The Backyard Brawl

On Thursday, Nov. 6, it's the rivalry that pits neighbor versus neighbor, turns friend into foe, and causes angst amongst family members. It's the annual "Backyard Brawl" between Byrd and Captain Shreve in the regular season finale. Kickoff for Shreveport's biggest and best rivalry is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Lee Hedges Stadium. Captain Shreve is the home team.

A Little About the Teams

The Byrd Yellow Jackets own a 2-7 overall record and a 1-6 record in District 1-5A after losing 48-17 to the Airline Vikings last Friday at M.D. Ray Field in Bossier City. The Captain Shreve Gators are 5-4 overall and 5-2 in District 1-5A. The Gators defeated the Haughton Buccaneers 65-44 last Thursday at Lee Hedges Stadium.

The Last Time Out

Airline star receiver Kenny Darby, who's committed to LSU, had a game-high five receptions for 118 vards, scored the game's first touchdown on a 3-vard run and added a 99-vard kickoff return for a touchdown to lead the Vikings to a 48-17 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets on Halloween night in Bossier City. Captain Shreve running back Jamarcea Plater scored three rushing touchdowns and quarterback Jackson Gaskin tossed four touchdown passes to lead the Gators to a 65-44 victory against Haughton at Lee Hedges Stadium on Thursday. The win snapped the Gators' four-game losing skid.

The Series

This will be the 48th meeting between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and the Captain Shreve Gators in a series that dates back to 1967. The Yellow Jackets lead the overall series 29-18. Byrd won that inaugural meeting 48-0, but Shreve would go on to win the next nine straight games. These two schools have met on the gridiron every year since 1989. In those 37 meetings, Byrd is 28-9 against Shreve. The Yellow Jackets have also won 26 of the last 30 games over the Gators. However, the Gators have won the last two meetings, including last year's 42-34 victory over the Yellow Jackets.

Last Year Versus Shreve

The Captain Shreve Gators used two 80-yard touchdown passes and a 68-yard touchdown run from Jamarcea Plater to defeat the Byrd Yellow Jackets 42-34 in the 47th annual "Backyard Brawl." Plater rushed for a game-high 141 yards and two touchdowns and he threw one of the 80-yard touchdown passes on a trick play. Byrd's Christian Maxie rushed for 121 yards and two touchdowns in the losing effort.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009. Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 32-24 (.571) record in his five seasons as Byrd's head coach. Captain Shreve is coached by Jeremy Wilburn, who is in his second season as the Gators' head coach. Wilburn is the eighth head coach in Shreve history, and his first head coaching job. He has led the Gators to a 11-9 (.550) record in his two seasons at Shreve. Wilburn moved to Captain Shreve after serving as the offensive coordinator at Huntington in 2023 and spending four years on the Raiders' staff. He was a graduate assistant at Northwestern State where he received his undergraduate degree. After a brief stint away from coaching, he was at Airline before moving over to Huntington, Wilburn, who is a Byrd alum, quarterbacked the Yellow Jackets from 2001-03. In his three-year varsity career, Wilburn rushed for 410 yards and eight touchdowns and he passed for 733 yards and eight touchdowns.

2021 District 1-5A Champions Four consecutive playoff appearances Won two playoff games in 2024 Two 9-win seasons in four years Stacy Ballew is in his fifth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers.

Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history, allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.



The 47-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

Yellow Jackets Football History

2025 marks the 121st season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 101st season as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September 17, 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 70-28-12 record...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 700-448-35 (.606) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 32-24 (.571) record in his five seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history... Byrd has made the playoffs for 15 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 72 games, and holds a 36-34-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles...Ballew is 2-2 versus Captain Shreve.

Byrd totaled 290 rushing yards versus Airline snapping its streak of seven straight games of 300-plus rushing yards...Nine times last season the Jackets rushed for over 300 yards in a game...Wing back Christian Maxie accounted for 220 of Byrd's 290 rushing yards against Airline...Maxie rushed for 341 yards and a school-record six touchdowns against the Benton Tigers...It was the fourth-best rushing performance in a game in program history...Maxie's 220 rushing yards marked the 10th time in his career that Maxie has rushed for over 100 yards in a game and the eighth time he's rushed for over 150 yards in 19 career varsity games...He scored two rushing touchdowns against the Vikings giving him eight multi-touchdown games in his career...Maxie and fullback Collin Deere both rushed for over 100 yards and scored two touchdowns against Huntington...It was the second time this season the duo accomplished that feat... Maxie had an 86-vard touchdown scamper against Huntington, which was the longest of his career, and Byrd's longest since Harrison Ayres' 85-yarder against Alexandria in 2024...Deere rushed for 228 yards and two touchdowns against the Parkway Panthers...It was the 15th-best single game performance in program history... Deere has rushed for over 200 yards in a game twice this season...Deere scored two or more touchdowns in four games this season...Before a knee injury ended his season, Deere needed just nine yards to reach the 1,000-yard mark this season...Asher Murray's 54-yard field goal against Airline was the fifth made field goal of his career from 50-plus yards, and the most of any kicker in program history...Murray's 54-yard field goal against the Vikings was his sixth make of the season moving him into a tie for first place on the carrer list and seventh place on the single-season list...Murray set the single-season record last year with 12 made field goals...Byrd's 33-0 shutout of John Ehret was the Jackets' first shutout victory since last year's 20-0 playoff win over Woodlawn of Baton Rouge... Byrd rushed for 424 yards in its 43-36 loss to Evangel...The 424 rushing yards was the 13th best team single-game rushing performance in program history...It was the first time Byrd had rushed for over 400 yards in a game since rushing for 412 yards versus Alexandria in last year's quarterfinals...Under Stacy Ballew's five seasons, the Jackets are 28-8 when rushing for 300 or more yards in a game...Byrd is 6-2 under Ballew when it rushes for 400 or more yards in a game...Deere had 175 rushing yards and Maxie had 128 yards against John Ehret...It marked the first time since last season's playoff loss to Alexandria that the Jackets had two backs eclipse the 100-yard mark in a game...Quarterback Jackson Davis tossed a 6-yard touchdown pass to Collin Deere against the Eagles...It was the Jackets first completed pass of the season, the first touchdown pass of the season and the first of Davis' varsity career...Davis had a 1-yard touchdown run against Evangel, also the first of his career...Wide receiver Logan Carlson had a 39-yard reception on a halfback pass from Maxie against Benton, which was the longest reception of his career...It was the second time Maxie connected with Carlson this season as they had a 29-vard pass against Huntington...Following the 36-35 overtime loss to Haughton. Byrd is now 2-4 in overtime games...It was the Jackets' first overtime game under coach Stacy Ballew and the team's first since a 22-21 loss to Captain Shreve in 2019...Byrd's first-ever overtime game was a 34-28 loss to Airline in 1991...The Jackets and Vikings have had two overtime games, including a three-overtime thriller, a 36-34 Byrd win in 2016...Collin Deere rushed for a career-high 253 yards and four touchdowns against Haughton...Deere's 253 rushing yards was the ninth-best rushing performance in program history...Deere's four rushing touchdowns were the most for a fullback since Desmond Simmons had four against Southwood in 2022...Deere's 35 rushing attempts was one carry shy of tying his personal high and the school record of 36, which he shares with Duan Maiden, who had 36 against Fair Park in 1992...Deere had 36 carries for 206 yards, his previous high, against Benton last year...Christian Maxie has five career touchdown runs of 70+ yards...Junior quarterback Jonathan Harris made his first career start against Haughton...Sophomore quarterback Leo Ezernack started his first game against Benton...Byrd's 49-6 loss to the St. Amant Gators was the highest amount of points ever given up by the Jackets and the largest point differential (43) in a season opener in program history...

St. Amant's 49 points were the most given up by Byrd in a season opener since 1965 when the Jackets were beaten 40-0 by the Sulphur Golden Tornados...Benton's 40 points were the most points allowed by the Jackets in a win since 2009 when Byrd beat Tioga 52-41...In 11 of the 24 losses Byrd has suffered in Ballew's five seasons, the Jackets have given up 40 or more points...Parkway's 52 points were the most points allowed since 2022 when the Jackets gave up 63 to the Benton Tigers...Byrd has not returned a punt in nine games this season...Natchitoches Central safety Imari Speed had a 35-yard scoop-and-score which was the first for a Byrd opponent since 2023... Haughton receiver Ethan Johnson had 13 receptions for 289 yards and three touchdowns...Johnson's 289 receiving yards was the most ever allowed by Byrd breaking the previous high of 267 set by Benton's Pearce Russell in 2022...Haughton blocked a Byrd extra-point attempt marking the second straight week a Jacket PAT attempt was blocked and it cost the Jackets a win...Bucs linebacker Jameson Voigt blocked an Asher Murray punt which was the first time Byrd has had a punt blocked since Airline's Laterious Pouncy blocked one in 2011...Christian Maxie's 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown was Byrd's only touchdown against St. Amant...Maxie's 95-yarder tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return for a touchdown in program history...The 49-6 loss to St. Amant was also the first time since suffering a 23-2 loss to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the 2023 playoffs that Byrd failed to score an offensive touchdown...St. Amant's defense allowed just 100 yards of total offense to Byrd, all on the ground...The 100 total offensive yards was Byrd's lowest output since being held to 61 yards by the Parkway Panthers on Oct. 12, 2023... After surrendering over 500 yards of total offense per game through the first three games, the Jackets allowed just 102 total offensive yards to John Ehret...Ehret's 102 yards were the fewest amount of yards allowed by Byrd since giving up just 69 yards to the Southwood Cowboys in 2022...Twice this season, Byrd has given up two of the longest kickoff returns for touchdowns in school history - 99 yards to Airline's Kenny Darby and 98 yards to Parkway's Braxxton Black.

The 2025 Schedule and Polls

Six of the 10 opponents on Byrd's 2025 schedule advanced to the playoffs in 2024. Evangel, Huntington, Airline and Parkway all won at least one playoff game last season. The defending Select Div. I Champion Edna Karr Cougars were the No. 1 ranked team again in this week's Louisiana Sports Writer's Association poll, while the St. Augustine Purple Knights and the John Curtis Patriots tied for the No. 2 ranking. The Evangel Eagles fell one spot to No. 9 in the LSWA Top-10, while undefeated Parkway garnered 16 votes in this week's LSWA poll. This season, Crescent City Sports is releasing its polls according to playoff divisions. CCS has the Karr Cougars as the top ranked team in Select Division I, while the Parkway Panthers are the new No. 1 team in Non-Select Division I. The Evangel Eagles fell to eighth in the CCS SD1 poll after last week's loss to Lafayette Christian. Parkway and Evangel meet on Friday for the District 1-5A title. Louisiana Sports Line has Karr ranked as its unanimous No. 1. The Shreveport-Bossier Journal has Parkway as the No. 1 ranked team in its weekly Top 10. The Evangel Eagles are No. 2 while the Captain Shreve Gators are at No. 7. The SBJ poll only ranks teams located in Caddo and Bossier parishes.

Offensive Lineman Love

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive lineman is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Despite lacking experience and size, Byrd's 2024 offensive line was outstanding. The O-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 381.8 yards of total offense and 32 points per game. The 2024 Jackets offense set the single season rushing record with 4,358 yards. The 2025 offensive line has allowed the Jackets to rush for over 300 yards in seven straight games this season. Byrd had 290 rushing yards against Airline snapping that streak. Byrd has had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 14 consecutive seasons. Since 1993, 38 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. For the second straight season, offensive line coach Craig Harris is selecting a "Lineman of the Week" based on his grading system. For the second time this season, senior Jacob Martin was chosen as the Lineman of the Week. "Martin and (Mason) Kinley had essentially the same grade," said Harris. "However, Martin had eight knockdowns to Kinley's six. We played well up front but needed to be more consistent .We had two more sophomores get valuable reps and look forward to seeing them get more reps in week 10."

Maxie Makes History

Despite the loss to Airline, junior wing back Christian Maxie continued his historic season a he rushed for 220 of Byrd's 290 yards and he scored two touchdowns. Maxie had a historic night in leading the Yellow Jackets to a 49-40 win over the Benton Tigers. Maxie had 32 carries for 341 yards and scored a school-record six touchdowns (121 years of Yellow Jackets Football). He also added a touchdown pass of 39 yards to receiver Logan Carlson. It was Byrd's longest pass of the season. Maxie accounted for 42 of Byrd's 49 points. He scored 36 points which tied a school record set by Joe Almokary versus Longview, Texas in 1928 (5 TDs, 6 PATs). His 341-yard rushing performance was the fourthbest single-game rushing performance in program history. What makes Maxie's incredible performance even more memorable was that he was the only starter remaining in Byrd's backfield. His historic night garnered Player of the Week honors from GeauxPreps, KTAL TV6 and the Tim Fletcher Show. On the season, Maxie has 1,446 rushing yards on 140 carries and has scored 19 rushing touchdowns. His 1,446 rushing yards currently ranks fifth on the season rushing leaders list. Maxie has scored 20 total touchdowns on the season (95-vard kickoff return) for 120 points which is tied for sixth on the season scoring leaders list with Rodney Hill, who scored 120 points in 2000, Maxie's 2,437 career rushing yards ranks fifth on the career rushing list. Maxie showed his big play ability in the opener against St. Amant as he returned a kickoff for 95 yards and a touchdown. It tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return in program history. It was the first kickoff return for a touchdown since Christian Jones had a 61-yard return for a touchdown against the Southwood Cowboys on Oct. 28, 2022. Against Huntington, Maxie had a dazzling 86-yard touchdown run, the longest of his career. Against Natchitoches Central, he rushed for 150 yards and two touchdowns, including a 79-yarder. It was his fifth career touchdown run of 70-plus yards. He rushed for 230 yards and three touchdowns against Evangel. It was the 14th best rushing performance by a Jacket in program history. In 19 varsity games, Maxie has 27 rushing touchdowns and is averaging 10.6 yards per carry and 128.3 yards per game.

Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy, Makes a Name for Himself

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of California Berkeley. Abram was 3-for-3 on field goal attempts before suffering a leg injury. However, all three of Abram's field goals were from 40-plus yards with a long of 49 against Oregon State. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 44 and 52 yarders, in the 2024 quarterfinal game against Alexandria. It was the fourth time in 2024 that Murray had kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). It also marked the first time in program history that a Jackets' place kicker had kicked three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. According to Lee Hiller of the Shreveport-Bossier Advocate, it was the first time any kicker in northwest Louisiana had accomplished that feat. Earlier in the '24 season against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal had given or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray's two field goals against ASH gave him 12 made field goals for the season, which set the single-season record for made field goals. He finished the 2024 season making 12-of-14 field goals, converting 44-of-47 on PAT kicks, and 48 of his 57 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Opponents starting field position was the 22 yard line. Murray's list of postseason accolades included: First-Team All-District, All-Metro, All-Prep and All-State selections. He was also named a MaxPreps All-American. In addition to his place kicking duties this season, he is also the Jackets' punter. He booted his first field goal of the season, a 23-yarder against Evangel, then followed with two (46, 32) successful kicks against John Ehret. Against Parkway, Murray capped Byrd's first drive with a 50-yard field goal. He added a 32-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Against Airline, Murray booted a 54-yard field goal giving him 18 made field goals, including five from 50+ yards, in his career and moving him into a first place tie with Shauhnessy on Byrd's career kicking list. Asher's six made field goals ties him with Abram and two others for seventh place on the season list. He's averaging 38.2 yards per punt this season with a long of 54 against Benton. Five of his punts have been downed inside the 20-yardline. Thirty-eight of his 48 kickoffs have resulted in a touchback. A Texas A&M commit, Murray plans on graduating at mid-term, then joining the Aggies in time for spring football practice.

The Injury Bug Bites Byrd Hard

The injury bug has bitten Byrd hard this season. Against Haughton, starting guard Jordan Wilson was likely lost for the season with an injury to his foot. Starting tackle Trenton Morris, who was already banged up, missed the last two games with a lower leg injury. Wing back Peter Santiago was injured in the Huntington game and had season-ending surgery last week. Starting quarterback Jackson Davis and backup Jonathan Harris suffered injuries in the Natchitoches Central game as well. Full-back Collin Deere was lost for the remainder of the season with a knee injury against the Chiefs. Deere also had surgery last week. Starting corner back Azariae "Tigg" Barfield has been missed the majority of the season due to a hip injury. Tight end Duncan Rowe has missed a number of games causing Malik Jones to move over to offense from defense. Linebackers Madden Cromer and Amaree Hayes missed time recently but both returned against Benton. Fullback Dominic Foy suffered a lower leg injury against Airline and did not return.

Ja'Cari Just Makes Plays

Senior safety Ja'Cari Williams really came on strong as a sophomore in 2023, and solidified his presence as a junior in 2024. He finished third on the team with 72 total tackles, including three tacklesfor-loss, one interception and three forced fumbles in 2024. Two of those forced fumbles came against St. Paul's in the playoffs. Williams was a First-Team All-District selection and has emerged as the leader of the Purple Swarm Defense in 2025. Through nine games, Williams is second on the team with 43 total tackles, which includes a team-high 27 solo stops. He also has two tackles-forloss, five pass break-ups, a fumble recovery and two interceptions, including a pick in the end zone against Benton. He's also been a great kick returner for the Jackets averaging 20.1 yards per return. A quiet leader but intense playmaker, Williams has racked up 150 total tackles in his three-year varsity career.

Shiny Cromer

Byrd lost its three starting linebackers from 2024, including District 1-5A Co-Defensive MVP Sam Greer, who set a school record for tackles in a season with 136. It's not easy to step in and try to fill the void left by such an outstanding player as Greer. After overcoming some nagging injuries, senior Madde Cromer has shined when he has been on the field. Despite missing two games, Cromer leads the team with 44 tackles. He has three tackles-for-loss and a fumble recovery.

Gray Matters

Senior lan Gray has been the anchor of Byrd's defensive line. On the season, he has tallied 27 total tackles, including 16 solo stops, 8.5 tackles-for-loss, 2.5 sacks and a fumble recovery. In his two varsity seasons, he has registered 67 total tackles, 15.5 tackles-for-loss, four sacks and two fumble recoveries, proving that having Gray on the defensive front really matters for Byrd.

Hilliard Having A Solid Season

Junior defensive end Conrad Hilliard is having a solid season. Against John Ehret, Hilliard finished the night tied Madden Cromer with a team-high six tackles. He had a season-best 3.5 tackles-for-loss for negative 16 yards and registered 1.5 sacks for minus seven yards. The junior followed that performance up by recording a team-high eight tackles, a tackle-for-loss and a fumble recovery against Parkway. On the season, Hilliard is third on the team with 38 total tackles. He leads the team with 11 tackles-for-loss and four sacks. He also recovered fumbles in back-to-back games against Parkway and Huntington. Hilliard, who's also Byrd's deep snapper, got dinged up in the Airline game and did not return.

Who Was Lee Hedges?

You probably know that Byrd and Captain Shreve share occupancy of Lee Hedges Stadium. But, who was Lee Hedges? The stadium is named in honor of legendary football coach Lee Hedges, who passed away on July 9, 2023, at the age of 93. Lee Hedges dedicated his life to teaching and mentoring young people in Shreveport. Hedges is best known for guiding the 1973 Captain Shreve Gators to a perfect 14-0 record and the Class 4A State Championship. However, Shreve was not the only Shreveport school where he was successful. A three-sport standout at Fair Park before going on to star at LSU, Hedges would begin his legendary coaching career at arch-rival Byrd as the Yellow Jackets' head coach in 1956. He led Byrd to the state title game that first season, losing to the Istrouma Indians, 14-7. After four years on Line Avenue, Hedges moved to newly-opened Woodlawn in 1960. He had tremendous success at Woodlawn, leading the Knights to the 1965 state championship game. Hedges' 217 career wins are the most for any coach in the history of Caddo-Bossier football.

A Rivalry Unlike Any Other

The "Backyard Brawl" between the Byrd Yellow Jackets and Captain Shreve Gator is one of the most unique rivalries in the state. It's unlike any other rivalry in that you have divisions of loyalties within families. Former Byrd All-State linebacker Brad Petree's brothers played at Shreve. The Frierson Family had cousins staring across the line of scrimmage at one another. Former Jacket kicker Jake Wyss' younger brothers, Zane and Michael, are both Gators. Zane was Shreve's kicker last year, and Michael, is currently the Gators' long snapper. Drive through nearly any south Shreveport neighborhood and you'll see yard signs reading "Sting 'Em Jackets" or "Go Gators" in adjacent houses. This rivalry that pits neighbor versus neighbor, turns friend into foe, and causes angst amongst families.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." 2025 marks the 101st season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Association boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are six other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Buckingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017) and Shimorye Hampton (2017).

Former Jackets Now Head Coaches

In addition to former Yellow Jacket quarterback Jeremy Wilburn coaching at Captain Shreve there are a few more former Byrd players serving as head coaches in the high school ranks. Nicholas Peoples, who holds the career interceptions record (10) at Byrd, is the head coach at Green Oaks. Former Jacket running back Chadwick Lewis is the head coach at Southwest High School in Little Rock, Arkansas. Christopher Wilson, who played at Byrd from 2009-11, is the head coach at North Webster.

Over the Airwaves

Byrd football has been broadcast live on The Tiger (KWKH) for over 30 years. Charlie Cavell is in his 28th season behind the microphone as the "Voice of the Byrd Yellow Jackets" calling the play-by-play action. Dr. Kirk Martinson is the color analyst, while former Yellow Jacket defensive back Dominique Wilson provides sideline reports. Marc Weddleton and Chad Ardoin are the statisticians. Former Jacket fullback Jason Little is frequent guest commentator. Byrd Football can be heard on AM 1130 and FM 103.3 The Tiger or by visiting 1130thetiger.com and clicking on the Listen Live button. By downloading the 1130 The Tiger app fans can listen to Byrd Football anywhere in the world.

Former Byrd Yellow Jackets in the collegiate ranks in 2025 are kicker Abram Murray at the University of California, Berkeley, offensive lineman Carson Bruno at Texas Christian University, wide receiver Jackson Dufrene at Nicholls State University, defensive lineman Darell Cottonham, Jr., at Louisiana Christian University, linebacker Makarios "Junior" Brown at Southern Arkansas University, punter/kicker Jackson Cooper at Lamar University, defensive back James Logan at Capital University (Ohio),, linebacker Devon Strickland at Centenary College and quarterback J.D. Gallman at Kansas Wesleyan.

Salute to Service

Throughout the 101 years of Byrd Football numerous former players have entered into military service. One of the most notable former Yellow Jackets to serve our great nation was Leo Bird. A four sport lettermen, Bird was a standout for the Jackets from 1935-37. He graduated from Byrd in 1938, and would take his gridiron talents to Baton Rouge. A star at LSU, Bird was the Tigers' 1941 team captain. He led the Tigers in passing for three straight seasons, and was the first LSU quarterback to throw three touchdowns in a game. Answering the country's call to arms during WWII, Bird took his skills and leadership to the U.S. Navy, where he became a pilot. He flew the F-6F Hellcat with the VF-51 group from the carrier USS San Jacinto. It was with this unit that he became an "Ace." According to contemporary and end-of-war reports, Bird downed 5-1/2 Japanese planes. He also took part in the sinking of a Japanese destroyer with other Hellcat fliers. In September of 1944, he was on a mission in the Pacific escorting torpedo bombers that were attacking the Japanese. On his way back to the carrier, he saw a downed pilot floating below him and stayed in the area, circling over the site, even though he was low on fuel. The downed pilot was George H. W. Bush, who survived that crash to become the 41st President of the United States and the father of 43rd president, George W. Bush. Leo Bird was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross and the Air Medal for his bravery in combat. He passed away on May 24, 1996 in Shreveport's Highland Hospital at the age of 77.
