JAMBOREE TIME

On Thursday, Aug. 25, it'll be Jamboree time as the 2022 high school football season will kick off across the state of Louisiana. The Byrd Yellow Jackets and Captain Shreve Gators will give fans a snippet of their great rivalry when the two rivals meet in the Jamboree at Independence Stadium. The freshmen teams will begin play at 6 p.m. then the junior varsity squads will follow with the varsity teams finishing out the evening.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAM

The Byrd Yellow Jackets finished the 2021 season with a 9-2 overall record after losing 45-14 to the Brother Martin Crusaders in the Division I quarterfinals. Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A title with a 6-1 record and were the No. 3 seed in the Div. I Playoffs. It was the second straight district championship for the Jackets, and the first for head coach Stacy Ballew. The Yellow Jackets return seven starters on offense and five starters on defense.

LAST TIME OUT

The Byrd Yellow Jackets scored the only touchdown in the live portion of last week's scrimmage with the Ruston Bearcats. The touchdown came a 43-yard pass from Lake Lambert to Jackson Dufrene in the final minutes of the scrimmage. Both defenses played well in the scrimmage holding the opposing offenses in check throughout the half.

THE SEASON

The Byrd Yellow Jackets posted a 9-2 overall record in 2021. Byrd won a share of the District 1-5A title for the second straight season. The nine wins were the most for a first-year head coach since 1960 when J.D. Cox's Yellow Jackets won 11 games. The 2021 Byrd Yellow Jackets had six First-Team All-District and five First-Team All-City selections. It was an incredible season, particularly considering Byrd had to replace 17 starters off the 2020 State Championship team as well as the head coach who had been there 31 years.

THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense.

The assistant coaches include: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Lindsey Bruno, offensive line; Marty Guerrero, wide receivers, Shimorye Hampton, running backs; Jason Pope, defensive coordinator; Jalen Bowers, defensive line and Dayton Corbett, corner backs. The freshmen coaches include: Josh Cason, Ronnie Buckingham, Carlos Doss and Kellum Humphrey.

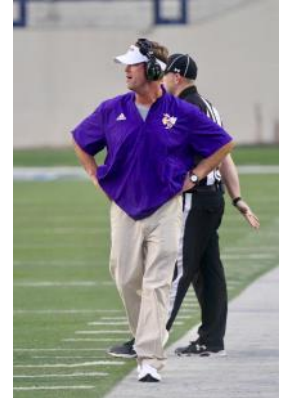
THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew begins his second season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star state was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.



Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 43-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

2021 was the 117th season of Yellow Jackets football and the 96th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school’s name change in late September of that year...In those 21 seasons of SHS football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 117-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times... Shreveport-Byrd owns a 674-426-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school’s all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the school’s history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs 16 of the last 17 years, the longest run in school history...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-31-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...Mitchell Ramsey scored three touchdowns in Byrd’s 24-21 win over the Maumelle Hornets...Ramsey was the first Yellow Jacket to score three or more touchdowns in a game since William Berry scored four TDs against Airline on Nov. 7, 2020...Ramsey’s 79-yard punt return for a touchdown against Maumelle was the first for the Yellow Jackets since Jalin Thomas’ 78-yard return for a TD against Barbe on Sept. 4, 2015...Ramsey’s 87-yard touchdown run against Parkway was the first 80-plus yard TD run by a Jacket since Tysen Hardman’s 80-yarder against East Ascension in 2014...Senior place kicker Michael Hamauei’s 42-yard field goal proved to be the difference in Byrd’s win over Maumelle...The 42-yarder was Hamauei’s first career made field goal, and it was Byrd’s first 40-plus yard field goal since Scotty Roblow hit a 42-yarder against Captain Shreve on Sept. 27, 2018...Hamauei has followed that up with makes of 37, 41, 30 and 31 yards...Junior fullback Devon Strickland rushed for a game-high 206 yards and two touchdowns against Huntington...Strickland was the first Byrd back to rush for 200-plus yards in a game since Charlie Barham rushed for 248 against Captain Shreve in 2018...Strickland had 151 yards and a touchdown in the Jackets’ 51-27 win over Airline...Devon was the lone bright spot in Byrd’s quarterfinal playoff loss to Brother Martin as he rushed for 109 yards and a touchdown...Byrd rushed for 512 yards against Parkway, which was the third-highest single game total in school history...Three Jackets rushed for over 100 yards against the Panthers...Three backs eclipsing the 100-yard plateau marked the first time in over 25 years that Byrd had three backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...The 512 rushing yards against Parkway also marked the second time this season Byrd has had a Top 10 rushing performance in school history...The Jackets had 442 total rushing yards in the season opener against Huntington... Byrd rushed for 412 yards in its win over Airline marking the fourth time this season the Jackets have amassed over 400 yards on the ground...The seven rushing touchdowns against Airline were the most for Byrd since scoring seven against Parkway in 2017...Five times this season the Jackets have rushed for five or more touchdowns in a game... Christian Jones blocked a Huntington punt which resulted in a safety...It was the first blocked punt for Byrd since Trent Jones blocked a Shreve punt in 2014...Byrd’s 43-14 win over Huntington was the first for coach Stacy Ballew...The 51 points scored by the Jackets against the Airline Vikings were the most points scored by Byrd since beating Southwood 51-0 last year...Byrd had just 97 rushing yards against Natchitoches Central...It was the Jackets’ lowest rushing total since 2019 when Byrd had just 104 rushing yards against the Chiefs...Since then, Byrd has tallied 2,058 rushing yards in its five consecutive victories... The Jackets rushed for 3,649 yards this season, which was the fourth highest single-season rushing total in school history...Safety Ryan Todd had career highs in tackles with eight and pass breakups with three against Maumelle...Safety John Jordan had his first interception of the season against Haughton, then later Ryan Todd picked off a Collin Rains pass as well...The Jackets also recovered a fumble against Haughton marking the first time all season Byrd has forced three turnovers in a game...The Jackets equaled that mark against Airline with two interceptions and two fumble recoveries...Lake Lambert’s 25-yard touchdown pass to Jackson Dufrene against Benton was the first touchdown pass of the season for Byrd...It was also the first touchdown reception of Dufrene’s career...Lambert tossed his second TD pass against Shreve, a 13-yarder to Devon Strickland on Byrd’s first offensive play.

SHREVEPORT'S GREAT LAKE

Most have heard of the Great Lakes of North America - Superior, Michigan, Huron, Erie, and Ontario. Shreveport has its own Great Lake in senior quarterback Lake Lambert. Lambert, who's 6'2", 195 lbs., led the Jackets to the state championship as a sophomore and the quarterfinals as a junior. In 2020, Lambert was the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995. In the 20 games he's started at Byrd (missed two games due to injury last season), Lambert has led Byrd to 17 wins. In those 20 games, he's rushed for 775 yards, 10 touchdowns and averaged over five yards a carry. He's completed 41 of his 85 pass attempts for 774 yards and five touchdowns and has thrown just one interception, which came in 2020. Heading into 2022, Lambert is one of seven offensive starters returning for the Jackets. Lake is the youngest son of Michelle and the late Bryan Lambert. Lake's older brothers were also athletes at Byrd, Garrett played football while Brock played baseball.

JACKETS GROUND ATTACK ROLLED OVER OPPONENTS

In the 11 games of the 2021 season, the Byrd Yellow Jackets ground attack rolled over opponents. The Jackets amassed 512 rushing yards against Parkway, which was the third-highest single-game rushing total in school history. They followed that up by rushing for 421 yards and five touchdowns against Benton. Against Airline, the Jackets churned out 412 rushing yards and seven touchdowns. Byrd had 387 yards and three touchdowns against Shreve and 326 against Southwood. That was a five-game total of 2,059 yards and an average of 411.6 yards per game. Four times in 2021, versus Huntington (442), Parkway (512), Benton (421) and Airline (412), Byrd rushed for over 400 yards with each ranking in the Top 15 single-game performances in history. The Jackets finished the season with 3,649 rushing yards, which was the fourth best season total in school history.

TWO-HEADED MONSTER AT FULLBACK

Senior Devon Strickland and junior Dixon Poirier gave the Byrd Yellow Jackets a two-headed monster at fullback in 2021. The two "B" backs combined for 1,347 rushing yards and 12 touchdowns. Strickland averaged 7.0 yards per carry, while Poirier is averaged 5.9. Strickland rushed for 206 yards in the season-opener against Huntington, and led the team with 937 rushing yards. Poirier finished the season with 410 rushing yards.

A NICHOLS WORTH

Wingback Tyler Nichols proved his worth in Byrd's triple-option offense this season. In Byrd's 18-3 win over Tioga, Nichols rushed for a game-high 101 yads and a touchdown. It was his first time to eclipse the century mark. Nichols had a 53-yard scamper against Benton, which led to a Byrd touchdown. In 10 games, Nichols has 61 carries for 399 yards and seven touchdowns. His seven rushing touchdowns ranks second only to Mitchell Ramsey's 11. He also had two receptions for 43 yards in Byrd's 38-7 win over Haughton. Nichols finished the season with 445 rushing yards, averaged 6.8 yards per carry and scored seven touchdowns.

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that quarterback Lake Lambert, wingback Tyler Nichols and linebacker Brooks Brossette are all two-sport stars at Byrd? All three seniors started on Byrd's baseball team in the spring. Lambert played multiple positions but is expected to be the starting catcher in 2023, while Nichols, who led the team in hitting last season, was the second baseman and Brossette was the center fielder.

BRUISER BROOKS BROSSETTE

Brooks Brossette (pronounced Bro-Shay) has turned into a bruising linebacker in Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. The senior stepped into a starting role last season and finished as the team's leading tackler with 106 total tackles, 84 solo stops and 22 assisted tackles. The 106 total tackles is the fifth highest season tackles total since 2002. Brossette had 13 total tackles against Natchitoches Central, including two tackles-for-loss. His 13 tackles marked the first time a Jacket defender had registered double digit tackles last season, and the first since two players had 11 tackles in the 2020 Division I State Championship. Brossette followed that stellar performance against the Chiefs by totaling 12 tackles against Parkway, 12 against Benton, including at season-high 11 solo stops. Five times in 2021, Brossette registered double-digit tackles, including tallying 11 tackles (9 solo, 2 assists) in the season finale against Southwood. Brossette also led the team with 10 tackles-for-loss. He was an All-District and All-City selection.

BUILT FORD TOUGH

Senior defensive end Isaiah Ford helped build Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense into a tough unit in 2021. Ford registered 45 total tackles last season, including a seven tackles-for-loss. He also had two sacks, a pass breakup and an interception to his credit. Ford was a First-Team All-District and All-City selection.

OVER THE AIRWAVES

Byrd football has been broadcast live on AM 1130 The Tiger for over 25 years. Charlie Cavell begins his 25th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson will move into the booth this season as the color analyst, while Larry Little will provide sideline reports. Former Byrd offensive lineman Carlton Holland, Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. Smartphone users can download the 1130 The Tiger app and listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world.

THE 2022 SCHEDULE, POLLS & MORE

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2022 schedule made the playoffs in 2021. Parkway, Benton, Haughton, Natchitoches and Captain Shreve each made it to the 2021 Class 5A playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. Huntington made it to the Class 4A playoffs, while Calvary made it to the Division IV semifinals. The Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 regional finals before losing to the Gilmer Buckeyes. With the LHSAA's spring shakeup of the "select" - "non-select" designations, the Byrd Yellow Jackets are no longer guaranteed a playoff spot in the Division I playoffs. The CrescentCitySports.com poll and the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association poll are expected to come out next week prior to the start of the 2022 season. GeauxPreps is expected to release its Class 5A preseason poll later this week.

2022 OUTLOOK

Offense - with two-year starter Lake Lambert (6'2", 195, Sr.) at quarterback as well as a stable of experienced backs returning, including wingbacks Tyler Nichols (5'6", 165, Sr.) and Josh Allen (5'9", 170, Sr.) and fullback Dixon Poirier (5'10", 175, Jr.) as well as last year's leading rusher in fullback Devon Strickland (5'10", 195, Sr.), should provide Byrd with an arsenal of weapons. The Jackets operate out of a multiple-option offense and are not known for their aerial capabilities. However, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene (6'3", 170, Sr.) hopes to change those perceptions. Dufrene caught the attention of opponents and scouts alike, particularly during summer 7-on-7 competitions and college camps. He received an offer from the University of Arkansas – Monticello after attending the Boll Weevils' summer camp. The emergence of Dufrene as a reliable receiver gives Lambert, who has a strong and accurate arm, another weapon at his disposal. Connor Ridenour (5'8", 150, Sr.), who grew up playing football in Canada before his parents moved the family to Shreveport, is the only other returning receiver. A pair of sophomores in Alex Schoonover and Wesley Morgan are expected to be in the wide receiver rotation as well. If there are any questions about Byrd offensively it's along the offensive line where the Jackets lost four players – center Caleb Aillet, tackles Wyatt McCollum and Guy Stone as well as tight end Patrick Snead. Both starting guards Jack Thigpen (5'10", 190, Sr.) and Kyle Sprague (5'10", 200, Sr.) return. Ballew and his staff are hoping to get starting left tackle Kailen Moore (6'3", 223, Sr.) back after he missed the entire spring with non-football related issues. Johnathon Helton (5'10", 175, Jr.) is slated to take over at center, while Jackson Rust (6'3", 200, Sr.) and Dylan Gillie (6'0", 170, Jr.) are penciled in at the right and left tackle spots, respectively. Expect Colton Miller (5'11", 263, Sr.) and Owen Scott (6'2", 215, Jr.) to vie for playing time as well. The Purple Swarm Defense will be led by All-District, All-City performers in linebacker Brooks Brossette (6'0", 185, Sr.) and defensive end Isaiah Ford (6'2", 195, Sr.). With a nose for the football and a high-intensity motor, Brossette registered 106 total tackles, including 10 tackles-for-loss, last season. Ford, who features a long, lean frame with a wide wingspan, had 45 tackles, seven tackles-for-loss and two sacks as a junior. In addition to Ford, Byrd returns tackles Brennan Belanger (5'10", 205, Sr.) and Ben Martinson (6'1", 230, Sr.) to its four-man defensive front. The two tackles combined for 44 tackles, seven tackles-for-loss and three sacks a year ago. Wyatt Watkins (6'2", 180, Sr.), who played linebacker last season, moves down to defensive end opposite of Ford. Watkins had 18 tackles and four tackles-for-loss as a reserve linebacker in 2021. Because Brossette grabs the majority of the accolades, and rightfully so, the other linebacker in Byrd's 4-2-5 defensive scheme often gets overlooked. William Whitman (5'11", 165, Sr.) and Ashton Fullwood (5'10", 205, Jr.) will compete for the starting job opposite of Brossette. Both players saw substantial playing time last season. With the graduation of safeties Ryan Todd and John Jordan as well as cornerbacks Ja'Kerryon LaCour and Tyler Poland, the Yellow Jackets will need to replace a good portion of its defensive backfield. However, LaMichael Taylor (5'10", 163, Sr.), Christian Jones (6'0", 165, Sr.) and Jude Partington (5'10", 155, Sr.) all saw significant playing time throughout the 2021 season. Jones really burst on to the scene last year for Byrd and finished the season as the Jackets' second-leading tackler with 50 tackles, including 38 solo stops. Expect Walker Fox (5'10", 165, Sr.), who moved from the offensive to defense in the spring, Grant Johnson (5'11, 176, Jr.) along with Braylin Daniels (5'9", 140, Sr.) and Jason Green (5'10", 165, Sr.) to compete for playing time. Over the last 25 years Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of exceptional place kickers, including last year's starter Michael Hamaeui, who's now playing soccer at Millsaps College. Primed to carry on that tradition is junior Abram Murray (6'1", 180, Jr.), who sat out last season after transferring from Calvary Baptist Academy. Murray, who's slated for the Class of 2024, already has offers from Power 5 schools like Arkansas and Miami and is ranked as the top kicking prospect for 2024. Matthew Booras (5'11", 135, Jr.) will once again handle the punting duties for Byrd. Booras averaged 33.9 yards per punt as a sophomore last season.
