Home Opener of Sorts

On Thursday, Sept. 7, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play host to their crosstown rivals the Huntington Raiders. Technically, it's the home opener for Byrd, but because of the closure of Lee Hedges Stadium for the 2023 season, the two teams will meet at Northwood High School's Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium. This summer, new artificial turf and lights installed were installed at Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium. A side note, the late Jerry Burton coached at Byrd from 1977-82 and compiled a 23-37 (.439) record as the Yellow Jackets' head coach. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets are 0-1 after last Friday's 27-10 season-opening loss to the Pleasant Grove Hawks in Texarkana, Texas. Huntington is off to a 1-0 start after the Raiders defeated the Mansfield Wolverines 36-28 at Independence Stadium last Friday.

Last Time Out

Pleasant Grove used a balanced offensive attack to score four first half touchdowns, two off of Byrd turnovers, as the Hawks defeated the Yellow Jackets 27-10 at Hawk Stadium in Texarkana, Texas. Led by quarterback Ahkhari Johnson, an Arkansas commit, Pleasant Grove's offense rushed for 176 yards and two touchdowns and passed for 169 yards and two scores. Byrd junior wingback Quinton Hilliard was the leading ground gainer in the game with 109 yards on six carries. Huntington survived a scare from upstart Mansfield as the Raiders outlasted the Wolverines 36-28 last Friday at Independence Stadium. Faced with fourth down and just 13 seconds left in the game, Huntington clinging to a 29-28 lead, the Raiders put the game away on Kaleb Tucker's second touchdown reception of the game.

The Series

This will be the 35th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Huntington Raiders in a series that dates back to 1973. Byrd leads the overall series 24-10. The Yellow Jackets and the Raiders had met every year from 1985 through 2008. In those 22 games, Byrd posted a 15-7 record against the Raiders. The Yellow Jackets have won six straight over the Raiders, including last year's 46-22 victory in week two. Huntington's last wins came in back-to-back seasons as the Raiders defeated the Jackets 26-16 in 2003 and 30-16 in 2004. The Jackets' 43-14 victory over the Raiders in the 2021 season opener gave Stacy Ballew his first-ever win as Byrd's head coach.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent 27 years of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 17-7 (.630) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach.

Huntington is coached by Stephen Dennis, who is in his seventh season at the helm of the Raiders' program. He was 31-31 in his previous six seasons at Huntington. In 2021, Huntington posted a 9-3 record and advanced to the second round of the Class 4A Playoffs. He was the defensive coordinator for six seasons at Northwood before accepting the Huntington job. Dennis played at Parkway when former Northwood coach Jim Gatlin was the head coach there. He went on to play for Dennis Dunn at Louisiana Christian before returning to coach at Parkway with Gatlin. He then joined Dunn's staff at LC for two seasons before coming back to Shreveport to serve as defensive coordinator under Gatlin at Northwood.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Two consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school histo-

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football his-



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 118-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 682-431-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 17-7 (.630) record through 24 games... Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the program's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

With its 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove, Byrd now owns 14-10 record in season openers since 2000Since 1905, the Yellow Jackets own a 62-54-3 record in season openers...Quarterback J.D. Gallman had a career-long 50-yard run against Pleasant Grove...It was only the second career start at quarterback for Gallman...He started the Haughton game in 2022...Byrd had 18 players make their first-ever start against Pleasant Grove...Only J.D. Gallman, Dixon Poirier, Ashton Fullwood and Malachi Johnson had ever started a game for Byrd...Linebacker Sam Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against PG...The last time Byrd lost to a school from Caddo Parish (public or private) was in week nine of the 2019 season, a 22-21 overtime loss to Captain Shreve...The Yellow Jackets are 11-0 against Caddo Parish schools since.

Hilliard Highlights Opener

The effort of junior wingback Quinton Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. Hilliard had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. After the timeout, fullback Dixon Poirier plunged in from a yard out to give Byrd it's first points of the game and the season.

Murray Was Masterful

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray was masterful as usual in the opener against Pleasant Grove. Murray averaged 43.0 yards on four punts, including a long of 55 yards. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has three punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the fourth quarter. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled, but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the fourth of his career and the third from 40-plus yards. He needs just two more field goals to climb into the career Top 10 list at Byrd. Two of his three kickoffs against Pleasant Grove resulted in touchbacks.

Brotherly Love

Kian Fox, John Rushing and Jackson Thrasher each had older brothers in the program last year.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it's one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Airline, Benton, Haughton and Parkway each made it to the 2022 Non-Select Division I Playoffs. Haughton upset district champion Airline in the first round. After winning its first-round game, Benton lost 29-28 on a controversial finish in round two. Byrd, Captain Shreve and Huntington participated in the Select Div. I Playoffs. Shreve was the No. 2 seed but lost to Parkway in the second round. The Calvary Cavaliers made it to the Select Division IV quarterfinals. For the second straight year, the Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 Regional Finals before losing to the eventual state champion Carthage Bulldogs. The John Curtis Patriots, who are the defending Select Div. I Champions, remain atop the rankings in all three polls (Louisiana Sports Writer's Association, GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports) for the second consecutive week. John Curtis, who knocked Byrd out of the playoffs in 2022, crushed the Central Lafourche Trojans 51-0 last Friday. District 1-5A teams recognized in this week's polls were the Airline Vikings and the Captain Shreve Gators, who received 14 and two votes, respectively, in the LSWA poll. The Vikings and Gators were among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll.

Uncertain Playoff Picture

Last week, a Louisiana judge issued a temporary injunction in favor of the nine member schools currently locked in a lawsuit against the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA). The injunction effectively bars the LHSAA from implementing its current playoff format which was revamped last fall to include a new definition for "Select" schools, pending further legal proceedings. Since 2013, Byrd was deemed a "select" school and has participated in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs every season, reaching the state finals in 2013 and 2020. With the start of the 2023 season, it's uncertain of what the LHSAA football playoffs will look like when they are set to begin the second weekend in November.

Last Time Versus the Raiders

Last year, Byrd quarterback Lake Lambert rushed for a game-high 185 yards and two touchdowns to lead the Yellow Jackets to a 46-22 win over the Huntington Raiders. Lambert had touchdown runs of five and 95 yards, which was the second longest rushing touchdown in school history.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for nearly 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 26th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while Byrd champion golfer Grant Reagan provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. Fans can download the 1130 The Tiger app to their smart device and listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world.

A Look Ahead

On Thursday, Sept. 14, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play host to the Calvary Baptist Academy Cavaliers at Independence Stadium. It'll be the first of three straight games for Byrd at Independence Stadium. It'll also be the fourth consecutive Thursday night game for the Jackets.

2023 OUTLOOK

(The following was preview article written for CrescentCitySports.com)

With the loss of 32 seniors from last year's team, including many three-year starters that went to the 2020 Division I State Championship, this season will likely be the toughest test for third-year Byrd head football coach Stacy Ballew.

Ballew, who owns a 17-6 record in his previous two seasons, and his staff are having to replace 20 starters from last year's team. Couple that with a staunch non-district schedule and a very tough District 1-5A slate, it's understandable why this season will be Ballew's toughest test.

Senior J.D. Gallman, who mostly played wide receiver and was the backup quarterback last season, is expected to take over behind center for three-year starter Lake Lambert. Due to an injury to Lambert, Gallman did start the Haughton game at quarterback in 2022. Unfortunately for Gallman and the Jackets, turnovers during four consecutive second-half possessions resulted in a disappointing 23-14 loss to the Buccaneers. Junior Harrison Ayres and sophomore Asher Murray and are expected to vie for playing time.

The one group that does possess valuable experience is the offensive backfield. Senior fullback Dixon Poirier along with junior fullback Desmond Simmons and junior wing back Malachi Johnson all logged significant playing time last season.

Despite missing a number of games with injuries last season, Poirier rushed for 370 yards and five touchdowns and averaged 8.4 yards per carry. Simmons, who was the third-string fullback in 2022, took advantage of his time by rushing for 265 yards and six touchdowns. Against Southwood, Simmons rushed for a game-high 106 yards and scored four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper to close out the scoring. Johnson played in 10 of Byrd's 12 games in 2022 and totaled 340 yards and three touchdowns while averaging 7.4 yards per carry. Senior Jontavious Mobery, who played in three games in 2022, and junior Quinton Hilliard will be in the running back rotation as well.

Two of the biggest areas of concern for Ballew and his staff are the offensive line and the wide receiving corps. With zero returning starters and little experience these two groups will have to learn on the fly. Seniors Dylan Gillie, Gehrig Smith, Owen Scott and Noah Slaughter are expected to step in and fill some of the spots along the line. Obviously, there will be position battles aplenty along the O-line, especially at the center spot.

With Gallman moving to quarterback and Jackson Dufrene to Nicholls State, no wide receiver on the Byrd roster has registered a reception in varsity action. Junior Alex Schoonover is expected to be one of Gallman's top targets. Senior Matthew Booras, who was the backup kicker and punter the last two seasons and is an outstanding soccer player, has made the move to wide receiver and is expected to be in the rotation.

The final two lines of Byrd's alma mater reads "Always deep within our hearts, the purple and the gold." From his days as an All-District lineman to now as the Jackets' head coach, no one bleeds Byrd purple and gold more than Ballew. He's spent a total 27 years, more than half of his life, at the Line Avenue school. In 18 of his 23 years on the Jackets' coaching staff, Ballew has coached Byrd's "Purple Swarm Defense," particularly the linebackers. While it's virtually impossible to replace a player the caliber of All-District and All-City Defensive MVP Brooks Brossette, you throw-in having to replace nine additional defensive starters and it's easy to see why this will be Ballew's toughest coaching test to date.

To put it into perspective, 13 of the 14 players listed on Byrd's 2022 defensive statistics sheet (top tacklers) are no longer in the program. Senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood is the only returning starter to the Jackets' defense. Fullwood tallied 38 tackles last season, including 26 solo stops and two tackles-for-loss and one fumble recovery. He has fully recovered from an ankle injury he suffered in Byrd's 49-10 blowout of the Alexandria Trojans in the regional round of the 2022 playoffs. Junior Sam Greer, who saw limited time last season, is expected to compete for the spot opposite of Fullwood. Senior Roshun Johnson and juniors Kian Fox and Jackson Johnson will compete for playing time as well.

Along the defensive line, seniors John Rushing and Mattias Franklin along with junior Darrell Cottonham are the top returnees for three of the four defensive line spots. Senior Desmond Bell and sophomore lan Gray are battling for one of the tackle spots, while juniors Jordan Washington, Rhyan Perry are expected to be the backups at end.

The entire secondary will be new for Byrd in 2023. Juniors Kaidan Abraham-Miller and James Logan were backup corner backs last season. Senior Grant Johnson, who is also Byrd's long-snapper, and

juniors Ethan Sipes and Jordan Moreau were backups at the safety spots in 2022. A litany of juniors - Jackson Thrasher, James Logan, Kristian Roberson, Elijah Cooper and Ethan Oliver are all battling for playing time.

The biggest and brightest returner is All-District and All-City punter and placekicker Abram Murray. The senior, who is a University of Miami commitment, was 48-for-50 on extra point attempts last season, while averaging 41.6 yards per punt with a long of 66. Junior Jackson Cooper and Abram's younger brother Asher will handle the backup kicking duties.

If the lack of returning starters and the large number of inexperienced players wasn't enough of a concern for Ballew and his staff, then a glance at the 2023 schedule should be enough to squeeze the stuffings out of a stress ball. Byrd opens the 2023 season on the road in Texarkana, Texas against the Pleasant Grove Hawks, who posted an 11-3 record in 2022. The Hawks lost to the Class 4A Division 2 champion Carthage Bulldogs in the regional finals of the UIL playoffs last season.

With Byrd's home field Lee Hedges Stadium closed for the season due to construction, week two's matchup against crosstown rival Huntington will now be played at Northwood's Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium. In week three, the Jackets will play the Calvary Baptist Cavaliers at Independence Stadium. Calvary return the majority of its team from last year and the Cavs appear poised to make a deep playoff run.

Week four not only begins the gauntlet that is District 1-5A, but it's also the annual "Backyard Brawl" matchup against arch-rival Captain Shreve. In district play, the Yellow Jackets have road trips to Airline, the defending district champions, and to Haughton. Byrd has home games against Parkway, Benton, Southwood and Natchitoches Central. All of those games with the exception of the Southwood game will be played at Independence Stadium. The Jackets and Cowboys will play at Jerry Burton Memorial Stadium.

By the time Byrd faces off against Natchitoches Central and its new head coach Jess Curtis - a three-time state champion at Many - in week 10, we should have a good idea if Ballew and the Jackets have passed the test.
