## Regular Season Finale

On Friday, Nov. 4, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will host the Natchitoches Central Chiefs in the 2023 regular season finale at Independence Stadium. The outcome of the District 1-5A game will affect Byrd's seeding in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

## A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 3-6 overall record and a 3-3 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 37-18 win over the Southwood Cowboys. The Natchitoches Central Chiefs are 2-7 overall and 1-5 in District 1-5A. The Chiefs lost 36-35 to the Haughton Buccaneers in the final seconds of last Friday's game at Turpin Stadium in Natchitoches. Natchitoches Central has los its last two games by one point each - 27-26 to Parkway on Oct. 20, and 36-35 to Haughton on Oct. 27. The Chiefs last four Iosses have all been one score games.

## Last Time Out

Byrd had four different players score at least one touchdown, while the Yellow Jackets' ground attack amassed 333 rushing yards en route to a 37-18 win over the Southwood Cowboys last Friday evening at Independence Stadium. The Haughton Buccaneers scored a touchdown in the finals seconds of the game, then got a two-point conversion pass to defeat the Natchitoches Central Chiefs 36-35 last Friday at Turpin Stadium in Natchitoches.

## The Series

This will be the 40th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Natchitoches Central Chiefs in a series that dates back to 1920. The Yellow Jackets lead the overall series 29-9, and there has been one tie, a scoreless affair in 1920. These two schools met on the gridiron every year from 1993 to 2010. In those 18 meetings, the Jackets posted a 12-6 record against the Chiefs. Since 2002, Byrd has won 12 of the 14 games against Natchitoches Central, including eight straight from 200209. Natchitoches Central's two wins came in 2010, when the Chiefs beat the Yellow Jackets 33-31 at Turpin Stadium, and 2021's 23-10 Natchitoches victory in Shreveport. The Yellow Jackets own a 3 -1 record against the Chiefs since Natchitoches Central returned to District 1-5A in 2019, including last year's 34-3 win in Natchitoches.

## Did You Know...

...that former Byrd quarterback Arnaz Battle was a sixth-round draft pick of the San Francisco 49ers in 2003. He played receiver for the 49ers from 2003-09 and for the Pittsburgh Steelers from 201012. Battle and his wife, Billye, have four children and live in Texas.

## The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 20-12 (.625) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach. Ballew is 1-1 against the Natchitoches Central Chiefs.
Natchitoches Central is coached by Jess Curtis, who is in his first year as the head coach of the Chiefs. Curtis in in his 14th season as a head coach having spent 13 very successful seasons at Many. In his 13 seasons, Curtis took the Tigers to six state championship games, winning three titles in 2014, 2020 and 2022. Many defeated Union Parish 35-14 last year in the LHSAA's Non-Select Div. III State Championship. Curtis owns a 151-33 (.821) record in his 14 seasons as a head coach, including a 149-26 (.851) mark as the Many head coach.

## Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions
Two consecutive playoff appearances

Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.
An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.
In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.
After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football his-
 tory.

The 45 -year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

## Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 685-436-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 20-12 (.625) record through 32 games...With his 20th win, Ballew passed coach E.L. Alberson, who was 19-4-5 as the Jackets' head man from 1920-22... Ballew needs three more victories to tie three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

## 2023 Notes

As a team the Jackets had 333 rushing yards against Southwood, which marked the sixth time this season Byrd has eclipsed the 300 -yard mark...That equals the total number of games with over 300 rushing yards of last year's team...Fullback Desmond Simmons registered career highs in carries with 28 and rushing yards with 205 against Airline...Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 200 yards since Lake Lambert had 267 rushing yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game...Defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller had two interceptions against Southwood...It was the first multi-interception game for a Byrd defender since Chris Grieder's three picks against Haughton in 2020...Abraham-Miller has tied the single-season interception record with five, which is held by Grieder and Nicholas Peoples...Parkway's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was its lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since last year's Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop $63-8$ in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game... Byrd had six rushing touchdowns against Benton marking the second time this season the Jackets have rushed for six touchdowns... Quarterbacks Harrison Ayres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Abram Murray kicked two field goals $(24,25)$ against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two $(42,25)$ against Captain Shreve...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119 -year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five rushing touchdowns in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Johnson's 13 rushing touchdowns on the season are the most for a Byrd back since Mitchell Ramsey had 13 in 2021...Receiver Matthew Booras' 61 -yard reception against Parkway was the longest reception of the season...The 61 yards on that one play accounted for over half of Byrd's total offensive output (118) against the Panthers...Ja'Cari Williams is averaging 17.8 yards per kick return and his 33 -yard return against Airline is the longest of the season...Ballew is 1-1 against the Natchitoches Central Chiefs.
