The Backyard Brawl in the Regular Season Finale

On Thursday, Nov. 7, it's the rivalry that pits neighbor versus neighbor, turns friend into foe, and causes angst amongst family members. It's the annual "Backyard Brawl" between Byrd and Captain Shreve in the regular season finale. Kickoff for Shreveport's biggest and best rivalry is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium, and Byrd is the home team.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 7-2 overall record and a 5-2 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 35-21 loss to the Airline Vikings. The Captain Shreve Gators are 5-4 overall and 4-3 in District 1-5A after last Friday's 63-34 trouncing of the Haughton Buccaneers. There's significant Select Div. I playoff seeding implications on the line in this game.

The Last Time Out

Airline running back D.J. Allen rushed for 103 yards and two touchdowns and receiver Kenny Darby added 126 receiving yards and two scores to lead the Vikings to a 35-21 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets last Friday at Lee Hedges Stadium. With the victory, the Vikings remain undefeated and have clinched at least a share of the District 1-5A title. Captain Shreve running back Jamarcea Plater, who's the new school single-season rushing record-holder, scored five touchdowns and Gabe Lockett added two more scores as the Gators crushed the Haughton Buccaneers 63-34 last Friday at Harold Harlan Stadium. The Shreve win snapped the Gators' two-game losing skid.

The Series

This will be the 47th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Captain Shreve Gators in a series that dates back to 1967. The Yellow Jackets lead the overall series 29-17. Byrd won that inaugural meeting 48-0, but Shreve would win the next nine straight games. These two schools have met on the gridiron every year since 1989. In those 36 meetings, Byrd is 28-8 against Shreve. The Yellow Jackets have also won 26 of the last 29 games over the Gators. Last year, the Gators defeated the Yellow Jackets 35-28 in the 46th edition of the "Backyard Brawl."

Last Time Versus the Gators

Trailing 28-27 late in the fourth quarter, Captain Shreve stopped Byrd on a 4th-and-2 to force a turnover on downs. On the ensuing play, Gators' running back Jamarlon Otis raced 66 yards for the eventual game-winning touchdown. Shreve added a two-point conversion to make the final 35-28. Otis finished the night with a game-high 190 rushing yards and two touchdowns. Byrd did have two backs rush for over 100 yards and two touchdowns in the game, fullback Dixon Poirier (142) and wing back Malachi Johnson (134). Unfortunately for Byrd, Poirier would break his arm in the game and be lost for the remainder of the season.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus. Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 28-15 (.651) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Captain Shreve is coached by Jeremy Wilburn, who is in his first season as the Gators' head coach. Wilburn is the eighth head coach in Shreve history. Shreve is also Wilburn's first head coaching job. He has led the Gators to a 5-4 (.555) record this season. He came to Captain Shreve after being the offensive coordinator at Huntington in 2023 and spending four years on the Raiders staff. He was a graduate assistant at Northwestern State where he received his undergraduate degree. After a brief stint away from coaching, he was at Airline before moving over to Huntington. Wilburn, who is a Byrd alum, quarterbacked the Yellow Jackets from 2001-03. In his three-year varsity career, Wilburn rushed for 410 yards and eight touchdowns and he passed for 733 yards and eight touchdowns.

2021 District 1-5A Champions Three consecutive playoff appearances Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football his-



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have won eight state championships and have been the state runners-up six times...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 693-439-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 28-15 (.651) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...In 2023, Byrd made the playoffs for the 14th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 18 of the last 19 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons and holds a 34-33-2 record...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013... After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted giving Byrd eight titles.

2024 Notes

Byrd's 261 rushing yards against Airline was its lowest total of season... It was also the second time the Jackets didn't have a back rush for over 100 yards in a game this season...Byrd was held scoreless in the first half for the first time since last season's playoff loss at Jesuit...Byrd rushed for 368 yards against Benton, marking the seventh time this season that the Jackets have eclipsed the 300yard rushing plateau as a team...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 206 yards on 36 carries and scored a touchdown against the Tigers...Receiver Alex Schoonover has three touchdown receptions on the season, including a 12-yard game-winner against Huntington...Against Natchitoches, Schoonover caught a 42-yard touchdown pass from Harrison Ayres which was the longest pass of the season...Quinton Hilliard's 41-yard touchdown reception against Benton was the first of his career...It also marked the first time since weeks 3-5 of the 2022 season that Byrd had three consecutive games with a touchdown pass...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (164) and Quinton Hilliard (103), each rush for over 100 yards against Huntington marking the third time this season that Byrd has accomplished that feat...Simmons and Hilliard had long touchdown runs of 77 and 75 yards. respectively, against the Raiders...Wing back Christian Maxie had touchdown runs of 76 and 73 yards against Parkway...Maxie's 291-yard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing yards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...Fullback Desmond Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing TDs against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game...Simmons' 11-vard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 56-yard field goal against Benton, which tied a school, city and parishes record held by Byrd's John Shaughnessy, who hit his 56-yarder in the 2008 playoffs against Airline...Murray has kicked five field goals on the season, three in consecutive weeks (6-8), with all three coming at the end of the first half to give Byrd a 3-point advantage at halftime... Linebacker Sam Greer has registered 13 double-digit tackle games in his three-year varsity career... Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer's 98 tackles this season ties his total from 2023, which ranks eighth on the single-season tackles list...Greer has 22.5 tackles-for-loss in his career which ranks ninth on the career tackles-for-loss list...Linebacker Ethan Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, which also was the first of four consecutive double-digit tackle games...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Greer & Sipes have set season high marks with 11 solo tackles (Greer vs. Airline) and 10 assists (Sipes vs. Huntington)...Wing back Quinton Hillard has scored at least one touchdown in eight of Byrd's nine games and leads the team with 12 touchdowns...Four times in his three-year varsity career, Hilliard has registered back-to-back games scoring two touchdowns...Captain Shreve kicker Zane Wyss' brother Jake was an All-District and All-City kicker at Byrd from 2012-14...Captain Shreve head coach Jeremy Wilburn posted a 3-0 record versus the Gators in his three-year Byrd career...Shreve principal Bryant Sepulvado played (1996-98) and coached at Byrd.

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. Three times this season, Ayres has guided Byrd to over 400 yards of total offense, including a season-high 413 yards in the season opening 26-10 win over St. Amant. Avres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40-yard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-yard scamper against the Gators. Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and his first passing touchdown of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. His third passing touchdown of the season was a 12-yard game-winning pass to Alex Schoonover against Huntington. Those two connected again on a 42-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Ayres and Quinton Hilliard connected on a 41-yard touchdown pass against Benton. Ayres was the first Jacket quarterback to toss touchdown passes in three straight games since Lake Lambert did it in 2022. His five touchdown passes are the most for a Byrd quarterback since Lambert tossed six in 2022. With Ayres behind center, Byrd is averaging 382.4 yards of total offense and 32.6 points per game.

Hilliard's Highlight Reels Continue to Roll

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023 and those reels have continued to roll in 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. The senior had a 41-yard touchdown reception, the first of his career, against Benton. He added a late rushing touchdown to essentially put the game away for Byrd. He had two rushing touchdowns to go along with 88 rushing yards against Airline. Hilliard now has six multi-touchdown performances in his career. He has scored at least one touchdown in eight of Byrd's nine games this season and leads the team with 12 TDs. He also leads the team with 810 all-purpose yards.

Spotlighting Deere

With starter Desmond Simmons still out with an injury, sophomore Collin Deere has been in the spotlight as the featured fullback in Byrd's ground attack. The Friday night lights were not too bright for Deere as he rushed for a game-high 206 yards on 36 carries and he scored a touchdown against Benton. In the three games since Simmons' injury, Deere has rushed for 403 yards, four touchdowns and is averaging 5.7 yards per carry. Despite playing in just seven games, Deere is third on the team with 613 rushing yards. He's averaging 5.6 yards per carry and 87.6 yards per game.

Santiago Issues a Code Red to Benton

Sophomore wing back Peter Santiago got his first varsity start against Benton and quickly administered a "code red" to the Tigers' defense. Santiago rushed for 83 yards on just seven carries and scored two touchdowns. His first varsity touchdown came on an eight-yard run in the first quarter. He would score his second touchdown on a 33-yard scamper in the fourth quarter to put Byrd ahead 30-21. With the expected return of Christian Maxie to the lineup and the emergence of Santiago as a viable rushing threat strengthens Byrd's arsenal of backs.

The 2024 Schedule. Polls and Power Rankings

Eight of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2024 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2023. Byrd's two non -district opponents this season, St. Amant and John Ehret, both advanced to the regional round of the playoffs last season. The Edna Karr Cougars remain the unanimous No. 1 ranked team this week in all three polls - Louisiana Sports Writers Association, GeauxPreps.com and CrescentCitySports. The Airline Vikings (9-0) are ranked eighth in this week's LSWA and GeauxPreps polls and ninth in the CCS poll. Parkway is ranked 10th in the GeauxPreps poll. Byrd was among the "Others to Watch" in the CCS poll. In the latest Select Div. I Power Rankings, Byrd is seeded ninth with a 12.680 power rating, while Huntington is 17th, Captain Shreve is 19th and Evangel is currently 24th. With 24 teams making the Select Div. I Playoffs and the top eight seeds receiving a first-round bye, the 47th annual "Backyard Brawl" will go a long way in determining if the Yellow Jackets will be amongst the top eight seeds.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through six games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 389.0 yards of total offense and 34.0 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's Ione First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected tackle Mason Coenen as the "Linemen of the Week." It was sixth time this season that Coenen has been selected for the honor. "Coenen graded out the highest," said Harris. "With a good showing in the second half, (Elijah) Chembles had his best game of the season."

Christianius Maxie-mus

One of the newest faces in the Jackets' backfield this season is wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multioption attack. Against the St. Amant Gators, Maxie rushed for a game-high 154 yards and had a long run of 40 yards, which helped set up Byrd's first touchdown. He scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. Maxie had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest single-game output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. The sensational sophomore leads the team in rushing with 727 yards and is averaging 14.3 yards per carry and 121.2 yards per game. He missed three games prior to returning to the lineup last week against Airline.

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of lan Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. If you add defensive lineman Kamerun Anderson it's a Party of Five. The defensive line has continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks and have done a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's linebackers. Through nine games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 108 total tackles, 23 tackles-for-loss for 97 yards, five sacks for 41 yards, three pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries and a touchdown. Anderson's stats adds 13 more tackles and 1.5 tackles-for-loss to those totals.

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes give Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacker duo. Greer and Sipes lead the team with 98 and 91 total tackles, respectively. Greer registered 13 double-digit tackle games in his varsity career. Against Huntington, the dynamic duo combined for 28 tackles, five tackles for loss and a sack. That performance came a week after combining for 32 tackles against Parkway - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. The two linebackers have combined to tally double-digit tackles 12 times in nine games. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023, Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallying 201 total tackles which ranks sixth on the career tackles list. His 98 tackles this season ties his total from last season. Greer has 22.5 tackles-for-loss in his career, which ranks ninth on the career tackles-for-loss list and two-and-a-half ahead of assistant coach Shimorye Hampton (20).

Logan's Run

Byrd cornerback and kick returner James Logan continues to have a great run in this his senior season. He has 36 total tackles, including 23 solo stops, two interceptions, two pass breakups, four passes defended and three blocked kicks. Logan blocked his third kick of the season against Airline. He has 15 kick returns for 290 yards and is averaging 19.3 yards per return. He had a long return of 56 yards against Natchitoches Central. Logan also has the longest punt return of the season, 28 yards, against Evangel.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of Miami. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 23 and 32 yarders, in the Jackets' 26-10 season-opening win over St. Amant. Asher was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. Murray's 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was also the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal gave or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). He is now 5-for-6 on field goals this season and has moved into ninth place on the single-season made field goals list. Murray is 35-of-37 on PAT kicks, and 32 of his 38 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponent's average starting field position is their own 22 yard line. Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of talented kickers, including such names as David Hankins, Jake Wyss, Shaughnessy and Scotty Roblow just to name a few.

Who Was Lee Hedges?

Lee Hedges Stadium is named in honor of legendary football coach Lee Hedges, who passed away on July 9, 2023, at the age of 93. Who was Lee Hedges? Lee Hedges dedicated his life to teaching and mentoring young people in Shreveport. He is best known for guiding the 1973 Captain Shreve Gators to a perfect 14-0 record and the State Championship. However, Shreve was not the only Shreveport school where he was successful. A three-sport star at Fair Park, Hedges would begin his legendary coaching career at arch-rival Byrd as the Jackets' head coach in 1956. He led Byrd to the state title game that first season, losing to the Istrouma Indians, 14-7. After four years on Line Avenue, Hedges moved to newly-opened Woodlawn in 1960. He had tremendous success with the Knights, leading them to the 1965 state championship game. Hedges' 217 career wins are the most for any coach in the history of Caddo-Bossier football.

The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team is wearing a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

Alumni Report

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This is the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 27th season behind the microphone as the play-by-play "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets." Friday's broadcast of the "Backyard Brawl" will be Cavell's 300th game behind the microphone. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Jacket Dominic Wilson provides sideline reports. 
