Homecoming 2025

On Friday, Sept. 26, the City of Byrd will celebrate Homecoming 2025 when the Yellow Jackets host the John Ehret Patriots. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. Lee Hedges Stadium.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 0-3 overall record and a 0-2 record in District 1-5A after suffering a 43-36 loss to the Evangel Eagles last Friday at Lee Hedges Stadium. The John Ehret Patriots own a 1-2 record after edging the L.B. Landry Charging Buccaneers 14-13 last Friday at Hoss Memtsas Stadium. Ehret is a member of the seven-team District 10-5A, which doesn't begin district play until week six of the season.

The Last Time Out

Evangel quarterback Peyton "Pop" Houston, who committed to LSU on Sept. 22, showed why he's one of the top rated quarterbacks in the Class of 2027. Houston accounted for 559 yards (225 rushing, 334 passing) and five touchdowns to lead the Eagles to 43-36 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets last Friday at Lee Hedges Stadium. After falling behind 22-7 after the first quarter, Byrd rallied to get within three points, 36-33, with 7:17 remaining in the game. Jackets' wing back Christian Maxie had 17 carries for 230 yards and three touchdowns in the losing effort. The John Ehret Patriots got their first win of the season by edging the Lord Beaconsfield Landry Charging Buccaneers, 14-13, last Friday at Hoss Memtsas Stadium.

The Series

This will be the fourth meeting between Byrd and John Ehret in a series that began in 2006 with a 34 -28 Yellow Jackets' victory in the first round of the 2006 playoffs. The Patriots would get their revenge and evened the series the following year with a 27-3 win over the Jackets in the regional round of the 2007 playoffs. The 2006 game was played at Hoss Memtsas Stadium in Harvey, while the 2007 game was played at Joe Yenni Stadium in Metairie. Last year, Byrd utilized a stout running game to amass 382 yards, including 107 from fullback Desmond Simmons, to defeat the John Ehret Patriots 35-14 at Hoss Memtsas Stadium in Harvey, La.

Last Year Versus Ehret

For the second time in the four weeks of the 2024 season, the Byrd Yellow Jackets went on a long road trip and came away with a victory. Byrd traveled down to West Jefferson's Hoss Memtsas Stadium in Harvey, La., and used a stout running game to amass 382 yards, including 107 from fullback Desmond Simmons, to defeat the John Ehret Patriots 35-14. The Jackets had five different backs rush for over 50 yards in the game, and four different backs score touchdowns. Ehret running back Darrius Smith kept the Patriots in the game as he rushed for 117 yards on 25 carries and scored two touchdowns.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1, and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 30-20 (.600) record in his five seasons as Byrd's head coach. Willie Brooks, Jr., is in his first season as the head coach of the John Ehret Patriots. However, Brooks is a very familiar name in Jefferson Parish coaching ranks having spent 12 seasons at Helen Cox (2004-15) where he was the Cougars original head coach. Helen Cox High School permanently closed in early 2024 as part of a 2023-24 consolidation plan set forth by the Jefferson Parish School Board. Brooks spent three seasons at Riverdale (2017-19), where he went 12-18 with the Rebels, and three seasons at West Jefferson (2020-22), where he compiled a 12-15 record with the Buccaneers. He is in his 19th season as a head coach.

2021 District 1-5A Champions Four consecutive playoff appearances Won two playoff games in 2024 Two 9-win seasons in four years Stacy Ballew is in his fifth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 47-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2025 marks the 121st season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 101st season as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September 17, 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 70-28-12 record...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 698-444-35 (.608) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 30-20 (.600) record in his five seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history... Byrd has made the playoffs for 15 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 72 games, and holds a 36-34-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles...Ballew is 2-2 in Homecoming games.

Byrd rushed for 424 yards in its 43-36 loss to Evangel...The 424 rushing yards was the 13th best team single-game rushing performance in program history...It was the first time Byrd had rushed for over 400 yards in a game since rushing for 466 yards versus Benton in 2023...Wing back Christian Maxie rushed for 230 yards and three touchdowns against Evangel...Maxie's three touchdowns equaled his career high, which he's previously done twice... Maxie has 1,335 rushing yards and 12 touchdowns in his two seasons at Byrd...Maxie has scored 12 touchdowns and is averaging 11.2 yards per carry in 13 career games...Quarterback Jackson Davis tossed a 6-yard touchdown pass to Collin Deere against the Eagles...It was the Jackets first completed pass of the season, the first touchdown pass of the season and the first of Davis' varsity career...Davis finished 3-for-7 passing for 44 yards - all career highs...Davis had a 1-yard touchdown run against Evangel, also the first of his career...Wide receiver Logan Carlson had a 32-vard reception which was the longest reception of his career and longest pass of Davis' career...Following the 36-35 overtime loss to Haughton, Byrd is now 2-4 in overtime games...It was the Jackets' first overtime game under coach Stacy Ballew and the team's first since a 22-21 loss to Captain Shreve in 2019...Byrd's first-ever overtime game was a 34-28 loss to Airline in 1991...The Jackets and Vikings have had two overtime games, including a threeovertime thriller, a 36-34 Byrd win in 2016... Fullback Collin Deere rushed for a career-high 253 yards and four touchdowns against Haughton...Deere's 253 rushing yards was the ninth-best rushing performance in program history...Deere's four rushing touchdowns were the most since Malachi Johnson registered five rushing TDs against Huntington in 2023, and the most for a fullback since Desmond Simmons had four against Southwood in 2022...Deere's 35 rushing attempts was one carry shy of tying his personal high and the school record of 36, which he shares with Duan Maiden, who had 36 against Fair Park in 1992...Deere had 36 carries for 206 yards, his previous high, against Benton last year...Christian Maxie had a 73-yard touchdown run against the Bucs...It was the third-career touchdown run of 70+ yards in his career...Byrd rushed for 360 yards against Haughton...Nine times last season the Jackets rushed for over 300 yards in a game...Junior quarterback Jonathan Harris made his first career start against Haughton...Haughton receiver Ethan Johnson had 13 receptions for 289 yards and three touchdowns...Johnson's 289 receiving yards was the most ever allowed by Byrd breaking the previous high of 267 set by Benton's Pearce Russell in 2022...Haughton blocked a Byrd extra-point attempt marking the second straight week a Jacket PAT attempt was blocked...Bucs linebacker Jameson Voigt blocked an Asher Murray punt which was the first time Byrd has had a punt blocked since Airline's Laterious Pouncy blocked one in 2011...Byrd's 49-6 loss to the St. Amant Gators was the highest amount of points ever given up by the Jackets and the largest point differential (43) in a season opener in program history...St. Amant's 49 points were the most given up by Byrd in a season opener since 1965 when the Jackets were beaten 40-0 by the Sulphur Golden Tornados...It was also the most points allowed since 2022 when the Jackets gave up 63 to the Benton Tigers...In nine of the 20 losses Byrd has suffered in Ballew's five seasons, the Jackets have given up 40 or more points...Christian Maxie's 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown was Byrd's only TD against St. Amant...Maxie's 95 yarder tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return for a touchdown in program history...It was also the first time since suffering a 23-2 loss to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the 2023 playoffs that Byrd failed to score an offensive touchdown...St. Amant's defense allowed just 100 yards of total offense to Byrd, all on the ground...The 100 total offensive yards was Byrd's lowest output since being held to 61 yards by the Parkway Panthers on Oct. 12, 2023...Byrd did not complete a pass in its five attempts against the Gators...Byrd was 0-for-2 passing against Haughton...Twice last season Byrd did not complete a pass in a game (Parkway loss, Woodlawn BR - win)....Byrd is 0-3 for the first time since 2023 when the Jackets started 0-5... The 2023 team would finish 4-7...Byrd's defense is giving up over 500 yards of total offense per game...Evangel's 639 yards of total offense were the most allowed by Byrd since Benton amassed 678 in 2022.

BYRD BLASTS

The 2025 Schedule, Polls and Power Rankings

Six of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2025 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2024. Evangel, Huntington, Airline and Parkway all won at least one playoff game last season. The defending Select Div. I Champion Edna Karr Cougars were the No. 1 ranked team in this week's Louisiana Sports Writer's Association poll. This season, Crescent City Sports is releasing its polls according to playoff divisions. CCS has the Karr Cougars as the top ranked team in Select Division I, while the Ruston Bearcats are the No. 1 team in Non-Select Division I. The Evangel Eagles (7) and the Airline Vikings (1) each garnered votes in this week's LSWA poll. The Shreveport-Bossier Journal has the Airline Vikings as the No. 1 team in its weekly Top 10. The SBJ poll is only for teams located in Caddo and Bossier parishes.

Injury Bug Bites Byrd

The injury bug bit Byrd hard leading up to the season opener against St. Amant, particularly along the offensive line. Senior guard Jacob Martin, the only returning starter, was injured in the Ruston scrimmage as was junior tackle Trenton Morris. Morris did return to against St. Amant, and Martin saw his first action against Evangel. Mason Kinley, who was the only other experienced offensive lineman, suffered an injury in the Jamboree against Captain Shreve but did return against Haughton. Starting guard Jordan Wilson has been lost for a while with an injury to his foot. Junior starting quarterback Jackson Davis injured his shoulder after being tackled in the end zone against St. Amant. Davis did not play against Haughton but returned to the lineup against Evangel. The Purple Swarm Defense faced the Buccaneers without the services of two of its key defenders, lineman lan Gray and corner back Azariae Barfield. Gray did return against Evangel, but Barfield andCamron Williams, the other starting cornerback, are out indefinitely with hip injuries.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive linemen is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Despite lacking experience and size, Byrd's 2024 offensive line was outstanding. The 0-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 381.8 yards of total offense and 32 points per game. The 2024 Jackets offense set the single season rushing record with 4,358 yards. Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 14 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 38 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. For the second straight season, offensive line coach Craig Harris will select a "Lineman of the Week" by based on his grading system. In his first game back since being injured in the scrimmage at Ruston, senior guard Jacob Martin was chosen as the Lineman of the Week. "We aren't near our standard, but I'm proud of the whole group," said Harris. "They're working hard, coachable, and you could see the improvements."

Nothing Runs Like A Deere

Junior fullback Collin Deere had an outstanding sophomore season, rushing for 743 yards and six touchdowns while splitting time with Desmond Simmons, who rushed for 1,0333. That's nearly 1,800 rushing yards from the fullback spot which is crucial for Byrd's offensive success. Simmons was lost to graduation, making Deere the No. 1 fullback, and he is expected to pick up where he left off in 2024. He did just that against the Haughton Buccaneers by rushing for a career-high 253 yards on 35 carries and he scored four touchdowns, also a career-high. Deere's 35 carries were one tote shy of a single-game record of 36, one in which he shares (vs. Benton in 2024) with Duan Maiden, who did it against Fair Park in 1992. Deere also had an incredible two-point conversion reception making him accountable for 26 of Byrd's 35 points. His 26 points scored were the most by a Jacket since 2023 when Malachi Johnson had five rushing touchdowns and 30 points scored against the Huntington Raiders. In his two-year varsity career, Deere has 204 carries for 1,138 yards and has scored 10 touchdowns. He's averaged 5.6 yards per carry, showing that nothing runs like a Deere.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for over 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 28th season behind the microphone as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Yellow Jacket defensive back Dominique Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Former Jacket fullback Jason Little is frequent guest color commentator. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. By downloading the 1130 The Tiger app fans can listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world.

BYRD BANTER

Maxie-mum Effort

Junior wingback Christian Maxie emerged as a big play threat in Byrd's multi-option attack in 2024. He really turned heads by rushing for 991 yards, scoring eight touchdowns and averaging 11 yards per carry in 2024. This season, Maxie has added kick returns to his list of duties. Once again, he showed his big play ability against St. Amant as he returned a kickoff for 95 yards and a touchdown. It tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return in program history. It was the first kickoff return for a touchdown since Christian Jones had a 61-yard return for a touchdown against the Southwood Cowboys on Oct. 28, 2022. Against Haughton, Maxie rushed for 88 yards, including a dazzling 73-yard touchdown run. It was his third career touchdown run of 70-plus yards. He rushed for 230 yards and three touchdowns against Evangel. It was the 14th best rushing performance by a Jacket in program history. In the 13 games he's played, Maxie has rushed for 1,335 yards and 12 touchdowns. He's averaging 11.2 yards per carry in his varsity career.

Peter Santiago Shows Up

Junior wing back Peter Santiago had been very quiet in the first two games having just five carries for eight yards. He was targeted a couple times but did not have a reception. However, Santiago showed up in a big way for Byrd against Evangel. The junior wing back rushed for 84 yards on just eight carries, and added a reception for six yards. Santiago got his first varsity start against Benton last year and quickly established himself as force at wingback. He rushed for 83 yards on just seven carries and scored two touchdowns against the Tigers. His first varsity touchdown came on an eight-yard run in the first quarter. He would score his second touchdown on a 33-yard scamper in the fourth quarter to put Byrd ahead 30-21. Having Santiago as a viable threat in the backfield with fullback Collin Deere and wingback Christian Maxie makes Byrd's multiple option attack very difficult to defend.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy, Makes a Name for Himself

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of California Berkeley. Abram has made three 40-plus yard field goals in his first three games at Cal. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 44 and 52 yarders, in the 2024 quarterfinal game against Alexandria. It was the fourth time in 2024 that Murray had kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). It also marked the first time in program history that a Jackets' place kicker had kicked three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. According to Lee Hiller of the Shreveport-Bossier Advocate, it was the first time any kicker in northwest Louisiana had accomplished that feat. Earlier in the season against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal had given or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray's two field goals against ASH gave him 12 made field goals for the season, which set the single-season record for made field goals. With his 12 made field goals, Murray moved into fourth place on the career kicking list. He finished the 2024 season making 12-of-14 field goals, converting 44-of-47 on PAT kicks, and 48 of his 57 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Opponents starting field position was the 22 yard line. Murray's list of postseason accolades included: First-Team All-District, All-Metro, All-Prep and All-State selections. He was also named a MaxPreps All-American. In addition to his place kicking duties this season, he is also the Jackets' punter. He booted his first field goal of the season, a 23-yarder against Evangel. He now has 13 made field goals in his career tying him with Jake Wyss on the career kicking list. Asher recently committed to Texas A&M. He plans on graduating from Byrd in December, then joining the Aggies in time for spring football practice.

A Buzz Back In Time

Byrd fullback Justan Gibson rushed for 208 yards and four touchdowns to lead the Jackets to a 34-28 win over the John Ehret Patriots in the bi-district round of the 2006 playoffs. Faced with a fourth and one inside their own 35-yardline, John Ehret coach Billy North decided to go for the first down. North inserted Patriots' nose guard Drake Nevis, at running back. Nevis would later go on to star at LSU and was drafted by the Indianapolis Colts. He won the 107th Grey Cup with the Winnipeg Blue Bombers in 2019. Byrd's Purple Swarm defense led by Allen Frierson and Timmy Brown were able to stop Nevis short of the line to gain and preserve the Byrd win.

ACKET JARGON

Davis Takes the Wheel

Junior quarterback Jackson Davis has taken over as Byrd's starting quarterback. The junior, who also plays baseball at Byrd, saw action in six games last season mostly in mop-up duty. Davis has big shoes to fill. Last year's starter Harrison Ayres led the Jackets to nine wins while rushing for 581 yards and eight touchdowns. Ayres also passed for 577 yards and seven touchdowns. Davis was injured in the second half of the St. Amant game and did not return. Junior backup Jonathan Harris, who also plays baseball for the Jackets, replaced Davis. After missing the Haughton game, Davis returned to the starting lineup against Evangel, and had his best game to date. He was 3-of-7 passing for 44 yards. Davis' 6-yard touchdown pass to Collin Deere was the first of his Byrd career. He also added a 1-yard touchdown run later in the game, which was the first rushing touchdown of his career. Davis helped lead Byrd's offense to 464 yards of total offense, which was its highest output since last year's playoff game at Alexandria.

Asesino Silencio Numero Cinco

Senior safety Ja'Cari Williams really came on strong as a sophomore in 2023, and solidified his presence as a junior in 2024. He finished third on the team with 72 total tackles, including three tacklesfor-loss, one interception and three forced fumbles in 2024. Two of those forced fumbles came against St. Paul's in the playoffs. Williams was a First-Team All-District selection and has emerged as the leader of the Purple Swarm Defense in 2025. Through three games, Williams leads the team with 12 solo tackles. He's second on the team with 19 total tackles. He also has a tackle-for-loss and a pass break-up. Asesino Silencio Numero Cinco (silent assassin number five - Williams' number) is a quiet leader, but he is a deadly presence in Byrd's secondary having racked up 126 total tackles in his three-year varsity career.

Gray Matters

Senior defensive lineman Ian Gray missed the Haughton game with an undisclosed injury. Not having Gray's presence along the defensive front really mattered. The Jackets were unable to consistently get pressure on Bucs quarterback Taylor Weathersby or contain. Gray was back on the field against Evangel and had four total tackles, including three solo stops, a tackle-for-loss and a fumble recovery.

New Kids On The Block

Byrd lost its three starting linebackers from 2024, including District 1-5A Co-Defensive MVP Sam Greer, who set a school record for tackles in a season. Who are the new kids trying to fill the 269-combined tackles void left by Greer, Ethan Sipes and Kian Fox? Seniors Madden Cromer, Amaree Hayes and Abram Anderson along with juniors Charlie Sepulvado, Aaden Crowe, Brock Wiman, and at times, Conrad Hilliard, have all seen action in '25. Cromer is currently leading the team in tackles with 23. Sepulvado missed the opener with an injury but came back against Haughton and had a huge sack of Bucs quarterback Taylor Weathersby. Unfortunately, Sepulvado was in and out of the game due to cramping issues on a very hot and humid night between the pines at Prescott Field.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." 2025 marks the 101st season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Association boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are six other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017) and Shimorye Hampton (2017).

Former Jackets Now Head Coaches

In addition to former Yellow Jacket quarterback Jeremy Wilburn coaching at Captain Shreve there are a few more former Byrd players serving as head coaches in the high school ranks. Nicholas Peoples, who holds the career interceptions record (10) at Byrd, is the head coach at Green Oaks. Former Jacket running back Chadwick Lewis is the head coach at Little Rock Southwest High School in Arkansas. Christopher Wilson, who played at Byrd from 2009-11, is the head coach at North Webster.

A Look Ahaad

On Friday, Sept. 26, the Byrd Yellow Jackets return to District 1-5A play when they take on one of the top teams in the area, the Parkway Panthers. Kickoff is scheduled for 7 p.m. at to Lee Hedges Stadium.

Alumni Report

Former Byrd Yellow Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2025 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of California, Berkeley, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, defensive lineman Darell Cottonham, Jr., at Louisiana Christian University, linebacker Makarios "Junior" Brown at Southern Arkansas University, punter/kicker Jackson Cooper at Lamar University, defensive back James Logan at Capital University (Ohio), and linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College.

Who Was Lee Hedges?

Lee Hedges Stadium is named in honor of legendary football coach Lee Hedges, who passed away on July 9, 2023, at the age of 93. Who was Lee Hedges? Lee Hedges dedicated his life to teaching and mentoring young people in Shreveport. He is best known for guiding the 1973 Captain Shreve Gators to a perfect 14-0 record and the Class 4A State Championship. However, Shreve was not the only Shreveport school where he was successful. A three-sport star at Fair Park, Hedges would begin his legendary coaching career at arch-rival Byrd as the Jackets' head coach in 1956. He led Byrd to the state title game that first season, losing to the Istrouma Indians, 14-7. After four years on Line Avenue, Hedges moved to newly-opened Woodlawn in 1960. He had tremendous success with the Knights, leading them to the 1965 state championship game. Hedges' 217 career wins are the most for any coach in the history of Caddo-Bossier football.

Another Buzz Back In Time

After beating John Ehret, 34-28, in the 2006 playoffs, the Byrd Yellow Jackets would face the Patriots in the 2007 playoffs. And, one week after knocking rival Captain Shreve out of the playoffs, Byrd would have to travel to Metairie, La., to face John Ehret. The two teams had played at West Jefferson's Hoss Memtsas Stadium in 2006, but scheduling conflicts with other West Bank schools (L.W. Higgins, West Jefferson) in the playoffs forced the game to be moved to East Jefferson's Joseph Yenni Stadium. Ehret would get its revenge by beating Byrd 27-3 and eliminating the Jackets from the playoffs.

1905 SHS Football Team - The Original Yellow Jackets

Coach Wade Leone recently found a very old piece of paper while cleaning out the equipment room. On it was the roster and results of the 1905 Shreveport High School football team, the original Yellow Jackets. The roster included: Alan Reed, end; Walter Leabo, tackle; Leland Baird, guard; Stalky Robinson, center; Herman Strauss, guard; Willis Butler, tackle, Willie Dickinson, end; Ike Turner, halfback; Levi Hulsizer, fullback; Albert Dreyfuss, halfback; Hayes Meriwether, quarterback; Fred Dizell, alternate guard; Frazier Francisco, alternate; Leonard Dreyfuss and Bob Bates. After suffering a 15-0 loss to the Shreveport Athletic Assoc. in the first-ever football game played in Shreveport, the SHS Yellow Jackets won five straight games, including avenging the loss to the SAA, to finish the season 5-1.

Salute to Service

Throughout the 101 years of Byrd Football numerous former players have entered into military service. One of the most notable former Jackets currently serving our great nation is lieutenant Zack Ward. An All-District, All-City offensive lineman at Byrd, Ward continued his playing career at the U.S. Military Academy at West Point, N.Y. After graduating from West Point, Ward was commissioned as a second lieutenant in the U.S. Army. Ward, who is a first lieutenant, and is currently serving with the 10th Mountain Division stationed in Estonia. He recently returned to Shreveport to get married.

Did You Know?

Did you know that country music star Jordan Davis was the Yellow Jackets' quarterback from 2003-05? After graduating from LSU in 2012, he moved to Nashville and signed a recording contract with Universal Music Group Nashville in 2016. His debut single, "Singles You Up," hit number one on the Billboard Country Airplay chart in April 2018. Davis' song "Buy Dirt" featuring Luke Bryan won ACM Song of the Year in 2020. Earlier this year, he performed during Byrd's Centennial Celebration.

Where Are They Now?

Allen Frierson, the youngest of the three Frierson brothers to play at Byrd, was one of the key players to make a fourth-down stop on John Ehret's Drake Nevis in the Jackets' 2006 playoff win over the Patriots. After Byrd, Frierson earned degrees from Washington & Lee University and the Colorado School of Mines. He currently works for Devon Energy in Oklahoma City, Okla. Frierson married his Byrd sweetheart and former Yellow Jackets cheerleader, Emily Smith, and the couple have four children.
