### It's Jamboree Time

On Thursday, Aug. 28, it'll be Jamboree time as the 2025 high school football season will kick off across the state of Louisiana. The Byrd Yellow Jackets and Captain Shreve Gators will give fans a snippet of Shreveport's best rivalry when the two teams meet in the Jamboree at Lee Hedges Stadium. The freshmen teams will begin play at 5 p.m. then the junior varsity squads will follow with the varsity teams capping off the evening.

#### A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets, who were the No. 10 seed in the LHSAA's Select Division I Playoffs, finished the 2024 season with a 9-4 overall record. The Jackets won two playoff games before losing 43-32 to the No. 2 seed Alexandria Senior High Trojans in the quarterfinals. Byrd finished with 5-3 record in District 1-5A. Byrd lost 28 seniors from the 2024 team, including 10 starters on offense and seven on defense as well as punter Jackson Cooper. The Captain Shreve Gators finished the 2024 season with a 6-5 record. The Gators lost 58-48 to district rival Evangel in the first round of the Select Division I Playoffs.

### The Last Time Out

Behind a five touchdown performance from running back J.T. Lindsey, the No. 2 seeded Alexandria Senior High Trojans defeated the No. 10 seed Byrd Yellow Jackets 43-32 at J.L. "Butch" Stoker Stadium. Lindsey, an LSU signee, rushed for 169 yards and four touchdowns and added a 42-yard touchdown reception on a screen pass to keep ASH undefeated and lead the Trojans into the semifinals. Kristian Roberson's 10-yard touchdown run on a reverse pitch brought the Jackets to within two points, 28-26, in the fourth quarter. Quinton Hilliard's two-point conversion rush was stopped short of the goal line. ASH would score two more times to Byrd's one to make the final 43-32. Byrd amassed 412 rushing yards in the game, and had two backs, fullback Desmond Simmons (142) and quarterback Harrison Ayres (133), each rush for over 100 yards and score a touchdown. Jackets place kicker Asher Murray kicked two field goals in the game, including a 52 yarder, his third field goal of 50-plus yards this season.

### The 2025 Season

2025 is the 101st season of Byrd Football. In 2024, the Centennial Season, the Yellow Jackets posted a 9-4 record. It was the second time in four seasons under head coach Stacy Ballew that the Yellow Jackets won nine games. Byrd reached the state playoffs for the 15th consecutive year, which is the longest period in program history. For the fourth time in 12 seasons and for the first time since 2020, the Yellow Jackets won two playoff games.

### The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. He owns a 30-17 (.638) record in his four seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Craig Harris, offensive line; Rahkeem Mitchell, running backs; Carlos Doss, wide receivers; Shimorye Hampton, defensive line; Jalen Bowers, linebackers; Benji Piazza, corner backs, and Ballew coaches the safeties. The freshmen coaches are Lee Wooldridge, Ronnie Buckingham and Tucker Gardner. Cordarious Wayne is the certified athletic trainer. Captain Shreve is coached by Jeremy Wilburn, who begins his second season as the Gators' head coach. Shreve posted a 6-5 record in Wilburn's first season. Most recently he was the offensive coordinator at Huntington. Wilburn, who is a Byrd alum, quarterbacked the Yellow Jackets from 2001-03. In his three-year varsity career, Wilburn rushed for 410 yards and 8 TDs and passed for 733 yards and eight touchdowns.

Stacy Ballew is in his fifth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football his-



The 45-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

### **Yellow Jackets Football History**

2025 marks the 121st season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 101st season as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September of 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 68-28-12 record... Shreveport-Byrd owns a 696-441-35 (.609) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 30-17 (.652) record in his four seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 15 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 72 games, and holds a 36-34 -2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runnersup six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles.

### 2024 Notes

Byrd rushed for a season-high 412 yards against Alexandria, surpassing the previous high of 298 against Evangel...Byrd finished the season with 4,358 rushing yards, which ranks first on the single season team rushing yards list...Nine times this season the Jackets eclipsed the 300-yard plateau as a team...Byrd's 4,963 yards of total offense also set the single-season mark breaking the previous record of 4,558 set by the 2013 team...After missing the final four games of the regular season, senior fullback Desmond Simmons returned to action against Woodlawn and led the Jackets with 197 rushing yards, which was the second-highest total of his career, and he scored a touchdown ...Simmons rushed for 150 yards and a touchdown against St. Paul's, which was the seventh 100plus yard game of his career...Simmons rushed for 142 yards and a touchdown against ASH... Simmons finished the season with 1,033 rushing yards to become the first Byrd back to eclipse the 1.000-yard plateau in a season since Lake Lambert rushed for 1.021 yards in 2022...Simmons finished his career with 1,978 rushing yards, which ranks ninth on the career rushing list...Sophomore fullback Collin Deere rushed for 206 yards on 36 carries and scored a touchdown against Benton...It was the second time this season a Byrd back rushed for over 200 yards in a game, coincidentally done by two sophomores (Maxie & Deere)...Receiver Alex Schoonover led the team with 12 receptions for 229 yards and four touchdowns, including a 12-yard game-winner against Huntington...Wing back Quinton Hilliard's 53-yard touchdown reception against ASH was the longest of the season...Hillard scored at least one touchdown in 11 of Byrd's 13 games and led the team with 15 touchdowns and 90 points...Four times in his three-year varsity career. Hilliard registered back-to-back games scoring two touchdowns...Kristian Roberson's 10-yard touchdown run against ASH was the first of his career....Quarterback Harrison Ayres threw six touchdown passes this season, which was the most since Lake Lambert tossed six in 2022...Byrd had two backs, Desmond Simmons (142) and Harrison Ayres (133), each rush for over 100 yards against ASH marking the fourth time this season that Byrd had accomplished that feat...Ayres had an 85-yard touchdown run against ASH, which was the longest of the season...On the season, Byrd had five touchdown runs of 70 or more yards (Ayres 85, Simmons 77, Hilliard 75, and wing back Christian Maxie 76 and 73)...Maxie's 291-vard rushing output against Parkway was the sixth-best single-game performance in program history...Maxie's 291 rushing yards were the most by a sophomore back since Justan Gibson, Byrd's career rushing leader, rushed for 255 yards against Captain Shreve in 2004...Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns against Shreve, which was the fourth time the sophomore had rushed for over 100 yards in a game this season...Maxie finished the season second on the team behind Simmons with 991 rushing yards...Byrd's 412 rushing yards against ASH is tied for the 16th best single-game rushing performance in program history...Junior kicker Asher Murray booted a 56-yard field goal against Benton, which tied a school, city and parishes record held by Byrd's John Shaughnessy, who hit his 56-yarder in the 2008 playoffs against Airline...Murray kicked two field goals (52, 44) against ASH, which was the fourth time this season he made two field goals in a game...Murray finished the season by making 12-of-14 field goals and setting the single-season record, previously held by Ben Eldredge, who made 10 field goals in 2009...Murray's 12 made field goals puts him in fourth place on the career made field goals list... Murray booted three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) this season, which was a first in program history both in a season and in a career...Linebacker Sam Greer registered 15 double-digit tackle games in his three-year varsity career...Greer had a career-high 17 tackles, including nine solo stops, against Parkway...Greer registered a season-high four tackles-for-loss, including two sacks against John Ehret...Greer's 136 total tackles this season set the single-season tackles record...Greer's 239 career tackles ranks second on the career tackles list behind Paul Dupée's 265...Greer had 26 tackles-forloss in his career which ranks him sixth on the career tackles-for-loss list...Greer along with Parkway's Mark Copenhaver were selected by the District 1-5A coaches as the Defensive Co-MVPs...continued on next page

Linebacker Ethan Sipes had 113 total tackles on the season which ranks fifth on the single-season tackles list...Sipes had a career-high 15 tackles against Parkway, which was also the first of four consecutive double-digit tackle games and five overall...Sipes had a career-high four tackles-for-loss, a sack and a forced fumble against Evangel...Greer & Sipes have set season high marks with 11 solo tackles (Greer vs. Airline) and 10 assists (Sipes vs. Huntington)...Sipes was a Second-Team All-District selection.

### 2025 Season Preview

### Tradition, Tenacity, and a New Season of Promise

As the relentless sun pours over Shreveport in late summer, stadium seats begin to fill once more with a sense of renewal and expectation. The 2025 C.E. Byrd High School Yellow Jackets return to the gridiron, carrying with them the weight of a storied legacy and the unyielding drive to carve their mark in Louisiana high school football. With a blend of returning talent, new faces, and a coaching staff steeped in experience, the Yellow Jackets are poised for a campaign brimming with intrigue, ambition, and the unmistakable hum of Friday night lights.

### Recap of 2024: A Foundation for the Future

Last season, Byrd's journey was one of adversity and grit. A string of hard-fought wins led to the Yellow Jackets' deep playoff run, where their signature multi-option attack challenged even the most disciplined defenses. While the playoff run fell short of state glory, the team's determination never wavered, setting the stage for a 2025 squad that enters with both unfinished business and invaluable lessons in hand.

The '25 Jackets will quickly have to figure out how to replace nine offensive starters, including four linemen, and a 1,000-yard rusher in fullback Desmond Simmons. Defensively, Byrd does return five starters, including standout defensive lineman lan Gray and versatile safety Ja'Cari Williams. The linebacking corps will be the biggest question marks due to the loss of three seniors, including Sam Greer, who set the single-season tackles record. Greer was a National Football Foundation and College Hall of Fame scholar athlete as well as a Composite Academic All-State selection after finishing his four years at Byrd with a 4.69 grade point average.

### **Coaching Staff: Leadership Forged in Tradition**

Head coach Stacy Ballew returns for his fifth season, bringing with him strength, toughness and a commitment to the core values that have long defined Byrd football: discipline, physicality, and adaptability. Surrounded by an experienced cohesive group of assistant coaches, five of whom are Byrd alums, their message is clear: success is built not overnight, but by hard work and dedication.

### Offense: The Engine of Persistence

The Yellow Jackets' offensive identity remains rooted in the triple-option, a system that demands intelligence, patience, and unity from its participants. The biggest task falls squarely upon the shoulders of offensive line coach Craig Harris, who has to replace four starters (five if you include the tight end), including All-District and All-City performer Mason Coenen. The lone returning starter is senior guard Jacob Martin (6'3", 295). Senior Mason Kinley (5'9", 191), who saw some action at center last season, moves out to left tackle alongside Martin. Junior Mohanad Wadi (5'6", 259) is projected to take over at center, while a pair of juniors Lewis Jones (5'10", 226) and Trenton Morris (6'0", 283) are expected to line up at right guard and right tackle, respectively. Former wide receiver senior Duncan Rowe (6'1", 183) moves inside to take over the tight end spot.

Wide receiver Alex Schoonover is gone leaving junior Logan Carlson (5'10", 154) and senior Henry Peacock (5'7", 150), a converted defensive back, to compete for the starting job. Schoonover had 12 receptions for 221 yards and four touchdowns, including a game winner against Huntington in 2024. As usual, the focus will be on the Byrd backfield, where a quartet of juniors are expected to lead the Jackets' ground attack. Quarterback Jackson Davis (6'1", 166) takes over for two-year starter Harrison Ayres. Davis, who also plays baseball, possesses a strong arm and gives offensive coordinator Wade Leone the ability to throw the ball when opposing defenses are stacking the tackle box to try and stop the run. However, the biggest expectation for Davis will be to take care of the football and

distribute it to the trio of talented backs behind him.

Fullback Collin Deere, who started the '24 season opener against St. Amant as well as four other games, will try to replace the 1,033-yard season registered by Desmond Simmons. Deere (6'1", 201), who rushed for 743 yards and six touchdowns in 2024, has the physical makeup and running style of a traditional service academy fullback.

Most of the focus will be on returning wingback Christian Maxie, whose blend of quickness, speed and elusiveness made him one of the district's most reliable ground-gainers in 2024. Maxie (5'10", 181) finished the '24 season with 991 rushing yards and eight touchdowns and was a First-Team All-District selection. Peter Santiago (5'10", 183) saw action in five games last season rushing for 128 yards, two touchdowns and averaged 9.1 yards per carry.

There's no doubting the talent and ability of the Byrd's quartet of junior backs but having to replace the productivity (37 total TDs) of Ayres, Simmons and wingback Quinton Hilliard (13 rushing and two receiving TDs) is a very tall order.

### **Defense: Stoutness Meets Speed**

Defensively, Ballew will be trying to replace the production of defensive end Darrel Cottonham, Jr., as well as linebackers Sam Greer and Ethan Sipes. However, returning senior starter Ian Gray (6'1", 248) as well as seasoned veterans senior Tayvious Washington (6'1", 290) and junior Kamerun Anderson (5'10", 215) gives the Purple Swarm Defense a solid core up front. Senior Javion Johnson (5'10", 237) and junior Clay Atkinson (5'7", 197) are penciled in as the defensive ends. They will have to try and replace the production (54 combined tackles and 20 tackles-for-loss) from All-District, All-Metro, All-Prep end Cottonham, Jr., (Centenary College) and Rhyan Perry.

The biggest area of concern for Ballew, who's also the defensive coordinator, and linebackers coach Jalen Bowers is how do you replace the likes of Sam Greer (All-District, All-City MVP, All-Metro, All-Prep MVP), who set the single-season tackles record with 136, Ethan Sipes and Kian Fox. That task will fall upon Madden Cromer (6'0", 183) at middle linebacker, junior Conrad Hilliard (6'2", 196) at weak side linebacker and junior Charlie Sepulvado (5'8", 164) at the hybrid "buck" linebacker spot. The secondary has the most experience (45 combined games played) of any position group on the defense. Senior safety Ja'Cari Williams (5'10", 193, All-District, All-City) is a playmaker who can play near the line of scrimmage or on the back end. Senior Abram Anderson (5'10", 179) is expected to man the other safety spot opposite of Williams. Seniors Azariae Barfield (6'2", 182) and Cameron Williams (5'9", 134) gives the Purple Swarm Defense experienced veterans at the corner spots.

### **Special Teams: The Hidden Advantage**

REER PASSING LEADERS

Lake Lambert (2020-22)

No preview of the Yellow Jackets would be complete without mentioning the crucial, often overlooked special teams' unit, and that begins with place kicking. Byrd has a long and storied history of great kickers – David Hankins (Ole Miss), John Shaughnessy (Northwestern State), Scotty Roblow (Northwestern State), Abram Murray (California) to name just a few.

Senior Asher Murray (5'11", 176), the younger brother of Abram, is poised to be the greatest kicker in the 121-year history of Yellow Jackets' football. A First-Team All-State selection last year, Murray was the first kicker in program history to kick three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. According to Lee Hiller of the Shreveport-Bossier Advocate, Murray was the first to accomplish that feat in northwest Louisiana football history. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by Shaughnessy. Murray set the single-season record for made field goals with 12, and entering this season, sits in fourth place on the career made field goals list, six behind Shaughnessy. He recently committed to Texas A&M.

Coach Ballew was unsure if Murray will also be the Jackets' punter or will a younger player assume the duties left vacant by Jackson Cooper, who averaged 36.1 yards per punt in '24. Hilliard is expected to take over the long snapping duties, while Peacock returns as the holder on place kicks. Gone is James Logan who handled the bulk of the return duties last year (19.5 AKR, 9.3 APR). In his sophomore and junior seasons, Ja'Cari Williams returned some kicks but it's not clear at this time who will handle kick and punt returns in '25.

Asher Murray (PK, Sr.): Murray has been dubbed "one of the best kickers in the country" by Louisiana Football Magazine editor Lee Brecheen. The Texas A&M commit is poised to rewrite all of the place kicking records in the 121-year history of Yellow Jackets football (101st of C.E. Byrd). Murray is also one of the best all-around athletes on the team having seen plenty of action at quarterback as a sophomore.

lan Gray (DL, Sr.): The defensive line will be heart of the defense and Gray is the unbridled leader of that line

Ja'Cari Williams (FS, Sr.): A very versatile player, Williams is the anchor in the secondary, always around the ball at critical moments.

### **Season Outlook: The Road Ahead**

The 2025 season finds the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets at a crossroads of tradition and opportunity. With a roster lacking in experience but hungry for achievement, and a coaching staff as invested as ever, expectations always remain high on Line Avenue. The offense will rely on methodical drives and ball control, while the defense aims to create chaos and capitalize on turnovers.

### Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy, Makes a Name for Himself

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of California, Berkeley. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 44 and 52 yarders, in the quarterfinal game against Alexandria. It was the fourth time Murray had kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). And, for the first time in program history a Jackets place kicker has kicked three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. Against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was also the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal gave or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray's two field goals against ASH gave him 12 made field goals this season which set the single-season record for made field goals. With his 12 made field goals, the junior kicker has moved into fourth place on the career kicking list. He finished the season making 12-of-14 field goals, 44-of-47 on PAT kicks, and 48 of his 57 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Opponents starting field position was the 22 yard line. The coaches in District 1-5A selected Asher as the First-Team All-District place kicker. Asher has continued the Murray Family kicking legacy at Byrd, while making a name for himself.

### **Byrd Well Represented on 2024 All-District Teams**

The Byrd Yellow Jackets were well represented on the All-District teams which were chosen by the eight District 1-5A head coaches. Sophomore running back Christian Maxie and senior tackle Mason Coenen were First-Team selections on offense, while senior defensive lineman Darell Cottonham, Jr., senior linebacker Sam Greer and junior safety Ja'Cari Williams were First-Team selections on defense. Junior place kicker Asher Murray was chosen as the First-Team All-District kicker. Linebacker Sam Greer, who set the single-season tackles record this season, along with Parkway linebacker Mark Copenhaver were chosen as Co-Defensive Most Valuable Players. Second-Team selections from Byrd were senior offensive lineman Joshua Hutson, junior defensive lineman lan Gray, senior linebacker Ethan Sipes and senior corner back James Logan. Honorable mentions were senior quarterback Harrison Ayres, running back Quinton Hilliard and offensive lineman Ayden Boutte. In the coming weeks, the Shreveport Times will release the All-City Team, the Shreveport-Bossier Journal will release the All--Metro Team and the Shreveport-Bossier Advocate will release the All-Prep Team. After the LHSAA's Prep Classic, the Louisiana Sports Writer's Association and the Louisiana Football Coaches Association will release their respective All-State Teams. 
