On Friday, Nov. 10, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel to Metairie and the Shrine on Airline to battle the Jesuit Blue Jays in the bi-district round of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at the stadium formerly known as Zephyr Field.

A Little About the Teams

Byrd enters the playoffs with a 4-6 overall record and is the No. 17 seed. The Yellow Jackets finished in a three-way tie for third place in District 1-5A with a 4-3 record. Byrd defeated Natchitoches Central 42-14 in last Friday's regular season finale at Independence Stadium. Jesuit also enters the playoffs with a 4-6 overall record. The Blue Jays garnered the No. 16 seed after their 13-10 win over the Archbishop Rummel Raiders last Friday, Jesuit finished with a 2-4 record in District 9-5A, aka "The Catholic League."

Last Time Out

Malachi Johnson rushed for 161 yards and two touchdowns to lead Byrd to a 42-14 victory over Natchitoches Central last Friday at Independence Stadium. Johnson's output paced Byrd's rushing attack that amassed 376 rushing yards and scored five rushing touchdowns. After Rummel took an early 3-0 lead. Jesuit tied the score on an Ethan Cabos 40-vard field goal. A one-vard touchdown run by Blue Jay quarterback Beau Perez and a Cabos 31-yard field goal made the score 13-3 with 4:35 left in the first half. Rummel would cut the lead to 13-10 with 25 seconds remaining in the first half, but that would be all the scoring in the game as the Blue Jays held on to beat the Raiders 13-10.

The Series

This will be the 10th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Jesuit Blue Javs in a series that dates back to 1931. Byrd defeated Jesuit 14-0 in 1931 to finish the season 11-0 and capture its second straight state championship. Eight of the nine previous meetings between these historic programs have come in the state playoffs. Each team has won four games in the series and there has been one tie. The one tie, a scoreless affair, came in the 1933 title game. Jesuit was awarded the win based on penetrations (2-0), and would claim the school's first football state title. The Jackets would get their revenge in 1935 by beating the Jays 19-0 in the state championship. Byrd's only setback of the 1943 season was a 25-7 loss to Jesuit in the state championship game. The Blue Jays would beat the Yellow Jackets 7-6 in the 1953 state championship at State Fair Stadium in Shreveport. Jesuit would make it four straight over Byrd with wins in 1960 and 1964. A week after beating Jesuit - Shreveport 35-0, Byrd defeated Jesuit - New Orleans, 21-12, in week three of the 1966 season. That was also the only non-playoff game in the series. In the last meeting during the 2002 playoffs, the Yellow Jackets defeated the Blue Jays 27-7, which gave Byrd its first playoff victory in 40 years.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 21-12 (.636) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach.

Jesuit is coached by Ryan Manale, who is in his third year as the head coach of the Blue Jays. He is 19-14 (.576) in his three seasons at Jesuit. Manale is in his 12th season as a head coach having spent nine successful seasons at De La Salle in New Orleans. In his nine seasons at De La Salle, Manale took the Cavaliers to three LHSAA Select Division II State Championship games in 2017, 2019 and 2020. Manale owns a 98-37 (.726) record in his 12 seasons as a head coach, including a 79-23 (.775) mark as the De La Salle head coach.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Three consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school historv.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football historv.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

This is the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 98th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 21 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 75-29-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 686-436-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 21-12 (.636) record through 33 games...With his 20th win, Ballew passed coach E.L. Alberson, who was 19-4-5 as the Jackets' head man from 1920-22... Ballew needs three more victories to tie three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 14 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 40 different seasons and holds a 34-32-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

With 376 rushing yards in its 42-14 win over Natchitoches Central, Byrd eclipsed the 300-yard mark plateau for the seventh time this season...Byrd also had five rushing touchdowns against the Chiefs, which marked the fourth time the Jackets have had five or more rushing TDs in a game this season... Fullback Desmond Simmons registered career highs in carries with 28 and rushing yards with 205 against Airline...Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 200 yards since Lake Lambert had 267 rushing yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game...Defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller had two interceptions against Southwood...It was the first multi-interception game for a Byrd defender since Chris Grieder's three picks against Haughton in 2020...Abraham-Miller's first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central set the single-season interception record with six...Nicholas Peoples holds the career interception record with 10...Parkwav's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was its lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since last year's Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 vards in a game...Ouarterbacks Harrison Avres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...Quarterbacks Asher Murray and Ayres scored their first ever varsity touchdowns against Calvary...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Quarterback Lake Lambert had five rushing touchdowns in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Johnson's 15 rushing touchdowns on the season are the most for a Byrd back since fullback Charlie Barham had 17 in 2018...Receiver Matthew Booras' 61-yard reception against Parkway was the longest reception of the season...The 61 yards on that one play accounted for over half of Byrd's total offensive output (118) against the Panthers...Booras had the first touchdown reception of his career, a 26-yarder, against Natchitoches Central...Linebacker Sam Greer has registered six double-digit tackle games this season, including three season-high 11 tackle

BYRD BLASTS

The 2023 Schedule, Polls and More

Seven of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2023 schedule have advanced to the playoffs. Byrd's three nondistrict opponents this season - Pleasant Grove, Huntington and Calvary - have a combined record of 27-3 through week 10. The defending Non-Select Div. I Champion Destrehan Wildcats (10-0), who have won 24 straight games, and the Ruston Bearcats (10) are tied for the No. 1 ranking team in the final Louisiana Sports Writer's Association poll. GeauxPreps and CrescentCitySports doesn't do a poll after week 10. The Captain Shreve Gators (9-1), who are the District 1-5A Champions, are ranked eighth, while the Airline Vikings (9-1) are 10th in the LSWA poll. The Calvary Cavaliers (10-0) are ranked No. 1 in Class 2A in the final LSWA poll. Pleasant Grove (10-0) was ranked third in Dave Campbell's Texas Football Class 4A Div. II Rankings for most of the season. The Hawks will play Rusk in the first round of the University Interscholastic League Playoffs.

Magical Malachi Johnson

After missing the Benton game with an injury, junior wingback Malachi Johnson returned to action and ascended to wizard level by wielding his magic against the Haughton Buccaneers. Johnson rushed for a career-high 192 yards on just nine carries (21.3 avg.) and he scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards to lead the Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the Huntington game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almokary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Arnaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. He continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns, and was voted The Times Football Athlete of the Week for week five. Johnson currently leads the team with 886 rushing yards and 15 rushing touchdowns, and he is averaging 10.9 yards per carry. The last Byrd wing back to average 10-plus yards a carry for an entire season was Mitchell Ramsey in 2021, who averaged 10.8 yards per attempt, while amassing 900 rushing yards and scoring 13 rushing touchdowns.

Simmons Is No Sleeper

Fullback Desmond Simmons had a sensational sophomore season in 2022, and was splitting time with Dixon Poirier this season until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards and a touchdown. Against Airline, Simmons had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. He was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game. The junior burst onto the scene last year in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. This season, Simmons has rushed for 649 yards, two touchdowns and is averaging 4.7 yards per carry.

Harrison Paints A Pretty Picture

Junior Harrison Ayres, who was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the season, has taken over as Byrd's starting quarterback and has led the Jackets to four wins in the seven games he's started. In the seven games since taking over as the Jackets' primary signal caller, Ayres has helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 328.6 rushing yards and 32.9 points per game. He has carried the ball 58 times for 299 yards and four touchdowns. The junior has seen time at tight end, quarterback and fullback this season.

Mobery's Sweet Senior Season

Wing back Jontavious Mobery continues to have a sweet senior season. He's rushed for 397 yards, four touchdowns and is averaging an incredible 10.7 yards per carry. Mobery had a game-high 157 yards and three touchdowns against Benton. His 10 carries, 157 yards and three touchdowns were also career highs. Mobery had 90 yards on nine carries against Southwood, then followed that performance by rushing for 70 yards on just three carries against Natchitoches Central, including a careerbest 60-yard scamper.

A Look Ahead

The winner of the bi-district game between Byrd and Jesuit will play the No. 1 seeded Holy Cross Tigers in New Orleans in the regional round.

BYRD BANTER

Highlight Reel Runs From Hilliard

Wing back Quinton Hilliard has seemingly provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he's touched the ball this season. The junior, who also plays basketball at Byrd, is averaging 9.6 yards per carry and a touchdown every 4.83 carries. Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. He had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. Hilliard had a spectacular15-yard touchdown run against Benton as he took a toss around the right end, raced down the sidelines before leaping from the four-yard line into the end zone for the touchdown, his first as a Yellow Jacket. Against Airline, Hilliard showed off his speed on a 14-yard touchdown run. He had his first multi-touchdown performance (2) against Southwood, then followed that performance with two touchdown runs against Natchitoches Central.

Murray Continues His Mastery

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray has just been masterful this season. Murray is averaging 40.2 yards per punt and has had nine punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He has six punts of over 50 yards, including a career-long punt of 68 yards against Parkway. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray now has nine career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Benton, Murray kicked two field goals (24, 35). He was the first Byrd kicker since Scotty Roblow in 2018 to kick two field goals in a game. He kicked a 23-yard field goal against Parkway moved him into a four-way tie for fifth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with nine career made field goals. Murray is 38-for-39 on PAT kicks, and 41 of his 52 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks this season. Opponents' average starting field position is the 21 yard line.

Believing In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras has done. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, who's a Miami Hurricanes commit, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras has earned a starting job as a wide receiver. His 61-yard catch and run against Parkway was the longest reception of the season for the Jackets. Booras had his first career touchdown reception on a 26-yard pass from Asher Murray against Natchitoches Central. More importantly, he is Byrd's primary kick and punt returner. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, has 14 kickoff returns for 215 yards and six punt returns for 77 yards this season.

Leaving A Legacy

There are at least five current Byrd players whose fathers also wore the purple and gold. Wingback Malachi Johnson's father Juston, also a wingback, played for Byrd from 2002-04. Ashton and Alton Fullwood's father Albert was a Yellow Jacket from 2002-04. Tight end Ronnie Buckingham's father Ronnie, who's a freshmen coach, played for the Jackets from 2001-03. Defensive end Darrell Cottonham, Jr.'s father, Darrell, Sr., played at Byrd from 1994-96.

Brotherly Love

In looking at Byrd's 2023 rosters (varsity and freshmen), one will notice there are a number of players bearing the same last name. That's because there are at least five sets of brothers in the Byrd Football program. Abram and Asher Murray, Ashton and Alton Fullwood, Quinton and Conrad Hilliard, Noah and Willie Hearod and Mason and Mills Coenen. Kian Fox, John Rushing and Jackson Thrasher each had older brothers in the program last year.

JACKET JARGON

Full Speed Ahead for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from last year's team is senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. After a fine junior campaign, in which he tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops, Fullwood is now the leader of Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. He suffered a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria last year. After a lengthy recovery, it has been full speed ahead for Fullwood in this his senior season. In his career, Fullwood has 127 total tackles, including 67 solo stops, 12.5 tackles-for -loss and four fumble recoveries. Against Parkway, Fullwood registered career highs with 14 tackles and four tackles-for-loss. Fullwood received the Honesty & Integrity Award from Masonic Lodge 179 earlier this season, and last week, and was voted *The Times* Football Athlete of the Week for week eight. The senior had 10 total tackles, including four unassisted tackles, a half tackles-for-loss, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery against Natchitoches Central.

Sam I Am

Ashton Fullwood's linebacking mate is junior Sam Greer. The duo has been a bright spot for Byrd's defense. Greer had 11 total tackles, including six solo stops, a tackle-for-loss, a half sack, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery against Natchitoches Central. Greer's 11 total tackles matched a season-high, which he's done two previous times, and he's now registered double-digit tackles in six games this season. Through 10 games, Greer leads the team with 89 total tackles, and has moved into 10th place on the single-season tackles leaders list. He also has seven tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and an interception on the season.

Not Taken For Grant-ed

The important roles that senior Grant Johnson plays on this team is not taken for granted by his teammates and coaches. Johnson, who also plays baseball at Byrd, is the starting free safety on the Purple Swarm Defense and he's the long snapper on punts and place kicks. His 48 total tackles ranks third behind Greer and Fullwood. Johnson has five tackles-for-loss, two passes defended, two interceptions and a fumble recovery this season. He had his first double-digit tackle game of his career with 10 tackles against Parkway. His outstanding snapping efforts have allowed Abram Murray to average 40.2 yards per punt and be 6-of-9 on field goal attempts, with all three misses from 50-plus yards.

Kaiden's Knack for Picks

Junior defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller has a knack for picking off passes. With his first quarter interception of Natchitoches Central quarterback Owen Smith's pass, the junior registered his sixth interception of the season, which set the single-season record that he previously shared with Luther Dallas in 2015, and Nicholas Peoples, who had five in 2010 and 2011. Peoples holds the career record with 10 interceptions from 2009-11. Abraham-Miller had two picks against Southwood and had a second interception against Natchitoches taken away due to a penalty against Byrd.

Beyond the Gridiron

Despite the two schools being separated by over 300 miles, the respectful rivalry that exists between Byrd and Jesuit goes beyond the gridiron. The two schools have met numerous times on the baseball diamond throughout out the 20th and 21st centuries. Most meetings have come in the state playoffs, including the last three seasons. Historically, one the best baseball programs in the state, Jesuit has dominated the series (9-2) going back to 1948.
