Ouarterfinals

On Friday, Nov. 29, the No. 10 seed Byrd Yellow Jackets will travel to Alexandria, La., to face the No. 2 seed Alexandria Senior High Trojans in the quarterfinals of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at L.W. "Butch" Stoker Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets, who are the No. 10 seed, own a 9-3 overall record after last Friday's 37-15 win over the No. 7 seeded St. Paul's Wolves in regional round of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Byrd finished with 5-3 record in District 1-5A. The Alexandria Senior High Trojans are the No. 2 seed and own an 11-0 overall record. The Trojans had a bye in the first round then crushed the No. 18 seed Evangel Eagles, 49-6, last Friday in the regional round. Alexandria finished with a perfect 5-0 record in District 2-5A.

The Last Time Out

The Byrd Yellow Jackets defeated the St. Paul's Wolves 37-15 last Friday night in the regional round of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs. Byrd senior fullback Desmond Simmons rushed for 150 yards on 27 carries and scored a touchdown. For the second straight week, Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense had four takeaways, two interceptions and two fumble recoveries, and held the Wolves to just 15 points. The No. 2 seeded Alexandria Trojans crushed the No. 18 Evangel Eagles 49-6 behind four first half rushing touchdowns from running back and LSU commit J.T. Lindsey.

The Series

It's hard to believe, but this will be only the second meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Alexandria Senior High Trojans. Byrd beat ASH 49-10 in the first round of the 2022 Select Div. I Playoffs. For many years in the early 20th century, the Shreveport-Byrd Yellow Jackets did routinely play a team from Central Louisiana, but it was the Alexandria-Bolton Bears. Shreveport-Byrd and Alexandria-Bolton played 44 times from 1916 through 1964 with the Yellow Jackets holding a 32-11-1 lead in that series. Over the last 25 years, Byrd has played seven playoff games against teams from District 2-5A and is just 2-5 in those seven games.

Last Time Versus Alexandria

Behind a record-setting performance from quarterback Lake Lambert, the No. 6 seeded Byrd Yellow Jackets cruised to a 49-10 win over the No. 22 seeded Alexandria Trojans in the regional round of the 2022 Select Division I Playoffs at Lee Hedges Stadium. Lambert rushed for a career-high 267 yards and five touchdowns against Alexandria. Lambert's 267 rushing yards were the sixth best single-game performance in school history. His 97-yard touchdown run against the Trojans was the second-longest rushing touchdown in program history.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 30-16 (.652) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. Alexandria Senior High is coached by Thomas Bachman, who is in his ninth year at the helm of Trojans football program. Bachman, who prepped at Evangel Christian Academy, is the son of former Evangel and Red River coach John Bachman. He took over the ASH football program in 2015 and led the Trojans to the 2020 State Championship game, where Alexandria suffered an excruciating 35-34 loss to the Acadiana Wrecking Rams. Bachman owns a 67-37 (.644) record in his nine seasons at Alexandria Senior High.

Four consecutive playoff appearances

Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marks the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record... Shreveport-Byrd owns a 695-440-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 30-16 (.652) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for the 15th consecutive year, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 71 games, and holds a 36-33-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles...Stacy Ballew has a 3-3 record in playoff games.

Byrd rushed for 298 yards against St. Paul's, narrowly missing the 300-yard plateau...However, the 298 rushing yards against the Wolves upped Byrd's rushing total to 3,946 yards, which vaulted this team from fifth to first on the single season team rushing yards list...Eight times this season the Jackets have eclipsed the 300-yard plateau as a team...Senior fullback Desmond Simmons returned to action against Woodlawn and led the Jackets with 197 rushing yards, which was the second-highest total of his career, and a touchdown...Simmons rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown against St. Paul's, which was the seventh 100-plus yard game of his career...Simmons scored three touchdowns against Evangel, two rushing and one receiving, and added two more rushing touchdowns against John Ehret marking his third career multiple touchdown game...Simmons' 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel was the first catch of his career...Simmons had two receptions against St. Paul's...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 206 yards on 36 carries and scored a touchdown against the Benton Tigers...It was the second time this season a Jacket back had rushed for over 200 yards in a game, coincidentally done by two sophomores (Maxie & Deere)...Receiver Alex Schoonover has four touchdown receptions on the season, including a 12-yard game-winner against Huntington...Wing back Quinton Hilliard's 41-yard touchdown reception against Benton was the first of his career...Hillard has scored at least one touchdown in 10 of Byrd's 12 games and leads the team with 14 touchdowns and 84 points...Four times in his three-year varsity career, Hilliard has registered back-to-back games scoring two touchdowns...Kristian Roberson's 50-yard reception against St. Paul's was the longest pass play of the season for Byrd...Roberson also had a 10-yard rush on the first carry of his career...Quarterback Harrison Ayres has thrown six touchdown passes on the season which is the most since Lake Lambert tossed six in 2022...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (164) and Quinton Hilliard (103), each rush for over 100 yards against Huntington marking the third time this season that Byrd has accomplished that feat...Simmons and Hilliard had long touchdown runs of 77 and 75 yards, respectively, against the Raiders...Wing back Christian Maxie had touchdown runs of 76 and 73 yards against Parkway...Maxie's 291-yard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing vards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns against Shreve marking the fourth time the sophomore has rushed for over 100 yards this season...Byrd rushed for 398 yards in its 35-23 win over Evangel, which is tied for the 18th best single-game rushing performance in team history...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 56-yard field goal against Benton, which tied a school, city and parishes record held by Byrd's John Shaughnessy, who hit his 56-yarder in the 2008 playoffs against Airline...Murray kicked two field goals (36 & 50) against Woodlawn, giving him back-to-back games (39 & 45 vs. Shreve) with two made field goals... It was also the third time this season Murray has booted two field goals in a game...Murray's 32-yard field goal against St. Paul's upped his season total to 10 and moves him into a tie for first place on the single-season list with Ben Eldredge, who made 10 field goals in 2009...Murray's 10 made field goals has him in a tie for fourth place on the career made field goals list with Eldredge...Murray has booted two 50+ yard field goals this season, which is a first in program history both in a season as well as a career...Linebacker Sam Greer has registered 15 double-digit tackle games in his three-year varsity career...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer's 129 total tackles this season puts him atop the single-season tackles list and his 232 career tackles ranks third on the career tackles list...Greer has 25 tackles-forloss in his career which ranks him tied for sixth with Paul Dupée on the career tackles-for-loss list... Linebacker Ethan Sipes has 107 total tackles on the season which is tied for sixth on the singleseason tackles list with Jonathan Stewart...Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, which also was the first of four consecutive double-digit tackle games and five overall...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Greer & Sipes have set season high marks with 11 solo tackles (Greer vs. Airline) and 10 assists (Sipes vs. Huntington).

In the Ayres Tonight

Senior Harrison Ayres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started last season. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. Three times this season, Ayres has guided Byrd to over 400 yards of total offense, including a season-high 413 yards in the season-opening 26-10 win over St. Amant. Ayres had 10 carries for 54 yards, including a 40-yard run, and scored a touchdown on a nine-yard scamper against the Gators. Against Haughton, he had his second rushing touchdown and his first passing touchdown of the season. He threw his second touchdown pass of the season against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. His third passing touchdown of the season was a 12-yard game-winning pass to Alex Schoonover against Huntington. Those two connected again on a 42-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Ayres and Quinton Hilliard connected on a 41-yard touchdown pass against Benton. Ayres was the first Jacket quarterback to toss touchdown passes in three straight games since Lake Lambert did it in 2022. Against Shreve, Ayres passed for a career-high 93 yards and a touchdown, which gives him a total of six on the season. His six touchdown passes are the most for a Byrd quarterback since Lambert tossed six in 2022. He had a career-long 70-yard touchdown run against Woodlawn. He completed a career-high five passes against St. Paul's. Ayres holds an 13-7 record as the Jackets' starting quarterback. Byrd is averaging 372.9 yards of total offense and 32 points per game with Ayres behind center this season.

Hilliard's Highlight Reels Continue to Roll

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023 and those reels have continued to roll in 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 114 yards on just nine carries against St. Amant. He averaged 12.7 yards per carry and scored two touchdowns, including Byrd's first of the season on an incredible 58-yard jaunt. His second touchdown came on a third-and-goal from the five where he outran the Gator defense to the pylon to put Byrd ahead by two scores. Hillard rushed for 81 yards on just four carries and had his second consecutive two touchdown performance against Haughton, scoring on runs of 43 and six yards. The senior had a 41-yard touchdown reception, the first of his career, against Benton. He added a late rushing touchdown to essentially put the game away for Byrd. He had two rushing touchdowns to go along with 88 rushing yards against Airline. Hilliard now has six multi-touchdown performances in his career. He has scored at least one touchdown in 10 of Byrd's 12 games this season and leads the team with 14 TDs for 84 points.

Desmond Delivers

Senior fullback Desmond Simmons had been sidelined with an injury since the Huntington game. However, he returned in a big way against Woodlawn rushing for a game-high 197 yards and scored on a 3-yard run. It was his best performance of the season, and the second-highest single game output of his career. Against St. Paul's, Simmons rushed for a game-high 150 yards and a touchdown. His best performance came last year against Airline when he rushed for 205 yards. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64-yard scamprer. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. His 11-yard touchdown reception against Evangel this season was the first of his career. In his three-year varsity career, Simmons has rushed for 1,836 yards on 324 carries and has scored 16 touchdowns.

Nothing Runs Like A Deere

While starter Desmond Simmons was out, sophomore Collin Deere was the featured fullback in Byrd's ground attack. Fans found out that nothing runs like a Deere as he rushed for a game-high 206 yards on 36 carries and he scored a touchdown against Benton. In the four games Simmons missed, Deere ran for 476 yards, four touchdowns and averaged 5.3 yards per carry. Deere is third on the team with 743 rushing yards and is averaging 5.4 yards per carry and 74.3 yards per game.

Schoonover Shines

Senior receiver Alex Schoonover has been the favorite target for quarterback Harrison Ayres this season. Schoonover leads the team with 10 receptions for 206 yards and has scored four touchdowns, which is the most since Jackson Dufrene's 23 for 547 and six touchdowns in 2022. He had his best receiving game against Natchitoches Central with three catches for 71 yards and one touchdown.

BYRD BANTER

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Through 12 games, the O-line has paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 372.9 yards of total offense and 32.0 points per game. In 2023, Noah Slaughter was Byrd's Ione First-Team All-District Selection. With Slaughter's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 13 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 37 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. This week, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected guard Jacob Martin as the "Linemen of the Week." It's the second straight week that Martin has been selected for the honor. Harris said, "Martin graded out the highest," Harris said. "However, the film was most enjoyable to grade. The group played really well together and were able to adjust to the multiple fronts they saw."

Maxie-mum Effort

One of the brightest stars in the Jackets' backfield this season is wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multi-option attack. Against the Captain Shreve Gators, he rushed for a team-high 121 yards and scored two touchdowns. Maxie scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. He had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest single-game output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. The sensational sophomore leads the team in rushing with 900 yards and is averaging 11.2 yards per carry and 100 yards per game despite missing three games due to an injury.

Roberson Rises Up

In Byrd's multi-option offense wide receivers don't see a lot of targets. Such is the case with senior wide receiver Kristian Roberson. However, in the last four games Roberson has risen up and proven he's a viable threat. In those four games, he's caught three passes for 78 yards, including a 50-yarder against St. Paul's, and had a 10-yard run on a reverse.

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of lan Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham is Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome. If you add tackle Kamerun Anderson, it's a Party of Five. The defensive line has continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks, stopping the run, and have done a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's linebackers. Through 12 games, Byrd's Fearsome Foursome has combined for 142 total tackles, 28.5 tackles-forloss for 113 yards, 9.5 sacks for 49 yards, five pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, five fumble recoveries for 16 return yards and a touchdown. Anderson's stats adds 18 more tackles and 1.5 tackles-forloss and a sack to those totals.

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes gives Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacker duo. Greer and Sipes lead the team with 129 and 107 total tackles, respectively. Against Huntington, the dynamic duo combined for 28 tackles, five tackles for loss and a sack. That performance came a week after combining for 32 tackles against Parkway - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. The two linebackers have combined to tally double -digit tackles 14 times (Greer 9, Sipes 5) in 11 games. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023, Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallying 232 total tackles, which ranks third on the career tackles list behind Paul Dupée (265) and Brooks Brossette (233). Greer's 129 total tackles this season ranks first on the single-season list, while Sipes' 107 total tackles ranks tied for sixth with Jonathan Stewart on the list. Greer has 25 tackles-for-loss in his career, which is tied for sixth with Dupée on the career tackles-for-loss list. With his 4.0+ grade point average, Greer has been namedto the LHSAA's All-Academic Composite Team, and is one of 21 area football players on the National Football Foundation McNaughton Chapter Preseason Scholar-Athlete Watch List.

JACKET JARGON

Logan's Run

Byrd cornerback and kick returner James Logan continues to have a great run in this his senior season. He has 42 total tackles, including 28 solo stops, three tackles-for-loss, four interceptions, two pass breakups, four passes defended and three blocked kicks. Logan blocked his third kick of the season against Airline. He has 16 kick returns for 330 yards and is averaging 20.6 yards per return. He had a long return of 56 yards against Natchitoches Central. Logan also has the longest punt return of the season, 28 yards, against Evangel. Logan picked off two passes against St. Paul's, giving him five career interceptions for 133 return yards.

Ja'Cari Jumps Into the Fray

Junior defensive back Ja'Cari Williams really jumped into the fray in 2023, and with the season-ending injury to Kaiden Abraham-Miller this season, Williams' presence in the secondary has significantly increased. He's responded incredibly well, ranking third on the team with 63 total tackles, three tackles-for-loss, one interception and three forced fumbles, two of those coming against St. Paul's. Against Haughton, he had a strip-sack of Bucs' quarterback Taylor Weathersby that led to lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score.

SIv As A Fox

Senior Kian Fox, who also plays lacrosse at Byrd, plays the hybrid "buck" linebacker position for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense. Fox played one the best games of his varsity career against the Woodlawn Panthers. He had four tackles, including three solo stops, a strip sack and fumble recovery against the Panthers. This season, Fox has registered 18 total tackles, two tackles-for-loss, a forced fumble, and a fumble recovery. Kian is the younger brother of former Jacket two-sport standout Walker Fox, who is currently playing baseball at East Texas Baptist University.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of Miami. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 36 and 50 yarders, against Woodlawn. It was the third time this season Murray has kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). It's also the first time in program history that a place kicker has kicked two 50+ yard field goals in a season as well as in a career. Murray was perfect against Haughton going 7-for-7 on PAT kicks and 8-for-8 on kickoffs for touchbacks. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was also the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal gave or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray booted a 32-yard field goal against St. Paul's giving him 10 made field goals this season which has moved into a tie for first place on the single-season made field goals list with Ben Eldredge, who kicked 10 in 2009. With his 10 made field goals, the junior kicker is tied for fourth on the career kicking list with Eldredge. Murray is 42-of-45 on PAT kicks, and 45 of his 52 kickoffs have resulted in touchbacks. He has ensured the Murray Family legacy at Byrd.

Former Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2024 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of Miami, punter Scotty Roblow and deep snapper Sawyer Benson at Northwestern State University, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, offensive lineman Calvin "Trey" Lester III at Mississippi Valley State University, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Ouachita Baptist University.
