Homecoming 2023

On Friday, Oct. 27, the City of Byrd will celebrate Homecoming 2023 when the Jackets play host to the Southwood Cowboys at Independence Stadium. Note the special kickoff time of 5 p.m. Following the Byrd game, the Woodlawn Knights and Northwood Falcons are scheduled to kickoff at 8 p.m.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 2-6 overall record and a 2-3 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 42-28 loss to the Airline Vikings. After a 42-6 loss to the Captain Shreve Gators last Thursday, the Southwood Cowboys remain winless on the season with a 0-8 overall record and a 0-5 record in district play. Southwood's last victory, one that wasn't later forfeited, was an 18-16 win over Parkway on Nov. 1, 2019. The Cowboys have lost (and or forfeited) 34 games since. Southwood's losing skid started the week after the win over Parkway when the Cowboys were beaten 44-6 by the Byrd Yellow Jackets. Since 2018, the Cowboys have a 2-51 record.

Last Time Out

Trailing Airline 35-28 in the fourth quarter, Byrd was faced with a fourth down and three from its own 33. A fumble on the handoff between quarterback Harrison Ayres and fullback Desmond Simmons was recovered by the Vikings. Six plays later Airline quarterback tossed his fourth touchdown pass of the game to lift the Vikings to a 42-28 win over the Jackets. Captain Shreve remained undefeated in District 1-5A with a 42-6 win last Thursday over the Southwood Cowboys.

The Series

This will be the 52nd meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Southwood Cowboys in a series that dates back to 1970. The Jackets lead the overall series 34-17. This has been a series of streaks as Byrd won the first four meetings, then Southwood won 15 of the next 16. The Yellow Jackets have won 29 of the last 31 games over the Cowboys, including a string of 13 straight over Southwood since 2010. Last year, Byrd shut out Southwood 58-0, marking the ninth time the Jackets have shutout the Cowboys in this series. It was also the largest margin of victory for Byrd in the 51-year history of the series. Southwood has shut out Byrd only once, 27-0, in 1975. In 1988, Byrd surrendered the most points in school history suffering a 70-6 loss to Southwood. Byrd's 37-24 win in 2021 was the smallest margin of victory in the Jackets' current 13-game winning streak.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 19-12 (.613) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach. Ballew is 2-0 against the Southwood Cowboys.

Southwood is coached by Mike Green, who is in his first year as the head coach of the Cowboys. Green in in his 14th season as a head coach with stints at Woodlawn, Huntington and Mansfield before Southwood. He owns a 52-86 (.377) record in his 14 seasons as a head coach, including 0-8 as the Cowboys' head coach. Green went 13-26 in four seasons (2000-03) with the Woodlawn Knights, 9-19 in three seasons (2004-06) with the Huntington Raiders, and 30-33 in six seasons (2016-21) with the Mansfield Wolverines. He spent the 2022 season as an assistant at Woodlawn. Green has a 1-2 record against Byrd with all three meetings coming during his stint as the Huntington head coach.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Two consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school histo-

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football his-



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 684-436-35 (.607) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 19-12 (.613) record through 31 games...Ballew's 19 wins ties him with coach E.L. Alberson, who was 19-4-5 as the Jackets' head man from 1920-22...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown, and has won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 13 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 17 of the last 18 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

Fullback Desmond Simmons registered career highs in carries with 28 and rushing yards with 205 against Airline...Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 200 yards since Lake Lamber had 267 rushing yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game...As a team the Jackets amassed 389 rushing yards against the Vikings, which marked the fifth time this season Byrd has eclipsed the 300-vard mark...Last year, the Jackets had six games with over 300 rushing yards...Defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller intercepted his third pass of the season against Airline...Last year, safety Christian Jones led the team with three interceptions...Parkway's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was its lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since last year's Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...Byrd had six rushing touchdowns against Benton marking the second time this season the Jackets have rushed for six TDs... Quarterbacks Harrison Ayres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five rushing touchdowns in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs... Receiver Alex Schoonover had his first career touchdown reception against Benton...It came on a dazzling diving catch of an Asher Murray pass after he avoided a sack to deliver the pass...Receiver Matthew Booras' 61-yard reception against Parkway was the longest reception of the season...The 61 yards on that one play accounted for over half of Byrd's total offensive output (118) against the Panthers...Ja'Cari Williams is averaging 17.8 yards per kick return and his 33-yard return against Airline is the longest of the season...Byrd owns a 17-8 record in Homecoming games over the previous 25 seasons...Ballew is 0-2 in Homecoming games...The Jackets suffered a 23-10 loss to Natchitoches Central in 2021 and a 23-14 loss to the Haughton Buccaneers last season.

BYRD BLASTS

The 2023 Schedule, Polls and More

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule made the playoffs in 2022. Byrd's three non-district opponents this season - Pleasant Grove, Huntington and Calvary - have a combined record of 19-2 through week seven. For the fourth consecutive week, the Edna Karr Cougars (7-0) remain atop the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association Class 5A poll. The defending Non-Select Div. I Champion Destrehan Wildcats (8-0), who have won 21 straight games, remain the No. 1 ranked team in the GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports polls. The Captain Shreve Gators are ranked ninth in the CrescentCitySports poll and 10th in the GeauxPreps poll. Both Shreve and Airline received votes in the LSWA poll. The Vikings were amongst the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll and the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll. The Calvary Cavaliers are ranked No. 1 in Class 2A in the LSWA poll and No. 2 in the other two polls behind the St. Charles Catholic Comets. Pleasant Grove is ranked third in Dave Campbell's Texas Football Class 4A Div. Il Rankings. In the latest Power Rankings, Byrd was at No. 16. If the LHSAA Select Division I Playoffs were to begin this week, the Jackets would face the No. 17 Northwood Falcons.

Don't Sleep on Simmons

Fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational sophomore season in 2022, and was splitting time with Dixon Poirier this season until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards and a touchdown. Against Airline, Simmons had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. He was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game. The junior burst onto the scene last year in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood, by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. This season, Simmons has rushed for 512 yards, one touchdown and is averaging 5.0 yards per carry.

Magical Malachi Continues His Wizardry

After missing the Benton game with an injury, junior wingback Malachi Johnson returned to action and ascended to wizard level by wielding his magic against the Haughton Buccaneers. Johnson rushed for a career-high 192 yards on just nine carries (21.3 avg.) and he scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards to lead the Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the Huntington game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almokary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Arnaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. He continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns, and was voted *The Times* Football Athlete of the Week for week five. Johnson currently leads the team with 660 rushing yards and 12 rushing touchdowns. He is averaging 9.7 yard per carry.

Ayres Apparent

Junior Harrison Ayres, who was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the season, has taken over as Byrd's starting quarterback and has led the Jackets to two wins in the five games he's started. In the five games since taking over as the primary signal caller, Ayres has helped lead the Jackets' ground attack to average 318 rushing yards and 30.2 points per game. Ayres has carried the ball 47 times for 236 yards and two touchdowns and is 2-for-5 passing for 76 yards and a touchdown. The junior has seen time at tight end, quarterback and fullback so far this season.

Did You Know...

...that Byrd offensive coordinator Wade Leone is a Southwood alum. He was the Cowboys' quarterback in 1997-98 and was 0-2 against Jackets. After graduating from Southwood, Leone went to Northwestern State University where he played for the Demons. Leone started out as a quarterback and then earned a letter as a safety on the 2002 team that went 9-4 and reached the I-AA playoffs, making 16 tackles, breaking up 2 passes and forcing a fumble

Murray Continues His Mastery

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray has just been masterful this season. Murray is averaging just under 40 yards per punt and has had seven punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has five punts of over 50 yards, including a career-long punt of 68 yards against Parkway. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has eight career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Benton, Murray kicked two field goals (24, 35). He was the first Byrd kicker since Scotty Roblow in 2018 to kick two field goals in a game. He kicked a 23-yard field goal against Haughton, which proved to be the difference in the game. His 23-yard field goal against Parkway moved him into a four-way tie for fifth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with nine career made field goals. Murray is 27-for-28 on PAT kicks, and 34 of his 40 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks this season.

Believing In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras has done. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, who's a Miami Hurricanes commit, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras has earned a starting job as a wide receiver. His 61-yard catch and run against Parkway was the longest reception of the season for the Jackets. More importantly, he is Byrd's primary kick and punt returner. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, has 11 kickoff returns for 161 yards and six punt returns for 77 yards this season.

Hilliard Highlights Again

The effort of junior wingback Quinton Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. Hilliard had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. Hilliard had a highlight reel 15-yard touchdown run against Benton. The junior, who also plays basketball for Byrd, took a toss around the right end and down the sidelines before leaping from the four-yard line into the end zone for the touchdown, his first as a Yellow Jacket. Against Airline, Hilliard had a 14-yard touchdown run. The junior is averaging 10.4 yards per carry and a touchdown every 10 carries.

Big Plays Continue to Bite Byrd

Big plays continue to bite Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. In the opener against Pleasant Grove, Byrd's defense gave up six plays of 20-plus yards, including a 64-yard rush by Hawks' running back Nick Bells. Pleasant Grove also had a kickoff return of 60 yards. It was the big play that allowed the Huntington Raiders to capture the 44-43 win over Byrd. The Jackets allowed five scoring plays of 20 or more yards, including a 62-yard pass from Lorenzo White to Kaleb Tucker. That pass-catch duo was responsible for three of those five big plays, including an 82-yard touchdown pass on the Raiders second possession of the fourth quarter. On Huntington's first possession of the fourth quarter, White hooked up with Jamarion Washington for an 80-yard touchdown. Both of those possessions were one play, 80-plus yard scores. Against Calvary, Cavaliers quarterback Abram Wardell threw three touchdown passes of 77, 53 and 49 yards. Against Shreve, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis' 66-yard touchdown run in the fourth quarter proved to be the difference in the game. On Benton's first play from scrimmage the Tigers completed a seven-vard hitch that turned into an 80-vard touchdown. With 2:58 remaining in the Haughton game and the Buccaneers faced with fourth down and six from their own 24, quarterback Christian Turner connected with receiver Zu'Mondous Davis on a 76-yard touchdown pass to cut the Byrd lead to 31-28. Through eight games, Byrd's defense has given up 12 scoring plays (11 pass, 1 rush) of 40 or more yards.

Playoff Picture Becoming Clearer

With the LHSAA's decision to approve the definition of a "select" school on Oct. 4, the Select Division I Playoffs format will be like it was in 2022. The top eight seeds will received first round byes and the remaining 16 teams will meet in the bi-district round. The Byrd Yellow Jackets have been designated a "select" school for nearly a decade, and according to the latest GeauxPreps power rankings Byrd currently sits at No. 16 with two regular season games remaining. If the Select Division I Playoffs were to begin this week, the Yellow Jackets would host the No. 17 Northwood Falcons in the first round. Obviously, the power rankings will change over the next two weeks. The LHSAA will release the playoff brackets on Sunday, Nov. 5.

Full Speed Ahead for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from last year's team is senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. After a fine junior campaign, in which he tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops, Fullwood is now the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. He suffered a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria last year. After a lengthy recovery, it has been full speed ahead for Fullwood in this his senior season. In his career, Fullwood has 111 total tackles, including 60 solo stops, 15 tackeles-forloss and three fumble recoveries. Against Parkway, Fullwood registered career highs with 14 tackles and four tackles-for-loss. Fullwood recently received the Honesty & Integrity Award from Masonic Lodge 179. The senior had eight total tackles, including five unassisted tackles, and a tackle-for-loss against Airline.

Ja'Cari Jumps Into the Fray

Sophomore defensive back Ja'Cari Williams has really jumped into the fray over the last few games. Williams' first significant action came against Captain Shreve, when he had five total tackles, including three solo stops. His had a personal-best seven tackles in Byrd's 31-28 win over Haughton. Against Airline, Williams had four total tackles but really stood out on special teams as he had three kickoff returns for 59 yards, including a long of 33.

Not Taken For Grant-ed

The important roles that senior Grant Johnson plays on this team is not taken for granted by his teammates and coaches. Johnson, who also plays baseball at Byrd, is the starting free safety on the Purple Swarm Defense and he's the long snapper on punts and place kicks. His 41 total tackles ranks third behind Greer and Fullwood. Johnson has five tackles-for-loss, two passes defended, two interceptions and a fumble recovery this season. He had his first double-digit tackle game of his career with 10 against Parkway. His outstanding snapping efforts have allowed Abram Murray to average nearly 40 yards per punt and be 6-of-9 on field goal attempts.
