Going Back to Bossier For the second time this season the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River to Bossier Parish to play a District 1-5A game. On Friday, Oct. 20, the Jackets will head over to north Bossier City to take on the Airline Vikings. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at M.D. Ray Field at Airline Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 2-5 overall record and a 2-2 record in District 1-5A after last Thursday's 21-3 loss to the Parkway Panthers at Independence Stadium. The Airline Vikings own a 6-1 overall record and a 3-1 District 1-5A record after Thursday's 56-21 trouncing of the Haughton Buccaneers at Harold Harlan Stadium. Entering week eight, Parkway and Airline are tied for second place in District 1-5A with identical 3-1 records. Captain Shreve sits in first place with a 4-0 mark.

Last Time Out

Parkway's defense lived up to its billing as the Panthers complete stymied Byrd's multi-option offense, limiting the Jackets to their lowest output of the season at just 118 yards. Leading 7-3, Parkway used two 80-yard scoring drives, one at the end of the first half and the other to begin the second half to take a 21-3 lead midway through the third quarter. It would be all the scoring Parkway would need as the Panthers' defense kept Byrd out of the end zone for the first time since week two of the 2019 season. The week after suffering their first loss of the season and playing a Haughton Buccaneer team that knocked them from the 2022 playoffs, the Airline Vikings scored early and often in the first half to lead by 35 points at halftime. Airline exacted a small bit of revenge on Haughton, who knocked the Vikings out of the 2022 playoffs, as it cruised to the 56-21 win.

The Series

This will be the 48th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Airline Vikings in a series that began in 1964. The Yellow Jackets captured a 27-6 victory in that inaugural meeting, and hold a 29-18 lead in the series. Airline's 36-20 win over Byrd in 2017 snapped the Yellow Jackets' 14-game winning streak over the Vikings. These two schools have played every year since 1991, including twice in 2008 and 2011. In those 34 games, the Yellow Jackets hold a 24-10 advantage. Byrd has won 18 of the 20 games against Airline since 2005. In 2016, Byrd captured a thrilling 36-34 victory over Airline in triple overtime. In 2019, the Jackets upset the seventh-ranked Vikings 21-6 in a driving rainstorm at M.D. Ray Field at Airline Stadium. Last year, Airline defeated Byrd 48-28 at Lee Hedges Stadium.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 19-11 (.633) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach. Ballew is 2-0 against the Parkway Panthers.

Airline is coached by Justin Scogin, who is in his second year as the head coach of the Vikings. Scogin owns a 13-5 (.722) record through 18 games as the Vikings' head coach. Last season, he led Airline to the District 1-5A title and was named the District Coach-of-the-Year. Scogin took over for Bo Meeks, who stepped away from coaching over health concerns in 2022. Scogin is no stranger to District 1-5A as he served as an assistant coach at Parkway under David Feaster. After Parkway, Scogin went down to Leesville and was the Wampus Cats' offensive coordinator for four years.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Two consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school historv.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football historv.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 684-435-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 19-11 (.633) record through 30 games...Ballew's 19 wins ties him with coach E.L. Alberson, who was 19-4-5 as the Jackets' head man from 1920-22...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

Parkway's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was its lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since last year's Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...In its 31-28 win over Haughton. Byrd totaled 373 rushing vards marking the fourth time in six games the Yellow Jackets have amassed over 300 rushing yards in a game...Last year, the Jackets had six games with over 300 rushing yards...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...Byrd had six rushing touchdowns against Benton marking the second time this season the Jackets have rushed for six TDs... Ouarterbacks Harrison Avres and Asher Murrav each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Asher Murray's 24-yard touchdown pass to Alex Schoonover was Byrd's first touchdown pass of the season...Five games is the farthest into a season that Byrd has gone before throwing a touchdown pass since 2021 when it took seven games before registering a TD pass...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...The last time Byrd started a season 0-4 was in 2019...Entering week seven, the combined record of the four teams Byrd lost to is 21-3...After the 0-4 start, the 2019 Jackets did win four of their next six games with the last three losses coming on a combined total of seven points...Huntington's 44-43 win over Byrd snapped the Jackets' six-game winning streak in the series with the Raiders...The loss to Huntington also snapped Byrd's 11-game winning streak against schools (public or private) from Caddo Parish...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five TDs in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Receiver Alex Schoonover had his first career touchdown reception against Benton...It came on a dazzling diving catch of an Asher Murray pass after he avoided a sack to deliver the pass...Receiver Matthew Booras' 61-yard reception against Parkway was the longest reception of the season...The 61 yards on that one play accounted for over half of Byrd's total offensive output (118) against the Panthers.

BYRD BLASTS

Parkway Defense Stuffs Byrd

Parkway's tough defense lived up to its pregame billing by holding Byrd to just three points, which was the Jackets lowest point total since being shutout 24-0 in week two of the 2019 season against West Monroe. Parkway stuffed Byrd's multi-option offense by limiting the Jackets to just 34 plays and 118 yards of total offense, which was its lowest yardage output (76) since 2016 against Evangel. It was also the fifth time in seven games that Parkway's defense did not allow an opposing offense to reach the end zone.

The 2023 Schedule and Polls

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Byrd's three nondistrict opponents this season - Pleasant Grove, Huntington and Calvary - have a combined record of 19-2 through week seven. For the third consecutive week, the Edna Karr Cougars (6-0) remain atop the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association Class 5A poll. The defending Non-select Div. I Champions Destrehan Wildcats (7-0), who have won 20 straight games, remain the No. 1 ranked team in the GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports polls. Despite having three teams with 6-1 records, no District 1-5A teams are ranked in this week's polls. Captain Shreve and Airline received votes in the LSWA poll and were among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll. The Gators, Vikings and Parkway Panthers were amongst the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll. The Calvary Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in Class 2A in the LSWA poll and No. 2 in the other two polls behind the St. Charles Catholic Comets. Pleasant Grove is ranked third in Dave Campbell's Texas Football Class 4A Div. II Rankings. For the second straight week the Hawks scored 63 points in a district game, beating Pittsburg 63-7rival the Gilmer Buckeyes 63-28 last Friday.

Magical Malachi Continues His Wizardry

After missing the Benton game with an injury, junior wingback Malachi Johnson returned to action and ascended to wizard level by wielding his magic against the Haughton Buccaneers. Johnson rushed for a career-high 192 yards on just nine carries (21.3 avg.) and he scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards to lead the Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the Huntington game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almokary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Arnaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. He continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns, and was voted The Times Football Athlete of the Week for week five. Johnson leads the team with 594 rushing yards and 11 rushing touchdowns. He is averaging 9.7 yard per carry.

Avres Apparent

Junior Harrison Ayres, who was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the season, has taken over as Byrd's starting quarterback and has led the Jackets to two wins in the four games he's started. In the four games since taking over as the primary signal caller, Ayres has helped lead the Jackets' ground attack to 1,202 rushing yards and to average 31 points per game. Ayres has carried the ball 39 times for 182 yards and one touchdown in those four games. He was 2-for-4 passing for 76 yards and a touchdown against the Benton Tigers. The junior has seen time at tight end, guarterback and fullback so far this season.

Don't Sleep on Simmons

Fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational sophomore season in 2022, and was splitting time with Dixon Poirier this season until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards - both career highs - and a touchdown. The junior burst onto the scene last year in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood, by rushing for a gamehigh 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. This season, Simmons has rushed for 307 yards, one touchdown and is averaging 4.1 yards per carry.

Murray Continues His Mastery

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray has just been masterful this season. Murray is averaging just under 40 yards per punt and has had seven punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has five punts of over 50 yards, including a long of 68 yards against Parkway. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has eight career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45 -yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Benton, Murray kicked two field goals (24, 35). He was the first Byrd kicker since Scotty Roblow in 2018 to kick two field goals in a game. He kicked a 23-yard field goal against Parkway moved him into a four-way tie for fifth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with nine career made field goals. Murray is 23-for-24 on PAT kicks, and 31 of his 36 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks this season.

Believing In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras has done. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, who's a Miami Hurricanes commit, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras has earned a starting job as a wide receiver. His 61-yard catch and run against Parkway was the longest reception of the season for the Jackets. More importantly, he is Byrd's primary kick and punt returner. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, has 10 kickoff returns for 142 yards and six punt returns for 77 yards this season.

Big Plays Continue to Bite Byrd

Big plays continue to bite Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Byrd's defense gave up six plays of 20-plus yards, including a 64-yard rush by Hawks' running back Nick Bells. Pleasant Grove also had a kickoff return of 60 yards. It was the big play that allowed the Huntington Raiders to capture the 44-43 win over Byrd. The Jackets allowed five scoring plays of 20 or more yards, including a 62-yard pass from Lorenzo White to Kaleb Tucker. That pass-catch duo was responsible for three of those five big plays, including an 82-yard touchdown pass on the Raiders second possession of the fourth quarter. On Huntington's first possession of the fourth quarter, White hooked up with Jamarion Washington for an 80-yard touchdown. Both of those possessions were one play, 80-plus yard scores. Against Calvary, Cavaliers quarterback Abram Wardell threw three touchdown passes of 77, 53 and 49 yards. Against Shreve, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis' 66-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in the game. On Benton's first play from scrimmage the Tigers completed a seven-vard hitch that turned into an 80-vard touchdown. With 2:58 remaining in the Haughton game and the Buccaneers faced with fourth down and six from their own 24, quarterback Christian Turner connected with receiver Zu'Mondous Davis on a 76-yard touchdown pass to cut the Byrd lead to 31-28. Through seven games, Byrd's defense has given up 12 scoring plays (11 pass, 1 rush) of 40 or more yards.

Buzz Back In Time

The Byrd Yellow Jackets and Airline Vikings played twice during the 2008 season. The first meeting was the District 1-5A opener in week two of the season. Behind Tramario Hall's 144 rushing yards and two touchdowns, Byrd shut out Airline 28-0 at then Caddo Parish Stadium. The real story was the performance of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense, which held Airline scoreless and limited the Vikings to just 141 yards of total offense. Nine weeks later, the two teams would meet again in the first round of the Class 5A playoffs. Again, the Purple Swarm Defense held the Vikings scoreless as Byrd defeated Airline 13-0. Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy booted two field goals in the first quarter to put the Jackets ahead 6-0. Shaughnessy's second field goal was a 56 yarder, which set school, city and Caddo-Bossier records for the longest field goal in history. After a stellar career at Northwestern State, Shaughnessy, who owns the school record for field goals made in a career with 18, is a surgeon in Jackson, Miss., now.

Full Speed Ahead for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from last year's team is senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. After a fine junior campaign, in which he tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops, Fullwood is now the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. He suffered a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria last year. After a lengthy recovery, it has been full speed ahead for Fullwood in this his senior season. In his career, Fullwood has 103 total tackles, including 55 solo stops, 14 tackles-for-loss and three fumble recoveries. Against Parkway, Fullwood registered career highs with 14 tackles and four tackles-for-loss. Fullwood recently received the Honesty & Integrity Award from Masonic Lodge 179.

Sam I Am

Ashton Fullwood's linebacking mate is junior Sam Greer. The duo has been a bright spot for Byrd's defense. Greer had 11 total tackles, including five solo stops and a tackle-for-loss against Pleasant Grove. He matched that high of 11 tackles against Shreve. Through seven games, Greer leads the team with 61 total tackles, including 23 solo stops, eight tackles-for-loss and a forced fumble. Greer has had four double-digit tackles games to his credit this season.

Not Taken For Grant-ed

The important roles that senior Grant Johnson plays on this team is not taken for granted by his teammates and coaches. Johnson, who also plays baseball at Byrd, is the starting free safety on the Purple Swarm Defense and he's the long snapper on punts and place kicks. His 38 total tackles ranks third behind Greer and Fullwood. Johnson has seven tackles-for-loss, two passes defended, two interceptions and a fumble recovery this season. He had his first double-digit tackle game of his career with 10 against Parkway. His outstanding snapping efforts have allowed Abram Murray to average nearly 40 yards per punt and be 6-of-8 on field goal attempts.

Playoff Picture Cleared, Reclassification Coming

In August, a Louisiana judge issued a temporary injunction in favor of the nine member schools currently locked in a lawsuit against the Louisiana High School Athletic Association (LHSAA). The injunction effectively bars the LHSAA from implementing its current playoff format which was revamped last fall to include a new definition for "select" schools. Since 2013, Byrd was deemed a "select" school and has participated in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs every season, reaching the state finals in 2013 and 2020. On Tuesday, Oct. 4, in a special meeting, the LHSAA voted in favor of accepting the Executive Committee's definition of a "select" school, thereby keeping the current playoff system in place for 2023. The next big issue on the association's agenda is reclassification and redistricting. The process begins with the gathering and finalizing of enrollment numbers at its 404 member schools.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for nearly 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 26th season as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while Byrd champion golfer Grant Reagan provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. Fans can download the 1130 The Tiger app to their smart device and listen to Byrd Football anywhere.
