Battle of the Purple & Gold BHS's

On Thursday, Sept. 28, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play host to the Benton Tigers in a District 1-5A battle between two teams that will be fully decked out in purple trimmed neatly in gold that use the initials BHS. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Independence Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 0-4 overall record and a 0-1 record in District 1-5A after Thursday's 35-28 loss to the Captain Shreve Gators. The Benton Tigers own a 1-3 overall record and a 0-1 District 1-5A record after Thursday's 60-35 loss to the Airline Vikings.

Last Time Out

Trailing 28-27 late in the fourth quarter, Captain Shreve stopped Byrd on a fourth down and two to force a turnover on downs. On the ensuing play, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis raced 66 yards for the eventual game-winning touchdown. Shreve added a two-point conversion to make the final 35-28. Otis finished the night with a game-high 190 rushing yards and two touchdowns. Byrd did have two backs rush for over 100 yards and two touchdowns in the game, fullback Dixon Poirier (142) and wing back Malachi Johnson (134). Airline quarterback Ben Taylor put up video game-like numbers in leading the Vikings to a 60-35 win over the Benton Tigers last Thursday. Taylor completed 14 of 23 passes for 455 yards and seven touchdowns in the first half. He played just one series in the third quarter. Three Viking receivers had over 100 receiving yards in the game - Bryson Broom (155), Javris Davis (138) and Tre Jackson (124).

The Series

This will be only the fourth meeting between Byrd and Benton. The Yellow Jackets won the first two games in the series, 46-31 in 2019 and 45-17 in 2021. The two teams didn't play in 2020 due to the Coronavirus pandemic. Last year, Benton defeated Byrd, 63-28, at Tiger Stadium. It was the second-highest points allowed by the Yellow Jackets in program history. The two teams used to meet in the annual spring game back when Mitch Downey, who's now the Superintendent of Bossier Parish Schools, was the Benton head coach and Mike Suggs was the Byrd head coach.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSU in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 17-10 (.630) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach.

Reynolds Moore is in his 11th season as the head coach of the Benton Tigers. He owns a 77-41 (.652) record in his 11 seasons as the Tigers' head coach. Moore is two wins away from surpassing Hoss Newman for second place on the Benton coaching victories list. Mitch Downey sits atop that list with 141 wins in his 16 seasons at Benton. Moore has taken the Tigers to the playoffs in nine of his previous 10 seasons. His overall coaching record is 88-70 (.557). Moore spent his first four years as a head coach at Bolton High School in Alexandria. He posted an 11-29 record in those four seasons with the Bears. Moore is 1-2 versus Byrd.

Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

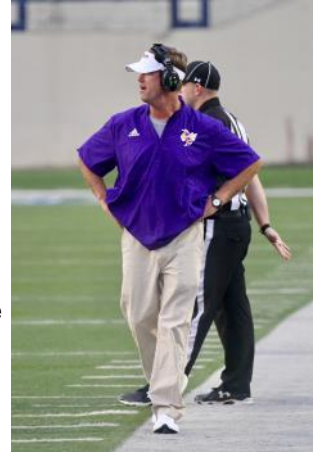
In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 682-434-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 17-10 (.630) record through 27 games...Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in the program's history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

Byrd is 0-4 for the first time since 2019 when the Jackets finished the year 4-7...After the 0-4 start, the 2019 Jackets did win four of their next six games with the last three losses coming on a combined total of seven points...Calvary's 42 points scored in the first half were the most points allowed in a half by the Jackets since surrendering 49 points to Benton in the first half of last year's 63-28 Tigers' victory...Opponent's are averaging 283 passing yards and four passing touchdowns per game...Huntington's 44-43 win over Byrd snapped the Jackets' six-game winning streak in the series with the Raiders...The loss to Huntington also snapped Byrd's 11-game winning streak against schools (public or private) from Caddo Parish...Prior to the Huntington loss, the last time the Jackets lost to a Caddo school was in week nine of the 2019 season when Byrd suffered a 22-21 overtime loss to arch-rival Captain Shreve...With its 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove, the Yellow Jackets are 62-54-3 in season openers since 1905...Quarterback Harrison Ayres got his first career start against Captain Shreve...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Byrd had 18 players make their first-ever start against Pleasant Grove...Only J.D. Gallman, Dixon Poirier, Ashton Fullwood and Malachi Johnson had ever started a game for Byrd...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Linebacker Sam Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against Pleasant Grove...Greer equaled that season-high with 11 tackles against Shreve...Byrd had two backs, Dixon Poirier (142) and Malachi Johnson (134) each rush for over 100 yards against Shreve...The last time that happened was week two of 2022 against Huntington when Lake Lambert rushed for 185 yards and Dixon Poirier for 144...The last time Byrd had two different players score two or more touchdowns in a game was in 2022 against Southwood (Lambert - 2 and Desmond Simmons - 4).

Murray Continues His Mastery

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray has continued his mastery this season. Murray is averaging 41.8 yards per punt and has had five punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has four punts of over 50 yards, including a long of 65 yards. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has seven career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Huntington, Murray hit a 22-yarder, the fifth of his career. He needs just one more field goal to climb into the career Top 10 list at Byrd. Murray is 12-for-12 on PAT kicks, and 14 of his 19 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks this season.

BYRD BLASTS

The 2023 Schedule and Polls

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Airline, Benton, Haughton and Parkway each made it to the 2022 Non-Select Division I Playoffs. Haughton upset district champion Airline in the first round. After winning its first-round game, Benton lost 29-28 on a controversial finish in round two. Byrd, Captain Shreve and Huntington participated in the Select Div. I Playoffs. Shreve beat Tioga in the first round but lost 48-7 to No. 1 seed Warren Easton in the second round. The Calvary Cavaliers made it to the Select Division IV quarterfinals. For the second straight year, the Pleasant Grove Hawks advanced the Class 4A Division 2 Regional Finals before losing to the eventual state champion Carthage Bulldogs. The John Curtis Patriots, who are the defending Select Div. I Champions, remain atop the rankings in all three polls (Louisiana Sports Writer's Association, GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports) for the fifth consecutive week. John Curtis, who knocked Byrd out of the playoffs in 2022, beat Jesuit 41-21 to retain the top spot in 5A. J.T. Curtis moved to within three wins of tying the all-time record held by the late John McKissick of Summerville, South Carolina, for the most wins in United States prep football history. The only District 1-5A team ranked in this week's polls are the Airline Vikings, who are eighth in the LSWA and CCS polls. The Vikings, who are 4-0, are among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll. The Parkway Panthers, who are 4-0 as well, were among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll and received one vote for the LSWA poll. The Calvary Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in Class 2A in the LSWA poll and No. 2 in the other two polls behind the St. Charles Catholic Comets.

Malachi Continues His Magic

Byrd's disappointing 44-43 loss to Huntington did not diminish the magical night for junior wingback Malachi Johnson. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almkary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Amaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. Malachi continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns. Through four games, Johnson leads the team with 399 rushing yards and eight rushing touchdowns.

Ayres Apparent

With senior J.D. Gallman's move to defensive back, Harrison Ayres, who's been the Jackets' starting tight end, started at quarterback for Byrd against Shreve. While he had just seven yards on six carries, Ayres, who's a junior, did guide the Jackets' ground attack to 306 rushing yards, which was the second-highest single-game total of the season.

Devastating News for Dixon

Senior fullback Dixon Poirier was well on his way to having a career night against arch-rival Captain Shreve when disaster struck. Late in the third quarter, Poirier ran for four yards before going down in obvious pain. Later, it was diagnosed that he had broken his arm and will require surgery to repair the damage. Up to that point, Poirier had rushed for 142 yards, three shy of his career high, and two touchdowns. The senior had 110 rushing yards and two touchdowns in the first half. In the first quarter, Poirier blocked a Shreve punt, which set up his first touchdown run of seven yards. He would add a six-yard touchdown run in the second quarter to help Byrd tie the game at 14.

Hilliard Highlights Opener

The effort of junior wingback Quinton Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. Hilliard had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. After the timeout, fullback Dixon Poirier plunged in from a yard out to give Byrd its first points of the game and the season. Since the opener, Hilliard has just six carries for 21 yards.

Last Year's Battle of the Purple & Gold BHS's

In the 2022 Battle of the Purple & Gold BHS's, Benton quarterback Gray Walters tossed a school-record eight touchdown passes, four to receiver Pearce Russell, to lead the Tigers to 63-28 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets at Benton's Tiger Stadium. Walters' 516 passing yards and eight touchdowns were the most ever by an opposing quarterback against the Yellow Jackets. Walters was responsible for 48 of Benton's 63 points, which was the most ever against Byrd. Tigers' receiver Pearce Russell had 12 catches for 267 yards, which were the most receptions and yards ever allowed by Byrd. Russell's four receiving touchdowns in a game against Byrd tied Natchitoches Central's Kendrick Aaron, who had four in 2010.

Scouting the Tigers

Benton is off to a 1-3 start to the season. The Tigers' lone victory was a 28-26 win over the Northwood Falcons in the season opener. Similar to Byrd, Benton is having to replace a large majority of starters from its 2022 team. One starter that coach Reynolds Moore is elated to have returning is talented running back Greg Manning. In two games against Byrd, Manning has 47 carries for 259 yards and a touchdown and three receptions for 41 yards and a touchdown. Benton has struggled on defense, twice giving up 60-plus points and the Tigers are allowing 46.26 points per game.

Big Plays Continue to Bite Byrd

Big plays continue to bite Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Byrd's defense gave up six plays of 20-plus yards, including a 64-yard rush by Hawks' running back Nick Bells. Pleasant Grove also had a kickoff return of 60 yards. It was the big play that allowed the Huntington Raiders to capture the 44-43 win over Byrd. The Jackets allowed five scoring plays of 20 or more yards, including a 62-yard pass from Lorenzo White to Kaleb Tucker. That pass-catch duo was responsible for three of those five big plays, including an 82-yard touchdown pass on the Raiders second possession of the fourth quarter. On Huntington's first possession of the fourth quarter, White hooked up with Jamarion Washington for an 80-yard touchdown. Both of those possessions were one play, 80-plus yard scores. Against Calvary, Cavaliers quarterback Abram Wardell threw three touchdown passes of 77, 53 and 49 yards. Last week against Shreve, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis' 66-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in the game.

Full Speed Ahead for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from last year's team is senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. After a fine junior campaign, in which he tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops, Fullwood is now the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. He suffered a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria last year. After a lengthy recovery, it has been full speed ahead for Fullwood in this his senior season. Through four games of the season, Fullwood has 23 total tackles, five tackles-for-loss and two fumble recoveries.

Sam I Am

Ashton Fullwood's linebacking mate is junior Sam Greer. The duo has been a bright spot for Byrd's defense. Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against Pleasant Grove. He matched that high of 11 tackles against Shreve. Through four games, Greer leads the team with 35 total tackles, including 11 solo stops, three tackles-for-loss and a forced fumble. Greer and Fullwood will have their hands full against Benton, especially trying to tame the Tigers' talented running back Greg Manning.

Buzz Back In Time

In the 2021 meeting between Byrd and Benton, the Yellow Jackets defeated the Tigers 45-17 at Lee Hedges Stadium. Byrd rushed for 421 yards and five touchdowns in the win. Josh Allen led the Jackets with a team-high 122 yards on just eight carries. Allen and Mitchell Ramsey each had two rushing touchdowns in the game.

A Look Ahead

On Friday, Oct. 6, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River to east Bossier Parish to face the Haughton Buccaneers in a District 1-5A game. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Harold Harlan Stadium.

Believing In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras has done. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, who's a Miami Hurricanes commit, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras has earned a starting job as a wide receiver. More importantly, he is Byrd's primary kick and punt returner. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, has nine kickoff returns for 115 yards and three punt returns for 60 yards this season.

Brotherly Love

In looking at Byrd's 2023 rosters (varsity and freshmen), one will notice there are a number of players bearing the same last name. That's because there are at least five sets of brothers in the Byrd Football program. Abram and Asher Murray, Ashton and Alton Fullwood, Quinton and Conrad Hilliard, Noah and Willie Heard and Mason and Mills Coenen. Kian Fox, John Rushing and Jackson Thrasher each had older brothers in the program last year.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it's one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew, there's seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Stacy Ballew (1996), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimoye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2023).
