## THE SERIES

## REGULAR SEASON FINALE IN NATCHITOCHES

On Friday, Nov. 4, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel south on Interstate 49 to Natchitoches to battle the Natchitoches Central Chiefs in the regular season finale. Kickoff for the District 1-5A game is scheduled for 7 p.m. at "Rags" Turpin Stadium.

## A little bit about the teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets are 6-3 overall and 3-3 in District 1-5A after last Friday's 58-0 thrashing of the Southwood Cowboys. The Natchitoches Central Chiefs are 3-6 overall and 3-3 in District 1-5A after losing 56-20 last Friday to the Haughton Buccaneers.

## LAST TIME OUT

The Byrd Yellow Jackets jumped out to a 37-0 halftime lead then cruised to a 58-0 win over the Southwood Cowboys last Friday at Independence Stadium. Byrd's Desmond Simmons rushed for 106 yards and scored four touchdowns to lead the Jackets. Colin Rains and Tyler Rhodes led the way for Haughton as the Bucs defeated the Natchitoches Central Chiefs 56-20 at Harold Harlan Stadium last Friday. Rains finished 10-of-15 passing for 228 yards and two touchdowns, while Rhodes had 15 carries for 92 yards and two TDs - and threw for another.

This will be the 39th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Natchitoches Central Chiefs in a series that dates back to 1920. The Yellow Jackets lead the overall series 289 , and there has been one tie, a scoreless affair in 1920 . These two schools met on the gridiron every year from 1993 to 2010. In those 18 meetings, the Jackets posted a 12-6 record against the Chiefs. Since 2002, Byrd has won 11 of the 13 games against Natchitoches Central, including eight straight from 2002-09. Natchitoches Central's two wins came in 2010, when the Chiefs beat the Yellow Jackets 33-31 at Turpin Stadium, and last year's 23-10 Natchitoches victory in Shreveport.

## THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An AllDistrict offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 15-5 record at Byrd. Natchitoches Central is coached by James Wilkerson, III, who is in his third year at the helm of Chiefs football program. Wilkerson is a former Byrd assistant coach, who served a total of 10 years in two separate stints as the running backs coach under Suggs. He took over the program from Byron Keller, who was 6-14 in his two seasons at Natchitoches Central. The Chiefs went 0-8 in Wilkerson's first season, and 7-4 last season. A Northwestern State alum, Wilkerson served as the head coach of the St. Mary's Tigers from 2004-07. The Tigers went 22-20 (.524) in four seasons under Wilkerson.

## THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew is in his second season as the head coach of the C．E．Byrd Yellow Jackets． However，Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life， four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach，at the Line Avenue school．

An All－District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter，Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992－95．He was a sophomore on Byrd＇s 1993 District Championship team that went 10－1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8－ 3．After graduating in 1996，he returned to his alma mater in 1998，working as an assistant coach，while attending LSU Shreveport．He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001，Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching posi－ tion at Acton Junior High School in Granbury，Texas．His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs．


In 2005，Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football，where he＇d remain for 16 seasons，to coach linebackers．Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009．He＇d oversee some of the top＂Purple Swarm Defens－ es＂in school history．


Under his tutelage，the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game．Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry．

After Suggs retired in May 2021，Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jack－ ets football history．

The 43 －year－old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years．The couple has twins，LeighAnne and Jackson，who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

## YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

2022 marks the 118th season of Yellow Jackets football and the 97th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season prior to the school's name change in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of SHS football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...ShreveportByrd owns a 680-429-35 (.610) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 15-5 record through his first 20 games...Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the school's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs 16 of the last 17 years, the longest run in school history... Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 31 different seasons and holds a 33-31-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double -digit wins, a first in school history...Jackson Dufrene caught a 32-yard touchdown pass and added a 49-yard touchdown run in the win over Pleasant Grove...Dufrene is the first Yellow Jacket to score rushing and receiving touchdowns in the same game since William Berry did it in the 2019 playoff loss to St. Augustine...Berry had a 65-yard reception and a 13-yard run against Purple Knights...Dufrene's first TD reception of his career came on a 25-yard reception against Benton in 2021...Dufrene has caught TD passes in four of Byrd's nine games this season, including a 57-yarder against Benton, the longest of his career...All four of Lake Lambert's touchdown passes this season have been to Dufrene...Lambert has nine career TD passes...Lambert has 30 completions this season which is the most in his three-year varsity career...Lambert rushed for a career-high 185 yards and two TDs against Huntington...His 95-yard touchdown run against the Raiders was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history...Lambert was 7 -for- 8 passing for a career-high 146 yards against Calvary...Dixon Poirier's two touchdown runs against Pleasant Grove marked the second time in his career he's scored two rushing touchdowns in a game...The first coming in the 2021 season opener against Huntington...Poirier rushed for a career-high 144 yards against the Raiders...As a team the Jackets rushed for 423 yards against the Hawks, which was the most since rushing for 412 against Airline in week eight of the 2021 season...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense did not allow Pleasant Grove to score an offensive touchdown...It had been since week two of the 2021 season in Byrd's 18-3 win over Tioga that the defense had not given up a touchdown...Josh Allen scored two touchdowns against Parkway making the first time he's scored two TDs in a game since last year's 45-17 win over Benton...Benton's 63 points against Byrd was the second highest point total allowed by the Jackets in program history... The highest was a 70-6 loss to Southwood in 1988...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 11-0 against Caddo Parish schools since...Against Calvary, Byrd had 146 passing yards and 99 rushing yards...It was the first time since the 2019 game versus Natchitoches Central (a 9-7 Jackets win) that Byrd had more passing yards than rushing yards...Benton quarterback Gray Walters' 516 passing yards and 8 touchdowns were the most ever by an opposing quarterback against the Yellow Jackets...Walters' was responsible for 48 of Benton's 63 points, which was the most ever against Byrd...Tigers' receiver Pearce Russell had 12 catches for 267 yards, which were the most receptions and yards ever allowed by Byrd...Russell's 4 receiving touchdowns tied Natchitoches Central's Kendrick Aaron, who had four in 2010...Byrd's seven rushing touchdowns against Southwood was the most rushing TDs for a Byrd team since tallying 7 against Airline in 2021...Byrd's 39-14 win over No. 8 Parkway at Preston Crownover Stadium was the Yellow Jackets' first road win over a ranked opponent since 2019 when the Jackets upset No. 7 Airline 21-6 in a driving rainstorm at M.D. Ray Field at Airline Stadium...Three this season Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense has held an opponent to less than 40 rushing yards -37 vs. Huntington, 36 vs. Parkway and (-6) vs. Southwood...Devon Strickland's 115 rushing yards against Airline marked the first time a Byrd back other than Lake Lambert had eclipsed the 100-yard rushing plateau...Sophomore fullback Desmond Simmons had 106 rushing yards and 4 TDs vs. Southwood...Simmons was the first Byrd back to score 4 rushing TDs in a games since William Berry had four vs. Airline in 2020.

## LAMBERT'S LEGACY CONTINUES

Senior quarterback Lake Lambert continues to leave an impressive legacy at Byrd High School. After suffering an injury in the Benton game, Lambert returned in a big way against then No. 8 Parkway. Lambert rushed for a game-high 114 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Jackets to a 39-14 win over the Panthers. In 2020, Lambert was the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995. In the 28 games he's started at Byrd (missed three games due to injury), Lambert has led Byrd to 23 wins. In those 28 games, he's rushed for 1,400 yards, 19 touchdowns and averaged 5.4 yards per carry. He's completed 71 of his 135 pass attempts for 1,312 yards and nine touchdowns and has thrown just one interception, which came in 2020. Lambert was 6 -for- 6 passing for 79 yards against Huntington, but it was his rushing performance against the Raiders that was most impressive as he had 15 carries for 185 yards and two touchdowns, all career highs (equaled TDs). His second touchdown run came on a 95-yard scamper, which was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history. Lambert currently leads the team in rushing with 625 yards, which is also a career-high. He's thrown for 578 yards, which is also a career-high, and he needs just 30 more passing yards to pass Brock Restovich and move into 10th place on the career passing leaders list.

## GOING TO JACKSON

Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene has been quarterback Lake Lambert's "go-to" guy. Dufrene, who's a senior, has caught a touchdown pass in four of Byrd's eight games. He caught a 41-yard touchdown pass in Byrd's 14-7 win over Calvary, which was a career-long at the time. He bested that mark with a 44-yard touchdown reception against Captain Shreve. Against Benton, Dufrene caught a 57-yarder, which is his new career best. On the season, Dufrene is Byrd's leading receiver with 17 receptions for 397 yards. He's averaging 23.4 yards per reception and 49.6 receiving yards per game. Dufrene also has four carries for 97 yards and a touchdown. He leads the team in all-purpose yards with 87.9 yards per game. Dufrene's 397 receiving yards is the most for a Byrd receiver since 2015 when Joey Jernigan had 15 receptions for 412 yards and five touchdowns. Dufrene needs 121 more receiving yards to crack the Top 10 for receiving yards in a season.

## STRICKLAND SPEAKING

Senior running back Devon Strickland, who led the team in rushing in 2021 with 937 yards, has been playing through a lower leg injury he suffered in the Calvary game. Despite the injury, Strickland has looked like his old self the last three games. He rushed for 80 yards on 17 carries and a touchdown against Parkway, and against Airline, Strickland had 115 yards on 17 carries and a touchdown. The 115-yard output was his highest rushing total of the season. He was the first Byrd back other than Lake Lambert to eclipse the 100-yard mark in a game this season. He had 54 yards on nine carries against Southwood in one half of action. For the season, Strickland has rushed for 480 yards on 90 carries and has scored five touchdowns. He also has 10 receptions for 163 yards.

## SIMMONS' SENSATIONAL NIGHT VERSUS SOUTHWOOD

Sophomore fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational night carrying the football in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood. Simmons rushed for a game-high 106 yards and scored four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper to close out the scoring. Simmons was the first Byrd back to score four rushing touchdowns in a game since William Berry reached the end zone four times against Airline in 2020. It was only the fifth time this season a Byrd back has rushed for over 100 yards in a game.

## BROSSETTE MOVES INTO TOP 5

Despite being bothered by a lower leg injury, linebacker Brooks Brossette has been leading Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. After missing the Jamboree, Brossette came back in style as he led the team with seven total tackles, including six solo stops, and two tackles-for-loss against Pleasant Grove. For his efforts, Brossette was named the KTBS TV3 Bob Griffin's Player-of-the-Week. The senior stepped into a starting role last season and finished as the team's leading tackler with 106 total tackles, 84 solo stops and 22 assisted tackles. The 106 total tackles is the fifth highest season tackles total since 2002. Brossette tied a career-high 13 with total tackles against Airline. He also added a tackles-for-loss and a interception return for a touchdown of 35 yards. His 13 tackles marked the third straight game Brossette has tallied double-digit tackles. Five times this season, Brossette has registered double-digit tackles, equaling the amount of double-digit tackle games he totaled last season. He also leads the team with 12 tackles-for-loss, two more than he totaled last season. After his 12 tackle performance against Parkway, Brossette was named the Live Oak Environmental / Tim Fletcher Show "Crusher of the Week." An AllDistrict and All-City selection in 2021, Brossette has totaled 198 total tackles in his threeyear varsity career, and he has moved into fifth place on the career Top 10 tackles list.

## MR. JONES AND ME

In his three-year varsity career, Byrd safety Christian Jones has had propensity for making big plays. None was bigger than his goal-line interception of Calvary quarterback Bryce Carpenter's pass in the final minute of the game. Jones' interception, which he returned 69 yards, sealed the 14-7 victory for the Yellow Jackets. That only tells part of the story. Jones also had 10 total tackles, including seven solo stops, and two pass breakups equaling or setting career highs against the Cavaliers. On the season, Jones has 53 total tackles, including 37 solo stops. He has three tackles-for-loss and six pass breakups to go along with his two interceptions. His big play propensity continued against Benton as he returned a kickoff 80 yards for a touchdown. It was Byrd's first kickoff return for a touchdown since Mitchell Ramsey's 50-yard TD return against Airline in 2020. Jones got his second kickoff return for a touchdown, 61 yards, against Southwood.

## BUILT FORD TOUGH

Last season, Byrd defensive end Isaiah Ford emerged as a tough defender to block. Ford registered 45 total tackles in 2021, including seven tackles-for-loss, two sacks, a pass breakup and an interception to his credit. Ford was a First-Team All-District and All-City selection in 2021. In his last four games, Ford has tallied 22 tackles, seven tackles-for-loss and 3.5 sacks. On the season he has 50 total tackles, 11 tackles-for-loss and 6.5 sacks.

## PURPLE SWARM STINGS SOUTHWOOD

Byrd's Purple Swarm defense was impressive in shutting out Southwood 58-0 last Friday. It was Byrd's first shutout victory since beating Southwood 51-0 in 2020. Byrd's defense allowed Southwood just 69 yards of total offense. The Jackets held the Cowboys to negative six rushing yards. It was the lowest rushing output for an opponent since game that 2020 game versus Southwood in which the Cowboys were held to negative 99 rushing yards. Reserve defensive back Jacob "Hunter" Thrasher had two interceptions and a forced fumble in the game.

## A LOOK AHEAD

On Sunday, Nov. 6, the Jackets will find out where they'll be seeded and when they'll play in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs.

Byrd has a long history of outstanding place kickers and punters and junior Abram Murray is continuing that tradition. In his first-ever field goal attempt as a Byrd Yellow Jacket, Murray booted a 45 -yarder against the Huntington Raiders. He surpassed that personal best with a 49 -yard field goal against Captain Shreve. Murray is 3 -for- 6 on field goal attempts. He's 35 -of- 36 on extra point kicks. Thirty-eight of his 46 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks with opponents average starting field position is the 21 yard line. Murray has also punted 18 times and is averaging 39.2 yards per punt. He's had four fair catches and five punts downed inside the 20.

## THE 2022 SCHEDULE, POLLS, POWER RATINGS \& MORE

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2022 schedule made the playoffs in 2021. Parkway, Benton, Haughton, Natchitoches and Captain Shreve each made it to the 2021 Class 5A playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. Huntington made it to the Class 4A playoffs, while Calvary made it to the Division IV semifinals. The Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 regional finals before losing to the Gilmer Buckeyes. With the LHSAA's spring shakeup of the "select" - "non-select" designations, the Byrd Yellow Jackets are no longer guaranteed a playoff spot in the Division I playoffs. The Destrehan Wildcats again occupy the top spot in two of the three statewide polls - Louisiana Sports Writer's Association and CrescentCitySports.com this week. Despite having to forfeit their first three wins of the season, the Karr Cougars are the top-ranked in the GeauxPreps.com poll. Airline, Parkway, Benton and Byrd were among the District 1-5A teams mentioned in the three polls. The Byrd Yellow Jackets currently sit a No. 5 in the latest LHSAA Select Division I Power Rankings. If the Jackets remain in the top eight, they would have a first-round by in the Select Division I Playoffs.
