SEASON OPENER

On Thursday, Sept. 2, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will open the 2021 regular season against their crosstown rivals the Huntington Raiders. It'll be the first meeting between the two schools since 2008. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Independence Stadium.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAMS

The Byrd Yellow Jackets finished the 2020 season with a 10-1 overall record after falling 35-12 to Catholic in the Division I finals. Byrd captured the District 1-5A title with a 6-0 record and were the No. 3 seed in the Div. I Playoffs. It was the first district championship for the Jackets since 2015, and the sixth for retired head coach Mike Suggs. The Yellow Jackets lost nine starters on offense and eight starters on defense as well as its kicker and punter.

LAST TIME OUT

Last Friday, Byrd fans got a preview of the "Backyard Brawl" as Byrd faced off against arch rival Captain Shreve in the Jamboree. Byrd took advantage of two Shreve turnovers to capture a 27-14 win over the Gators in a half of football. The Jackets rushed for 257 yards and three touchdowns. Huntington defeated Woodlawn 30-0 in its jamboree on Friday at Independence Stadium. Raider wide receiver Tre Carter had more than 100 yards receiving and two touchdowns against Woodlawn.

THE SERIES

This will be the 33rd meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Huntington Raiders in a series that dates back to 1973. Byrd leads the overall series 22-10. The Yellow Jackets and the Raiders had met every year from 1985 through 2008. In those 22 games, Byrd posted a 15-7 record against the Raiders. The Jackets have won four straight over the Raiders, including a 49-0 shellacking in the last meeting in 2008.

THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009. Huntington is coached by Stephen Dennis, who is in his fifth season at the helm of the Raiders' program. He is 16-23 in his previous four seasons at Huntington. In 2020, Huntington posted a 6-3 record and advanced to the second round of the Class 4A Playoffs. He was the defensive coordinator for six seasons at Northwood before accepting the Huntington job. Dennis played at Parkway when former Northwood coach Jim Gatlin was the head coach there. He went on to play for Dennis Dunn at Louisiana College before returning to coach at Parkway with Gatlin. He then joined Dunn's staff at LC for two seasons before coming back to Shreveport to serve as defensive coordinator with Gatlin at Northwood. Former Byrd assistant coach Scott Abernathy is the Raiders defensive coordinator while former Jacket quarterback Jeremy Wilburn is the offensive coordinator.

THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew begins his first season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jack-ets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star state was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 43-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who are seniors at Byrd.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

This is the 117th season of Yellow Jackets football, 96th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school's name change in late September of that year...In those 21 seasons of SHS football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 116-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won seven state championships and have been the state runners-up seven times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 665-424-35 (.607) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...With its 51-0 win over Southwood, Byrd captured the 2020 District 1-5A crown, and has won 23 district titles in the school's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs 15 of the last 16 years, the longest run in school history...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-30-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...Mitchell Ramsey's 94-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Calvary was the fourth longest in school history...Jalin Thomas holds the record, which will never be broken, with a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown against Haughton in 2017...Ramsey opened the East Ascension game with an 83-yard kickoff return for a touchdown and he returned an onside kick 50 yards for a score against Airline...Ramsey is the first Yellow Jacket to have had three kickoff returns for touchdowns in the same season in over 23 years...Ramsey's three kickoff return touchdowns marks the first time since 2004 that Byrd has had two in a season as a team...Those came in the 2004 season finale when Byrd beat Ouachita 52-42 and had two kickoff returns for touchdowns by two different players to open and close the scoring in that game...The last documented player to have two kickoff returns for touchdowns in a season was Frank Pernici in 1955...Pernici had two 92-yard kickoff returns for touchdowns against Bossier and Bolton in '55...Ramsey's 50-yard return of a Vikings' onside kick for a touchdown marked the third time a Byrd player had returned an onside kick for a touchdown at Independence Stadium - Jaylen McClinton 55 yards vs. Marshall, Texas in 2011 and Ryan Downey 50 yards vs. Bastrop in 2013...Ramsey rushed for 138 yards against East Ascension which was a season high...Chris Grieder's three interceptions against Haughton tied the school record for picks in a game...Grieder tied Nicholas Peoples, who had three interceptions against Parkway in 2011...William Berry's 67-yard run against Airline was the longest of his career...Berry had career-highs in rushing yards with 135 and in touchdowns with four against Airline...Berry's four rushing touchdowns were the most since Charlie Barham had four against Calvary in 2018...Byrd had six rushing touchdowns in its 42-7 win over Parkway which is the most rushing touchdowns since scoring seven against Parkway in 2017...Lake Lambert became the first Jacket quarterback to throw two touchdown passes in a game since Cameron Felt tossed two against Benton in 2019...Byrd had more passing yards (112) than East Ascension (85), which marked the only time the Jackets had done that in 2020...Campbell Brown's five sacks against Airline broke the modern-day record of 3.5 sacks set by Ryan Anthony in Byrd's 2011 playoff victory over West Jefferson...Brown's five tackles-for-loss against Airline was the most by a Jacket in 2020...Brown's 15-yard scoop and score against the Vikings marked the first fumble returned for a touchdown by a Jacket since Chris Singleton recovered a fumble in the end zone against Southwood in 2016...Andrew Burak's fumble recovery in the end zone against Southwood was the second of the season...The Purple Swarm Defense held Southwood to -67 yards of total offense which was the fewest yardage allowed in 23 years...Byrd's 51-0 blanking of Southwood was the second shutout of the season for the Jackets, which is the most since 2008 when they registered four shutouts...The 51 points scored by the Jackets against the Cowboys was the most points scored by Byrd since beating Barbe 53-14 in the 2015 season opener...Byrd's 8-0 regular season record marked the 11th time since 1926 that the Jackets have finished a regular season without a loss (two seasons had ties - 1937 & '53)...In three of those seasons - 1926, '31 and '37, the Jackets would go on to win the state championship...Byrd's 1-point win over John Curtis was the smallest margin of victory since 1964 when the Jackets advanced on first downs (13-9) after a scoreless tie with Glen Oaks...LHSAA executive director Eddie Bonine said a topic at the September executive committee meeting would be the retroactive awarding of football state championships to John Curtis (2017) and Byrd (2020) in the wake of forfeitures by Catholic from a penalty ruling earlier this year.

2021 BYRD YELLOW JACKETS FOOTBALL PREVIEW

Ch-ch-ch-changes

Turn and face the strange

Ch-ch-changes

There's gonna have to be a different man

Those lyrics from the late great Rock and Roll Hall of Fame singer-songwriter David Bowie's hit song "Changes" best describes the scene around the Byrd High School football program entering the 2021 football season.

For the first time in nearly a quarter of a century there is a different man at the helm of the Yellow Jackets' football team. Stacy Ballew takes over as head coach after long-time coach and offensive coordinator Mike Suggs retired in May.

Ballew, who is a Byrd alum, has been a part of Suggs' staff since 2002, first serving as a running backs coach before moving to the defensive side of the ball in 2005 to coach linebackers. In 2009, Ballew took over as the defensive coordinator while continuing to coach the Jacket linebackers. Ballew admits he wasn't fully aware of the extent of the love, passion and support that exists for the Yellow Jackets.

"I don't know if surprised is the right word," says the 43-year-old Ballew. "I've always known Byrd had good support, but I wasn't aware of the depth of that support until I took over. The amount of support for this program from the administration, faculty, staff, students, parents, former coaches and players is unbelievable. I didn't see it coming. There's just so many people that want this program to succeed. It's tremendous."

While the musings of Ziggy Stardust (anyone under the age of 45, ask your parents or Google the name) likely doesn't mean much to Ballew or Byrd fans, unless Stardust is a 6'2", 215 lb., linebacker who runs a sub-4.5, 40-yard dash, but ch-ch-changes are aplenty in the Byrd football program entering the 117th season of Yellow Jackets football.

Besides Ballew, there's plenty of changes among the coaching staff. Wade Leone, who coached safeties the last few seasons, moves over to the offensive side to take over as the offensive coordinator. Leone, a former quarterback at Southwood High School, takes over for Suggs, who had called plays for the last 31 years at Byrd. Lindsey Bruno, returns as the offensive line coach, while Marty Guerrero comes in to coach wide receivers.

On the defensive side of the ball, Jason Pope has been elevated to defensive coordinator and will work with the safeties. Byrd alum and former McNeese State Cowboy Jalen Bowers returns to his alma mater and will coach the defensive line. Ballew will continue to work with the linebackers, while Dayton Corbett moves from coaching wide receivers to now working with the defensive backs. The Yellow Jackets enjoyed an incredible 2020 season in which they went 10-1, with the only blemish coming in the 35-12 loss to Catholic High of Baton Rouge in the Division I State Championship. The Bears recently had to vacate the title along with the 2017 title and two state runners-up for LHSAA violations.

In addition to putting his coaching staff together, Ballew must figure out how to replace nine starters on offense and eight on defense from last year's state runner-up team.

One consolation for the Byrd brain trust is that one of the two returning offensive starters is junior quarterback Lake Lambert. Lambert (6'2", 185 lb., Jr.) had a sensational sophomore season leading the Jackets to the 10-1 record and the state championship game.

"Lake (Lambert) played well beyond his age last season," said Ballew. "He may be the best all-around quarterback we've had at Byrd in a long time. He runs the option exceedingly well and can beat you with his legs as well as his arm. He has a strong and accurate arm, and as he showed in the Natchitoches Central game has the ability to put the team on his back and lead us to victory."

As good as Lambert was last year – rushing for 446 yards and six touchdowns and passing for 531 yards and three touchdowns with only one interception – he had veterans on the offensive line, in the backfield and at wide receiver, all of whom have graduated.

The only other returning offensive starter is senior wingback Mitchell Ramsey, who rushed for 529 yards and four touchdowns last season. Ramsey (5'11", 175, Sr.) averaged 7.1 yards per carry in 2020, but his biggest impact came as a kick returner. An All-District and All-City selection as a kick

returner, Ramsey had three kickoff returns for touchdowns last season, including a 94-yarder in the season-opener against Calvary. The 94-yard return was the fourth longest kickoff return for a touchdown in program history.

"Mitchell (Ramsey) has an incredible combination of speed and vision, which he showed last year with all his kick returns and big runs for touchdowns," said Ballew. "That combination makes him a threat to score every time he touches the football, and as the lone returning running back, he will be counted on heavily."

A bevy of backs are expected to join Lambert and Ramsey in the backfield of Byrd's multi-option offense. Josh Allen (5'10", 165, Jr.) is expected to line up opposite of Ramsey at the right wing, while Devon Strickland (5'10", 175, Jr.) is the likely starter at fullback. Walker Fox (5'10, 155, Jr.), Tyler Nichols (5'6", 155, Jr.) and Jacob McClure (6'0", 195, Sr.), who is coming off an injury, will vie for playing time at the wings. Dixon Poirer (So.) is listed as Strickland's back-up at fullback heading into training camp.

The Jackets will have five new starters on the offensive line. Only Caleb Aillet (5'9", 205, Sr.) at center and Wyatt McCollum (6'2", 215, Sr.) at right tackle have seen significant snaps at the varsity level. Kailen Moore (6'2", 205, Jr.) and Jack Thigpen (5'10", 185, Jr.) are penciled in as the starters at left tackle and left guard, respectively. When the Jackets employ a tight-end, Patrick Snead (6'3", 200, Sr.) is listed as the starter there.

Wide receiver Reed Sepulvado, who played in nearly every game in 2020, returns. Used primarily as a blocker, Sepulvado (5'10", 160, Sr.) lined up opposite of Byrd's leading receiver Kellum Humphrey, who had 16 receptions for 298 yards and two touchdowns in 2020. Humphrey began his career as a quarterback before making the move to receiver. Such is the case for Logan Pons (5'11", 180, Sr.), who was Lambert's backup at quarterback, during an injury-shortened 2020. The coaching staff wanted to find a place on the field for Pons in order to utilize his talent and abilities. Jackson Duffre (6'3", 150, Jr.) and Connor Ridenour (5'10", 150, Jr.) are expected to battle for playing time. Byrd's "Purple Swarm Defense" was outstanding last season giving up just over 14 points and 200 yards per game. However, the defense must replace eight starters, including six of the top eight tacklers.

The Jackets utilize a 4-2-5 base defense and will have four new starters up front. Brennan Belanger (5'10", 195, Jr.) and Isaiah Ford (Jr.) came out of spring as starters at the ends, while Jack Partington (6'2", 215, Sr.) and Ben Martinson (6'2", 200, Jr.) sit atop the depth chart at the two tackle spots. Ends Caden Adcock (5'11", 155, Jr.) and Jamichael Davis (6'4, 165, Sr.) along with tackles Jerquarrius Myles (Sr.) and Paul Stephens (5'11", 195, Sr.) will all vie for playing time.

Sawyer Benson (6'1", 175, Sr.) and Brooks Belanger (6'1", 200, Jr.) are listed as the starters at the "mike" and "will" linebackers, respectively. Anthony Solazzo (5'10", 160, Sr.) and Jacoby Smith (5'9", 150, Sr.) are listed as their backups.

At the "buck" linebacker spot, which is a hybrid linebacker-safety position, William Whitman (5'11", 160, Jr.) and Wyatt Watkins (6'2", 175, Jr.) are competing for the starting role.

With four veterans returning, including three starters, the secondary is expected to be the strength of the Purple Swarm Defense. Starting cornerbacks Tyler Poland (6'0", 165, Sr.) and Ja'Kerryon LaCour (5'7", 140, Sr.) return as does First-Team All-District weak safety John Jordan (5'11", 175, Sr.).

Jordan was tied for third on the team last season with 48 total tackles. He also had an interception and a fumble recovery. Ryan Todd (6'2", 190, Sr.), who was a Second-Team All-District selection with 30 total tackles, including a team-high 10 tackles-for-loss, last season takes over at free safety. Christian Jones (5'11", 160, Jr.), Lamichael Taylor (5'10", 160, Jr.) and Jude Partington (5'11", 150, Jr.) are listed as the primary backups in the defensive backfield.

If having to replace 17 starters wasn't stressful enough for Ballew and his staff, they're also facing changes on special teams. Michael Hamauei (5'10", 160, Sr.), who saw limited time last year mostly on kickoffs and extra points, is expected to take over both the punting and kicking duties this season. Also, look for Lambert to possibly be used as the punter. Lambert, whose late father Bryan was a collegiate punter, boomed a 52-yarder in his lone punt in 2020.

Deep snapping duties will be handled by Benson, who garnered high praise at the prestigious Rubio

Long Snapping camp over the summer. Lambert and Pons are expected to be the holders on field goals and extra points. Kick return duties will once again fall into the very capable hands of Ramsey. His three kickoff return touchdowns in 2020 marked the first time since 2004 that a Byrd team had two returns for touchdowns in a season. Prior to Ramsey, the last documented Yellow Jacket to have two kickoff returns for touchdowns in a season was Frank Pernici in 1955. Allen, Pons and Todd are also in the mix as possible returners.

One thing that didn't change in the transition from Suggs to Ballew was the strength of the Jackets' schedule. Byrd opens the season on Sept. 2 against crosstown rival Huntington. The Raiders are expected to be one of the top teams in District 1-4A this season.

In week two, Byrd will once again participate in the Battle on the Border High School Football Showcase at Independence Stadium. Byrd has played in all nine previous showcases having posted a 7-2 record. This year, the Jackets will face the Tioga Indians, who were a Class 4A playoff participant a year ago.

In week three, Byrd plays host to the Maumelle, Ark. Hornets in its final non-district game. It'll be the first-ever meeting between the two schools.

Last year, Byrd posted a 6-0 record in District 1-5A and captured the school's 23rd district title and its first since 2015. Ballew expects the race for the 2021 district title to be as wide open.

"In this district, it's a toss-up every week," said Ballew. "You can't take anyone for granted. Every team has great players and can make you look silly if you're not prepared and don't handle your business. I think it's going to be a very interesting battle that'll go down to the wire for the district title."

The Jackets travel to the piney woods of Haughton, La., in week four for the district opener against the Buccaneers.

Former Byrd assistant coach James Wilkerson, III, brings his Natchitoches Central Chiefs to Shreveport in week five.

The Jackets will cross over the Red River into Bossier Parish for the second time in three weeks when they travel to south Bossier City to face the Parkway Panthers at Preston Crownover Stadium in week six. In week seven, Byrd plays host to Benton. Last year's game between Byrd and Benton was cancelled due to Covid issues within the Tigers' program.

Byrd makes its third trip across the Red River in week eight as the Jackets head to north Bossier City to meet the Airline Vikings. The annual "Backyard Brawl" between Byrd and Captain Shreve takes place in week nine. The regular season finale for Byrd comes against crosstown rival Southwood. With Byrd being designated a "select" school by the LHSAA the Jackets will again participate in the 13-team Division I Playoffs.
