Showdown in SoBo

On Thursday, Oct. 3, the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River to south Bossier City for a showdown with the Parkway Panthers. Kickoff for the "Showdown in SoBo" is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Preston Crownover Stadium, Bobby Marlow Field, which is located on the campus of Elm Grove Middle School.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 4-0 overall record and a 2-0 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 35-14 win over the John Ehret Patriots. The Parkway Panthers are 4-0 overall and 2-0 in District 1-5A after last Friday's 40-12 victory over the Natchitoches Central Chiefs.

For the second time this season, the Byrd Yellow Jackets went on a long road trip and came away with a victory. Byrd utilized its stout running game to amass 382 yards, including 107 from fullback Desmond Simmons, to defeat the John Ehret Patriots 35-14 at Hoss Memtsas Stadium in Harvey, La. Operating without the services of starting quarterback Kaleb Williams, who was injured on the third play of the game, the Parkway Panthers used a bevy of running backs in Carmaro Mayo, CJ Dudley, Antonio Gladney and Jayden Lewis to run through and around the Natchitoches Central Chiefs. All four backs scored rushing touchdowns (Mayo, two) to pace the Panthers to a 40-12 victory at Turpin Stadium in Natchitoches.

The Series

This will be the 41st meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and Parkway Panthers. The Yellow Jackets lead the series 23-17. This series began in 1970 with a 28-12 Byrd win, the first of three straight for the Jackets before Parkway posted its first win, 13-0, in 1977. In the 13 games since Parkway moved into District 1-5A, Byrd leads the series 7-6. However, the Byrd-Parkway series has historically been a series of streaks - from 1970-79 Byrd won six of the seven games; 1980-89 Parkway won eight of the 10 games; 1991-2008 Byrd won nine of the 10 games; 2011-16 Parkway won four of the six games, while Byrd has won five of the last seven games. Last year, Parkway defeated Byrd 21-3 in Shreveport to snap Jackets' three-game series winning streak.

Last Time Versus Parkway

Parkway's defense lived up to its billing as the Panthers completely stymied Byrd's multi-option offense, limiting the Jackets to their lowest output of the season at just 118 yards. Leading 7-3, Parkway used two 80-yard scoring drives, one at the end of the first half and the other to begin the second half, to take a 21-3 lead midway through the third quarter. It would be all the scoring Parkway would need as the Panthers' defense kept Byrd out of the end zone for the first time since week two of the 2019 season.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter. Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 25-13 (.658) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Parkway is coached by Coy Brotherton, who is in his fifth season at the helm of the Panthers' program. Brotherton owns a 29-18 (.617) record at Parkway and a 59-35 (.628) overall record. He moved over to Parkway after spending five years at Captain Shreve as the Gators' offensive coordinator. Before Shreve, Brotherton was the head coach at Plain Dealing for four years compiling a 30-17 (.638), which is second best in Lions history. Brotherton comes from a family of football coaches. His father, Bob, coached at Haughton for 33 years, including the Bucs' 1977 State Championship season, while his brother, Jason, was the head coach at Haughton,

Achievement

2021 District 1-5A Champions Three consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 690-437-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 25-13 (.658) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...With the win over Evangel, Ballew passed three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton with 24 career victories...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...In 2023, Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school

2024 Notes

Byrd is 4-0 for the fourth time in the last five seasons...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...The Jackets rushed for 382 yards against John Ehret, marking the third time in four games they have eclipsed the 300-yard rushing plateau as a team...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (171) and Christian Maxie (157), each rush for over 100 yards against Evangel... It was the second time this season that Byrd had two backs eclipse the 100-yard mark in the same game...Fullback Desmond Simmons has rushed for 284 yards and four touchdowns in his the last two games...Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing TDs against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game...Simmons' 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Fullback Collin Deere scored his first varsity touchdown on a 23-yard run against John Ehret...With his second quarter interception against St. Amant, defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller now has seven career interceptions...Abraham-Miller's set the single-season interception record with six in 2023 and needs just three more picks to tie Nicholas Peoples, who holds the career interception record with 10...Junior kicker Asher Murray kicked two field goals (23, 32) against St. Amant...The two made field goals were the first of Murray's career and marked the first time since Asher's older brother, Abram, kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton in week five of the 2023 season that a Byrd kicker had two made field goals in a game...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense had four takeaways, three interceptions and one fumble recovery, against the St. Amant Gators...It marked the first four-takeaway game for Byrd since the 2023 regular season finale against Natchitoches Central (2 fumbles, 2 interceptions)... It also was the first three-interception game for the Jackets since week two of the 2020 season when Chris Grieder set single-game record with three picks against the Haughton Bucs...Linebacker Sam Greer registered six double-digit tackle games in 2023, including three season-high 11 tackle games...Greer picked up where he left off in 2023 by logging double-digit tackles in three of Byrd's four games...Greer ha a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Linebacker Ethan Sipes set career highs with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Quinton Hillard scored on runs of 43 and 6 yards against Haughton, and has registered back-to-back games with two or more rushing touchdowns twice in his varsity career (2023 Natchitoches & Southwood)...Hilliard has scored at least one touchdown in all four games and leads the team with six TDs...Christian Maxie scored his first varsity touchdown on a 12-yard run against Haughton...Maxie has scored a rushing touchdown in three straight games...lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score against the Bucs was the first fumble return for a touchdown by a Yellow Jacket since Jude Partington's 70 yarder against Benton in 2022...The last time Byrd faced an undefeated Parkway team was in 2022 when the Panthers were 6-0, and the Yellow Jackets prevailed 39-14.

BYRD BLASTS

In the Ayres Tonight

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. In the 2024 opener against St. Amant, Ayres guided Byrd to 413 yards of total offense, including 386 rushing yards. Ayres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40-yard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-yard scamper against the Gators. Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown, Byrd's first of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. With Ayres behind center, Byrd is averaging 386.8 yards of total offense and 36.2 points per game.

Highlight Reel Runs Continue For Hilliard

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023. His highlight reel runs have continued in the first three games of 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon and into the end zone to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. He now has four multi-touchdown performances in his career, both coming in back-to-back games - 2023 vs. Natchitoches & Southwood and 2024 vs. St. Amant & Haughton. Against Evangel, Hilliard nearly made it three consecutive games with two touchdowns but had a 39-yarder taken off the board due to a holding penalty on the Jackets. However, he would have a fantastic 27-yard touchdown scamper in the second quarter against the Eagles. His 14-yard touchdown against John Ehret gives him at least one rushing touchdown in four straight games.

Maxie-mum Effort

One of the newest faces in the Jackets' backfield this season is wingback Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multioption attack. He started at left wing back against the St. Amant Gators and rushed for a game-high 154 yards and had a long run of 40 yards, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. Maxie scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. He rushed for 157 yards and a touchdown against Evangel. Maxie has scored a touchdown in three straight games.

Do Not Sleep on Simmons

Opponents should not sleep on senior fullback Desmond Simmons. In 2023's game against Airline he had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in the 2022's playoffs. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 run. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. Against Evangel, Simmons rushed for a game-high 171 yards and two touchdowns. He also scored on an 11-yard reception, the first of his career, against the Eagles. Simmons rushed for 107 yards and two touchdowns against John Ehret. He has scored in three straight games.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through the first four games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 386.8 yards of total offense and 36.2 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected tackle Mason Coenen and guard Ayden Boutte as "Co-Linemen of the Week." The two combined for eight knockdowns, and according to Harris, "They worked well together both on the front side with double teams and working to linebackers, and on backside blocks." Center Elijah Chembles was an honorable mention with seven knockdowns.

BYRD BANTER

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of lan Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. Against St. Amant, Byrd's defensive line played a major factor in the Jackets' 26-10 win. The defensive line continuously harassed and pressured Gators quarterback Cooper Babin which led to him throwing three interceptions and completing just 50% of his passes. Through four games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 58 total tackles, 11.5 tackles-for-loss for 58 yards, two pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries and a touchdown.

Sam I Am

Senior linebacker Sam Greer was one of the bright spots for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense in 2023. He continued to shine in Byrd's 26-10 season-opening win over St. Amant. Greer had 11 total tackles, including three solo stops and a tackle-for-loss. His 11 total tackles against the Gators matched a career-high, which he has done three previous times. Greer registered six double-digit tackle games last season and has three in four games this season. He finished the 2023 season as the team's leading tacker with 98 total tackles, which ranks eighth on the single-season tackles list. Greer also had 10 tackles-for-loss, two forced fumbles, a fumble recovery and an interception in 2023 and was a Second-Team All-District selection. In his 3-year varsity career, Greer has 138 total tackles and 15.5 tackles-for-loss. He had 10 tackles, four tackles-for-loss and two sacks against John Ehret.

Abraham-Miller Picks Up Where He Left Off

Senior defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller displayed a knack for picking off passes last season. His first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central was his sixth pick of the 2023 season and set the single-season school record, which he previously shared with Nicholas Peoples, who had five in 2010 and 2011, and Luther Dallas, who have five in 2015. In the week one win over St. Amant, Abraham-Miller picked up where he left off with a second quarter interception in the end zone that thwarted a Gators' drive. That interception gave Abraham-Miller seven career picks and he has legitimate chance at Peoples' career record of 10 interceptions, which he set from 2009-11.

Sensational Sipes

Sam Greer's linebacking mate is Ethan Sipes, who had a sensational night against the Evangel Eagles. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble. He is second on the team in tackles with 32 and tackles-for-loss with six.

Ja'Cari Jumps Into the Fray

Junior defensive back Ja'Cari Williams really jumped into the fray in 2023. Williams' first significant action came in last season's "Backyard Brawl" with Shreve, when he had five total tackles, including three solo stops. Against Evangel, Williams tied a personal-best with seven tackles, including four solo stops. Versus Haughton, he had a strip-sack of Bucs' quarterback Taylor Weathersby that led to lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score.

The 2024 Schedule, Polls and More

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2024 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2023. Byrd's two non -district opponents this season, St. Amant and John Ehret, both advanced to the regional round of the playoffs last season. The defending Non-Select Div. I Champion Ruston Bearcats, who the Yellow Jackets faced in the scrimmage, are the unanimous No. 1 ranked team again this week in all three polls - Louisiana Sports Writers Association, GeauxPreps.com and CrescentCitySports polls. The Airline Vikings were the top vote getters (11) of teams just outside the LSWA's Top 10 from District 1-5A. Byrd received two votes in the LSWA poll, and along with the Vikings and Parkway Panthers were among the "others to watch" in the CCS poll. Byrd and Airline were among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll. Airline, Byrd and Parkway are in the Top 5 in the SBC Advocate's NWLA rankings.

A Look Ahead

On Friday, Oct. 11, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will play their fourth consecutive road game as they travel to Independence Stadium to tangle with the Huntington Raiders. Kickoff for the District 1-5A game is scheduled for 7 p.m.

Kicking Duo

In high school football, the third phase of the game, special teams, specifically place kicking and punting, gets overlooked for various reasons. Often times, coaches are forced to look to the boys and girls soccer teams for someone who can kick a football or forego the kicking game all together. Many high school teams are fortunate to have one reliable kicker. The Byrd Yellow Jackets have the luxury of two reliable kickers in junior Asher Murray and senior Jackson Cooper. Murray booted two field goals, 23 and 32 yarders, in the Jackets' 26-10 season-opening win over St. Amant. Murray was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. Cooper is averaging 42.2 yards per punt with a long of 59. The two kickers have combined to go 19-of-20 on PAT kicks, and 22 of their 25 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponent's average starting field position is their own 20 yard line. Over the last three decades, Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of talented kickers, including Murray's older brother, Abram, who's kicking for the Miami Hurricanes.

Buzz Back In Time

In 2022, Byrd starting quarterback Lake Lambert returned from injury, and along with wing back Josh Allen paid big dividends as each scored two touchdowns to lead the Jackets to a 39-14 win over the previously undefeated Parkway Panthers at Preston Crownover Stadium. The Jackets rushed for over 300 yards and five touchdowns in the win.

Alumni Report

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team is wearing a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This is the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 27th season behind the microphone as the play-by-play "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets." Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Jacket Dominic Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. By downloading the 1130 The Tiger app fans can listen to Byrd Football anywhere.

Where Are They Now?

Will Anglin was a defensive back for the Yellow Jackets from 2009-11. He finished his varsity career second on the career pass break-ups list with 25. Kaiden Abraham-Miller's seventh career interception earlier this season moved him past Anglin for third on the all-time interceptions list. Anglin, who graduated from Northwestern State and coached there, is now the defensive line coach at Wayne State College in Nebraska. The Wildcats are 3-1 currently.

Puple & Gold Legacy

There's at least three players on the current roster whose fathers also wore the purple and gold for Byrd. Fullback Alton Fullwood's father, Albert, was a Yellow Jacket from 2002-04. Tight end Ronnie Buckingham's father Ronnie, who's a freshmen coach, played for the Jackets from 2001-03. Defensive end Darell Cottonham Jr.'s father, Darell Sr., played at Byrd from 1994-96.


