2023 Season Ends In Metairie

The 2023 high school football season ended for the Byrd Yellow Jackets on Friday, Nov. 10, at the Shrine on Airline in Metairie. The Jackets lost 23-2 to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the bi-district round of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. It was the second straight year the Yellow Jackets ended a season in Metairie.

A Little About the Team

Byrd finished the 2023 season with a 4-7 overall record and was the No. 17 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. The Yellow Jackets finished in a three-way tie for third place in District 1-5A with a 4-3 record. Byrd loses five starters on offense and five on defense as well as kicker / punter Abram Murray.

Last Time Out

On a dreary night at the Shrine on Airline in Metairie, Byrd's performance reflected the less than ideal conditions as the Yellow Jackets lost 23-2 to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the bi-district round of the LHSAA's Division I Playoffs. Jesuit's defense limited Byrd's offense to just 81 yards of total offense and zero points. The Jackets avoided a shutout by registering a safety when the ball was snapped over the head of Jesuit punter Andrew Bordelon and he kicked it out of the back of the end zone. Blue Jays' running back Patrick Berrigan was the star of the game as he rushed for 177 yards and two touchdowns.

Tentative 2024 Schedule

2023 was a reclassification and redistricting year for the Louisiana High School Athletic Association. In 2024 District 1-5A will be a nine team district due to the departure of Southwood and the additions of Huntington and Evangel. At the annual LHSAA meeting in January, a vote on doing away with classifications and moving to divisions, like the playoffs, is expected, so there could be additional changes coming. The following is Byrd's 2024 schedule: Week 1 at St. Amant; Week 2 vs. Haughton*; Week 3 at Evangel*; Week 4 at John Ehret; Week 5 at Parkway*; Week 6 at Huntington*; Week 7 vs. Natchitoches Central*; Week 8 at Benton*; Week 9 vs. Airline*; Week 10 vs. Captain Shreve*. The spring game will be played on May 10 against Neville at Byrd's Bundrick Field. The fall scrimmage is scheduled for Aug. 23 versus Ruston at Byrd's Bundrick Field.

The Season

The 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football came to an end in Metairie on Friday, Nov. 10, 2023. It was the second straight year that Byrd's season ended in Metairie. It was the first losing season for Byrd since 2019 when the Jackets posted an identical 4-7 record. However, for the 14th consecutive season Byrd reached the state playoffs. Byrd had one player, offensive lineman Noah Slaughter, named First-Team All-District. The Jackets did have seven players named Second-Team All-District.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSU in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 21-13 (.618) record in his three seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Lindsey Bruno, offensive line; Rahkeem Mitchell, running backs; Kellum Humphrey, wide receivers; Jalen Bowers, defensive line; Shimorye Hampton, linebackers and Benji Piazza, cornerbacks. Freshmen coaches include: Carlos Doss, Ronnie Buckingham, Seth Guerra, Bryson Vance and Jason Pope. Cordarius Wayne is the certified athletic trainer.

Stacy Ballew just completed his third season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

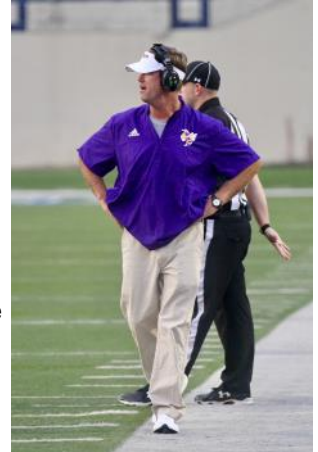
In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

2023 was the 119th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 99th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1925 season after the school's name changed in September of that year...In those 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 686-437-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 21-13 (.618) record in his three seasons as the Jackets' head coach...Ballew needs three more victories to tie three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2023 Notes

Byrd scored just two points against Jesuit which marked the second time this season the Jackets failed to score a touchdown in a game, Parkway beat Byrd 21-3 in week seven...The last times Byrd was kept out of the end zone in a game was in weeks one and two of the 2019 season when the Jackets were shut out by Brother Martin (28-0) and West Monroe (24-0)...With its 376 rushing yards in its 42-14 win over Natchitoches Central, Byrd eclipsed the 300-yard mark plateau for the seventh time this season...Byrd also had five rushing touchdowns against the Chiefs, which marked the fourth time the Jackets had five or more rushing TDs in a game this season...Fullback Desmond Simmons registered career highs in carries with 28 and rushing yards with 205 against Airline...Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 200 yards since Lake Lambert had 267 rushing yards against Alexandria in the 2022 regional playoff game...Defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller had two interceptions against Southwood...It was the first multi-interception game for a Byrd defender since Chris Grieder's three picks against Haughton in 2020...Abraham-Miller's first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central set the single-season interception record with six...Nicholas Peoples holds the career interception record with 10...Parkway's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was the Jackets' lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since last year's Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time this season that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...Quarterbacks Harrison Ayres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since last year's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Lake Lambert had five rushing touchdowns in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs...Johnson's 15 rushing touchdowns this season were the most for a Byrd back since fullback Charlie Barham had 17 in 2018...Receiver Matthew Booras' 61-yard reception against Parkway was the longest reception of the season...The 61 yards on that one play accounted for over half of Byrd's total offensive output (118) against the Panthers...Linebacker Sam Greer registered six double-digit tackle games this season, including three season-high 11 tackle games.

BYRD BLASTS

Magical Malachi Johnson

After missing the Benton game with an injury, junior wingback Malachi Johnson returned to action and ascended to wizard level by wielding his magic against the Haughton Buccaneers. Johnson rushed for a career-high 192 yards on just nine carries (21.3 avg.) and he scored three touchdowns on runs of 62, 60 and 40 yards to lead the Jackets to a 31-28 win over the Buccaneers. Johnson, who's 5'5" 155 lbs., was the leading rusher in the Huntington game with 165 yards on 11 carries (15.0 avg.) and he scored an incredible five touchdowns. Johnson's five touchdown performance tied a school record, which was originally set in 1928 by legendary Byrd back Joe Almokary, who did it twice during that season - versus Longview and Minden. The five rushing touchdowns in a game feat was replicated four more times in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football. Lee Stokes in 1931 vs. Minden, Amaz Battle in 1995 vs. Natchitoches Central, Xavier Long in 2011 playoffs vs. West Jefferson and last season by quarterback Lake Lambert, who reached the end zone five times in Byrd's 49-10 regional playoff win over the Alexandria Trojans. He continued his magic against Shreve as he rushed for 134 yards and two touchdowns, and was voted *The Times* Football Athlete of the Week for week five. Johnson finished the season as the team leader with 889 rushing yards and 15 rushing touchdowns, which were the most rushing touchdowns since Charlie Barham had 17 in 2018. Johnson also averaged 9.9 yards per carry. Johnson was a Second-Team All-District selection.

Simmons Was No Sleeper

Fullback Desmond Simmons was splitting time with Dixon Poirier this season until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Captain Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards and a touchdown. Against Airline, he had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game. The junior burst onto the scene last year in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. Simmons finished the season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection.

Harrison Painted A Pretty Picture

Junior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. He was also 2-of-5 passing for 76 yards and a touchdown on the year. The junior saw playing time at tight end, quarterback and fullback this season.

Mobery's Sweet Senior Season

Wing back Jontavious Mobery had sweet senior season as he rushed for 415 yards, four touchdowns and averaged an incredible 10.4 yards per carry. Mobery was the first Byrd wing back to average 10-plus yards a carry for an entire season since Mitchell Ramsey in 2021 averaged 10.8 yards per attempt. Mobery had a game-high 157 yards and three touchdowns against Benton. His 10 carries, 157 yards and three touchdowns were career highs. Mobery had 90 yards on nine carries against Southwood, then followed that performance by rushing for 70 yards on just three carries against Natchitoches Central, including a career-best 60-yard scamper.

Highlight Reel Runs From Hilliard

Wing back Quinton Hilliard seemingly provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball this season. The junior, who also plays basketball at Byrd, averaged 9.3 yards per carry and scored a touchdown every five carries. Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. He had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. Hilliard had a spectacular 15-yard touchdown run against Benton as he took a toss around the right end, raced down the sidelines before leaping from the four-yard line into the end zone for the touchdown, his first as a Yellow Jacket. Against Airline, Hilliard showed off his speed on a incredible 14-yard touchdown run. He had his first multi-touchdown performance (2) against Southwood, then followed that performance with two touchdown runs against Natchitoches Central.

BYRD BANTER

Murray Continued His Mastery in 2023

Byrd senior place kicker and punter Abram Murray had a masterful season in 2023. Murray averaged 40.1 yards per punt and had 11 punts downed inside the 20-yard line. He had seven punts of over 50 yards, including a career-long punt of 68 yards against Parkway. Going back to last year's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Murray had 10 career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. His 52.8 yards per punt average against Captain Shreve is a single game school record. He also holds the career punting average record with a 39.9 yards per punt average. The University of Miami commit also booted a 45-yard field goal in the opener against Pleasant Grove. It was not an easy kick as the snap was bobbled and the ball was on its side at placement but Murray maintained his composure and drilled the kick. The field goal was the third of his career from 40-plus yards. Against Benton, Murray kicked two field goals (24, 35). He was the first Byrd kicker since Scotty Roblow in 2018 to kick two field goals in a game. He kicked a 23-yard field goal against Houghton, which proved to be the difference in the game. His 23-yard field goal against Parkway moved him into a four-way tie for fifth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with nine career made field goals. Murray was 38-for-39 on PAT kicks, and 42 of his 53 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks and opponents' average starting field position was the 21 yard line. Murray participated in the LHSAA & LFCA "I-20 Bowl" all-star game was named the Second-Team All-District punter. He also was named to the LHSAA's Composite Academic All-State Team with a grade point average of 4.0 or better. The composite team covers all classifications.

Belief In Booras

In today's world of specialization, especially in football, it's not often where a kicker and punter transition into an every down player, much less at a skill position. However, that's exactly what senior Matthew Booras did in 2023. Booras spent 2021 as Byrd's primary punter and reserve kicker. He punted 30 times for a 33.9 average. He also had seven kickoffs and two extra-point kicks. With the emergence of All-District, All-City punter and kicker Abram Murray, Booras saw his kicking duties and playing time diminish. Believing in himself, Booras made the decision to change positions. Alongside Alex Schoonover, Booras earned a starting job as a wide receiver and was the Jackets' primary return specialist. His 61-yard catch and run against Parkway was the longest reception of the season for the Jackets. Booras had his first career touchdown reception on a 26-yard pass from Asher Murray against Natchitoches Central. Booras, who's also a standout soccer player, had 16 kickoff returns for 243 (15.2 avg.) yards and six punt returns for 77 (12.8 avg.) yards this season. Seeing Booras transition from a specialist to an every down player inspired junior kicker and punter Jackson Cooper to give it a try as well. Cooper started against Southwood and had one reception for 27 yards.

Poirier's Senior Season Ends Against Shreve

Senior fullback Dixon Poirier was well on his way to having a career night against arch-rival Captain Shreve when disaster struck. Late in the third quarter, Poirier ran for four yards before going down in obvious pain. Later, it was diagnosed that he had broken his arm which required surgery to repair the damage. Up to that point, Poirier had rushed for 142 yards, three shy of his career high, and two touchdowns. He had 110 rushing yards and two touchdowns in the first half. In the first quarter, Poirier blocked a Shreve punt, which set up his first touchdown run of seven yards. He would add a six-yard touchdown run in the second quarter to help Byrd tie the game at 14. In his three-year varsity career, Poirier rushed for 994 yards and 14 touchdowns. He averaged six yards a carry and had a career-long run of 54 yards as a sophomore in 2021 against Airline.

Some Love for the Offensive Line

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called for committing a penalty. Despite lacking experience and size, Byrd's offensive line performed admirably this season. The O-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 303.8 yards of total offense and 27.8 points per game this season. Despite suffering an ankle injury the week of the Jesuit game, senior guard Noah Slaughter was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has now had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. Senior tackle Dylan Gillie was a Second-Team All-District selection. Other Byrd offensive linemen included: Tanner Murrell, Willie Heard, Owen Scott, Jacob Martin, Gehrig Smith, Elijah Chembles, Ayden Boutte and Mason Coenen.

Full Heart for Fullwood

The lone returning starter from Byrd's 2022 team was senior linebacker Ashton Fullwood. In his junior campaign, Fullwood tallied 38 total tackles, including 26 solo stops before suffering a broken ankle in the Jackets' 49-10 playoff win over Alexandria. After a lengthy recovery, Fullwood returned fully healthy for his senior season. He finished second on the team with 82 total tackles, but led the team with 10.5 tackles-for-loss. In his three-year varsity career, Fullwood tallied 137 total tackles, including 74 solo stops, 13.5 tackles-for-loss and four fumble recoveries. In week seven against Parkway, Fullwood registered career highs with 14 tackles and four tackles-for-loss. Fullwood received the Honesty & Integrity Award from Masonic Lodge 179 earlier this season, and was voted *The Times* Football Athlete of the Week for week eight. The senior had 10 total tackles, including seven unassisted tackles, and a tackles-for-loss in his last game against Jesuit. Fullwood was a Second-Team All-District selection.

Sam I Am

Ashton Fullwood's linebacking mate was junior Sam Greer. The was a bright spot for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. Greer had 11 total tackles, including six solo stops, a tackle-for-loss, a half sack, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery against Natchitoches Central. His 11 total tackles against the Chiefs matched a season-high, which he did two previous times. Greer registered six double-digit tackle games this season. He finished the season as the team's leading tackler with 98 total tackles, which ranks eighth on the single-season tackles list. Greer also had 10 tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and an interception on the season. He was a Second-Team All-District selection.

Not Taken For Grant-ed

The important role that senior Grant Johnson played on this year's team was not taken for granted by his teammates or coaches. Johnson, who also plays baseball at Byrd, was the starting free safety on the Purple Swarm Defense and made all the calls defensively. His 58 total tackles ranked third on the team behind Greer and Fullwood. Johnson had five tackles-for-loss, two passes defended, two interceptions and a fumble recovery on this season. He notched his first double-digit tackle game of his career with 10 against Parkway. His outstanding snapping efforts allowed Abram Murray to average 40.1 yards per punt and kick six field goals. Johnson was recently named to the LHSAA's Academic All-State Team.

Kaiden Picks Off Record

Junior defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller displayed a knack for picking off passes this season. Abraham-Miller's first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central, was his sixth pick of the season and set the single-season record which he previously shared with Luther Dallas in 2015, and Nicholas Peoples, who had five in 2010 and 2011. In 2024, Abraham-Miller will have a chance at Peoples' career record of 10 interceptions, which he set from 2009-11. Abraham-Miller had two picks against Southwood, and had a second interception against Natchitoches taken away due to a penalty against Byrd.

Brotherly Love

On Byrd's 2023 varsity and freshmen rosters, there were a number of players that carried the same last names. There were at least five sets of brothers in the Byrd Football program in 2023. Abram and Asher Murray, Ashton and Alton Fullwood, Quinton and Conrad Hilliard, Noah and Willie Hearod and Mason and Mills Coenen. Kian Fox, John Rushing and Jackson Thrasher each had older brothers in the program last year.

Leaving A Legacy

There were at least five Jackets this season whose fathers also wore the purple and gold of C.E. Byrd High School. Wingback Malachi Johnson's father Juston, also a wingback, played for Byrd from 2002-04. Ashton and Alton Fullwood's father, Albert, was a Yellow Jacket from 2002-04. Tight end Ronnie Buckingham's father Ronnie, who's was a freshmen coach this season, played for the Jackets from 2001-03. Defensive end Darrell Cottonham, Jr.'s father, Darrell, Sr., played at Byrd from 1994-96.

Remembering a Jacket Legend

Dr. William S. "Billy" Bundrick, Sr., passed away on Dec. 9, 2023. Bundrick was an All-State end at Byrd in 1954, All-District and All-City running back in 1955 and an All-District performer on Byrd's 1956 State Championship baseball team. He was elected to the Byrd Athletics Hall of Fam in 1992.
