SEASON ENDS IN METAIRIE

On Friday, Nov. 25, the No. 6 seeded C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets lost 35-14 to No. 3 seeded John Curtis in the LHSAA's Select Division I quarterfinals at Joseph Yenni Stadium in Metairie, La. The loss brought an end to the 118th season of Yellow Jackets Football.

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE TEAM

The Byrd Yellow Jackets finished the season with an 8-4 overall record. The Jackets were the No. 6 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Byrd finished 4-3 and tied for third place in District 1-5A. Byrd loses 10 starters on both sides of the football from this year's team.

LAST TIME OUT

John Curtis running back Marlon Prout rushed for 120 yards and two touchdowns to lead the No. 3 seeded Patriots to a 35-14 win over the No. 6 seeded Byrd Yellow Jackets in the LHSAA's Select Division I quarterfinals at Joe Yenni Stadium in Metairie. With six minutes remaining in the first half and the game tied at seven, John Curtis defensive back Jermal Callio scooped up a Byrd fumble and returned it 20 yards for a Patriots touchdown. Callio's scoop and score was the first of three touchdowns the Patriots would score in that six minute span. Curtis led 28-7 at halftime, then cruised to the 35-14 win.

THE SEASON

The 118th season of Yellow Jackets Football came to an end in Metairie on Friday, Nov. 25, 2022, but that loss doesn't diminish what was another outstanding season for Byrd. For the third consecutive season, second under Stacy Ballew, the Yellow Jackets won at least eight games. And, for the 13th consecutive season Byrd reached the state playoffs. Byrd also had six players named First-Team All-District, including the Defensive Most Valuable Player in linebacker Brooks Brossette. Christian Jones earned All-District honors as both a defensive back and a kick returner.

THE COACHES

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 26 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 17-6 (.739) record in his two seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator, Lindsey Bruno, offensive line, Marty Guerrero - wide receivers, Shimorye Hampton - offensive backs, Jason Pope - defensive coordinator, Jalen Bowers - defensive line, Dayton Corbett - defensive backs. The Freshmen coaching staff includes Josh Cason, Ronnie Buckingham, Carlos Doss and Kellum Humphrey. Cordarius Wayne is the Certified Athletic Trainer.

THE BALLEW BIOGRAPHY

Stacy Ballew just completed his second season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent 26 years of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.



Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 44-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

2022 marked the 118th season of Yellow Jackets football and the 97th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name change in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 682-430-35 (.610) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 17-6 (.739) record through 23 games... Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the program's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene caught 2 touchdown passes against Natchitoches Central and was the first to accomplish that feat since Joey Jernigan caught 2 TDs against Green Oaks in 2015...Dufrene scored a rushing and a receiving touchdown against Pleasant Grove and was the first Yellow Jacket to score rushing and receiving touchdowns in the same game since William Berry did it in the 2019 playoff loss to St. Augustine...Berry had a 65-yard reception and a 13-yard run against Purple Knights... Dufrene has caught six touchdown passes this season, which is the most for a Byrd receiver since Jordan Powell had seven receiving TDs in 2013...Dufrene's 57-yard TD reception against Benton is the longest of his career...All six of Lake Lambert's touchdown passes this season went to Dufrene...Lambert's six TD passes were the most for a Byrd quarterback since Deuce Caston had seven in 2015...Lambert has 11 career TD passes, which is the most since Caston had 13 from 2013-15...Lambert's 35 completions this season is the most in his three-year varsity career and the most since Caston had 41 completions in 2015... Lambert rushed for a career-high 267 yards and five TDs against Alexandria...His 97-yard touchdown run against the Trojans was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history, surpassing his 95-yarder against Huntington in week two of the season...Lambert's five rushing TDs were the most since Xavier Long had five against West Jefferson on 11/11/11...Lambert's 267 yards were the sixth best rushing performance in the 118-year history of the program...Lambert's 1,021 rushing yards this season ranks third behind Arnaz Battle and Richard Carthon amongst Jacket quarterbacks since 1990...Byrd's 475 rushing yards versus Alexandria was the fourth best single-game performance in program history...Byrd's 49 points against ASH were the most points scored in a playoff game since scoring 56 against the West Jefferson Buccaneers in 2011...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense did not allow an offensive touchdown against Pleasant Grove, Southwood or Natchitoches Central...Benton's 63 points against Byrd was the second highest point total allowed by the Jackets in program history...The highest was a 70-6 loss to Southwood in 1988...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 11-0 against Caddo Parish schools since...Against Calvary, Byrd had 146 passing yards and 99 rushing yards...It was the first time since the 2019 game versus Natchitoches Central (a 9-7 Jackets win) that Byrd had more passing yards than rushing yards...Twice this season Byrd has scored seven rushing touchdowns - vs. Southwood and Alexandria...Byrd's 39-14 win over No. 8 Parkway at Preston Crossover Stadium was the Yellow Jackets' first road win over a ranked opponent since 2019 when the Jackets upset No. 7 Airline 21-6 in a driving rainstorm at M.D. Ray Field at Airline Stadium...Three times this season Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense has held an opponent to less than 40 rushing yards - 37 vs. Huntington, 36 vs. Parkway and (-6) vs. Southwood...Byrd held Natchitoches to 81 rushing yards in the regular season finale...Devon Strickland's 115 rushing yards against Airline marked the first time a Byrd back other than Lake Lambert had eclipsed the 100-yard rushing plateau...Desmond Simmons had 106 rushing yards and four TDs vs. Southwood...Simmons was the first Byrd back to score four rushing TDs in a games since William Berry had 4 vs. Airline in 2020...Abram Murray had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63) against John Curtis...Those were the first 60+ yard punts since Scotty Roblow had a 64-yarder against Evangel in 2018.

LAMBERT LEAVES INCREDIBLE LEGACY

Senior quarterback Lake Lambert leaves an incredible legacy at Byrd High School. Lambert started 31 games at Byrd, missing three games due to injury, and led the Yellow Jackets to a 25-6 record. In 2020, Lambert was the first sophomore quarterback at Byrd to start every game since the great Arnaz Battle in 1995. After being knocked out of the Benton game this season, Lambert returned in a big way against then No. 8 Parkway. He rushed for a game-high 114 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Jackets to a 39-14 win over the Panthers. Lambert had a performance for the ages in the playoffs against Alexandria. He rushed for 267 yards and five touchdowns, including a 97-yard scamper on Byrd's first offensive play. The 97-yarder was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history, surpassing his 95 yard TD run in week two against Huntington. Lambert led the team in rushing this season with 1,021 yards, which ranks third behind Battle and Richard Carthon for season rushing totals amongst Jacket quarterbacks since 1990. In his three-year career, Lambert rushed for 1,796 yards, 24 touchdowns and averaged 6.3 yards per carry. He completed 76 of his 146 pass attempts for 1,447 yards and 11 touchdowns, and has thrown just two interceptions. His 1,447 passing yards ranks 10th on the career passing leaders list. Lambert was a Second-Team All-District Selection as an athlete.

GOING TO JACKSON

Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene was quarterback Lake Lambert's "go-to" guy this season. Dufrene, caught six touchdown passes this season, which was the most since Jordan Powell had seven receiving TDs in 2013. His two TD receptions against Natchitoches Central was a career-high, and marked the first time since 2015 that a Byrd receiver had two touchdown receptions in a game since Joey Jernigan had two against Green Oaks in week eight. Dufrene caught a 41-yard touchdown pass in Byrd's 14-7 win over Calvary, which was a career-long at the time. He bested that mark with a 44-yard touchdown reception against Captain Shreve. Against Benton, Dufrene caught a 57-yarder, which stands as his career best. Dufrene was Byrd's leading receiver in 2022 with 23 receptions for 547 yards. He averaged 23.8 yards per reception and 45.6 receiving yards per game. His 547 receiving yards are the most for a Byrd receiver in a season since Zarrell Sanders had 629 yards in 2007. Dufrene also had five carries for 113 yards and a touchdown. He finished second on the team in all-purpose yards with 74.7 yards per game. Dufrene's 547 receiving yards this season ranks eighth on the Top 10 list for receiving yards in a season. Dufrene was a First-Team All-District selection.

STRICKLAND SPEAKING

Senior running back Devon Strickland, who led the team in rushing in 2021 with 937 yards, played through a lower leg injury throughout the season. Despite the injury, Strickland finished the season with 653 rushing yards and seven touchdowns. He rushed for 80 yards on 17 carries and a touchdown against Parkway. He had his best outing against Airline, where he had 115 yards on 17 carries and a touchdown. The 115-yard output was his highest rushing total of the season. At the time, Strickland was the first Byrd back other than Lake Lambert to eclipse the 100-yard mark in a game this season. Strickland had 54 yards on nine carries against Southwood in just one half of action, and 68 yards against Natchitoches. He had four carries for 87 yards, including a 68-yard touchdown run, against Alexandria. For his career, Strickland rushed for 1,590 yards on 253 carries and scored 13 touchdowns. Strickland averaged 6.3 yards per carry and 72.3 rushing yards per game in his career. He also had 13 receptions for 216 yards and one touchdown.

BROOKS ALL OVER THE RECORD BOOK

Byrd has a rich tradition of producing great linebackers and Brooks Brossette is among the best to ever wear the purple and gold. His name is all over the Byrd Football Record Book. In typical Brossette fashion, he finished his Byrd career with his best statistical performance setting a career-high with 21 (13 unassisted, 8 assisted) total tackles against John Curtis. It was the second-highest single-game tackling performance in school history behind Mike Turner's 32 tackles against Fair Park in 1976. Despite being hampered by a lower leg injury throughout the season, Brossette was the unquestionable leader Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. After missing the Jamboree, Brossette came back in style as he led the team with seven total tackles, including six solo stops, and two tackles-for-loss against Pleasant Grove. For his efforts, Brossette was named the KTBS TV3 Bob Griffin's Player-of-the-Week. His 13 tackles against Airline marked the third straight game in which Brossette had tallied double-digit tackles. He also added a tackle-for-loss and an interception return for a touchdown of 35 yards against the Vikings. Six times this season Brossette registered double-digit tackles, surpassing the amount of double-digit tackle games he totaled in 2021. After his 12-tackle performance against Parkway, Brossette was named the Live Oak Environmental / Tim Fletcher Show "Crusher of the Week." His 115 tackles this season ranks third behind Paul Dupée and Mike Turner, who each had 124. He finished his three-year varsity career with 233 total tackles, which ranks third on the career Top 10 tackles list. His 18 tackles-for-loss also ranks third on the career list. An All-District and All-City selection in 2021, Brossette was named the 2022 District 1-5A Defensive Most Valuable Player.

THEY CALL HIM MISTER JONES

In his three-year varsity career, Byrd safety Christian Jones had propensity for making big plays. None was bigger than his goal-line interception of Calvary quarterback Bryce Carpenter's pass in the final minute of the game. Jones' interception, which he returned 69 yards, sealed the 14-7 victory for the Yellow Jackets. That only tells part of the story. Jones also had 10 total tackles, including seven solo stops, and two pass breakups equaling or setting career highs against the Cavaliers. This season, Jones tallied 75 total tackles, including 52 solo stops. He had three tackles-for-loss and six pass breakups to go along with three interceptions. His big play propensity continued against Benton as he returned a kickoff 80 yards for a touchdown. It was Byrd's first kickoff return for a touchdown since Mitchell Ramsey's 50-yard TD return against Airline in 2020. Jones got his second kickoff return for a touchdown, 61 yards, against Southwood. For his outstanding efforts this season, Jones was named a First-Team All-District performer at both defensive back and as a kick returner.

BUILT FORD TOUGH

Byrd defensive end Isaiah Ford was as tough of a defensive end as the Purple Swarm Defense has had in recent years. Ford registered 45 total tackles in 2021, including seven tackles-for-loss, two sacks, a pass breakup and an interception to his credit. Ford was a First-Team All-District and All-City selection in 2021. Ford produced even better numbers this season with 64 total tackles, 12 tackles-for-loss and 6.5 sacks and a pass-breakup. Ford's 6.5 sacks this season ranks sixth on the single-season list, while his 8.5 sacks ranks sixth on career list. His 19 tackles-for-loss ranks 10th on the career list. Ford was a First-Team All-District selection this season as well.

MURRAY CONTINUES THE TRADITION

Byrd has had a long history of outstanding place kickers and punters and junior Abram Murray has continued that tradition. In his first-ever field goal attempt as a Byrd Yellow Jacket, Murray booted a 45-yarder against the Huntington Raiders. He surpassed that personal best with a 49-yard field goal against Captain Shreve. Murray finished the season 3-for-7 on field goal attempts. He was 48-of-50 on extra point kicks. Forty-eight of his 64 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks with opponents average starting field position at the 21-yard -line. He scored 57 points on the season. Murray punted 24 times and averaged 41.6 yards per punt. He had four fair catches and eight punts downed inside the 20. Against John Curtis, Murray had two punts over 60 yards - 66 & 63. It was the first time since Scotty Roblow in 2018 that Byrd had a punt of over 60 yards in a game. A University of Miami commit, Murray was a First-Team All-District selection as a punter.

HEY JUDE

Defensive back Jude Partington's had a very productive senior season in 2022. Partington tallied 40 total tackles, including 29 solo stops, two tackles-for-loss and six pass breakups. However, it was his knack for creating turnovers that was key for the Purple Swarm Defense. Partington had two interceptions for 37 return yards. Against Benton, Jude recovered a fumble and returned it 70 yards for a touchdown. It was the fifth longest fumble return for a touchdown in the 118-year history of Yellow Jackets football. Against Airline, he had a career-high 10 tackles. He had a fumble return of 26 yards against John Curtis.

WHAT DOES THE FOX SAY?

Byrd defensive back Walker Fox doesn't say a whole lot, instead letting his play on the field speak for itself. Fox, who moved from offense to defense this season, made an big impact on the Purple Swarm Defense this season. Fox registered 56 total tackles this season, including 41 solo stops, four tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, two fumble recoveries and four pass breakups. He was also the holder on place kicks and did a outstanding job handling snaps and placements for kicker Abram Murray.

A NICHOLS WORTH

Wingback Tyler Nichols proved his worth in Byrd's multiple-option offense again this season. Nichols finished the '21 season with 445 rushing yards, averaged 6.8 yards per carry and scored seven touchdowns. This season, Nichols amassed 406 rushing yards, scored five touchdowns and averaged 7.0 yards per carry.

SIMMONS IS NO SLEEPER

Fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational sophomore season and is likely to split time with Dixon Poirier in 2023. In Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood, Simmons rushed for a game-high 106 yards and scored four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper to close out the scoring. Simmons was the first Byrd back to score four rushing touchdowns in a game since William Berry reached the end zone four times against Airline in 2020. He finished the season with 265 rushing yards, six touchdowns and averaged seven yards a carry.
