SHOWDOWN IN SOBO

On Friday, Oct. 24, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River to south Bossier City for a showdown with the undefeated Parkway Panthers. Kickoff for the "Showdown in SoBo" is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Preston Crownover Stadium.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAMS

The Byrd Yellow Jackets are 4-2 overall and 1-2 in District 1-5A after last Friday's 23-14 loss to the Haughton Buccaneers. The Parkway Panthers are a perfect 6-0 and 3-0 in District 1-5A after last Thursday's 55-6 shellacking of the Southwood Cowboys. The Panthers are ranked in the Top 10 in all major polls.

LAST TIME OUT

Trailing Haughton 17-14 in the second half, Byrd turned the ball over on four consecutive possessions. Haughton running back Tyler Rhodes rushed for 150 yards and two touch-downs. Rhodes' 29-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter propelled the Bucs to a 23-14 win over the Yellow Jackets. The Parkway Panthers used the momentum of a 38-point halftime lead to roll past the Southwood Cowboys, 55-6, last Thursday at Independence Stadium.

THE SERIES

This will be the 39th meeting between Byrd and Parkway. The Yellow Jackets lead the series 22-16. This series began in 1970 with a 28-12 Byrd win, the first of three straight for the Jackets before Parkway posted its first win, 13-0, in 1977. Last year, the Yellow Jackets defeated the Panthers 35-24 in Bossier City. In the 11 games since Parkway moved into District 1-5A, Byrd leads the series 6-5. However, the Byrd-Parkway series has historically been a series of streaks - from 1970-79 Byrd won six of the seven games; 1980-89 Parkway won eight of the 10 games; 1991-2008 Byrd won nine of the 10 games; 2011-16 Parkway won four of the six games, while Byrd has won four of the last five games.

THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 13-4 record at Byrd. Parkway is coached by Coy Brotherton, who is in his third season at the helm of the Panthers program. Brotherton owns a 17-10 record at Parkway and a 49-27 overall record. He moved over to Parkway after spending five years at Captain Shreve as the Gators' offensive coordinator. Before Shreve he was the head coach at Plain Dealing for four years compiling a 30-17 (.638), which is second best in Lions history. Brotherton comes from a family of football coaches. His father coached at Haughton for 33 years, including the Bucs 1977 State Championship season, while his brother, Jason, is the head coach at Haughton.

THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew is in his second season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.



In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the

football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.



Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 43-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

2022 marks the 118th season of Yellow Jackets football and the 97th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school's name change in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of SHS football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 677-428-35 (.610) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 13-4 record through his first 17 games...Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the school's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs 16 of the last 17 years, the longest run in school history...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-31-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double -digit wins, a first in school history...After 34-7 win over Pleasant Grove, Ballew is 2-0 in season openers, both wins coming on Sept. 2nd...With its 34-7 win over Pleasant Grove, the Yellow Jackets own a 62-53-3 record in season openers...Jackson Dufrene caught a 32 -yard touchdown pass and added a 49-yard touchdown run in the win over Pleasant Grove...Dufrene is the first Yellow Jacket to score rushing and receiving touchdowns in the same game since William Berry did it in the 2019 playoff loss to St. Augustine...Berry had a 65-yard reception and a 13-yard run against Purple Knights...Dufrene's first TD reception of his career came on a 25-yard reception against Benton in 2021...Dufrene has caught TD passes in four of Byrd's five games this season, including a 57-yarder against Benton, the longest of his career...All four of Lake Lambert's touchdown passes this season have been to Dufrene...Lambert has nine career TD passes...Lambert's three completions in six attempts for 58 yards and a touchdown against Pleasant Grove equaled or bettered his 2021 season highs...Lambert followed that performance by going 6-for-6 for 79 yards passing against Huntington...However, Lambert rushed for a career-high 185 yards and two TDs against Huntington...His 95-yard touchdown run against the Raiders was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history...Lambert was 7-for-8 passing for a career-high 146 yards against Calvary...Dixon Poirier's two touchdown runs against Pleasant Grove marked the second time in his career he's scored two rushing touchdowns in a game...The first coming in the 2021 season opener against Huntington...Poirier rushed for a career-high 144 yards against the Raiders...As a team the Jackets rushed for 423 yards, which was the most since rushing for 412 against Airline in week 8 of the 2021 season...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense did not allow Pleasant Grove to score an offensive touchdown...It had been since week two of the 2021 season in Byrd's 18-3 win over Tioga that the defense had not given up a touchdown...Josh Allen had a brilliant 72-yard run to set up Byrd's first touchdown against Pleasant Grove...It was the longest rush of Allen's career, but unfortunately he was injured on the play and is hopeful to return against Parkway...Benton's 63 points against Byrd was the second highest point total allowed by the Jackets in program history...The highest was a 70-6 loss to Southwood in 1988...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 10-0 against Caddo Parish schools since... Against Calvary, Byrd had 146 passing yards and 99 rushing yards...It was the first time since the 2019 game versus Natchitoches Central (a 9-7 Jackets win) that Byrd had more passing yards than rushing yards...The Jackets' 99 rushing yards against the Cavaliers was the lowest total since the 2021 Natchitoches Central game when they had only 97 rushing yards...Benton quarterback Gray Walters' 516 passing yards and 8 touchdowns were the most ever by an opposing quarterback against the Yellow Jackets...Walters' was responsible for 48 of Benton's 63 points, which was the most ever against Byrd...Tigers' receiver Pearce Russell had 12 catches for 267 yards, which were the most receptions and yards ever allowed by Byrd...Russell's 4 receiving touchdowns tied Natchitoches Central's Kendrick Aaron, who had four in 2010...Byrd's four turnovers (3 fumbles, 1 interception) on four consecutive possessions in the second half against Haughton were the most turnovers for a Byrd team in a game since the 2018 season opener versus Calvary.

Sophomore wingback Malachi Johnson, who's only 5'4" and 140, has been dynamite for Byrd the last three weeks. Johnson rushed for 84 yards on just three carries against Shreve. On third down and 20, Johnson rushed for 28 yards and a first down, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. On his second carry of the game, Johnson juked his way for 36 yards and another first down. That drive resulted in a field goal. His 20-yard jaunt started Byrd's decisive 10-play, 80-yard, fourth quarter drive. Against Benton, Johnson was Byrd's leading rusher with 89 yards, including a dazzling 41-yard touchdown run. Johnson has rushed for 198 yards on 34 carries and two touchdowns in four games.

On Byrd's opening drive of the second half against Benton, guarterback Lake Lambert was injured and had to be carted off the field. Lambert hopes to return for the Parkway game. In 2020, Lambert was the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995. In the 25 games he's started at Byrd (missed three games due to injury), Lambert has led Byrd to 21 wins. In those 25 games, he's rushed for 1,165 yards, 13 touchdowns and averaged 5.3 yards per carry. He's completed 63 of his 116 pass attempts for 1,174 yards and nine touchdowns and has thrown just one interception, which came in 2020. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Lambert had three pass completions for 58 yards and a touchdown. He was 6-for-6 passing for 79 yards against Huntington, but it was his rushing performance against the Raiders that was most impressive. Lambert had 15 carries for 185 yards and two touchdowns against the Raiders, all career highs (equaled TDs). His second touchdown run came on a 95-yard scamper, which was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history. Lambert was 7-for-8 passing for a career-high 146 yards and a touchdown against Calvary. In Byrd's 25-20 win against Captain Shreve, Lambert rushed for a game-high 142 yards and a touchdown. Lambert has thrown touchdown passes in four of the five games in which he's played, all to receiver Jackson Dufrene.

GOING TO JACKSON

Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene has been quarterback Lake Lambert's "go-to" guy. Dufrene, who's a senior, has caught a touchdown pass in four of Byrd's six games. He caught a 41-yard touchdown pass in Byrd's 14-7 win over Calvary, which was a career-long at the time. He bested that mark with a 44-yard touchdown reception against Captain Shreve. Against Benton, Dufrene caught a 57-yarder, which is his new career best. On the season, Dufrene is Byrd's leading receiver with 15 receptions for 348 yards. He's averaging 23.2 yards per reception and 58.0 receiving yards per game. Dufrene leads the team in scoring with 30 points. He also leads the team in all-purpose yards with 98.5 per game.

STRICKLAND SPEAKING

Senior running back Devon Strickland, who led the team in rushing in 2021 with 937 yards, has been playing through a lower leg injury he suffered in the Calvary game. Strickland had 24 yards on nine carries and one touchdown against Pleasant Grove. Strickland moved from fullback to wingback after Josh Allen's injury in the opener against Pleasant Grove. Against Huntington, Strickland had four carries for 29 yards, but was Byrd's leading receiver with four receptions for a team-high 53 yards. On Byrd's decisive scoring drive against Captain Shreve, Strickland had 55 yards on five carries, including an 8-yard touchdown run. He also ran in the 2-point conversion. This season he's rushed for 231 vards on 54 carries and has scored three touchdowns.

BROSSETTE CONTINUES CLIMB UP CAREER TACKLES LIST

Despite being bothered by a lower leg injury, linebacker Brooks Brossette has been leading Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. After missing the Jamboree, Brossette came back in style as he led the team with seven total tackles, including six solo stops, and two tacklesfor-loss. For his efforts, Brossette was named the KTBS TV3 Bob Griffin's Player-of-the-Week. The senior stepped into a starting role last season and finished as the team's leading tackler with 106 total tackles, 84 solo stops and 22 assisted tackles. The 106 total tackles is the fifth highest season tackles total since 2002. Brossette had a career-high 13 total tackles against Natchitoches Central, including two tackles-for-loss. His 13 tackles marked the first time a Jacket defender had registered double digit tackles last season, and the first since two players had 11 tackles in the 2020 Division I State Championship game versus Catholic. Brossette followed that stellar performance against the Chiefs with three consecutive double-digit tackle games. Five times in 2021, Brossette registered double-digit tackles. He also led the team with 10 tackles-for-loss. He was an All-District and All-City selection in 2021. Brossette has registered double-digit tackles in three of Byrd's six games this season. With his three-year varsity career total of 171 tackles, Brossette climbed into seventh place on the career Top 10 tackles list.

MR. JONES AND ME

In his three-year varsity career, Byrd safety Christian Jones has had propensity for making big plays. None was bigger than his goal-line interception of Calvary quarterback Bryce Carpenter's pass in the final minute of the game. Jones' interception, which he returned 69 yards, sealed the 14-7 victory for the Yellow Jackets. That only tells part of the story. Jones also had 10 total tackles, including seven solo stops, and two pass breakups equaling or setting career highs against the Cavaliers. On the season, Jones has 44 total tackles, including 31 solo stops. He has two tackles-for-loss and five pass breakups to go along with two interceptions. His big play propensity continued against Benton as he returned a kickoff 80 yards for a touchdown. It was Byrd's first kickoff return for a touchdown since Mitchell Ramsey's 50-yard TD return against Airline in 2020.

BUILT FORD TOUGH

Last season, Byrd defensive end Isaiah Ford emerged as a tough defender to block. Ford registered 45 total tackles in 2021, including seven tackles-for-loss, two sacks, a pass breakup and an interception to his credit. Ford was a First-Team All-District and All-City selection in 2021. Against Haughton, Ford had one of the best games of his career setting career highs with six solo stops, three assists, nine total tackles, three tackles-for-loss and 2.5 sacks. On the season he has 37 total tackles, seven tackles-for-loss and 5.5 sacks.

HEY JUDE

Byrd defensive back Jude Partington has had a productive senior season. Partington has registered 19 total tackles, including 11 solo stops and one tackle-for-loss. However, it has been his knack for creating turnovers that has been key for the Purple Swarm Defense. Partington has two interceptions for 37 return yards. Against Benton, Jude recovered a fumble and returned it 70 yards for a touchdown. It was the fifth longest fumble return for a touchdown in the 118-year history of Yellow Jackets football.

A LOOK AHEAD

On Thursday, Oct. 20, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play host to the red-hot Airline Vikings. Kickoff is set for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium..

A BATTLE OF KICKERS?

When Byrd and Parkway meet on Friday night there will be a battle inside the war between the Yellow Jackets and Panthers involving the two respective place kickers - Byrd's Abram Murray and Parkway's Aeron Burrel. The kickers are the top two rated junior kickers in the country, and for good reason. Burrel is 24-of-26 on PAT kicks, 7-of-9 on field goals, including a Bossier Parish record 52-yarder. Thirty-six of his 37 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. On his first-ever field goal attempt as a Byrd Yellow Jacket, Murray booted a 45-yarder against the Huntington Raiders. Murray surpassed that personal best with a 49-yard field goal against Captain Shreve. He's a perfect 19-for-19 on extra point kicks. Twenty-two of his 29 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponents average starting field position is the 21 yard line. Murray also averages 39.1 yards per punt.

THE 2022 SCHEDULE, POLLS & MORE

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2022 schedule made the playoffs in 2021. Parkway, Benton, Haughton, Natchitoches and Captain Shreve each made it to the 2021 Class 5A playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. Huntington made it to the Class 4A playoffs, while Calvary made it to the Division IV semifinals. The Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 regional finals before losing to the Gilmer Buckeyes. With the LHSAA's spring shakeup of the "select" - "non-select" designations, the Byrd Yellow Jackets are no longer guaranteed a playoff spot in the Division I playoffs. The Destrehan Wildcats occupy the top spot in two of the three statewide polls - Louisiana Sports Writer's Association and CrescentCitySports.com again this week. Despite having to forfeit their first three wins of the season, the Karr Cougars are the top -ranked in the GeauxPreps.com poll. The Parkway Panthers are ranked in all three polls. The undefeated Panthers are eighth in LSWA, ninth in GeauxPreps and 10th in CCS .

TURNOVER BUG BITES BYRD

The turnover bug has bitten the Byrd Yellow Jackets hard this season, particularly the last three weeks. In its first three games, Byrd turned the ball over only twice. In the last three games, the Yellow Jackets have turned the ball over 10 times (8 fumbles, 2 interceptions). Against Haughton, Byrd had turned the ball over on four consecutive possessions (3 fumbles, 1 interception) in the second half. Coaches and analysts often speak about points off of turnovers being the difference between winning and losing. This season opponents have scored six touchdowns (36 points and one missed field goal) off of the Jackets' 12 turnovers. In comparison to last season, Byrd turned the ball over only seven times in 11 games, and opponents scored just 12 points (1 touchdown and 2 field goals) off of those seven turnovers.

OVER THE AIRWAVES

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for over 25 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 25th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-byplay action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while Larry Little provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton, Chad Ardoin and former Byrd offensive lineman Carlton Holland are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. You can download the 1130 The Tiger app to your smart device and listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world. Home games are video live-streamed on the NFHS Network, which is a subscription service.
