood Cowboys in 1980, he went on to play receiver at Northeast Louisiana University, now ULM. After two years as an assistant at Southwood, he came to Byrd in 1990 as an assistant. In 1998, Suggs replaced Alan Carter to become the 20th head coach in school history. Catholic High School is coached by Gabriel Fertitta, who is in his fourth season as the Bears head coach. Fertitta owns an incredible 42-8 (.840) record in his four years at the helm of the Bears' football program. He spent two seasons as the head coach of the St. Stanislaus Rock-A-Chaws in Bay St. Louis, Miss., where his teams went 16-17. His 2017 Catholic High team defeated John Curtis, 17-14, to capture the Division I State Championship, which was the second title in school history. Fertitta has led the Bears to four consecutive Div. I State Championship appearances. He is in his second stint at Catholic, having served as an assistant coach under long-time coach Dale Weiner for three seasons beginning in 2007. Fertitta is a 2000 graduate of Holy Cross School in New Orleans.

#### THE SUGGS STORY

For over two decades Mike Suggs has been the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. By far the longest tenured coach in the 116-year history of Shreveport-Byrd Yellow Jackets football, Suggs is also the winningest in program history with a record of 167-88 (.655).

The Shreveport native was an All-State end at Southwood High School during some of the greatest years in Cowboys football history. His gridiron talents carried him on to Northeast Louisiana University, now the University of Louisiana Monroe, where he played wide receiver playing for ULM Hall-of-Fame coach Pat Collins. After his playing days, Suggs became a graduate assistant on Collins' staff. In 1987, ULM won the NCAA Division I-AA National Championship with a national-best 13-2 record.



In 1988, he returned to Shreveport and his high school alma mater as an assistant coach. After two seasons with the Cowboys, he was lured to Byrd by new Jackets head coach Alan Carter. It was a bold move by Suggs considering that the Byrd football program had just two winning seasons in the previous 15 years, and was coming off the worst decade in program history, which included a 30-game losing streak from 1983-86. Just how bad were things when Suggs arrived at Byrd, "We didn't have any usable equipment," he said. "When we got there all of our helmets were expired. Luckily, we had a generous booster who donated enough money for us to purchase new helmets and equipment." As the offensive coordinator, Suggs helped Byrd to two undefeated 10-0 regular seasons and two district titles in 1993 and '96 . After finishing the 1997 season with a 9-2 record and a third district title, Carter resigned and moved into an administrative role at Byrd. In 1998, Suggs became the 20th head coach in program history.

The dean of area head coaches, Suggs, who's in his 31st year at the Line Avenue school, has built Byrd into one of the preeminent football programs in the area. His teams have become a reflection of their head coach carrying a reputation for being tough, physical and smart.

Byrd has won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in program history. The Jackets have made the playoffs 15 of the last 16 years, the longest run in school history. In 2013, Suggs



guided the Yellow Jackets to the Division I State Championship game, losing a heartbreaker 23-22 to Archbishop Rummel. Suggs was named the 2013 Class 5A Coach of Year by the Louisiana Football Coaches Association. It was the second time he received the honor. For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Suggs' teams posted double-digit wins, which was a first in school history. When the Byrd defeated Parkway 31-13 in 2018, the victory gave Suggs 152 wins in his coaching career. That win moved him past Fair Park coaching legend F.H. Prendergrast for third place on the all-time

Caddo-Bossier wins list.

The 57-year-old Suggs and his wife Sandy, a native of Arnaudville, La., have two children, Cali, and Andrew, both of whom are Byrd alums. Cali is a teacher at South Highlands Elementary School in Shreveport, and Andrew works in the private sector.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS This is the 116th season of Yellow Jackets football, 95th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school's name change in late September of 1925...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 116-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won seven state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 665-423-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Mike Suggs is the school's alltime winningest coach with a 167-88 (.655) record...With its 51-0 win over Southwood, Byrd captured the 2020 District 1-5A crown, and has now won 23 district titles in the school's history...Byrd has won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Suggs' charges hold a 149-6 record when leading after three quarters...Byrd has made the playoffs 15 of the last 16 years, the longest run in school history...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-29-2 record...The Jackets have reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted doubledigit wins, a first in school history...Suggs holds a 97-44 record in district games in his 23 years...Mitchell Ramsey's 94-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Calvary was the fourth longest in school history...Jalin Thomas holds the record, which will never be broken, with a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Haughton in 2017...Ramsey opened the East Ascension game with an 83-yard kickoff return for a touchdown and he returned an onside kick 50 yards for a score against Airline...Ramsey is the first Yellow Jacket to have three kickoff returns for touchdowns in the same season in the Mike Suggs era...Ramsey's three kickoff return touchdowns marks the first time since 2004 that Byrd has had two in a season...Those came in the 2004 season finale when Byrd beat Ouachita 52-42 and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns by two different players to open and close the scoring in that game...The last documented player to have two kickoff returns for touchdowns in a season was Frank Pernici in 1955...Pernici had two 92-yard kickoff returns for touchdowns against Bossier and Bolton in '55...Ramsey's 50-yard return of a Vikings' onside kick for a touchdown marked the third time a Byrd player has returned an onside kick for a touchdown at Independence Stadium - Jaylen McClinton 55 yards vs. Marshall, Texas in 2011 and Ryan Downey 50 yards vs. Bastrop in 2013...Ramsey rushed for 138 yards against East Ascension which is a season high...Chris Grieder's three interceptions against Haughton tied the school record for picks in a game...Grieder tied Nicholas Peoples, who had three interceptions against Parkway in 2011...William Berry's 67yard run against Airline was the longest of his career...Berry had career-highs in rushing yards with 135 and in touchdowns with four against Airline...Berry's four rushing touchdowns were the most since Charlie Barham had four against Calvary in 2018...Byrd had six rushing touchdowns in its 42-7 win over Parkway which is the most rushing touchdowns since scoring seven against Parkway in 2017...Lake Lambert became the first Jacket quarterback to throw two touchdown passes in a game since Cameron Felt tossed two against Benton in 2019...Byrd had more passing yards (112) than East Ascension (85), which marked the first time this season the Jackets have done that...Byrd had more passing yards in back-to-back games against Natchitoches Central and Parkway in 2019... Campbell Brown's five sacks against Airline broke the modern-day record of 3.5 sacks set by Ryan Anthony in Byrd's 2011 playoff victory over West Jefferson...Brown's five tacklesfor-loss against Airline was the most by a Jacket this season...Brown's 15-yard scoop and score against the Vikings marked the first fumble returned for a touchdown by a Jacket since Chris Singleton recovered a fumble in the end zone against Southwood in 2016... Andrew Burak's fumble recovery in the end zone against Southwood was the second of the season...The Purple Swarm Defense held Southwood to -67 yards of total offense which was the fewest yardage allowed in the Mike Suggs' era...Byrd's 51-0 blanking of Southwood was the second shutout of the season for the Jackets, which is the most since 2008 when they registered four shutouts...The 51 points scored by the Jackets against the Cowboys was the most points scored by Byrd since beating Barbe 53-14 in the 2015 season opener...Byrd's 8-0 regular season record marks the 11th time since 1926 that the Jackets have finished a regular season without a loss (two seasons had ties - 1937 & '53)...In three of those seasons - 1926, '31 and '37, the Jackets would go on to win a state championship...The undefeated regular season was the third for Byrd under Mike Suggs and the Jackets' first since 2014...Byrd's 1-point win over John Curtis was the smallest margin of victory since 1964 when the Jackets advanced on first downs (13-9) after a scoreless tie with Glen Oaks...Suggs owns a 17-17 record in the playoffs.

### SHREVEPORT'S GREAT LAKE

Most have heard of the Great Lakes of North America - Superior, Michigan, Huron, Erie, and Ontario. Shreveport has its own Great Lake, but it isn't a waterway, it's Byrd's sophomore quarterback Lake Lambert. Lambert, who's 6'2", 183 lbs., has been great in leading the Jackets to their first undefeated regular season since 2014. Against Calvary, Lambert had eight carries for 45 yards and touchdown and was 4-for-7 passing for 63 yards. His biggest moment came in the fourth quarter after Calvary had cut the Jackets lead to 28-27. The sophomore signal caller orchestrated a 13-play, 66-yard drive that consumed nearly six and a half minutes of the final frame. An eight-yard Mitchell Ramsey touchdown run capped the drive to give Byrd a 35-27 lead, one that it would not relinquish. He led Byrd to its 28-10 win over Haughton, which snapped the Bucs three-game winning streak. Against Natchitoches Central, Lambert had six carries for 94 yards and scored two touchdowns. His first touchdown was a beautiful 33-yard scamper on an option keeper around the right side where he outran the Chiefs defense. On Byrd's next possession, Lambert had a 38-yard run to the Natchitoches six, setting up his one-yard TD run two plays later. Against East Ascension, Lambert threw for 112 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Jackets to a 27-20 victory over the Spartans. In leading Byrd to a 14-13 win over John Curtis, Lambert rushed for 41 yards and a touchdown and completed a 20-yard pass to Elijah Boer. He is the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995.

#### THIS BERRY IS SO SWEET

No berry has been sweeter for coach Mike Suggs and the Byrd Yellow Jackets than senior wingback William Berry. Berry had a career rushing night in helping lead Byrd to its 49-28 district win over Airline. He had nine carries for 135 yards and four touchdowns, all career highs. His four touchdown output against Airline was the most rushing TDs by a Byrd back since Charlie Barham had four against Calvary in 2018. Against East Ascension, Berry showed his versatility and speed as he gathered in a Lake Lambert pass and outran the Spartans' defense for a 70-yard touchdown, which proved to be the difference in the game. In 10 games this season, Berry has rushed for 448 yards and he has scored 11 touchdowns, which leads the team. He's averaging 7.9 yards per carry. After the Airline game, Berry was named the Player-of-the-Week by the *Shreveport Times*. Earlier this season, Berry was named to the LHSAA's Composite All-Academic Team, which covers all football playing classifications.

### MITCHELL THE MAGNIFICENT

Junior wingback Mitchell Ramsey has been magnificent for the Byrd Yellow Jackets this season. In the season opener against Calvary, Ramsey had a 94-yard kickoff return for a touchdown. The 94-yard return was the fourth longest kickoff return for a touchdown in school history. Against East Ascension, "Mitchell the Magnificent" returned the opening kickoff 83 yards for a touchdown. He added a 50-yard return for a score against Airline. The last documented Byrd player to have two kick returns for touchdowns in a season was Frank Pernici in 1955. Ramsey rushed for a season-high 138 yards against the Spartans. He also had a 58-yard touchdown run and a 59-yard scamper in that game. In Byrd's two playoff wins, Ramsey has a combined nine carries for 81 yards, which is a 9.0 yards per carry average. Through 10 games, Ramsey has rushed for 494 yards, but he leads the team with 896 all-purpose yards, which is an 89.6 average. He's also scored seven touchdowns on the season.

#### THOMPSON THE TERRIFIC RETURNS TO FORM

Senior fullback back Venzell Thompson was terrific for Yellow Jackets last season. In 2019, Thompson rushed for 588 yards and scored five touchdowns. He averaged 84 rushing yards per game and 4.4 yards per carry. This season, Thompson's playing time has been limited due to nagging injuries. Against Captain Shreve, he returned to form with a game-high 80 rushing yards on 17 carries. Against Natchitoches Central he rushed for 105 yards on 24 carries and he scored Byrd's first touchdown on a 7-yard run. It was the first time since last year's upset of then No. 7 Airline that Thompson had rushed for over 100 yards. Thompson had 21 carries for 112 yards and a touchdown in Byrd's 31-14 win over St. Augustine. He tied a career high with 24 carries against John Curtis. On Dec. 16, Thompson signed a National Letter of Intent with the U.S. Air Force Academy Falcons.

#### LITTLE IN NAME ONLY

The only thing that's been little about the role senior fullback Jason Little has played for this Byrd football team is his surname. He has been quite a compliment to Venzell Thompson at fullback both as a backup and as a starter. And, when quarterback Logan Pons was lost for the season, Little has stepped into the role as the backup to Lake Lambert. Little had his best rushing output against Haughton with 108 yards on 12 carries. The exclamation point of Little's big night against the Bucs came on a 48-yard touchdown scamper, which put the game out of reach. Against Parkway, Little had a career-high three rushing touchdowns in the Jackets' 42-7 rout of the Panthers. In Byrd's 31-14 win over St. Augustine, Little rushed for 85 yards and two touchdowns. Last week, Little provided a big spark to the Jackets when he came in for Thompson. He scored the gametying touchdown which capped off a 9-play, 69-yard drive. Little has rushed for 481 yards on the season, which ranks third on the team. His nine touchdowns is second only to William Berry's 11.


#### **HERMES HAS IT**

Senior safety Brayden Hermes has the "it" factor that coaches are always talking about. A starter since his sophomore season, Hermes is the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. Last season, he had 39 tackles, one tackle-for-loss, one interception, three pass break-ups and three blocked kicks. His high level of play has continued this season. Through 10 games, he is the team's leading tackler with 53 total tackles. In the opener against Calvary, Hermes broke through the Cavaliers line and blocked Thomas Murray's PAT attempt which kept Byrd in the lead at 28-27. Against East Ascension, Hermes intercepted a Spartan pass which allowed Byrd to run out the clock and win the game. His 29-yard interception return against St. Augustine set up Jason Little's six-yard touchdown run which capped the Jackets' 31-14 win. Hermes has 158 career tackles which ranks eighth on the career tackles list. He's tied for third on the career interceptions list with five. He also booted a 23-yard field goal against the Purple Knights, his first of the season.

## **BRUNO INKS WITH BULLDOGS**

On Dec. 16, senior defensive lineman Carson Bruno signed a National Letter of Intent with the Louisiana Tech Bulldogs. The son of coach Lindsey Bruno, who was an offensive lineman at Nicholls State, and former Byrd standout basketball player Amy Restovich Dunman, Carson is the first Yellow Jacket to sign with a Football Bowl Subdivision school since Zack Ward signed with Army in 2017. In the win over John Curtis, Bruno's interception late in the game helped send the Byrd Yellow Jackets to the Div. I State Championship.

#### JUNIOR IS A SENIOR PLAYMAKER

Throughout his three-year varsity career, senior linebacker Makarios "Junior" Brown has been one of the Purple Swarm Defense's biggest playmakers. Last year, Brown led the team with 64 total tackles, including 55 solo stops. He had 13 tackles-for-loss for 49 yards, which was a career-high, and put him tied for tenth on the single-season leaders list. He also had two sacks for 48 yards, two fumble recoveries and a pass breakup. In his three varsity seasons, Brown has 138 total tackles, 27 tackles-for-loss and 6.5 sacks. His 27 tackles-for-loss ranks him third on the career leaders list. Against John Curtis, Brown had his second career interception, which ended the game. Against St. Aug, he had two tackles-for-loss, a sack, a pass break-up and he tipped a pass which was intercepted by John Jordan.

#### **BIG JOHN**

Junior defensive back John Jordan has been big for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense, particularly in the playoffs. Last week against John Curtis, Jordan had six solo tackles, two assists and he recovered a fumble. The fumble recovery came on an untimed down right before halftime when Patriots quarterback Buddy Taylor mishandled the snap at the Byrd goal line. In Byrd's 31-14 win over St. Augustine, Jordan registered six total tackles, four solo and two assists. His second quarter interception and return of 27 yards set up Byrd's offense at the St. Aug 43-yard line. The Jackets would go on to score their first touchdown of the game. Jordan ranks fourth on the team with 37 tackles.

Former Byrd offensive lineman Carlton Holland and Marc Weddleton are the statisticians. Smartphone users can download the 1130 The Tiger app and listen to Yellow Jackets Football anywhere in the world. The in-stadium FM frequency for the Catholic game is 105.1 FM.

#### LAST TIME IN THE DIVISION I STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

Leading 22-16 with under 10 minutes remaining in the 2013 Div. I State Championship, Byrd forced Rummel to turn the ball over on downs after an incomplete pass halted the Raider drive at the Jackets' 33. On the ensuing play, Byrd turned the ball right back over to Rummel when fullback Louis Mills collided with quarterback Tyler Howard causing to the ball to come loose. Rummel would take advantage and score on an Ivan Phipps' 22-yard run. Justin Mourain's extra-point kick was good and gave the Raiders a 23-22 lead, one they wouldn't relinquish. Phipps' run was controversial because replays inside the Superdome showed him dropping the ball prior to the breaking the plane of the goal line.
