Revenge Against the Raiders

On Friday, Oct. 11, the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel to Independence Stadium to take on the Huntington Raiders. It'll be the fourth consecutive road game for Byrd. The Jackets will be looking for some revenge after last year's 44-43 loss to the Raiders. Kickoff for the District 1-5A game is scheduled for 7 p.m.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 4-1 overall record and a 2-1 record in District 1-5A after last Thursday's 46-35 loss to the Parkway Panthers. The Huntington Raiders are 4-1 overall and 4-0 in District 1-5A after last Friday's 28-27 victory over the Evangel Eagles.

The Last Time Out

In a battle of unbeaten teams, the Parkway Panthers were able to outlast the Byrd Yellow Jackets 46 -35 last Thursday at Preston Crownover Stadium. Parkway running back C.J. Dudley rushed for 210 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Panthers. Byrd wingback Christian Maxie rushed for 291 yards and three touchdowns in the losing effort. Maxie's output was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history. Huntington running back Jamarion Washington sprinted 80 yards on a touchdown run to bring the Raiders within one point of the Evangel Eagles midway through the fourth quarter. Washington then scored on a two-point conversion run to put the Raiders up for good 28-27.

The Series

This will be the 36th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Huntington Raiders in a series that dates back to 1973. Byrd leads the overall series 24-11. The Yellow Jackets and the Raiders had met every year from 1985 through 2008. In those 22 games, Byrd posted a 15-7 record against the Raiders. The Yellow Jackets had won six straight over the Raiders until last year's 44-43 Huntington victory in week two. It was the first Raiders' win since 2004. In the last 20 meetings between the two schools, Byrd is 16-4 against Huntington. The Yellow Jackets' 43-14 victory over the Raiders in the 2021 season opener gave Stacy Ballew his first-ever win as Byrd's head coach.

Last Time Versus Huntington

The Byrd Yellow Jackets and Huntington Raiders met at Northwood's Jerry Burton Stadium in week two of the 2023 season. After Malachi Johnson scored his fifth rushing touchdown of the game to put the Yellow Jackets within one point of tying the game, Byrd head coach Stacy Ballew opted to go for the two-point conversion and the potential win. On the ensuing play, Byrd fullback Dixon Poirier tried to go over the right side but was stopped by the Huntington defense just shy of the goal line, which allowed the Raiders to escape with a 44-43 win.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 25-14 (.641) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Huntington is coached by Stephen Dennis, who is in his eighth season at the helm of the Raiders' program. He was 38-35 in his previous seven seasons at Huntington. In 2021, Huntington posted a 9-3 record and advanced to the second round of the Class 4A Playoffs. He was the defensive coordinator for six seasons at Northwood before accepting the Huntington job. Dennis played at Parkway when former Northwood coach Jim Gatlin was the head coach there. He went on to play for Dennis Dunn at Louisiana Christian before returning to coach at Parkway with Gatlin. He then joined Dunn's staff at LCU for two seasons before coming back to Shreveport to serve as defensive coordinator under Gatlin at Northwood.

Three consecutive playoff appearances

Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 690-438-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 25-14 (.641) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...With the win over Evangel, Ballew passed three legendary coaches in George Hoy, Lee Hedges and Jerry Burton with 24 career victories...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...In 2023, Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history...The last three times ('21, '22, '24) Byrd began a season 4-0, the Jackets lost the next game.

2024 Notes

Wing back Christian Maxie's 291-yard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best singlegame performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing vards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...Byrd rushed for 383 yards against Parkway, marking the fourth time in five games the Jackets have eclipsed the 300-yard rushing plateau as a team...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (171) and Christian Maxie (157), each rush for over 100 yards against Evangel...It was the second time this season that Byrd had two backs eclipse the 100-yard mark in the same game... Fullback Desmond Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing TDs against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game...Simmons' 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Fullback Collin Deere scored his first varsity touchdown on a 23-yard run against John Ehret...With his second quarter interception against St. Amant, defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller now has seven career interceptions...Abraham-Miller's set the single-season interception record with six in 2023 and needs just three more picks to tie Nicholas Peoples, who holds the career interception record with 10...Junior kicker Asher Murray kicked two field goals (23, 32) against St. Amant...The two made field goals were the first of Murray's career and marked the first time since Asher's older brother, Abram, kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton in week five of the 2023 season that a Byrd kicker had two made field goals in a game...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense had four takeaways, three interceptions and one fumble recovery, against the St. Amant Gators...It marked the first four-takeaway game for Byrd since the 2023 regular season finale against Natchitoches Central (2 fumbles, 2 interceptions)...It also was the first three-interception game for the Jackets since week two of the 2020 season when Chris Grieder set single-game record with three picks against the Haughton Bucs...Linebacker Sam Greer registered six double-digit tackle games in 2023, including three season-high 11 tackle games...Greer picked up where he left off in 2023 by logging doubledigit tackles in four of Byrd's five games...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Linebacker Ethan Sipes set a career high with 15 tackles against Parkway...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Wing back Quinton Hillard has scored at least one touchdown in all five games and leads the team with seven TDs ...Christian Maxie scored his first varsity touchdown on a 12-yard run against Haughton...Maxie has scored at least one rushing touchdown in four straight games...lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score against the Bucs was the first fumble return for a touchdown by a Yellow Jacket since Jude Partington's 70 yarder against Benton in 2022...Darrell Cottonham leads the team with 8.5 tackles-for-loss.

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. In the 2024 opener against St. Amant, Ayres guided Byrd to 413 yards of total offense, including 386 rushing yards. Ayres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40-yard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-yard scamper against the Gators. Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown, Byrd's first of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. He scored his third rushing touchdown of the season on a 19-yard scamper against Parkway. With Ayres behind center, Byrd is averaging 386.0 yards of total offense and 36.0 points per game.

Highlight Reel Runs Continue For Hilliard

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023. His highlight reel runs have continued in the first three games of 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon and into the end zone to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. He now has four multi-touchdown performances in his career, both coming in back-to-back games - 2023 vs. Natchitoches & Southwood and 2024 vs. St. Amant & Haughton. Against Evangel, Hilliard nearly made it three consecutive games with two touchdowns but had a 39-yarder taken off the board due to a holding penalty on the Jackets. However, he would have a 27-yard touchdown jaunt in the second quarter against the Eagles. Hilliard's sensational 26-yard touchdown run against Parkway gives him at least one rushing touchdown in five straight games. He currently leads the team in scoring with seven touchdowns.

Christianius Maxie-mus

One of the newest faces in the Jackets' backfield this season is wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multioption attack. Maxie started at left wing back against the St. Amant Gators and rushed for a gamehigh 154 yards and had a long run of 40 yards, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. He scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. Maxie had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest singlegame output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. A holding penalty against Byrd negated an 18-yard run by Maxie which would've put him over the 300-yard mark. The sensational sophomore leads the team in rushing with 687 yards (16.4 per carry and 137.4 per game) and he has scored at least one touchdown in four straight games.

Do Not Sleep on Simmons

Opponents should not sleep on senior fullback Desmond Simmons. In 2023's game against Airline he had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in the 2022's playoffs. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 run. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. Against Evangel, Simmons rushed for a game-high 171 yards and two touchdowns. He also scored on an 11-yard reception, the first of his career, against the Eagles. In four games, Simmons has rushed for 380 yards and five touchdowns.

A Look Ahead

On Friday, Oct. 18, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will host the Natchitoches Central Chiefs. In conjunction with the 100th season of Byrd Football and Homecoming 2024, the City of Byrd has a number of special events planned for the week. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium.

BYRD BANTER

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of lan Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. Against St. Amant, Byrd's defensive line played a major factor in the Jackets' 26-10 win. The defensive line has continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks and have done a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's linebackers. Through five games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 60 total tackles, 14.5 tackles-for-loss for 73 yards, four sacks for 40 yards, two pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries and a touchdown.

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes give Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacker duo. Greer and Sipes lead the team with 52 and 47 total tackles, respectively. Greer registered six double-digit tackle games last season and has tallied four in five games this season. Against Parkway, the dynamic duo combined for 32 tackles - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023, Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallying 155 total tackles which ranks 10th on the career tackles list.

Abraham-Miller Picks Up Where He Left Off

Senior defensive back Kaiden Abraham-Miller displayed a knack for picking off passes last season. His first quarter interception against Natchitoches Central was his sixth pick of the 2023 season and set the single-season school record, which he previously shared with Nicholas Peoples, who had five in 2010 and 2011, and Luther Dallas, who have five in 2015. In the week one win over St. Amant, Abraham-Miller picked up where he left off with a second quarter interception in the end zone that thwarted a Gators' drive. That interception gave Abraham-Miller seven career picks and he has legitimate chance at Peoples' career record of 10 interceptions, which he set from 2009-11.

Ja'Cari Jumps Into the Fray

Junior defensive back Ja'Cari Williams really jumped into the fray in 2023. Williams' first significant action came in last season's "Backyard Brawl" with Shreve, when he had five total tackles, including three solo stops. Against Evangel, Williams tied a personal-best with seven tackles, including four solo stops. Versus Haughton, he had a strip-sack of Bucs' quarterback Taylor Weathersby that led to lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score. Williams is currently fourth on the team with 24 tackles.

The 2024 Schedule, Polls and More

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2024 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2023. Byrd's two non-district opponents this season, St. Amant and John Ehret, both advanced to the regional round of the playoffs last season. The defending Non-Select Div. I Champion Ruston Bearcats, who the Yellow Jackets faced in the scrimmage, are the unanimous No. 1 ranked team again this week in all three polls - Louisiana Sports Writers Association, GeauxPreps.com and CrescentCitySports polls. The Airline Vikings (5-0) are tied for 10th in the LSWA's poll this week. Byrd and Parkway Panthers were among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll, while the Vikings were among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through the first four games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 386.0 yards of total offense and 36.0 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected tackle Mason Coenen as the "Linemen of the Week." According to Harris, "Coenen had seven knockdowns." It's the fourth time in five games that the Coenen has received the honor. However, Harris did point out that, "Tanner Murrell (senior guard), did play his best game of the season."

Two Kickers Are Better Than One

In high school football, the third phase of the game, special teams, specifically place kicking and punting, gets overlooked for various reasons. Often times, coaches are forced to look to the boys and girls soccer teams for someone who can kick a football or forego the kicking game all together. Many high school teams are fortunate to have one reliable kicker. The Byrd Yellow Jackets have the luxury of two reliable kickers in junior Asher Murray and senior Jackson Cooper. Murray booted two field goals, 23 and 32 yarders, in the Jackets' 26-10 season-opening win over St. Amant. Murray was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. Cooper is averaging 42.2 yards per punt with a long of 59. The two kickers have combined to go 24-of-25 on PAT kicks, and 26 of their 30 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponent's average starting field position is their own 21 yard line. Over the last three decades, Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of talented kickers, including Murray's older brother, Abram, who's kicking for the Miami Hurricanes.

Buzz Back In Time

Oct. 11, 1990, is one of the most memorable nights in local high school football history. Byrd running back Charles Ball rushed for 407 yards in the Yellow Jackets' 34-14 win over the Huntington Raiders. The performance against Huntington remains the biggest rushing output for any high school player in the history of Shreveport-Bossier City. The victory marked the Yellow Jackets' first district win in two years. Not only did Ball shatter the record of Bossier's Tony Moss (361 yards vs. Airline, 1984), the Yellow Jackets star added 81 receiving yards on two catches. Ball was responsible for 407 of Byrd's 421 rushing yards and every one of the team's 81 receiving yards – 488 of the Jackets' 502 total yards. The victory came under first-year head coach, Alan Carter, and offensive coordinator (and future head coach) Mike Suggs.

Alumni Report

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team is wearing a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This is the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 27th season behind the microphone as the play-by-play "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets." Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Jacket Dominic Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. By downloading the 1130 The Tiger app fans can listen to Byrd Football anywhere.

Where Are They Now?

Liffort Hobley was a quarterback and defensive back for the Yellow Jackets from 1977-79. He played college football for the LSU Tigers. He played seven seasons in the NFL for the St. Louis Cardinals and Miami Dolphins. He had five interceptions, six sacks, eight fumble recoveries and scored two touchdowns in his professional career. He is currently self-employed and resides in Ft. Worth, Texas. He's also the President of the NFL Alumni Association in Dallas.


