Season Opener on the Road

On Friday, Sept. 1, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel up to Texarkana, Texas to open the 2023 season against the Pleasant Grove Hawks. The last time Byrd started a season away from Shreveport was 2019 against Brother Martin in New Orleans. It's also the first time since 2001 that Byrd has traveled to the Lone Star State to play a game. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Hawk Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets finished the 2022 season with an 8-4 overall record and went 4-3 and tied for third place in District 1-5A. The Jackets were the No. 6 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. The Jackets reached the quarterfinals before falling to eventual state champion John Curtis 35-14. Byrd is having to replace 20 starters from last year's team. The Pleasant Grove Hawks own a 1-0 record after last Friday's 10-7 season-opening win over the Brock Eagles.

Last Time Out

In the Jamboree, Captain Shreve place kicker John Chance booted a 47-yard field goal as time expired to lift the Gators to a 23-21 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets . Chance's kick came just seconds after Byrd had taken a 21-20 lead on J.D. Gallman's five-yard touchdown run and Abram Murray's PAT kick. The Pleasant Grove Hawks scored a fourth-quarter touchdown to capture a 10-7 win over the Brock Eagles in the 2023 season opener.

The Season

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football. The 118th season came to an end in Metairie, La., on Friday, Nov. 25, 2022, as Byrd lost 35-14 to the eventual Select Division I State Champion John Curtis Patriots. 2022 marked the third consecutive season, second under Stacy Ballew, that the Yellow Jackets won at least eight games. And, for the 13th consecutive season Byrd reached the state playoffs.

The Series

This will be the second meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and Pleasant Grove Hawks. In the 2022 season opener, the Jackets defeated the Hawks 34-7 in Shreveport. Byrd fullback Dixon Poirier rushed for 84 yards and two touchdowns and wide receiver Jackson Dufrene caught a touchdown pass and rushed for another score to lead the Jackets to the season-opening win.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 27 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 17-6 (.739) record in his two seasons as Byrd's head coach.

Pleasant Grove is coached by Josh Gibson, who is in 10th season at the helm of the Hawks' football program. In his previous nine seasons, Gibson has compiled an impressive 90-33 (.732) record. Gibson's 2017 Pleasant Grove team went 16-0 and captured the UIL Class 4A, Division II State Championship. In 2019, the Hawks posted a 15-1 record and captured their second state title in three seasons. In the three-year stretch from 2017 through 2019, Gibson's teams went 44-4 posting three consecutive seasons with 13 or more wins.

Ballew and Gibson worked together for a year in Texas and have remained friends over the years and this is how this matchup came to fruition.

2021 District 1-5A Champions
Two consecutive playoff appearances

Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 682-430-35 (.610) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 17-6 (.739) record through 23 games... Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the program's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2022 Revisted

Wide receiver Jackson Dufrene caught 2 touchdown passes against Natchitoches Central and was the first to accomplish that feat since Joey Jernigan caught 2 TDs against Green Oaks in 2015...Dufrene sored a rushing and a receiving touchdown against Pleasant Grove and was the first Yellow Jacket to score rushing and receiving touchdowns in the same game since William Berry did it in the 2019 playoff loss to St. Augustine...Berry had a 65-yard reception and a 13-yard run against Purple Knights... Dufrene has caught six touchdown passes this season, which is the most for a Byrd receiver since Jordan Powell had seven receiving TDs in 2013...Dufrene's 57-yard TD reception against Benton is the longest of his career...All six of Lake Lambert's touchdown passes this season went to Dufrene...Lambert's six TD passes were the most for a Byrd quarterback since Deuce Caston had seven in 2015...Lambert has 11 career TD passes, which is the most since Caston had 13 from 2013-15... Lambert's 35 completions this season is the most in his three-year varsity career and the most since Caston had 41 completions in 2015... Lambert rushed for a career-high 267 yards and five TDs against Alexandria...His 97-yard touchdown run against the Trojans was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history, surpassing his 95-varder against Huntington in week two of the season...Lambert's five rushing TDs were the most since Xavier Long had five against West Jefferson on 11/11/11...Lambert's 267 yards were the sixth best rushing performance in the 118-year history of the program...Lambert's 1,021 rushing yards this season ranks third behind Arnaz Battle and Richard Carthon amongst Jacket quarterbacks since 1990...Byrd's 475 rushing yards versus Alexandria was the fourth best single-game performance in program history...Byrd's 49 points against ASH were the most points scored in a playoff game since scoring 56 against the West Jefferson Buccaneers in 2011...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense did not allow an offensive touchdown against Pleasant Grove, Southwood or Natchitoches Central...Benton's 63 points against Byrd was the second highest point total allowed by the Jackets in program history...The highest was a 70-6 loss to Southwood in 1988...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 11-0 against Caddo Parish schools ever since... Against Calvary, Byrd had 146 passing yards and 99 rushing yards...lt was the first time since the 2019 game versus Natchitoches Central (a 9-7 Jackets win) that Byrd had more passing yards than rushing yards...Twice this season Byrd has scored seven rushing touchdowns - vs. Southwood and Alexandria...Byrd's 39-14 win over No. 8 Parkway at Preston Crownover Stadium was the Yellow Jackets' first road win over a ranked opponent since 2019 when the Jackets upset No. 7 Airline 21-6 in a driving rainstorm at M.D. Ray Field at Airline Stadium...Three times last season Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense held an opponent to less than 40 rushing yards - 37 vs. Huntington, 36 vs. Parkway and (-6) vs. Southwood...Byrd held Natchitoches to 81 rushing yards in the regular season finale...Devon Strickland's 115 rushing yards against Airline marked the first time a Byrd back other than Lake Lambert had eclipsed the 100-yard rushing plateau...Desmond Simmons had 106 rushing yards and four touchdowns against Southwood...Simmons was the first Byrd back to score four rushing TDs in a games since William Berry had four versus Airline in 2020...Abram Murray had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63) in the quarterfinal game against John Curtis...Those were the first 60+ yard punts since Scotty Roblow had a 64-yarder against Evangel in 2018.

BYRD BLASTS

Brotherly Love

In looking at Byrd's 2023 rosters (varsity and freshmen), one will notice there are a number of players bearing the same last name. That's because there are at least five sets of brothers in the Byrd Football program. Abram and Asher Murray, Ashton and Alton Fullwood, Quinton and Conrad Hilliard, Noah and Willie Hearod and Mason and Mills Coenen. Kian Fox, John Rushing and Jackson Thrasher each had older brothers in the program last year.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it's one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew, there's seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Stacy Ballew (1996), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carloss Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2023).

The 2023 Schedule and Polls

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Airline, Benton, Haughton and Parkway each made it to the 2022 Non-Select Division I Playoffs. Haughton upset district champion Airline in the first round. After winning its first-round game, Benton lost 29-28 on a controversial finish in round two. Byrd, Captain Shreve and Huntington participated in the Select Div. I Playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. The Calvary Cavaliers made it to the Select Division IV quarterfinals. For the second straight year, the Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 Regional Finals before losing to the eventual state champion Carthage Bulldogs. The John Curtis Patriots, who are the defending Select Div. I Champions, are ranked first in all three polls (Louisiana Sports Writer's Association, GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports) that came out this week. The only District 1-5A team recognized in any of the polls is the Captain Shreve Gators, who received six votes in the LSWA poll and was among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll.

Uncertain Playoff Picture

Last week, a Louisiana judge issued a temporary injunction in favor of the nine member schools currently locked in a lawsuit against the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA). The injunction effectively bars the LHSAA from implementing its current playoff format which was revamped last fall to include a new definition for "Select" schools, pending further legal proceedings. Since 2013, Byrd was deemed a "select" school and has participated in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs every season, reaching the state finals in 2013 and 2020. With the start of the 2023 season, it's uncertain of what the LHSAA football playoffs will look like when they are set to begin the second weekend in November.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for nearly 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 26th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while Byrd champion golfer Grant Reagan provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. Fans can download the 1130 The Tiger app to their smart device and listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world.

A Look Ahead

On Friday, Sept. 8, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play host to the Huntington Raiders. Technically, it's Byrd's home opener. However, due to construction forcing the closure of Lee Hedges Stadium for the season, the Jackets and Raiders will square off at Northwood High School's Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium. This summer, new artificial turf and lights installed were installed at Burton Memorial Stadium. A side note, the late Jerry Burton coached at Byrd from 1977-82. Burton compiled a 23-37 (.439) record as the Yellow Jackets head coach.

2023 OUTLOOK

(The following was preview article written for CrescentCitySports.com)

With the loss of 32 seniors from last year's team, including many three-year starters that went to the 2020 Division I State Championship, this season will likely be the toughest test for third-year Byrd head football coach Stacy Ballew.

Ballew, who owns a 17-6 record in his previous two seasons, and his staff are having to replace 20 starters from last year's team. Couple that with a staunch non-district schedule and a very tough District 1-5A slate, it's understandable why this season will be Ballew's toughest test.

Senior J.D. Gallman, who mostly played wide receiver and was the backup quarterback last season, is expected to take over behind center for three-year starter Lake Lambert. Due to an injury to Lambert, Gallman did start the Haughton game at quarterback in 2022. Unfortunately for Gallman and the Jackets, turnovers during four consecutive second-half possessions resulted in a disappointing 23-14 loss to the Buccaneers. Junior Harrison Ayres and sophomore Asher Murray and are expected to vie for playing time.

The one group that does possess valuable experience is the offensive backfield. Senior fullback Dixon Poirier along with junior fullback Desmond Simmons and junior wing back Malachi Johnson all logged significant playing time last season.

Despite missing a number of games with injuries last season, Poirier rushed for 370 yards and five touchdowns and averaged 8.4 yards per carry. Simmons, who was the third-string fullback in 2022, took advantage of his time by rushing for 265 yards and six touchdowns. Against Southwood, Simmons rushed for a game-high 106 yards and scored four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper to close out the scoring. Johnson played in 10 of Byrd's 12 games in 2022 and totaled 340 yards and three touchdowns while averaging 7.4 yards per carry. Senior Jontavious Mobery, who played in three games in 2022, and junior Quinton Hilliard will be in the running back rotation as well.

Two of the biggest areas of concern for Ballew and his staff are the offensive line and the wide receiving corps. With zero returning starters and little experience these two groups will have to learn on the fly. Seniors Dylan Gillie, Gehrig Smith, Owen Scott and Noah Slaughter are expected to step in and fill some of the spots along the line. Obviously, there will be position battles aplenty along the O-line, especially at the center spot.

With Gallman moving to quarterback and Jackson Dufrene to Nicholls State, no wide receiver on the Byrd roster has registered a reception in varsity action. Junior Alex Schoonover is expected to be one of Gallman's top targets. Senior Matthew Booras, who was the backup kicker and punter the last two seasons and is an outstanding soccer player, has made the move to wide receiver and is expected to be in the rotation.

The final two lines of Byrd's alma mater reads "Always deep within our hearts, the purple and the gold." From his days as an All-District lineman to now as the Jackets' head coach, no one bleeds Byrd purple and gold more than Ballew. He's spent a total 27 years, more than half of his life, at the Line Avenue school. In 18 of his 23 years on the Jackets' coaching staff, Ballew has coached Byrd's "Purple Swarm Defense," particularly the linebackers. While it's virtually impossible to replace a player the caliber of All-District and All-City Defensive MVP Brooks Brossette, you throw-in having to replace nine additional defensive starters and it's easy to see why this will be Ballew's toughest coaching test to date.

To put it into perspective, 13 of the 14 players listed on Byrd's 2022 defensive statistics sheet (top tacklers) are no longer in the program. Senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood is the only returning starter to the Jackets' defense. Fullwood tallied 38 tackles last season, including 26 solo stops and two tackles-for-loss and one fumble recovery. He has fully recovered from an ankle injury he suffered in Byrd's 49-10 blowout of the Alexandria Trojans in the regional round of the 2022 playoffs. Junior Sam Greer, who saw limited time last season, is expected to compete for the spot opposite of Fullwood. Senior Roshun Johnson and juniors Kian Fox and Jackson Johnson will compete for playing time as well.

Along the defensive line, seniors John Rushing and Mattias Franklin along with junior Darrell Cottonham are the top returnees for three of the four defensive line spots. Senior Desmond Bell and sophomore lan Gray are battling for one of the tackle spots, while juniors Jordan Washington, Rhyan Perry are expected to be the backups at end.

The entire secondary will be new for Byrd in 2023. Juniors Kaidan Abraham-Miller and James Logan were backup corner backs last season. Senior Grant Johnson, who is also Byrd's long-snapper, and

juniors Ethan Sipes and Jordan Moreau were backups at the safety spots in 2022. A litany of juniors - Jackson Thrasher, James Logan, Kristian Roberson, Elijah Cooper and Ethan Oliver are all battling for playing time.

The biggest and brightest returner is All-District and All-City punter and placekicker Abram Murray. The senior, who is a University of Miami commitment, was 48-for-50 on extra point attempts last season, while averaging 41.6 yards per punt with a long of 66. Junior Jackson Cooper and Abram's younger brother Asher will handle the backup kicking duties.

If the lack of returning starters and the large number of inexperienced players wasn't enough of a concern for Ballew and his staff, then a glance at the 2023 schedule should be enough to squeeze the stuffings out of a stress ball. Byrd opens the 2023 season on the road in Texarkana, Texas against the Pleasant Grove Hawks, who posted an 11-3 record in 2022. The Hawks lost to the Class 4A Division 2 champion Carthage Bulldogs in the regional finals of the UIL playoffs last season.

With Byrd's home field Lee Hedges Stadium closed for the season due to construction, week two's matchup against crosstown rival Huntington will now be played at Northwood's Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium. In week three, the Jackets will play the Calvary Baptist Cavaliers at Independence Stadium. Calvary return the majority of its team from last year and the Cavs appear poised to make a deep playoff run.

Week four not only begins the gauntlet that is District 1-5A, but it's also the annual "Backyard Brawl" matchup against arch-rival Captain Shreve. In district play, the Yellow Jackets have road trips to Airline, the defending district champions, and to Haughton. Byrd has home games against Parkway, Benton, Southwood and Natchitoches Central. All of those games with the exception of the Southwood game will be played at Independence Stadium. The Jackets and Cowboys will play at Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium.

By the time Byrd faces off against Natchitoches Central and its new head coach Jess Curtis - a three-time state champion at Many - in week 10, we should have a good idea if Ballew and the Jackets have passed the test.
