Battle of the Purple & Gold BHS's On Friday, Oct. 25, the Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel across the Red River and up to Benton, La., to take on the Tigers. This is a District 1-5A battle between two teams that will be fully decked out in purple trimmed neatly in gold which use the initials BHS. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Benton's Tiger Stadium, which is located on the campus of Benton Middle School.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 6-1 overall record and a 4-1 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 31-21 win over the Natchitoches Central Chiefs. The Benton Tigers are 1-6 overall and 0-4 in District 1-5A after last Friday's excruciating 33-32 loss to the Evangel Eagles.

The Last Time Out

Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 144 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Byrd Yellow Jackets to a 31-21 win over the Natchitoches Central Chiefs last Friday at Lee Hedges Stadium. Quarterback Harrison Ayres and receiver Alex Schoonover connected on a 42-yard touchdown pass, and place kicker Asher Murray added a 34-yard field goal, his longest of the season, to help Byrd to the homecoming victory. After Evangel took a 33-26 lead midway through the fourth quarter, Benton responded by using 13 plays and scoring with two minutes to go, getting within one. Benton coach Reynolds Moore didn't hesitate to go for the win. Running out of their "Diesel" package, Benton back Cole Austin rammed towards the end zone. Video showed the ball breaching the goal line, but after a long discussion by the officials, they said Austin's knee hit the turf just before the ball broke the plane of the goal line. The failed conversion attempt gave Evangel the 33-32 win.

The Series

This will be only the fifth meeting between Byrd and Benton. The Yellow Jackets have won three of the previous four meetings in the series. Byrd defeated Benton, 46-31 in 2019, 45-17 in 2021 and 61-35 last year. The two teams didn't play in 2020 due to the Coronavirus pandemic. In 2022, Benton defeated Byrd, 63-28, at Tiger Stadium. It was the second-highest points allowed by the Yellow Jackets in program history. The two teams used to meet in the annual spring game back when Mitch Downey, who retired as Bossier Parish Schools Superintendent in January, was the Benton head coach and Mike Suggs was the Byrd head coach.

Last Time Versus Benton

Playing without its top two running backs in Dixon Poirier and Malachi Johnson, Byrd's offense led by a pair of reserves in wing back Jontavious Mobery (157) and fullback Desmond Simmons (120) registered its highest points total (61) in a decade, and its largest yardage output of the season (556) as the Yellow Jackets beat the Benton Tigers 61-35 at Independence Stadium. The win was the first of the 2023 season for Byrd.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 27-14 (.659) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Reynolds Moore is in his 12th season as the head coach of the Benton Tigers. He owns an 83-51 (.619) record in his 12 seasons as the Tigers' head coach. Moore sits in second place on the Tigers' coaching victories list behind Mitch Downey, who had 141 wins in his 16 seasons at Benton. Moore has taken the Tigers to the playoffs in 10 of his previous 11 seasons. His overall coaching record is 94-80 (.540). Moore spent his first four years as a head coach at Bolton High School in Alexandria. He posted an 11-29 record in those four seasons with the Bears. Moore is 1-3 versus Byrd.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Three consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 692-438-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 27-14 (.659) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...In 2023, Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted...For three consecutive seasons from 2013-15 Byrd posted double-digit wins, a first in school history.

2024 Notes

Byrd rushed for 304 yards against Natchitoches Central, marking the sixth time in seven games that the Jackets have eclipsed the 300-yard rushing plateau as a team...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 144 yards on 25 carries and scored three touchdowns, all career highs, against the Chiefs...Receiver Alex Schoonover has three touchdown receptions on the season, including the 12yard game-winner against Huntington...Schoonover caught a 42-yard touchdown pass from Harrison Ayres, which was the longest pass of the season...It also marked the first time since weeks four and five of the 2022 season that Byrd has had back-to-back games with a touchdown pass...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (164) and Quinton Hilliard (103), each rush for over 100 yards against Huntington marking the third time this season that Byrd has had two backs rush for 100 yards in the same game...Simmons and Hilliard had long touchdown runs of 77 and 75 yards, respectively...Wing back Christian Maxie had touchdown runs of 76 and 73 yards against Parkway... Maxie's 291-yard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing yards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...Fullback Desmond Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing TDs against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game...Simmons' 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 34-yard field goal against Natchitoches Central, the longest of the season...Murray kicked two field goals (23, 32) against St. Amant...The two made field goals were the first of Murray's career and marked the first time since Asher's older brother, Abram, kicked two field goals (24, 25) against Benton in week five of the 2023 season that a Byrd kicker had two made field goals in a game...Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense had four takeaways, three interceptions and one fumble recovery, against the St. Amant Gators...It marked the first four-takeaway game for Byrd since the 2023 regular season finale against Natchitoches Central (2 fumbles, 2 interceptions)...It also was the first three-interception game for the Jackets since week two of the 2020 season when Chris Grieder set single-game record with three picks against the Haughton Bucs...Linebacker Sam Greer has registered 12 double-digit tackle games in his three-year varsity career...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer had 15 tackles against Huntington...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer has 22 tackles-for-loss in his career which ranks ninth on the career tackles-for-loss list...Linebacker Ethan Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, 13 tackles against Huntington and 11 tackles, including nine solo stops versus Natchitoches Central...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Wing back Quinton Hillard had scored at least one touchdown in six straight games until last week, but he still leads the team with eight touchdowns... Ian Gray's 10-yard scoop and score against Haughton was the first fumble return for a touchdown by a Yellow Jacket since Jude Partington's 70 yarder against Benton in 2022...Byrd and Benton have combined to score over 90 points in each of the last two games.

BYRD BLASTS

In the Avres Tonight

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. In the 2024 opener against St. Amant, Ayres guided Byrd to 413 yards of total offense, including 386 rushing yards. Ayres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40vard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-vard scamper against the Gators, Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and a passing touchdown. Byrd's first of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. His third passing touchdown of the season was a 12yard game-winning pass to Alex Schoonover against Huntington which won the game for Byrd. Those two connected again on a 42-yarder against Natchitoches Central. With Ayres behind center, Byrd is averaging 386.1 yards of total offense and 33.6 points per game.

Highlight Reel Runs Continue For Hilliard

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023 and he has continued to roll in 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon and into the end zone to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. He now has four multi-touchdown performances in his career, both coming in back-to-back games - 2023 vs. Natchitoches & Southwood and 2024 vs. St. Amant & Haughton. Against Evangel, Hilliard nearly made it three consecutive games with two touchdowns but had a 39-yarder taken off the board due to a holding penalty on the Jackets. However, he would have a 27-yard touchdown run in the second quarter against the Eagles. Hilliard's sensational 75-yard touchdown run against Huntington, the longest of his career, gives him eight touchdowns on the season, which leads the team.

Do Not Sleep on Simmons

Opponents should not sleep on senior fullback Desmond Simmons. In 2023's game against Airline he had 28 carries for 205 yards, both career highs. Simmons was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 vards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 run. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing vards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 vards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. His 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel this season was the first of his career. Against Huntington, Simmons rushed for a game-high 164 yards and had a 77-yard touchdown run, the longest of his career. In the five games, Simmons has rushed for 544 yards, has two receptions for 15 yards and has scored seven touchdowns.

Spotlighting Deere

With senior starter Desmond Simmons out with an injury, sophomore Collin Deere was in the spotlight as the featured back against the Natchitoches Central Chiefs. The Friday night lights were not too bright for Deere as he rushed for a game-high 144 yards and he scored three touchdowns, marking the third time this season a Jacket has scored three touchdowns in a game. In the five games he's played in, Deere has rushed for 354 yards, four touchdowns and is averaging 5.6 yards per carry.

The 2024 Schedule, Polls and Power Rankings

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2024 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2023. Byrd's two non -district opponents this season, St. Amant and John Ehret, both advanced to the regional round of the playoffs last season. After Ruston's loss to Neville, the Edna Karr Cougars are the new unanimous No. 1 ranked team this week in all three polls - Louisiana Sports Writers Association, GeauxPreps.com and CrescentCitySports polls. The Airline Vikings (7-0) are tied for 10th with the Mandeville Skippers in this week's LSWA poll. The Vikings, Jackets and Parkway Panthers were among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll, while the Vikings were among the "First Five Out" in the GeauxPreps poll. In the latest Select Div. I Power Rankings, Byrd is seeded seventh with a 12.990 power rating, while Huntington is 15th, Captain Shreve is 20th and Evangel is currently 26th, two spots below the lowest seed.

BYRD BANTER

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through six games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 388.0 yards of total offense and 34.0 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected guard Jacob Martin as the "Linemen of the Week." Martin graded out an outstanding 83 percent against Natchitoches Central. "He has a lot to polish up, but was able use his size and get five on the ground. He is aggressive and eager to learn and get better," said Harris. Harris also said the offensive line as a whole had what may have been their best performance against the Chiefs.

Christianius Maxie-mus

One of the newest faces in the Jackets' backfield this season is wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multioption attack. Against the St. Amant Gators, Maxie rushed for a game-high 154 yards and had a long run of 40 yards, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. He scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. Maxie had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest single-game output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. The sensational sophomore leads the team in rushing with 687 yards and is averaging 16.4 yards per carry and 137.4 yards per game.

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of Ian Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. The defensive line has continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks and have done a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's linebackers. Through seven games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 85 total tackles, 19.5 tackles-for-loss for 96 yards, four sacks for 40 yards, two pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries and a touchdown.

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes give Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacker duo. Greer and Sipes lead the team with 67 and 60 total tackles, respectively. Greer registered 12 doubledigit tackle games in his varsity career. Against Huntington, the dynamic duo combined for 28 tackles, five tackles for loss and a sack. That performance came a week after combining for 32 tackles against Parkway - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. The two linebackers have combined to tally double-digit tackles 10 times in seven games. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023, Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallying 181 total tackles which ranks seventh on the career tackles list. Greer's one tackles-for-loss against Natchitoches Central upped his career total to 22, which ranks ninth on the career tackles-for -loss list.

Logan Has Been Dynamite

"Dynamite comes in small packages" - This old adage applies to Byrd cornerback and kick returner James Logan. Logan, who stands 5'7" and weighs 121 lbs., has been dynamite this season both on defense and on special teams. He has 27 total tackles, including 19 solo stops, two interceptions, two pass breakups, four passes defended and two blocked kicks. Logan had four kick returns for 127 yards against Natchitoches, including a 56-yarder. His 43-yard punt return to the Natchitoches Central 49 helped set up Byrd's offense with great field position. It led to a four-play, 22 yard drive that resulted in an Asher Murray 34-yard field goal as time expired, which gave Byrd a 17-14 halftime lead

JACKET JARGON

Two Kickers Are Better Than One

In high school football, the third phase of the game, special teams, specifically place kicking and punting, gets overlooked for various reasons. Often times, coaches are forced to look to the boys and girls soccer teams for someone who can kick a football or forego the kicking game all together. Many high school teams are fortunate to have one reliable kicker. The Byrd Yellow Jackets have the luxury of two reliable kickers in junior Asher Murray and senior Jackson Cooper. Murray booted two field goals, 23 and 32 yarders, in the Jackets' 26-10 season-opening win over St. Amant. Murray was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. After a careerlong 34-yard field goal against Natchitoches Central, Murray is now 4-for-5 on field goals this season. Cooper is averaging 38 yards per punt with a long of 59. The two kickers have combined to go 31-of-32 on PAT kicks, and 33 of their 39 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponent's average starting field position is their own 23 yard line. Over the last three decades, Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of talented kickers, including Murray's older brother, Abram, who's kicking for the Miami Hurricanes.

The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team is wearing a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

Buzz Back In Time

Wing back Josh Allen rushed for a game-high 122 yards on just eight carries and scored two touchdowns to lead the Byrd Yellow Jackets to a 45-17 win over the Benton Tigers in week seven of the 2021 season. It was the first-ever meeting between the Jackets and the Tigers. Allen's efforts paced a Byrd ground attack that rolled up 421 yards and five touchdowns in the win.

Alumni Report

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This is the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).

Puple & Gold Legacy

There's at least three players on the current roster whose fathers also wore the purple and gold for Byrd. Fullback Alton Fullwood's father, Albert, was a Yellow Jacket from 2002-04. Older brother Ashton was a linebacker from 2021-23. Tight end Braylen Buckingham's father Ronnie, who's a freshmen coach, played for the Jackets from 2001-03. Defensive end Darell Cottonham Jr.'s father, Darell Sr., played at Byrd from 1994-96.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 27th season behind the microphone as the play-by-play "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets." Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Jacket Dominic Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians.
