Playoff Run Ends In Alexandria

On Friday, Nov. 29, the No. 10 seed Byrd Yellow Jackets' outstanding playoff run ended after suffering a 43-32 loss to the No. 2 seed Alexandria Senior High Trojans in the guarterfinals of the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs at J.L. "Butch" Stoker Stadium.

A Little About the Team

The Byrd Yellow Jackets, who were the No. 10 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs, finished the 2024 season with a 9-4 overall record. The Jackets won two playoff games before losing 43-32 to the No. 2 seed Alexandria Senior High Trojans in the guarterfinals. Byrd finished with 5-3 record in District 1-5A. Byrd loses 28 seniors from the 2024 team, including 10 starters on offense and seven on defense as well as punter Jackson Cooper. However, the Jackets do return wing back Christian Maxie, fullback Collin Deere as well as defensive lineman Ian Gray, corner back Azariae Barfield and safety Ja'Cari Williams.

The Last Time Out

Behind a five touchdown performance from running back J.T. Lindsey, the No. 2 seeded Alexandria Senior High Trojans defeated the No. 10 seed Byrd Yellow Jackets 43-32 at J.L. "Butch" Stoker Stadium. Lindsey, an LSU signee, rushed for 169 yards and four touchdowns and added a 42-yard touchdown reception on a screen pass to keep ASH undefeated and lead the Trojans into the semifinals. Kristian Roberson's 10-yard touchdown run on a reverse pitch brought the Jackets to within two points, 28-26, in the fourth guarter. Quinton Hilliard's two-point conversion rush was stopped short of the goal line. ASH would score two more times to Byrd's one to make the final 43-32. Byrd amassed 412 rushing yards in the game, and had two backs, fullback Desmond Simmons (142) and quarterback Harrison Ayres (133), each rush for over 100 yards and score a touchdown. Jackets place kicker Asher Murray kicked two field goals in the game, including a 52 yarder, his third field goal of 50-plus yards this season.

The 2024 Season

In the 100th season of Byrd Football, the Yellow Jackets posted a 9-4 record. It was the second time in four seasons under head coach Stacy Ballew that the Yellow Jackets won nine games. Byrd reached the state playoffs for the 15th consecutive year, which is the longest period in program history. For the fourth time in 12 seasons and for the first time since 2020, the Yellow Jackets won two playoff games.

The Centennial Season

2024 was the 100th season of C.E. Byrd Football and the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football. On Sept. 17, 1925, Shreveport High School was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd, who was the first superintendent of schools in Caddo Parish. The 2024 team wore a special helmet decal commemorating the centennial season.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 30-17 (.638) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Craig Harris, offensive line; Rahkeem Mitchell, running backs; Kellum Humphrey, wide receivers; Shimorye Hampton, defensive line: Jalen Bowers, linebackers; Benii Piazza, corner backs, and Ballew coaches the safeties, The freshmen coaches are Carlos Doss, Ronnie Buckingham, Seth Guerra, Bryson Vance and Tucker Gardner. Cordarious Wayne is the certified athletic trainer.

Achievements

2021 District 1-5A Champions Four consecutive playoff appearances Won two playoff games in 2024 Two 9-win seasons in four years

Stacy Ballew is in his fourth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.



After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2024 marked the 120th season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 100th season as C.E. Byrd... Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 67-28-12 record...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 695-441-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 30-17 (.652) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 15 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 72 games, and holds a 36-34-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles.

2024 Notes

Byrd rushed for a season-high 412 yards against Alexandria, surpassing the previous high of 298 against Evangel...Byrd finished the season with 4,358 rushing yards, which ranks first on the single season team rushing yards list...Nine times this season the Jackets eclipsed the 300-yard plateau as a team...Byrd's 4.963 yards of total offense also set the single-season mark breaking the previous record of 4,558 set by the 2013 team...After missing the final four games of the regular season, senior fullback Desmond Simmons returned to action against Woodlawn and led the Jackets with 197 rushing yards, which was the second-highest total of his career, and he scored a touchdown ...Simmons rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown against St. Paul's, which was the seventh 100plus yard game of his career...Simmons rushed for 142 yards and a touchdown against ASH... Simmons finished the season with 1,033 rushing yards to become the first Byrd back to eclipse the 1.000-vard plateau in a season since Lake Lambert rushed for 1.021 vards in 2022...Simmons finished his career with 1,978 rushing yards, which ranks ninth on the career rushing list...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 206 yards on 36 carries and scored a touchdown against Benton...It was the second time this season a Byrd back rushed for over 200 yards in a game, coincidentally done by two sophomores (Maxie & Deere)...Receiver Alex Schoonover led the team with 12 receptions for 229 yards and four touchdowns, including a 12-yard game-winner against Huntington...Wing back Quinton Hilliard's 53-yard touchdown reception against ASH was the longest of the season...Hillard scored at least one touchdown in 11 of Byrd's 13 games and led the team with 15 touchdowns and 90 points...Four times in his three-year varsity career. Hilliard registered back-to-back games scoring two touchdowns...Kristian Roberson's 10-yard touchdown run against ASH was the first of his career....Quarterback Harrison Ayres threw six touchdown passes this season, which was the most since Lake Lambert tossed six in 2022...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (142) and Harrison Ayres (133), each rush for over 100 yards against ASH marking the fourth time this season that Byrd had accomplished that feat...Ayres had an 85-yard touchdown run against ASH, which was the longest of the season...On the season, Byrd had five touchdown runs of 70 or more yards (Ayres 85, Simmons 77. Hilliard 75. and wing back Christian Maxie 76 and 73)...Maxie's 291-vard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing yards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson, Byrd's career rushing leader, rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns against Shreve, which was the fourth time the sophomore had rushed for over 100 yards in a game this season...Maxie finished the season second on the team behind Simmons with 991 rushing yards...Byrd's 412 rushing yards against ASH is tied for the 16th best single-game rushing performance in program history...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 56-yard field goal against Benton, which tied a school, city and parishes record held by Byrd's John Shaughnessy, who hit his 56-varder in the 2008 playoffs against Airline...Murray kicked two field goals (52, 44) against ASH, which was the fourth time this season he made two field goals in a game ... Murray finished the season by making 12-of-14 field goals and setting the single-season record, previously held by Ben Eldredge, who made 10 field goals in 2009...Murray's 12 made field goals puts him in fourth place on the career made field goals list... Murray booted three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) this season, which was a first in program history both in a season and in a career...Linebacker Sam Greer registered 15 double-digit tackle games in his three-year varsity career...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer's 136 total tackles this season set the single-season tackles record...Greer's 239 career tackles ranks second on the career tackles list behind Paul Dupée's 265...Greer had 26 tackles-forloss in his career which ranks him sixth on the career tackles-for-loss list...Greer along with Parkway's Mark Copenhaver were selected by the District 1-5A coaches as the Defensive Co-MVPs...continued on next page

Linebacker Ethan Sipes had 113 total tackles on the season which ranks fifth on the single-season tackles list...Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, which was also the first of four consecutive double-digit tackle games and five overall...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Greer & Sipes have set season high marks with 11 solo tackles (Greer vs. Airline) and 10 assists (Sipes vs. Huntington)...Sipes was a Second-Team All-District selection.

Rare Ayres

Senior Harrison Avres was the Jackets' starting tight end at the beginning of the 2023 season but took over as Byrd's starting quarterback against Captain Shreve. Ayres posted a 4-4 record in the eight games he started in 2023. In those eight games, Ayres helped lead Byrd's ground attack to average 299.3 rushing yards and 29.0 points per game. He finished the 2023 season with 69 carries for 340 yards and four touchdowns. Four times this season, Ayres guided Byrd to over 400 yards of total offense, including a season-high 488 yards in the quarterfinal loss to Alexandria. Ayres had a career rushing night against the Trojans with 19 carries for 133 yards, including a season-long 85yard touchdown scamper. Against Haughton, Ayres threw his first passing touchdown of the season. He threw his second against Evangel, marking the first time in his career to have back-to-back games with a passing touchdown. His third passing touchdown of the season was a 12-yard game-winning pass to Alex Schoonover against Huntington. Those two connected again on a 42-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Ayres and Quinton Hilliard connected on a 41-yard touchdown pass against Benton, making him the first Jacket quarterback to toss touchdown passes in three straight games since Lake Lambert did it in 2022. Ayres and Hilliard hooked up for a 53-yard touchdown pass against ASH, which was the longest of the season. Ayres finished the season with seven touchdown passes, which were the most for a Byrd quarterback since Deuce Caston tossed seven in 2015. He finished the season with 340 rushing yards and four touchdowns. He averaged nearly five yards a carry. Ayres finished his career with a 13-8 record as the Jackets' starting quarterback. With Ayres behind center, Byrd averaged 381.8 yards of total offense and 32 points per game this season. The senior signal caller guided the 2024 team to single-season records for rushing (4,358) and total offense (4,963). Harrison was also named to the LHSAA's Composite All-Academic Team.

Desmond Delivered

Senior fullback Desmond Simmons was sidelined with an injury for the final four weeks of the regular season. However, he returned in a big way in the playoffs and helped the Jackets reach the quarterfinals. Against Woodlawn, Simmons rushed for a game-high 197 yards and scored on a 3-yard run. It was his best performance of the season, and was the second-highest single game output of his career. Against St. Paul's, he rushed for a game-high 150 yards and a touchdown. He followed those two stellar outings by rushing for 142 yards and a touchdown against ASH. Simmons eclipsed the 100-yard mark in six of the eight games he played in 2024. Despite missing five of Byrd's 13 games, Simmons still led the team in rushing with 1,033 yards. He's the first Byrd back to rush for over a thousand yards in a season since Lake Lambert went for 1,021 yards in 2022. The best performance of his career came in 2023 against Airline when he rushed for 205 yards. Simmons burst onto the scene in Byrd's 58-0 win over Southwood in 2022 by rushing for a game-high 106 yards and scoring four touchdowns, including a 64-yard scamper. Simmons finished the 2023 season with 680 rushing yards, two touchdowns and averaged 4.6 yards per carry. He was a Second-Team All-District selection. In his three-year varsity career, Simmons rushed for 1,978 yards on 347 carries and scored 17 touchdowns. His 1,978 rushing yards ranks ninth on the career rushing list.

Hilliard's Highlights

Wing back Quinton Hilliard provided a full array of highlight reel clips every time he touched the ball in 2023 and those reels continued to roll throughout 2024. Hilliard, who also plays basketball at Byrd, rushed for 740 yards on the season, which was fourth best on the team, and he averaged 8.8 yards per carry. He scored at least one touchdown in 11 of Byrd's 13 games this season, and led the team with 15 touchdowns for 90 points. Hilliard had six multi-touchdown performances in his career. He had the most receiving yards (233) on the team despite having only six receptions. Hilliard averaged 38.8 yards per catch this season. His two touchdown receptions were a 41 yarder against Benton and a season-long 53 yarder against Alexandria. Hilliard finished the season second on the team with 1,004 all-purpose yards. In his three-year varsity career, Hilliard rushed for 1,018 yards, had 233 receiving yards and scored 21 touchdowns for 126 points.

Maxie-mum Effort

One of the brightest stars in the Jackets' backfield in 2024 was sophomore wing back Christian Maxie. Since turning heads in the spring game against Neville, Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multi-option attack. Against the Captain Shreve Gators, he rushed for a team-high 121 yards and scored two touchdowns. Maxie scored his first touchdown as a Byrd Yellow Jacket on a 12-yard scamper versus Haughton. He had an incredible night against the Parkway Panthers, rushing for 291 yards on just eight carries and scored three touchdowns on runs of 76, 73 and 51 yards. His 291 rushing yards was the sixth-highest single-game output in program history, and the most rushing yards by a sophomore back since the great Justan Gibson ran for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004. The sensational sophomore finished the season second on the team in rushing with 991 yards and he scored eight touchdowns. Maxie averaged 11 yards per carry and 99.1 yards per game despite missing three games due to an injury.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time offensive linemen are recognized is when their number is called after committing a penalty. Byrd's under-sized offensive line was outstanding in 2024. The O-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 381.8 yards of total offense and 32.0 points per game. They helped Byrd to set season records for rushing with 4,358 yards and total offense with 4,963 yards. In 2024, senior tackle Mason Coenen was Byrd's lone First-Team All-District Selection. With Coenen's selection, Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 14 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 38 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have been named First-Team All-District. After the quarterfinal game against Alexandria, offensive line coach Craig Harris selected guard Jacob Martin as the "Linemen of the Week." It was the third consecutive week and fourth time overall for Martin to be chosen for the honor. "Martin graded out at 92 percent with six knockdowns," Harris said. "However, the rest of the line played well too. They did a good job of not allowing leakage, and did an excellent job of getting up to linebackers and safeties to spring us for extra yards at critical moments." On setting the single-season records for rushing and total offense the former Byrd player turned coach said, "Every one of those linemen that suit up daily for practice had a hand in the record breaking this year."

Nothing Runs Like A Deere

While starter Desmond Simmons was out, sophomore Collin Deere was the featured fullback in Byrd's ground attack. Fans found out that nothing runs like a Deere as he rushed for a game-high 206 yards on 36 carries and he scored a touchdown against Benton. In the four games Simmons missed, Deere ran for 476 yards, four touchdowns and averaged 5.3 yards per carry. Deere finished the season third on the team with 743 rushing yards, averaged 5.4 yards per carry and 74.3 yards per game. He also scored six touchdowns on the season. With Desmond Simmons departing, the Yellow Jackets will look to Deere to take over as the full-time starter in 2025.

Schoonover Shines

With his 12 receptions this season, senior receiver Alex Schoonover was the favorite target for quarterback Harrison Ayres in 2024. His 229 receiving yards were second on the team to Quinton Hilliard's 233. In Byrd's run-based attack, Schoonover averaged 19.1 yards per receptions and 17.6 per game. He scored four touchdowns, including the game-winning 12-yard reception against Huntington, which were most by a Yellow Jackets receiver since Jackson Dufrene, who's playing at Nicholls State, had 23 receptions for 547 yards and six touchdowns in 2022. Schoonover, who also plays basketball at Byrd, had his best receiving game against Natchitoches Central with three catches for 71 yards and one touchdown.

Roberson Rose Up

CAREER PASSING LEADERS

In Byrd's multi-option offense wide receivers don't see a lot of targets. Such is the case with senior wide receiver Kristian Roberson. However, in the last five games the seldom-used Roberson rose up and proved to be a difference maker. In those five games, Roberson caught three passes for 78 yards, including a 50-yarder against St. Paul's, and had two 10-yard runs. In the fourth quarter of the quarterfinal game against Alexandria, Roberson scored his first career touchdown on a 10-yard reverse-pitch run. His touchdown brought the Jackets to within two points (28-26) of the undefeated and second-seeded Trojans. It also gave Byrd a chance to tie the game with 8:18 remaining. Unfortunately for the Jackets, Quinton Hilliard was stopped short of the goal line on the ensuing two-point conversion attempt.

Byrd's Fearsome Foursome

The Fearsome Foursome was the dominating defensive line of the Los Angeles Rams of the 1960s and 1970s. Deacon Jones, Merlin Olsen, Rosey Grier, and Lamar Lundy made up the Fearsome Foursome. They had size, quickness, range and toughness which put fear in opposing offenses. The Yellow Jackets' defensive front four of Ian Gray, Rhyan Perry, Tayvious Washington and Darell Cottonham Jr., was Byrd's version of the Fearsome Foursome this season. Add tackle Kamerun Anderson to the mix, it turned into a Party of Five. The defensive line continuously harassed and pressured opposing quarterbacks, stopped the run, and did a great job of keeping offensive linemen from blocking Byrd's outstanding linebackers. Byrd's Fearsome Foursome combined to finish the 2024 season with 151 total tackles, 27.5 tackles-for-loss for 113 yards, 9.5 sacks for 49 yards, six pass break-ups, two forced fumbles, five fumble recoveries for 26 return yards and a touchdown. Anderson's stats added 15 more tackles and 1.5 tackles-for-loss to those totals. With his 14.5 tackles-for-loss this season, Cottonham Jr., climbed into 10th place on the single-season TFL list. He was a First-Team All-District selection

Dynamic Linebacker Duo

Seniors Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes gave Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense a dynamic linebacking duo this season. Greer and Sipes led the team with 136 and 113 total tackles, respectively. Against Huntington, the dynamic duo combined for 28 tackles, five tackles for loss and a sack. That performance came a week after combining for 32 tackles against Parkway - Greer 17 and Sipes 15, both career highs. Sipes was the Jackets' leading tackler with 11 tackles, including four tackles-for-loss for negative 18 yards, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel. The two linebackers have combined to tally double-digit tackles 14 times (Greer 9, Sipes 5) this season. A Second-Team All-District selection in 2023. Greer has had an outstanding three-year career tallving 239 total tackles, which ranks second on the career tackles list behind Paul Dupée (265). Greer's 136 total tackles this season set the single-season record, while Sipes' 113 total tackles ranks fifth on the list. In his career, Greer registered 26 tackles-for-loss for 111 yards, which ranks sixth on the career tackles-for-loss list. Greer and Parkway linebacker Mark Copenhaver were chosen as Co-Defensive MVPs by the coaches in District 1-5A. Sipes was a Second-Team All-District selection. With his 4.0+ grade point average during all four years of high school, Greer was named to the LHSAA's Composite All-Academic Team. He is also one of 21 area football players on the National Football Foundation McNaughton Chapter Preseason Scholar-Athlete Watch List.

Logan's Run

Byrd cornerback and kick returner James Logan continues had a great run in his senior season. He has 47 total tackles, including 31 solo stops, three tackles-for-loss, four interceptions, two pass breakups, six passes defended and three blocked kicks. Logan blocked his third kick of the season against Airline. He had 21 kick returns for 409 yards and averaged 19.5 yards per return. He had a long return of 56 yards against Natchitoches Central. Logan also had the longest punt return of the season, 28 yards, against Evangel. Logan picked off two passes against St. Paul's, giving him five career interceptions for 133 return yards and moved him into a tie for fifth place on the career interceptions list.

Ja'Cari Jumped Into the Fray

Junior defensive back Ja'Cari Williams really jumped into the fray in 2023, and with the seasonending injury to Kaiden Abraham-Miller against Huntington, Williams' presence in the secondary significantly increased. He responded incredibly well, ranking third on the team with 72 total tackles, including three tackles-for-loss, one interception and three forced fumbles, two of those coming against St. Paul's. Against Haughton, he had a strip-sack of Bucs' quarterback Taylor Weathersby that led to lan Gray's 10-yard scoop and score. Williams was a First-Team All-District selection and will be looked upon to lead the Purple Swarm Defense in 2025.

Barfield's Breakout Season

Junior defensive back Azariae Barfield had a breakout season in 2024, and will be one of the few returning starters in 2025. His big breakout moment came in the third quarter of the Huntington game. With the Raiders threatening, Barfield came up with two pass break ups, including one in the end zone, on passes intended for Raiders' wide receiver Tyler Welch. The junior finished the season with 43 total tackles, including 30 solo stops, and two interceptions. He led the team with seven passes defended and five break-ups.

Senior Kian Fox, who also plays lacrosse at Byrd, played the hybrid "buck" linebacker position for Byrd's Purple Swarm Defense this season. Fox played one the best games of his varsity career against the Woodlawn Panthers. He had four tackles, including three solo stops, a strip sack and fumble recovery against the Panthers. Fox finished the season with 20 total tackles, two tackles-for-loss, a sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Kian is the younger brother of former Jacket two-sport standout Walker Fox, who is currently playing baseball at East Texas Baptist University. An Academic All-State selection, Kian plans to attend Centenary College and play lacrosse for the Gentlemen.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy, Makes a Name for Himself

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of Miami. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 44 and 52 yarders, in the quarterfinal game against Alexandria. It was the fourth time this season Murray has kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). And, for the first time in program history a Jackets place kicker has kicked three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was also the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal gave or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray's two field goals against ASH gave him 12 made field goals this season which set the single-season record for made field goals. With his 12 made field goals, the junior kicker has moved into fourth place on the career kicking list. He finished the season making 12-of-14 field goals, 44-of-47 on PAT kicks, and 48 of his 57 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Opponents starting field position was the 22 yard line. The coaches in District 1-5A selected Asher as the First-Team All-District place kicker. Asher has continued the Murray Family kicking legacy at Byrd, while making a name for himself.

Byrd Well Represented on All-District Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets were well represented on the All-District teams which were chosen by the eight District 1-5A head coaches. Sophomore running back Christian Maxie and senior tackle Mason Coenen were First-Team selections on offense, while senior defensive lineman Darell Cottonham, Jr., senior linebacker Sam Greer and junior safety Ja'Cari Williams were First-Team selections on defense. Junior place kicker Asher Murray was chosen as the First-Team All-District kicker. Linebacker Sam Greer, who set the single-season tackles record this season, along with Parkway linebacker Mark Copenhaver were chosen as Co-Defensive Most Valuable Players. Second-Team selections from Byrd were senior offensive lineman Joshua Hutson, junior defensive lineman lan Gray, senior linebacker Ethan Sipes and senior corner back James Logan. Honorable mentions were senior quarterback Harrison Ayres, running back Quinton Hilliard and offensive lineman Ayden Boutte. In the coming weeks, the *Shreveport Times* will release the All-City Team, the *Shreveport-Bossier Journal* will release the All -Metro Team and the *Shreveport-Bossier Advocate* will release the All-Prep Team. After the LHSAA's Prep Classic, the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association and the Louisiana Football Coaches Association will release their respective All-State Teams. The notes will be updated upon the release of the teams.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." In 2025, Byrd will celebrate its centennial. This was the 100th season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Associations boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are seven other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017). Shimorye Hampton (2017) and Seth Guerra (2022).
