FIRST-EVER TRIP TO TIGER STADIUM

On Friday, Sept. 30, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River to north Bossier Parish and to Benton's Tiger Stadium for a District 1-5A battle with the Benton Tigers. It's Byrd's first-ever visit to Tiger Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAMS

The Byrd Yellow Jackets are 4-0 overall and 1-0 in District 1-5A after last Thursday's hard-fought 25-20 win over the Captain Shreve Gators. The Yellow Jackets are ranked seventh in the latest Louisiana Sports Writer's Association poll. The Benton Tigers own a 1-3 overall record and a 0-1 district record after last Friday's lopsided 75-59 loss to the Airline Vikings.

LAST TIME OUT

The Byrd Yellow Jackets defeated the Captain Shreve Gators 25-20 last Thursday in the 45th edition of the "Backyard Brawl." After Shreve missed a field goal late in the game, Byrd drove 80 yards in six plays and took a commanding 25-12 lead on Devon Strickland's 8-yard touchdown run and 2-point conversion rush. In one of the craziest football games in local history, the Airline Vikings defeated the Benton Tigers 75-59 last Friday in Benton. The Vikings amassed over 700 yards of total offense, including a school-record 412 passing yards by quarterback Ben Taylor, in the win.

THE SERIES

This will be only the third meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Benton Tigers. Benton moved up from Class 4A to 5A and into District 1 in 2019. Byrd defeated Benton 46-31 in the first-ever meeting and the Yellow Jackets beat the Tigers 45-17 last year. The two teams used to meet in the annual spring game back when Mitch Downey, who's now the Superintendent of Bossier Parish Schools, was the Benton head coach and Mike Suggs was the Byrd head coach.

THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 13-2 record at Byrd, which is the best record for a Yellow Jackets head coach since 1960-61 when legendary coach J.D. Cox posted an 13-2 record in his first 15 games.

Reynolds Moore is in his 10th season as the head coach of the Benton Tigers. He owns a 68-34 record in his previous nine seasons as the Tigers' head coach. Moore has taken the Tigers to the playoffs in eight of his nine seasons at Benton. His overall coaching record is 80-66. Moore spent his first four years as a head coach at Bolton High School in Alexandria. He posted a 11-29 record those four seasons. Moore is 0-2 versus Byrd.

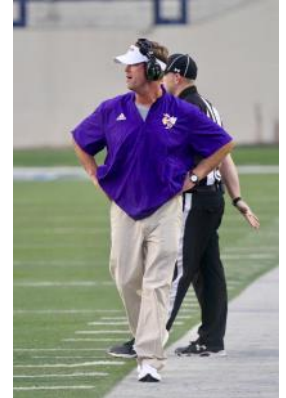
THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew is in his second season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.



Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 43-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

2022 marks the 118th season of Yellow Jackets football and the 97th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school's name change in late September of that year...In those 21 seasons of SHS football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times... Shreveport-Byrd owns a 677-426-35 (.611) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 13-2 record through his first 15 games, which is the best start for a Byrd head coach since J.D. Cox posted an identical 13-2 record through 15 games in 1960 -61...Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the school's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs 16 of the last 17 years, the longest run in school history...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-31-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...After 34-7 win over Pleasant Grove, Ballew is now 2-0 in season openers, both wins coming on Sept. 2nd...With its 34-7 win over Pleasant Grove, the Yellow Jackets own a 62-53-3 record in season openers...Jackson Dufrene caught a 32-yard touchdown pass and added a 49-yard touchdown run in the win over Pleasant Grove...Dufrene is the first Yellow Jacket to score rushing and receiving touchdowns in the same game since William Berry did it in the 2019 playoff loss to St. Augustine...Berry had a 65-yard reception and a 13-yard run against Purple Knights...Dufrene's first TD reception of his career came on a 25-yard reception against Benton in 2021...Dufrene has caught TD passes in three of Byrd's first four games this season...All three of Lake Lambert's touchdown passes this season have been to Dufrene...Lambert has eight career TD passes...Lambert's three completions in six attempts for 58 yards and a touchdown against Pleasant Grove equaled or bettered his 2021 season highs...Lambert followed that performance by going 6-for-6 for 79 yards passing against Huntington...However, Lambert rushed for a career-high 185 yards and two TDs against Huntington...His 95-yard touchdown run against the Raiders was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history...Lambert was 7-for-8 passing for a career-high 146 yards against Calvary...Dixon Poirier's two touchdown runs against PG marked the second time in his career he's scored two rushing touchdowns in a game...The first coming in the 2021 season opener against Huntington...Poirier rushed for a career-high 144 yards against the Raiders...As a team the Jackets rushed for 423 yards, which was the most since rushing for 412 against Airline in week 8 of the 2021 season...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense did not allow Pleasant Grove to score an offensive touchdown...It had been since week two of the 2021 season in Byrd's 18-3 win over Tioga that the defense had not given up a touchdown...Josh Allen had a brilliant 72-yard run to set up Byrd's first touchdown against Pleasant Grove...It was the longest rush of Allen's career, but unfortunately he was injured on the play and is out indefinitely...With its 14-7 win over Calvary, Byrd has won 21 of its last 22 regular season games dating back to the 2020 season...The lone blemish was last year's 23-10 loss to Natchitoches Central...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 10-0 since...Against Calvary, Byrd had 146 passing yards and 99 rushing yards...It was the first time since the 2019 game versus Natchitoches Central (a 9-7 Jackets win) that Byrd had more passing yards than rushing yards...The Jackets' 99 rushing yards against the Cavaliers was the lowest total since the 2021 Natchitoches Central game when they had only 97 rushing yards...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense is allowing just 14 points per game through the first four games, which is just 2.75 points higher than the 2021 defense allowed.

LAST TIME VERSUS THE TIGERS

In last season's meeting between Byrd and Benton, the Yellow Jackets scored 31 first-half points to cruise to a 45-17 win over the Tigers. The Jackets amassed 421 rushing yards in the game and were led by Josh Allen's 122 yards on just eight carries. Mitchell Ramsey scored on runs of 3 and 25 yards.

SHREVEPORT'S GREAT LAKE

Most have heard of the Great Lakes of North America - Superior, Michigan, Huron, Erie, and Ontario. Shreveport has its own Great Lake in Byrd senior quarterback Lake Lambert. Lambert, who's 6'3", 190 lbs., led the Jackets to the state championship as a sophomore and the quarterfinals as a junior. In 2020, Lambert was the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995. In the 24 games he's started at Byrd (missed two games due to injury in 2021), Lambert has led Byrd to 21 wins. In those 24 games, he's rushed for 1,152 yards, 13 touchdowns and averaged 5.3 yards per carry. He's completed 61 of his 112 pass attempts for 1,088 yards and eight touchdowns and has thrown just one interception, which came in 2020. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Lambert had three pass completions for 58 yards and a touchdown. He was 6-for-6 passing for 79 yards against Huntington, but it was his rushing performance against the Raiders that was most impressive. Lambert had 15 carries for 185 yards and two touchdowns against the Raiders, all career highs (equaled TDs). His second touchdown run came on a 95-yard scamper, which was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history. Lambert was 7-for-8 passing for a career-high 146 yards and a touchdown against Calvary. In Byrd's 25-20 win against Captain Shreve, Lambert rushed for a game-high 142 yards and a touchdown. He's thrown touchdown passes in three of Byrd's four games, all to receiver Jackson Dufrene.

GOING TO JACKSON

Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene has been quarterback Lake Lambert's "go-to" guy. Dufrene, who's a senior, has caught a touchdown pass in three of Byrd's four games, including back-to-back games. He caught a 41-yard touchdown pass in Byrd's 14-7 win over Calvary, which was a career-long at the time. He bested that mark with a 44-yard touchdown reception against Captain Shreve. On the season, Dufrene is Byrd's leading receiver with 10 receptions for 200 yards. He's averaging 20 yards per reception and 50 receiving yards per game. Dufrene is tied with Dixon Poirier for the team lead in scoring with 24 points. He leads the team in all-purpose yards with 103.2 per game.

STRICKLAND SPEAKING

Senior running back Devon Strickland led the team in rushing in 2021 with 937 yards. He scored six rushing touchdowns and one receiving last season. Strickland averaged 7.0 yards per carry and 93.7 yards per game. He rushed for 206 yards in last year's season-opener against Huntington, which was the first time since 2018 a Byrd back had rushed for over 200 yards. Strickland had 24 yards on nine carries and one touchdown against Pleasant Grove. Strickland moved from fullback to wingback after Josh Allen's injury in the opener against Pleasant Grove. Against Huntington, Strickland had four carries for 29 yards, but was Byrd's leading receiver with four receptions for a team-high 53 yards. On Byrd's decisive scoring drive against Captain Shreve, Strickland had 55 yards on five carries, including an 8-yard touchdown run. He also ran in the 2-point conversion.

JOHNSON JAUNTS PAST GATORS

Sophomore wingback Malachi Johnson made the most of his first significant action as a Jacket. Johnson rushed for 84 yards on just three carries against Shreve. On third down and 20, Johnson rushed for 28 yards and a first down, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. On his second carry of the game, Johnson juked his way for 36 yards and another first down. That drive resulted in a field goal. His 20-yard jaunt started Byrd's decisive 10-play, 80-yard, fourth quarter drive.

BROOKS IS BACK DOING BROSSETTE-LIKE THINGS

After missing the jamboree with an injury, linebacker Brooks Brossette was back in action for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense in the season opener against Pleasant Grove. Brossette came back in style as he led the team with seven total tackles, including six solo stops, and two tackles-for-loss. For his efforts, Brossette was named the KTBS TV3 Bob Griffin's Player-of-the-Week. The senior stepped into a starting role last season and finished as the team's leading tackler with 106 total tackles, 84 solo stops and 22 assisted tackles. The 106 total tackles is the fifth highest season tackles total since 2002. Brossette had a career-high 13 total tackles against Natchitoches Central, including two tackles-for-loss. His 13 tackles marked the first time a Jacket defender had registered double digit tackles last season, and the first since two players had 11 tackles in the 2020 Division I State Championship game versus Catholic. Brossette followed that stellar performance against the Chiefs with three consecutive double-digit tackle games. Five times in 2021, Brossette registered double-digit tackles. He also led the team with 10 tackles-for-loss. He was an All-District and All-City selection in 2021. Brossette has registered double-digit tackles in his last two games - 11 vs. Calvary and 12 vs. Shreve. In his 3-year varsity career, Brossette has 152 total tackles. He needs just one more tackle to move into 10th place on the career tackles list.

THEY CALL HIM MR. JONES

In his three-year varsity career, Byrd safety Christian Jones has had propensity for making big plays. None was bigger than his goal-line interception of Calvary quarterback Bryce Carpenter's pass in the final minute of the game. Jones' interception, which he returned 69 yards, sealed the 14-7 victory for the Yellow Jackets. That only tells part of the story. Jones also had 10 total tackles, including seven solo stops, and two pass breakups equaling or setting career highs against the Cavaliers. On the season, Jones has 28 total tackles, including 21 solo stops. He has two tackles-for-loss and four pass breakups to go along with his big interception.

WHAT DOES THE FOX SAY?

Byrd defensive back Walker Fox doesn't say a whole lot, instead letting his play on the field speak for itself. Fox, who moved from offense to defense this season, has made an impact for the Purple Swarm Defense. Through four games in his new role, Fox has registered 25 total tackles, including 16 solo stops, three tackles-for-loss, a forced fumble, a fumble recovery and two pass breakups. He's also the holder on place kicks and has done an outstanding job handling the snaps from Grant Johnson. Byrd is 13-for-13 on PAT kicks and 2-for-2 on field goals.

BUILT FORD TOUGH

Last season, Byrd defensive end Isaiah Ford emerged as a tough defender to block. Ford registered 45 total tackles in 2021, including seven tackles-for-loss, two sacks, a pass breakup and an interception to his credit. Ford was a First-Team All-District and All-City selection in 2021. In the first four games of the 2022 season, Ford has tallied 21 tackles, three tackles-for-loss and three sacks. Ford has registered a sack in each of Byrd's last three games.

A LOOK AHEAD

The Byrd Yellow Jackets will celebrate Homecoming 2022 on Friday, Oct. 7, when they play host to the Haughton Buccaneers.

THE 2022 SCHEDULE, POLLS & MORE

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2022 schedule made the playoffs in 2021. Parkway, Benton, Houghton, Natchitoches and Captain Shreve each made it to the 2021 Class 5A playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. Huntington made it to the Class 4A playoffs, while Calvary made it to the Division IV semifinals. The Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 regional finals before losing to the Gilmer Buckeyes. With the LHSAA's spring shakeup of the "select" - "non-select" designations, the Byrd Yellow Jackets are no longer guaranteed a playoff spot in the Division I playoffs. The Destrehan Wildcats occupy the top spot in two of the three statewide polls - Louisiana Sports Writer's Association and CrescentCitySports.com. Despite having to forfeit their first three wins of the season, the Karr Cougars are the top-ranked in the GeauxPreps.com poll. With its 25-20 win over Captain Shreve, Byrd is ranked 7th in the LSWA poll, 8th by CCS and 9th by GeauxPreps. After its loss to Byrd, Shreve dropped out of the Top 10 in all three polls. Parkway is among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps.com poll, while both the Panthers and the Gators received votes in the LSWA poll and were among the "others" in the CCS.com poll.

THE TRADITION CONTINUES

Byrd has a long history of outstanding place kickers and punters. Junior Abram Murray is continuing that tradition. In his first-ever field goal attempt as a Byrd Yellow Jacket, Murray booted a 45-yarder against the Huntington Raiders. Murray surpassed that personal best with a 49-yard field goal against Captain Shreve. He's a perfect 13-for-13 on extra point kicks. Sixteen of his 21 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponents average starting field position is the 21 yard line. Murray and Matthew Booras have split punting duties. The duo has punted 13 times for a 35.8 average. They've had four fair catches and four punts downed inside the 20.
