Select Division I Playoffs Begin

On Friday, Nov. 15, the No. 10 seed Byrd Yellow Jackets face the No. 23 seed Woodlawn Panthers in the first round of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 7-3 overall record and finished with 5-3 record in District 1-5A after last Friday's 42-34 loss to the Captain Shreve Gators. The Woodlawn Panthers are 4-6 overall and finished with a 2-3 in District 4-5A after last Friday's 15-14 win over the Liberty Magnet Patriots.

The Last Time Out

The Captain Shreve Gators used two 80-yard touchdown passes and a 68-yard touchdown run from Jamarcea Plater to defeat the Byrd Yellow Jackets 42-34 last Thursday in the 47th annual "Backyard Brawl." Plater rushed for a game-high 141 yards and two touchdowns and he threw one of the 80vard touchdown passes on a trick play. Byrd's Christian Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns in the losing effort. The Woodlawn Panthers halted their two-game losing skid by sneaking past the Liberty Magnet Patriots 15-14. Woodlawn's one-point victory also got the Panthers into the Select Division I Playoffs.

The Series

This will be the first-ever meeting between the Woodlawn Panthers and the Byrd Yellow Jackets. In fact, this will be only the fifth time Byrd has played a team from District 4-5A, and only the third meeting in the playoffs. Byrd has played Catholic of Baton Rouge twice in the playoffs, defeating the Bears 24-7 in the 2002 playoffs. In the 2020 Select Division I State Championship Game, Catholic won the game 35-12, but had to vacate the win and the title which was then awarded to Byrd. The Jackets played the Zachary Broncos in the 2013 and 2014 regular seasons, winning both games.

Last Time In The Playoffs

On a dreary night at the Shrine on Airline in Metairie, Byrd's performance reflected the less than ideal conditions as the Yellow Jackets lost 23-2 to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the first round of the 2023 LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Jesuit's defense limited Byrd's offense to just 81 yards of total offense and zero points. The Jackets avoided a shutout by registering a safety when the ball was snapped over the head of Jesuit punter Andrew Bordelon, and he kicked it out of the back of the end zone. Blue Jays' running back Patrick Berrigan was the star of the game as he rushed for 177 yards and two touchdowns. Woodlawn defeated Huntington 16-6 in the first round of the 2023 Select Div. I Playoffs. The Panthers lost 50-0 to the Edna Karr Cougars in the second round.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 28-16 (.636) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Woodlawn is coached by Scott Pellegrin, who is in his first season as the Panthers' head coach. Woodlawn is also Pellegrin's first head coaching job. He has led the Panthers to a 4-6 (.400) record this season. Prior to his arrival at Woodlawn, Pellegrin spent the previous four years at East Ascension High School in Gonzales, La., as the defensive coordinator. He spent one year as the defensive coordinator at Liberty Magnet High School in Baton Rouge and was part of Liberty's football program revival. Before coaching at Liberty, he coached five years at South Lafourche High School in Galliano, La. Pellegrin started his coaching career at E.D. White Catholic High School in Thibodaux, La., where he was an assistant coach for two seasons.

Three consecutive playoff appearances

Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record... Shreveport-Byrd owns a 693-440-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 28-16 (.636) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for the 15th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 41 different seasons, 69 games, and holds a 34-33-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles.

Byrd's 42-34 loss to Captain Shreve was the Jackets' second straight setback...The last time Byrd lost two consecutive games was in weeks seven (Parkway) and eight (Airline) of the 2023 season...The Shreve win over Byrd was the Gators' second straight in the series, which hasn't happened since 1989-90... Byrd's 247 rushing yards against Captain Shreve was its lowest rushing output of season... Byrd's 261 rushing yards the week before against Airline was the Jackets' previous low...Against Airline, Byrd was held scoreless in the first half for the first time since last season's playoff loss at Jesuit...Byrd rushed for 368 yards against Benton, marking the seventh time this season that the Jackets have eclipsed the 300-yard rushing plateau as a team...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 206 yards on 36 carries and scored a touchdown against the Tigers...It was the second time this season a Jacket back has rushed for over 200 yards in a game, coincidentally it was done by two sophomores (Maxie & Deere)...Receiver Alex Schoonover has four touchdown receptions on the season, including a 12-yard game-winner against Huntington...Quinton Hilliard's 41-yard touchdown reception against Benton was the first of his career...Hilliard's 46-yard reception against Shreve was the longest pass play of the season for Byrd...Quarterback Harrison Ayres has thrown six touchdown passes on the season which is the most since Lake Lambert tossed six in 2022...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (164) and Quinton Hilliard (103), each rush for over 100 yards against Huntington marking the third time this season that Byrd has accomplished that feat...Simmons and Hilliard had long touchdown runs of 77 and 75 yards, respectively, against the Raiders...Wing back Christian Maxie had touchdown runs of 76 and 73 yards against Parkway...Maxie's 291-yard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing yards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns against Shreve marking the fourth time the sophomore has rushed for over 100 yards this season...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...Fullback Desmond Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing touchdowns against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game... Simmons' 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Simmons has played in only five games this season and has not played since the Huntington game in week six...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 56-yard field goal against Benton, which tied a school, city and parishes record held by Byrd's John Shaughnessy, who hit his 56 -yarder in the 2008 playoffs against Airline...Murray kicked two field goals (39 & 45) against Shreve...It was the second time this season Murray has booted two field goals in a game...Murray has kicked seven field goals on the season, moving him into a tie with Morgan Burke for fifth on the single -season list...Linebacker Sam Greer has registered 14 double-digit tackle games in his three-vear varsity career...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer's 111 total tackles this season ranks fourth on the single-season tackles list...Greer has 23 tackles-for-loss in his career which ranks eighth on the career tackles-for-loss list...Linebacker Ethan Sipes has 98 total tackles on the season which is tied with Greer (2023) for ninth on the single-season tackles list...Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, which also was the first of four consecutive double-digit tackle games and five overall...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Greer & Sipes have set season high marks with 11 solo tackles (Greer vs. Airline) and 10 assists (Sipes vs. Huntington)...Wing back Quinton Hillard has scored at least one touchdown in nine of Byrd's 10 games and leads the team with 13 touchdowns...Four times in his three-year varsity career, Hilliard has registered back-to-back games scoring two touchdowns...Receiver Kristian Roberson had his first-ever reception against Airline, then followed with his second career catch last week against Shreve...Stacy Ballew has a 1-3 record in playoff games.

BYRD BLASTS

Ayres-ing It Out

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. Three times this season, Ayres has guided Byrd to over 400 yards of total offense, including a season-high 413 yards in the season-opening 26-10 win over St. Amant. Avres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40-yard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-yard scamper against the Gators. Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and his first passing touchdown of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. His third passing touchdown of the season was a 12-yard game-winning pass to Alex Schoonover against Huntington. Those two connected again on a 42-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Ayres and Quinton Hilliard connected on a 41-yard touchdown pass against Benton. Ayres was the first Jacket quarterback to toss touchdown passes in three straight games since Lake Lambert did it in 2022. Against Shreve, Avres passed for a career-high 93 yards and a touchdown, which gives him a total of six on the season. His six touchdown passes are the most for a Byrd quarterback since Lambert tossed six in 2022. Ayres holds an 11-7 record as the Jackets' starting quarterback. Byrd is averaging 378.2 yards of total offense and 32.7 points per game with Ayres behind center this season.

Hilliard's Highlight Reels Continue to Roll

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023 and those reels have continued to roll in 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. The senior had a 41-yard touchdown reception, the first of his career, against Benton. He added a late rushing touchdown to essentially put the game away for Byrd. He had two rushing touchdowns to go along with 88 rushing yards against Airline. Hilliard now has six multi-touchdown performances in his career. He has scored at least one touchdown in nine of Byrd's 10 games this season and leads the team with 13 TDs. He also leads the team with 879 all-purpose yards.

Simmons Sidelined

Senior fullback Desmond Simmons has been sidelined with an injury since the Huntington game. However against the Raiders, Simmons rushed for a game-high 164 yards and had a 77-yard touchdown run, the longest of his career. Simmons had a career night with 28 carries for 205 yards last year against Airline. He was the first Byrd back to rush for over 205 yards since Lake Lambert rushed for 267 yards against Alexandria in the 2022 playoffs. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64 run. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. His 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel this season was the first of his career. In the five games in which he's played, Simmons has rushed for 544 yards, has two receptions for 15 yards and has scored seven touchdowns. The Jackets are hoping to get Simmons back for the playoffs.

Nothing Runs Like A Deere

With starter Desmond Simmons still out with an injury, sophomore Collin Deere has been in the spotlight as the featured fullback in Byrd's ground attack. The Friday night lights were not too bright for Deere as he rushed for a game-high 206 yards on 36 carries and he scored a touchdown against Benton. In the four games since Simmons' injury, Deere has run for 476 yards, four touchdowns and is averaging 5.3 yards per carry. Despite playing in just seven games, Deere is third on the team with 686 rushing yards. He's averaging 5.4 yards per carry and 85.8 yards per game.

Schoonover Shines

Senior receiver Alex Schoonover has been the favorite target for quarterback Harrison Ayres this season. Schoonover leads the team with nine receptions for 196 yards and has scored four touchdowns, which is the most since Jackson Dufrene's 23 for 547 and six TDs in 2022. He had his best receiving game against Natchitoches Central with three catches for 71 yards and one touchdown.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through 10 games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 378.2 yards of total offense and 32.7 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's Ione First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected tackle Joshua Hutson as the "Linemen of the Week." It was first time this season that Hutson has been selected for the honor. "Hutson graded out the highest," said Harris. "It's great for Hutson. He has worked hard all year to improve, and he continues do so weekly."

Christianius Maxie-mus

One of the newest faces in the Jackets' backfield this season is wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multioption attack. Against the Captain Shreve Gators, he rushed for a team-high 121 yards and scored two touchdowns. Maxie scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. He had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest single-game output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. The sensational sophomore leads the team in rushing with 848 yards and is averaging 13.5 yards per carry and 121.1 yards per game. He missed three games due to injury prior to returning to the lineup against Airline.

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of lan Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. If you add defensive lineman Kamerun Anderson it's a Party of Five. The defensive line has continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks and have done a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's linebackers. Through 10 games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 119 total tackles, 23.5 tackles-for-loss for 103 yards, 5.5 sacks for 44 yards, three pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, four fumble recoveries and a touchdown. Anderson's stats adds 15 more tackles and 1.5 tackles-for-loss to those totals.

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes gives Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacker duo. Greer and Sipes lead the team with 111 and 98 total tackles, respectively. Greer has registered 14 double-digit tackle games in his varsity career. Against Huntington, the dynamic duo combined for 28 tackles, five tackles for loss and a sack. That performance came a week after combining for 32 tackles against Parkway - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. The two linebackers have combined to tally double-digit tackles 13 times in 10 games. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023, Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallying 214 total tackles which ranks fourth on the career tackles list. His 111 tackles this season ranks fourth on the single-season list, while Sipes' 98 total tackles is tied with Greer for ninth on the list. Greer has 23 tackles-for-loss in his career, which ranks tied for eighth on the career tackles-for-loss list with Treyvon Sims.

Logan's Run

Byrd cornerback and kick returner James Logan continues to have a great run in this his senior season. He has 41 total tackles, including 27 solo stops, three tackles-for-loss, two interceptions, two pass breakups, four passes defended and three blocked kicks. Logan blocked his third kick of the season against Airline. He has 16 kick returns for 330 yards and is averaging 20.6 yards per return. He had a long return of 56 yards against Natchitoches Central. Logan also has the longest punt return of the season, 28 yards, against Evangel.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of Miami. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 39 and 45 yarders against Captain Shreve. It was the second time this season Murray has kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant & Shreve). He was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. Murray's 56yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was also the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal gave or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). He is now 7-for-8 on field goals this season and has moved into a tie for fifth place with Morgan Burke on the single-season made field goals list. The junior kicker is ninth on the career kicking list. Murray is 37-of-39 on PAT kicks, and 38 of his 44 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. Opponent's average starting field position is their own 22 yard line. Byrd has been blessed with a bevy of talented kickers, including such names as David Hankins, Jake Wyss, Shaughnessy and Scotty Roblow just to name a few.

The Centennial Season

2024 is the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The team is wearing a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

Salute to Service

Throughout the 100 years of Byrd Football numerous former players have entered into military service. One of the most notable former Jackets currently serving our great nation is lieutenant Zack Ward. An All-District, All-City offensive lineman at Byrd, Ward continued his playing career at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, N.Y. After graduating from West Point, Ward was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the U.S. Army. Ward was recently promoted to first lieutenant, and is currently serving with the 10th Mountain Division stationed in Estonia.

Alumni Report

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This is the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017), Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).


