Due to the unavailability of Lee Hedges Stadium and stadium scheduling issues, the playing date for the District 1-5A game between Byrd and Parkway has been moved multiple times. Finally settled, the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Parkway Panthers will meet on Thursday, Oct. 12, at Independence Stadium. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 2-4 overall record and a 2-1 record in District 1-5A after Friday's 31-28 win over the Haughton Buccaneers at Harold Harlan Stadium. The Parkway Panthers own a 5-1 overall record and a 2-1 District 1-5A record after Friday's 45-0 win over the Southwood Cowboys at Preston Crownover Stadium. Entering week seven, Byrd, Parkway and Airline are tied for second place in District 1-5A with identical 2-1 records. Captain Shreve sits in first place with a 3-0 mark.

Last Time Out

Byrd wing back Malachi Johnson returned to the lineup in a big way Friday against the Haughton Buccaneers. The junior rushed for a career-high 192 yards to lead the Yellow Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards. The 62-yard scamper came on Byrd's first play from scrimmage. The Parkway Panthers celebrated Homecoming 2023 with a 45-0 blanking of the Southwood Cowboys on Friday. Technically, it was the third shutout posted by the Panthers this season. In reality, it was the fourth time in six games that the Parkway defense did not allow an opposing offense to score. Haughton registered a defensive touchdown in Parkway's 24-6 win in week four.

The Series

This will be the 40th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and Parkway Panthers. The Yellow Jackets lead the series 23-16. This series began in 1970 with a 28-12 Byrd win, the first of three straight for the Jackets before Parkway posted its first win, 13-0, in 1977. In the 12 games since Parkway moved into District 1-5A, Byrd leads the series 7-5. However, the Byrd-Parkway series has historically been a series of streaks - from 1970-79 Byrd won six of the seven games; 1980-89 Parkway won eight of the 10 games; 1991-2008 Byrd won nine of the 10 games; 2011-16 Parkway won four of the six games, while Byrd has won five of the last six games. Last year, Byrd defeated Parkway 39-14 in Bossier City to give the Yellow Jackets their third straight victory over the Panthers.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 19-10 (.655) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach. Ballew is 2-0 against the Parkway Panthers.

Parkway is coached by Coy Brotherton, who is in his fourth season at the helm of the Panthers' program. Brotherton owns a 23-15 (.605) record at Parkway and a 53-32 (.624) overall record. He moved over to Parkway after spending five years at Captain Shreve as the Gators' offensive coordinator. Before Shreve, Brotherton was the head coach at Plain Dealing for four years compiling a 30-17 (.638), which is second best in Lions history. Brotherton comes from a family of football coaches. His father coached at Haughton for 33 years, including the Bucs 1977 State Championship season, while his brother, Jason, is the head coach at Haughton. Brotherton is 0-3 against the Byrd Yellow Jackets.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Two consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school historv.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football historv.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 684-434-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 19-10 (.655) record through 29 games...Ballew's 19 wins ties him with coach E.L. Alberson, who was 19-4-5 as the Jackets' head man from 1920-22...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

In its 31-28 win over Haughton, Byrd totaled 373 rushing yards marking the fourth time in six games the Yellow Jackets have amassed over 300 rushing yards in a game...Last year, the Jackets had six games with over 300 rushing yards...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...Byrd had six rushing touchdowns against Benton marking the second time this season the Jackets have rushed for six TDs... Quarterbacks Harrison Ayres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Asher Murray's 24-yard touchdown pass to Alex Schoonover was Byrd's first touchdown pass of the season...Five games is the farthest into a season that Byrd has gone before throwing a touchdown pass since 2021 when it took seven games before registering a TD pass...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...The last time Byrd started a season 0-4 was in 2019...Entering week seven, the combined record of the four teams Byrd lost to is 21-3...After the 0-4 start, the 2019 Jackets did win four of their next six games with the last three losses coming on a combined total of seven points...Huntington's 44-43 win over Byrd snapped the Jackets' six-game winning streak in the series with the Raiders...The loss to Huntington also snapped Byrd's 11-game winning streak against schools (public or private) from Caddo Parish...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five TDs in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Linebacker Sam Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against Pleasant Grove...Greer equaled that season-high with 11 tackles against Shreve...Byrd had two backs, Dixon Poirier and Malachi Johnson, each score two touchdowns against Captain Shreve...The last time Byrd had two different players score two or more touchdowns in a game was in 2022 against Southwood (Lambert -2 and Desmond Simmons - 4)...For the first time since 2021, the Jackets have used three different quarterbacks... Receiver Alex Schoonover had his first career touchdown reception against Benton...It came on a dazzling diving catch of an Asher Murray pass after he avoided a sack to deliver the pass...Receiver Matthew Booras had his first reception of the season against Haughton...It was a seven-yard catch on an Asher Murray pass which resulted in a Byrd first down.

BYRD BLASTS

The 2023 Schedule and Polls

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Byrd's three nondistrict opponents this season - Pleasant Grove, Huntington and Calvary - have a combined record of 16-2 through week six. For the second consecutive week, the Edna Karr Cougars (5-0) remain atop the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association Class 5A poll. The defending Non-select Div. I Champions Destrehan Wildcats (6-0), who have won 19 straight games, remain the No. 1 ranked team in the GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports polls. With Captain Shreve's decisive 60-35 win over previously undefeated and ninth-ranked Airline last Friday, no District 1-5A teams are ranked in this week's polls. The Gators and the Vikings received votes in the LSWA poll, were among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll and amongst the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll. The Calvary Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in Class 2A in the LSWA poll and No. 2 in the other two polls behind the St. Charles Catholic Comets. Pleasant Grove is ranked third in Dave Campbell's Texas Football Class 4A Div. II Rankings. The Hawks throttled district rival the Gilmer Buckeyes 63-28 last Friday.

Magical Malachi Continues His Wizardry

After missing the Benton game with an injury, junior wingback Malachi Johnson returned to action and ascended to wizard level by wielding his magic against the Haughton Buccaneers. Johnson rushed for a career-high 192 yards on just nine carries (21.3 avg.) and he scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards to lead the Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the Huntington game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almokary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Arnaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. He continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns, and was voted The Times Football Athlete of the Week for week five. Johnson leads the team with 591 rushing yards and 11 rushing touchdowns. He is averaging 10.6 yard per carry.

Ayres Apparent

Junior Harrison Ayres, who was the Jackets' starting tight end, has taken over as Byrd's starting guarterback and has led Byrd to two wins in the three games he's started. In the three games since taking over as the primary signal caller, Ayres has helped lead the Jackets' ground attack to 1,145 rushing yards and to average 40 points per game. Ayres has carried the ball 30 times for 159 yards and one touchdown in those three games. He was 2-for-4 passing for 76 yards and a touchdown against the Benton Tigers. The junior has seen time at tight end, quarterback and fullback so far this season.

More on Moberv

With injuries to fullback Dixon Poirier and wing back Malachi Johnson, Byrd was desperately looking for a back to step to the forefront of its multi-option offense heading into the Benton game. Seldom used senior wing back Jontavious Mobery stepped into the spotlight by rushing for a game-high 157 yards and three touchdowns against the Tigers. His 10 carries and long run of 43 yards as well as his 157 yards and three touchdowns were all career highs. Mobery paced the Jackets' rushing attack that finished with a season-high 466 yards, which was the sixth-best rushing performance in program history. He had half of Byrd's six rushing touchdowns on the night, which was the second time this season the Yellow Jackets have scored six rushing touchdowns in a game.

Don't Sleep on Simmons

Fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational sophomore season in 2022, and was splitting time with Dixon Poirier this season until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards - both career highs - and a touchdown. The junior burst onto the scene last year in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood, by rushing for a gamehigh 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. This season, Simmons has rushed for 289 yards and is averaging 4.4 yards per carry.

Murray Continues His Mastery

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray has just been masterful this season. Murray is averaging 41.3 yards per punt and has had six punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has four punts of over 50 yards, including a long of 65 yards. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has seven career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Benton, Murray kicked two field goals (24, 35). He was the first Byrd kicker since Scotty Roblow in 2018 to kick two field goals in a game. He kicked a 23 -yard field goal against Haughton, which proved to be the difference in the game, and moved into eighth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with eight career made field goals. Murray is 23-for-24 on PAT kicks, and 29 of his 34 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks this season.

Hilliard Highlights Again

The effort of junior wingback Quinton Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. Hilliard had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. Hilliard had a highlight reel 15-yard touchdown run against Benton. The junior, who also plays basketball for Byrd, took a toss around the right end and down the sidelines before leaping from the four-yard line into the end zone for the touchdown, his first as a Yellow Jacket. Hilliard is averaging 10.2 yards per carry on the season.

Believing In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras has done. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, who's a Miami Hurricanes commit, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras has earned a starting job as a wide receiver. He had his first reception of the season against Haughton. A seven-yard reception that resulted in a first down. More importantly, he is Byrd's primary kick and punt returner. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, has 10 kickoff returns for 142 yards and six punt returns for 77 yards this season.

Big Plays Continue to Bite Byrd

Big plays continue to bite Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Byrd's defense gave up six plays of 20-plus yards, including a 64-yard rush by Hawks' running back Nick Bells. Pleasant Grove also had a kickoff return of 60 yards. It was the big play that allowed the Huntington Raiders to capture the 44-43 win over Byrd. The Jackets allowed five scoring plays of 20 or more yards, including a 62-yard pass from Lorenzo White to Kaleb Tucker. That pass-catch duo was responsible for three of those five big plays, including an 82-yard touchdown pass on the Raiders second possession of the fourth quarter. On Huntington's first possession of the fourth quarter. White hooked up with Jamarion Washington for an 80-yard touchdown. Both of those possessions were one play, 80-plus yard scores. Against Calvary, Cavaliers quarterback Abram Wardell threw three touchdown passes of 77, 53 and 49 yards. Against Shreve, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis' 66-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in the game. On Benton's first play from scrimmage the Tigers completed a seven-vard hitch that turned into an 80-vard touchdown. With 2:58 remaining in the Haughton game and the Buccaneers faced with fourth down and six from their own 24, quarterback Christian Turner connected with receiver Zu'Mondous Davis on a 76-yard touchdown pass to cut the Byrd lead to 31-28. Through six games, Byrd's defense has given up 12 scoring plays (11 pass, 1 rush) of 40 or more yards.

Full Speed Ahead for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from last year's team is senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. After a fine junior campaign, in which he tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops, Fullwood is now the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. He suffered a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria last year. After a lengthy recovery, it has been full speed ahead for Fullwood in this his senior season. Fullwood has 34 total tackles, including 13 solo stops and two fumble recoveries. His seven tackles-for-loss is tied for the team lead with his linebacking mate Sam Greer. Last week, Fullwood was the recipient of the Honesty & Integrity Award presented by the Masonic Lodge 179.

Sam I Am

Ashton Fullwood's linebacking mate is junior Sam Greer. The duo has been a bright spot for Byrd's defense. Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against Pleasant Grove. He matched that high of 11 tackles against Shreve. Through six games, Greer leads the team with 51 total tackles, including 20 solo stops, seven tackles-for-loss and a forced fumble. Greer had 10 tackles against Benton and was the first Byrd defender to 1egister back-to-back double-digit tackle games since last season when All-District, All-City Defensive MVP Brooks Brossette had three straight double-digit tackle games in weeks 6-8.

Not Taken For Grant-ed

The important roles that senior Grant Johnson plays on this team is not taken for granted by his teammates and coaches. Johnson, who also plays baseball at Byrd, is the starting free safety on the Purple Swarm Defense and he's the long snapper on punts and place kicks. His 28 total tackles ranks third behind Greer and Fullwood. Johnson has three tackles-for-loss, two passes defended and two interceptions. His outstanding snapping efforts have allowed Abram Murray to average over 40 yards per punt and be 5-of-7 on field goals with the only two misses coming on 50-plus yard attempts.

Playoff Picture Cleared, Reclassification Coming

In August, a Louisiana judge issued a temporary injunction in favor of the nine member schools currently locked in a lawsuit against the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA). The injunction effectively bars the LHSAA from implementing its current playoff format which was revamped last fall to include a new definition for "select" schools. Since 2013, Byrd was deemed a "select" school and has participated in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs every season, reaching the state finals in 2013 and 2020. On Tuesday, Oct. 4, in a special meeting, the LHSAA voted in favor of accepting the Executive Committee's definition of a "select" school, thereby keeping the current playoff system in place for 2023. The next big issue on the association's agenda is reclassification and redistricting. The process begins with the gathering and finalizing of enrollment numbers at the 404 member schools.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for nearly 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 26th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while Byrd champion golfer Grant Reagan provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. Fans can download the 1130 The Tiger app to their smart device and listen to Byrd Football anywhere.
