#### Opening The 100th Season On The Road

The C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets will open their 100th season on Friday, Sept. 6, against the St. Amant Gators. It's the second consecutive year the Yellow Jackets will start a season on the road. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at St. Amant's stadium known as "The Pit."

#### A Little About the Teams

Byrd finished the 2023 season with a 4-7 overall record and was the No. 17 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. The Yellow Jackets finished in a three-way tie for third place in District 1-5A with a 4-3 record. Byrd returns six starters on offense and six on defense from last year's team. The St. Amant Gators had an outstanding 2023 season posting a 10-2 overall record and a 4-1 record in District 5-5A, After defeating Quachita 31-3 in first round of the Non-Select Division I Playoffs, St. Amant lost 42-21 to the Mandeville Skippers in the Regional Round.

#### **Last Time Out For Real**

On a dreary night at the Shrine on Airline in Metairie, Byrd's performance reflected the less than ideal conditions as the Yellow Jackets lost 23-2 to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the bi-district round of the LHSAA's Division I Playoffs. Jesuit's defense limited Byrd's offense to just 81 yards of total offense and zero points. The Jackets avoided a shutout by registering a safety when the ball was snapped over the head of Jesuit punter Andrew Bordelon and he kicked it out of the back of the end zone. Blue Jays' running back Patrick Berrigan was the star of the game as he rushed for 177 yards and two touchdowns. The No. 21 seeded Mandeville Skippers upset the No. 5 seeded St. Amant Gators 42-21 in the regional round of the 2023 Non-Select Division I Playoffs.

#### The Series

This is the first-ever meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and St. Amant Gators. St. Amant High School is located southeast of Baton Rouge and just east of Gonzales, La. The Gators are members of the seven-team District 5-5A which includes: Denham Springs, Dutchtown, East Ascension, Live Oak, Prairieville and Walker. The only times Byrd faced a team from District 5-5A was against the East Ascension Spartans in the 2014 playoffs (W, 37-20) and the 2020 regular season (W, 27-20).

#### The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team will wear a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

#### The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent over half his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach. while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. He was promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009 and spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 21-13 (.618) record in his previous three seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Craig Harris, offensive line; Rahkeem Mitchell, running backs; Kellum Humphrey, wide receivers; Jalen Bowers, linebackers; Shimorye Hampton, defensive line and Benii Piazza, cornerbacks, Ballew is the defensive coordinator and coaches the safeties. Freshmen coaches include: Carlos Doss, Jason Pope, Seth Guerra, Ronnie Buckingham and Tucker Gardner. Cordarious Wayne is the certified athletic trainer. St. Amant is coached by David Oliver, begins in his 17th season as the head coach of the St. Amant Gators football program. Oliver has compiled a 102-59 (.633) record in his previous 16 seasons at St. Amant. He previously served as an assistant coach for 13 years with the Gators. He was the Gators' offensive coordinator under then head coach David Swacker before being promoted to head coach.

Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top "Purple Swarm Defenses" in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

#### YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

#### **Yellow Jackets Football History**

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 119-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 686-437-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns an 21-13 (.618) record in his three seasons as the Jackets' head coach...Ballew needs three more victories to tie three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...In 2023, Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship by the LHSAA and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...Byrd is 14-10 in season openers since 2000...Since 1905, the Yellow Jackets own a 62-54-3 record in season openers.

#### 2023 Notes

Byrd scored just two points against Jesuit which marked the second time during the 2023 season the Jackets failed to score a touchdown in a game...Parkway beat Byrd 21-3 in week seven...The last times Byrd was kept out of the end zone in a game was in weeks one and two of the 2019 season when the Jackets were shut out by Brother Martin (28-0) and West Monroe (24-0)...With its 376 rushing yards in its 42-14 win over Natchitoches Central, Byrd eclipsed the 300-yard mark plateau for the seventh time...Byrd also had five rushing touchdowns against the Chiefs, which marked the fourth time the Jackets had five or more rushing TDs in a game...Fullback Desmond Simmons registered career highs in carries with 28 and rushing yards with 205 against Airline...Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 200 yards since Lake Lambert had 267 rushing yards against Alexandria in the 2022 regional playoff game...Defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller had two interceptions against Southwood...It was the first multi-interception game for a Byrd defender since Chris Grieder's three picks against Haughton in 2020...Abraham-Miller's first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central set the single-season interception record with six...Nicholas Peoples holds the career interception record with 10...Parkway's defense held Byrd to just 118 yards of total offense which was the Jackets' lowest offensive output since managing just 76 yards against Evangel in 2016...Byrd had more passing yards (61) than rushing yards (57) for the first time since the 2022 Calvary game (146 pass, 99 rush)...The Jackets' 57 rushing yards against the Panthers was their lowest output since gaining just 55 rushing yards against the Evangel Eagles in 2016...Byrd scored 61 points against Benton, which was its highest point total since 2013 when the Jackets beat Bastrop 63-8 in the Battle on the Border...Jontavious Mobery (157) and Desmond Simmons (120) each rushed for over 100 yards in the win over Benton...It was the second time that the Jackets had two backs rush for over 100 yards in a game...Quarterbacks Harrison Ayres and Asher Murray each threw a touchdown pass against Benton...It was the first times since 2022's Natchitoches Central game that the Jackets had two touchdown passes in a game...Abram Murray kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton...Murray's two field goals marked the first time since week four of the 2018 season that a Byrd kicker had two field goals in a game when Scotty Roblow booted two (42, 25) against Captain Shreve...Wingback Malachi Johnson tied a school record for rushing touchdowns in a game with five against Huntington...Johnson's performance marked the seventh time in the 119-year history of Yellow Jackets Football that a Byrd player scored five rushing touchdowns in a game...Lake Lambert had five rushing touchdowns in Byrd's 49-10 win over Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs... Johnson's 15 rushing touchdowns in 2023 were the most for a Byrd back since fullback Charlie Barham had 17 in 2018...Linebacker Sam Greer registered six double-digit tackle games in 2023, including three season-high 11 tackle games.

#### **BYRD BLASTS**

#### **Outlook for 100th Season of Byrd Football**

In the 100th year of Byrd Football (120th combined), re-establishing its winning tradition will be the focus of the 2024 Yellow Jackets football team. After finishing the 2023 season with a 4-7 record, the first losing season for coach Stacy Ballew, getting back to playing tough, physical, fundamentally sound, disciplined football, in laymen terms "Byrd Football," will be paramount for a successful 2024 campaign. Having 12 returning starters should give the Yellow Jackets a solid foundation in which to rebuild that winning tradition. However, Byrd faces a daunting schedule in 2024. The Jackets have long non-district road trips to St. Amant to start the season and in week three at John Ehret, while dealing with the always tough and highly competitive District 1-5A, which got even stronger with the addition of Evangel and Huntington in 2024. Staying healthy will be a key component to reestablishing the tradition of "Byrd Football."

#### **Simmons Was No Sleeper**

Fullback Desmond Simmons split time with Dixon Poirier in 2023 until Poirier suffered a season-ending injury against Captain Shreve. In Byrd's 61-35 win over Benton, Simmons had 18 carries for 120 yards and a touchdown. Against Airline, he had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in last year's regional playoff game. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 scamper. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection.

#### **Harrison Painted A Pretty Picture**

Junior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started in 2023. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. He was also 2-of-5 passing for 76 yards and a touchdown on the year. Ayres saw playing time at tight end, quarterback and fullback in 2023.

#### **Highlight Reel Runs From Hilliard**

Wing back Quinton Hilliard seemingly provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, averaged 9.3 yards per carry and scored a touchdown every five carries. Hilliard was the highlight of the Byrd's 27-10 loss to Pleasant Grove. He had a game-high 109 rushing yards on just six carries. In the third quarter, he had a dazzling 55-yard scamper that eventually led to Byrd's first touchdown. Most everyone, including the Byrd coaching staff, believed that Hilliard had scored on the long run because he was hit and tackled into the end zone by a pair of Pleasant Grove defenders. However, the officials ruled Hilliard down at the half-yard line. Byrd was forced to call a timeout because the extra-point unit was already lining up for the PAT. Hilliard had a spectacular15-yard touchdown run against Benton as he took a toss around the right end, raced down the sidelines before leaping from the four-yard line into the end zone for the touchdown, his first as a Yellow Jacket. Against Airline, Hilliard showed off his speed on a incredible 14-yard touchdown run. He had his first multi-touchdown performance (2) against Southwood, then followed that performance with two touchdown runs against Natchitoches Central.

#### Taking It To the Maxie

The newest face in the Jackets' backfield this season is wingback Christian Maxie. The sophomore steps into the starting role opposite of senior Quinton Hilliard. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie has emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multi-option attack.

#### The 2024 Schedule, Polls and More

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2024 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2023. Byrd's two non-district opponents this season, St. Amant and John Ehret, both advanced to the regional round of the playoffs last season. The defending Non-Select Div. I Champion Ruston Bearcats, who the Yellow Jackets faced in the scrimmage, are the unanimous No. 1 ranked team in the Louisiana Sports Writers Association, GeauxPreps.com and CrescentCitySports polls. The Airline Vikings were the top vote getters with 20 of teams just outside the LSWA's Top 10. The Evangel Eagles received four votes in the LSWA poll, were among "the first five out," in the GeauxPreps poll and among the "others to watch" in the CCS poll. Airline, Benton, Byrd and Captain Shreve were also among the list of "others to watch" in the CCS poll.

#### **BYRD BANTER**

#### Some Love for the Offensive Line

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Despite lacking experience and size, Byrd's offensive line performed admirably in 2023. The O-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 303.8 yards of total offense and 27.8 points per game. Despite suffering an ankle injury the week of the Jesuit game, guard Noah Slaughter was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. Tackle Dylan Gillie was a Second-Team All-District selection. Tanner Murrell, Jacob Martin, Elijah Chembles, Ayden Boutte and Mason Coenen all saw significant playing time in 2023 and return for the 2024 season.

#### Oh Deere

Another fresh face and name in the Jackets' backfield this season is fullback Collin Deere. The sophomore has carried the payload for the Jackets in the preseason due to starter Desmond Simmons being sidelined with an undisclosed illness. Simmons is expected to be ready for the opener against St. Amant. At 6'1", 224 pounds, Deere along with Simmons gives Byrd a formidable tandem at the fullback spot heading into the season. Deere rushed for 37 yards and a touchdown in the Jamboree.

#### Sam I Am

Senior linebacker Sam Greer was one of the bright spots for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense in 2023. Greer had 11 total tackles, including six solo stops, a tackle-for-loss, a half sack, an interception, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery against Natchitoches Central. His 11 total tackles against the Chiefs matched a season-high, which he did two previous times. Greer registered six double-digit tackle games last season. He finished the season as the team's leading tacker with 98 total tackles, which ranks eighth on the single-season tackles list. Greer also had 10 tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and an interception on the season. He was a Second-Team All-District selection

#### Kaiden Picks Off Record

Junior defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller displayed a knack for picking off passes last season. Abraham-Miller's first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central was his sixth pick of the season and set the single-season school record, which he previously shared with Nicholas Peoples, who had five in 2010 and 2011, and Luther Dallas, who have five in 2015. In 2024, Abraham-Miller will have a chance at Peoples' career record of 10 interceptions, which he set from 2009-11. Abraham-Miller had a career-high two interceptions against Southwood. He nearly had a second two-pick game against Natchitoches Central, but it was wiped away due to a penalty against Byrd.

### Ja'Cari Jumps Into the Fray

Junior defensive back Ja'Cari Williams really jumped into the fray during the 2023 season. Williams' first significant action came against Captain Shreve, when he had five total tackles, including three solo stops. His had a personal-best seven tackles in Byrd's 31-28 win over Haughton. Against Airline, Williams had four total tackles but really stood out on special teams as he had three kickoff returns for 59 yards, including a long of 33. He finished the 2023 season with 35 total tackles, including 23 solo tackles, and two pass breakups.

#### Remembering a Pair of Jacket Legends

Dr. William S. "Billy" Bundrick, Sr., passed away on Dec. 9, 2023. Bundrick was an All-State end at Byrd in 1954, All-District and All-City running back in 1955 and an All-District performer on Byrd's 1956 State Championship baseball team. He was elected to the Byrd Athletics Hall of Fam in 1992. August 15, 2024, marked 37 years since the passing of Byrd great Dan Sandifer. Sandifer was one of the first Shreveporters to play in the NFL, where he made an immediate impact with a league record for interceptions by a rookie (13). His six-year professional football career included stops in Washington, Green Bay, Philadelphia and Chicago. Sandifer played collegiately at LSU.

#### A Look Ahead

The C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets will play their home and District 1-5A opener on Friday, Sept. 13, against the Haughton Buccaneers and their new head coach Matthew Sewell. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium

In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew, there's six other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).

#### **Alumni Report**

Former Byrd Yellow Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are as follows: punter Scotty Roblow and long snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

#### Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 27th season behind the microphone as the play-by-play "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets." Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Jacket Dominic Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. By downloading the 1130 The Tiger app fans can listen to Byrd Football anywhere.

#### **Legendary Lee Hedges**

When Byrd and Shreve met last Saturday in the 2024 Jamboree it marked the return of football to Lee Hedges Stadium, which is named in honor of legendary football coach Lee Hedges, who passed away on July 9, 2023, at the age of 93. Hedges had dedicated his life to teaching and mentoring young people in Shreveport. He is best known for guiding the 1973 Captain Shreve Gators to a perfect 14-0 record and the State Championship. However, Shreve was not the only Shreveport school where he was successful. A three-sport star at Fair Park, Hedges would begin his legendary coaching career at arch-rival Byrd as the Jackets' head coach in 1956. He led Byrd to the state title game that first season, losing to the Istrouma Indians, 14-7. After four years on Line Avenue, Hedges moved to newly opened Woodlawn in 1960. He had tremendous success with the Knights, leading them to the 1965 state championship game. Hedges' 217 career wins are the most for any coach in the history of Caddo-Bossier football.

#### From One Brother to Another

Last year, Byrd's place kicker and punter was Abram Murray, who is now kicking for the University of Miami Hurricanes. Abram's younger brother, Asher, who saw considerable time at quarterback for the Jackets in 2023, has decided to focus solely on kicking this season. The elder Murray averaged 40.1 yards per punt and had 11 punts downed inside the 20-yard line last season. He had seven punts of over 50 yards, including a career-long punt of 68 yards against Parkway. Going back to 2022's playoff game against John Curtis where he had two punts of over 60 yards (66, 63), Abram had 10 career punts of over 50 yards to his credit. His 52.8 yards per punt average against Captain Shreve set a single-game school record. He also holds the career punting average record with a 39.9 yards per punt average. Abram finished his career in four-way tie for fifth place on the career Top 10 field goals list at Byrd with nine career made field goals. In 2023, Abram was 38-for-39 on PAT kicks, and had 42 of his 53 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Abram participated in the LHSCA & LFCA "I-20 Bowl" all-star game was named the Second-Team All-District punter. He also was named to the LHSAA's Composite Academic All-State Team with a grade point average of 4.0 or better. To say that Asher has big shoes to fill would be quite the understatement.


