2025 Season Ends

The Byrd Yellow Jackets 2025 football season came to an end on Thursday, Nov. 6, following a 35-27 loss to arch rival Captain Shreve in the 48th annual "Backyard Brawl."

A Little About the Team

The Byrd Yellow Jackets finished the 2025 season with a 2-8 overall record and a 1-7 record in District 1-5A. Byrd missed the playoffs for the first time since 2008, snapping its streak of 15 straight playoff appearances. Byrd loses five starters on offense and five on defense. Four of the six starters slated to return on offense are in the Byrd backfield - quarterback Jackson Davis, wing backs Christian Maxie and Peter Santiago as well as fullback Collin Deere. However, Santiago and Deere will hopefully be able to fully recover from season-ending injuries.

The Last Time Out

Captain Shreve running back Jamarcea Plater rushed for 194 yards and three touchdowns to lead the Gators to a 35-27 win over the Byrd Yellow Jackets in the 48th edition of the "Backyard Brawl." Gator quarterback Jackson Gaskin was 8-for-8 passing for 190 yards and a touchdown. Byrd's Byrd's Christian Maxie rushed for 128 yards and two touchdowns and added a 62-yard receiving touchdown in the losing effort.

The 101st Season of Byrd Football

In the 101st season of Byrd Football, the Yellow Jackets posted a 2-8 record. It was the second time in five seasons under head coach Stacy Ballew that the Yellow Jackets finished below .500. The last time Byrd won just two games was in 1994 when the Jackets finished with an identical 2-8 record. Byrd's 1-7 record in District 1-5A marked the first time since 2018 (3-3) that the Jackets did not have a winning district record. Byrd did not make the playoffs for the first time since 2009.

Tentative 2026 Schedule Twists

The LHSAA is currently going through its reclassification and redistricting process. District 1-5A is likely to remain in its current nine-team configuration. However, the district football coaches have voted not to play a full eight-game district slate in 2026, opting instead to play a six-game district schedule. This means that each District 1-5A team will not play two district opponents for the 2026 and 2027 seasons. Byrd drew Airline and Natchitoches Central. However, the Yellow Jackets and Vikings are scheduled to play a non-district game in week two next season. Byrd's other non-district opponents are the Ouachita Lions, the 2025 Non-Select Division I Champions, in week one and the North DeSoto Griffins, the 2025 Non-Select Division II Runners-up, in week three. Ballew is still in search of a week four opponent. Beginning in week five, Byrd will play six straight District 1-5A games starting off with Benton, followed by Huntington, Haughton, Evangel, Parkway then finishing the regular season against Captain Shreve.

The Coaches

After Mike Suggs announced his retirement in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Stacy Ballew as the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets Football history. He earned his first victory as the Jackets' head coach in Byrd's 43-14 season-opening win over Huntington in 2021. Ballew has spent most of his life at the Line Avenue school. An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000. After a one-year hiatus, Ballew returned home in 2002 to become the running backs coach on Suggs' staff. In 2005, he would move over to the defensive side, where he'd remain for 16 seasons, coaching the linebackers. Promoted to defensive coordinator in 2009, Ballew spent 12 seasons coordinating the Purple Swarm Defense. Ballew owns a 32-25 (.561) record in his five seasons as Byrd's head coach. The rest of the coaching staff includes: Wade Leone, offensive coordinator; Craig Harris, offensive line; Rahkeem Mitchell, running backs; Carlos Doss, wide receivers; Shimorye Hampton, defensive line; Jalen Bowers, linebackers; Benji Piazza, corner backs, and Ballew coaches the safeties. The freshmen coaches are Lee Wooldridge, Ronnie Buckingham and Tucker Gardner. Cordarius Wayne is the certified athletic trainer.

Stacy Ballew finished his fifth season as the head coach of the C.E. Byrd Yellow Jackets. However, Ballew is no stranger to the purple and gold having spent three-fourths of his life, four as a student athlete and 22 as an assistant coach, at the Line Avenue school.

An All-District offensive lineman for coach Alan Carter, Ballew was a member of the Yellow Jackets from 1992-95. He was a sophomore on Byrd's 1993 District Championship team that went 10-1 and was a senior on the 1995 team that finished 8-3. After graduating in 1996, he returned to his alma mater in 1998, working as an assistant coach, while attending LSU Shreveport. He earned a bachelor of science degree from LSUS in 2000.

In 2001, Ballew left Shreveport and Byrd for a coaching position at Acton Junior High School in Granbury, Texas. His time in the Lone Star State was short lived as he returned home and to his alma mater in 2002 to become the running backs coach under head coach Mike Suggs.

In 2005, Ballew would move over to the defensive side of the football where he'd remain for 16 seasons, to coach linebackers. Suggs promoted Ballew to defensive coordinator in 2009. He'd oversee some of the top Purple Swarm Defense's in school history.

Under his tutelage, the 2020 Purple Swarm Defense was one of the best in program history, allowing just over 200 yards and 14 points a game. Byrd was particularly impressive against the run giving up just 80.3 yards per game and 3.0 yards per carry.

After Suggs retired in May 2021, Byrd principal Jerry Badgley named Ballew the 24th head coach in Yellow Jackets football history.

The 47-year-old Ballew has been married to the former Jennifer Lord for over 20 years. The couple has twins, LeighAnne and Jackson, who graduated from Byrd in 2022.

YELLOW JACKET STINGERS**Yellow Jackets Football History**

2025 marks the 121st season of Yellow Jackets Football and the 101st season as C.E. Byrd...Yellow Jackets Football began in 1905 and competed as Shreveport High School through the 1924 season...The school was renamed in honor of Clifton Ellis Byrd in September 17, 1925...In the 20 seasons of Shreveport High School Football, the Yellow Jackets compiled an impressive 70-28-12 record...Shreveport-Byrd owns a 700-449-35 (.606) overall won-loss record...Retired coach Mike Suggs is the school's all-time winningest coach with a 167-89 (.652) record...Head coach Stacy Ballew owns a 32-25 (.561) record in his five seasons as the Jackets' head coach...In Ballew's first season, Byrd captured a share of the 2021 District 1-5A crown...The Jackets have won 24 district titles in program history...Byrd won six district titles under Suggs, the most for one coach in school history...Byrd has made the playoffs for 15 consecutive years, the longest stretch in school history, and 19 of the last 20 seasons...Byrd has participated in the playoffs in 42 different seasons, 72 games, and holds a 36-34-2 record...The two ties were split 1-1, one win on first downs and one loss on penetrations...In the 120-year combined history of Shreveport-Byrd football, the Yellow Jackets have made 14 state championship game appearances, winning eight state championships and having been the state runners-up six times...In 2020, the Yellow Jackets reached the state finals for the 14th time in school history and the first time since 2013...After Catholic High of Baton Rouge was forced to vacate the title by the LHSAA, Byrd was awarded the 2020 Division I State Championship and Principal Jerry Badgley accepted, giving Byrd eight state titles..

2025 Notes

Byrd had its streak of seven straight games of 300-plus rushing yards snapped against Airline...The Jackets totaled 290 rushing yards versus the Vikings...Byrd had 266 rushing yards against Shreve...Nine times during the 2024 season the Jackets rushed for over 300 yards in a game...Wing back Christian Maxie has eclipsed the 100-yard rushing mark in five straight games and in seven of Byrd's 10 games...Maxie rushed for 128 yards and two touchdowns against Shreve...Maxie accounted for 220 of Byrd's 290 rushing yards against Airline...Maxie rushed for 341 yards and a school-record six touchdowns against the Benton Tigers...It was the fourth-best rushing performance in a game in program history...Maxie's 128 rushing yards against Shreve marked the 11th time in his career that he has rushed for over 100 yards in a game...Eight times in his career Maxie has rushed for over 150 yards in 20 career varsity games...He scored two rushing touchdowns against the Gators giving him nine multi-touchdown games in his career...Maxie and fullback Collin Deere both rushed for over 100 yards and scored two touchdowns against Huntington...It was the second time in 2025 the duo accomplished that feat... Maxie had an 86-yard touchdown scamper against Huntington, which was the longest of his career, and Byrd's longest since Harrison Ayres' 85-yarder against Alexandria in 2024...Deere rushed for 228 yards and two touchdowns against the Parkway Panthers...It was the 15th-best single game performance in program history... Deere has rushed for over 200 yards in a game twice this season...Deere scored two or more touchdowns in four games this season...Before a knee injury ended his season, Deere needed just nine yards to reach the 1,000-yard mark this season...Asher Murray's 54-yard field goal against Airline was the fifth made field goal of his career from 50-plus yards, and the most of any kicker in program history...Murray's 54-yard field goal against the Vikings was his sixth make of the season moving him into a tie for first place on the career kicking list and seventh place on the single-season list...Murray set the single-season record in 2024 with 12 made field goals...Byrd's 33-0 shutout of John Ehret was the Jackets' first shutout victory since last year's 20-0 playoff win over Woodlawn of Baton Rouge...Byrd rushed for 424 yards in its 43-36 loss to Evangel...The 424 rushing yards was the 13th best team single-game rushing performance in program history...It was the first time Byrd had rushed for over 400 yards in a game since rushing for 412 yards versus Alexandria in last year's quarterfinals...Under Stacy Ballew's five seasons, the Jackets are 28-8 when rushing for 300 or more yards in a game...Byrd is 6-2 under Ballew when it rushes for 400 or more yards in a game...Deere had 175 rushing yards and Maxie had 128 yards against John Ehret...It marked the first time since 2024's playoff loss to Alexandria that the Jackets had two backs eclipse the 100-yard mark in a game...Quarterback Jackson Davis tossed a 6-yard touchdown pass to Collin Deere against the Eagles...It was the Jackets first completed pass of the season, the first touchdown pass of the season and the first of Davis' varsity career...Davis had a 1-yard touchdown run against Evangel, also the first of his career...Wide receiver Logan Carlson had a 39-yard reception on a halfback pass from Maxie against Benton, which was the longest reception of his career...It was the second time Maxie connected with Carlson this season as they had a 29-yard pass against Huntington...Following the 36-35 overtime loss to Haughton, Byrd is now 2-4 in overtime games...It was the Jackets' first overtime game under coach Stacy Ballew and the team's first since a 22-21 loss to Captain Shreve in 2019...Byrd's first-ever overtime game was a 34-28 loss to Airline in 1991...The Jackets and Vikings have had two overtime games, including a three-overtime thriller, a 36-34 Byrd win in 2016...Collin Deere rushed for a career-high 253 yards and four touchdowns against Haughton...Deere's 253 rushing yards was the ninth-best rushing performance in program history...Deere's four rushing touchdowns were the most for a fullback since Desmond Simmons had four against Southwood in 2022...Deere's 35 rushing attempts was one carry shy of tying his personal high and the school record of 36, which he shares with Duan Maiden, who had 36 against Fair Park in 1992...Deere had 36 carries for 206 yards, his previous high, against Benton last year...Christian Maxie has five career touchdown runs of 70+ yards...Junior quarterback Jonathan Harris made his first career start against Haughton...notes continued on next page

Sophomore quarterback Leo Ezernack started his first game against Benton...Byrd's 49-6 loss to the St. Amant Gators was the highest amount of points ever given up by the Jackets and the largest point differential (43) in a season opener in program history...St. Amant's 49 points were the most given up by Byrd in a season opener since 1965 when the Jackets were beaten 40-0 by the Sulphur Golden Tornados...Benton's 40 points were the most points allowed by the Jackets in a win since 2009 when Byrd beat Tioga 52-41...In 11 of the 25 losses Byrd has suffered in Ballew's five seasons, the Jackets have given up 40 or more points...Parkway's 52 points were the most points allowed since 2022 when the Jackets gave up 63 to the Benton Tigers...Byrd did not register a punt return this season...Natchitoches Central safety Imari Speed had a 35-yard scoop-and-score which was the first for a Byrd opponent since 2023...Haughton receiver Ethan Johnson had 13 receptions for 289 yards and three touchdowns...Johnson's 289 receiving yards was the most ever allowed by Byrd breaking the previous high of 267 set by Benton's Pearce Russell in 2022...Haughton blocked a Byrd extra-point attempt marking the second straight week a Jacket PAT attempt was blocked and it cost the Jackets a win...Bucs linebacker Jameson Voigt blocked an Asher Murray punt which was the first time Byrd has had a punt blocked since Airline's Laterious Pouncy blocked one in 2011...Christian Maxie's 95-yard kickoff return for a touchdown was Byrd's only touchdown against St. Amant...Maxie's 95-yarder tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return for a touchdown in program history...The 49-6 loss to St. Amant was also the first time since suffering a 23-2 loss to the Jesuit Blue Jays in the 2023 playoffs that Byrd failed to score an offensive touchdown...St. Amant's defense allowed just 100 yards of total offense to Byrd, all on the ground...The 100 total offensive yards was Byrd's lowest output since being held to 61 yards by the Parkway Panthers on Oct. 12, 2023...After surrendering over 500 yards of total offense per game through the first three games, the Jackets allowed just 102 total offensive yards to John Ehret...Ehret's 102 yards were the fewest amount of yards allowed by Byrd since giving up just 69 yards to the Southwood Cowboys in 2022...Twice this season, Byrd has given up two of the longest kickoff returns for touchdowns in school history - 99 yards to Airline's Kenny Darby and 98 yards to Parkway's Braxton Black.

Maxie Has Historical Season

Junior wing back Christian Maxie had a historic season in 2025. He finished the 2025 campaign with 1,574 rushing yards on 168 carries and scored 21 rushing touchdowns. His 1,574 rushing yards was the third-best rushing season in program history. This season, Maxie scored 23 total touchdowns for 138 points, which ranks fourth on the season scoring leaders list. He rushed for over 100 yards in seven of Byrd's 10 games, including five straight from weeks six through 10. In the season finale against Shreve, Maxie had 128 rushing yards and two touchdowns and added a 62-yard touchdown reception, which was the longest completion of the season. Against Airline, he accounted for 220 of Byrd's 290 rushing yards and he scored two touchdowns. He had a historic night in leading the Yellow Jackets to a 49-40 win over the Benton Tigers. Maxie had 32 carries for 341 yards and scored a school-record six touchdowns (121 years of Yellow Jackets Football). He also added a touchdown pass of 39 yards to receiver Logan Carlson. Maxie accounted for 42 of Byrd's 49 points. He scored 36 points which tied a school record set by Joe Almokary versus Longview, Texas in 1928 (5 TDs, 6 PATs). His 341-yard rushing performance was the fourth-best single-game rushing performance in program history. What makes Maxie's incredible performance even more memorable was that he was the only starter remaining in Byrd's backfield. His historic night garnered Player of the Week honors from GeauxPreps, KTAL TV6 and the Tim Fletcher Show. Maxie showed his big play ability in the opener against St. Amant as he returned a kickoff for 95 yards and a touchdown. It tied Rodney Hill (2000) and Spanky McCoy (1954) for the second-longest kickoff return in program history. It was the first kickoff return for a touchdown since Christian Jones had a 61-yard return for a touchdown against the Southwood Cowboys on Oct. 28, 2022. Against Huntington, Maxie had a dazzling 86-yard touchdown run, the longest of his career. Against Natchitoches Central, he rushed for 150 yards and two touchdowns, including a 79-yarder. It was his fifth career touchdown run of 70-plus yards. He rushed for 230 yards and three touchdowns against Evangel. It was the 14th best rushing performance by a Jacket in program history. Maxie's 2,565 career rushing yards ranks fifth on Byrd's career rushing list. In the 20 games played in his career, Maxie has 29 rushing touchdowns, averaged 9.9 yards per carry and 128.2 yards per game. Eight times in his 20 career varsity games Maxie has rushed for over 150 yards. He has nine multi-touchdown games in his career. For the second straight season, Maxie was a First-Team All-District selection.

BYRD BANTER**Asher Continues Murray Family Legacy, Makes a Name for Himself**

After a stellar two-year career at Byrd, Abram Murray has continued his kicking career at the University of California Berkeley. Abram was 4-of-5 on field goal attempts this season for the Golden Bears. All four of Abram's field goals were from 40-plus yards with a long of 49 against Oregon State. Younger brother Asher is continuing the Murray family kicking legacy at Byrd. The younger Murray booted two field goals, 44 and 52 yards, in the 2024 quarterfinal game against Alexandria. It was the fourth time in 2024 that Murray had kicked two field goals in the same game (St. Amant, Shreve, Woodlawn). It also marked the first time in program history that a Jackets' place kicker had kicked three 50+ yard field goals (56, 50, 52) in a season as well as in a career. According to Lee Hiller of the *Shreveport-Bossier Advocate*, it was the first time any kicker in northwest Louisiana had accomplished that feat. Earlier in the '24 season against Benton, Murray booted a 56-yard field goal to give Byrd a 17-14 lead over the Tigers at halftime. His 56-yarder tied a school, city and parishes record held by former Byrd kicker John Shaughnessy, who kicked his record-setting field goal against the Airline Vikings in the 2008 playoffs. In addition to tying the record, it was the third consecutive week in which a Murray field goal had given or extended a Byrd halftime lead (10-6 vs. Huntington, 17-14 vs. Natchitoches Central, 17-14 vs. Benton). Murray's two field goals against ASH gave him 12 made field goals for the season, which set the single-season record for made field goals. He finished the 2024 season making 12-of-14 field goals, converting 44-of-47 on PAT kicks, and 48 of his 57 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. Opponents starting field position was the 22 yard line. Murray's list of postseason accolades included: First-Team All-District, All-Metro, All-Prep and All-State selections. He was also named a MaxPreps All-American. In addition to his place kicking duties this season, he is also the Jackets' punter. He booted his first field goal of the season, a 23-yarder against Evangel, then followed with two (46, 32) successful kicks against John Ehret. Against Parkway, Murray capped Byrd's first drive with a 50-yard field goal. He added a 32-yarder against Natchitoches Central. Against Airline, Murray booted a 54-yard field goal giving him 18 made field goals, including five from 50+ yards, in his career and moving him into a first place tie with Shaughnessy on Byrd's career kicking list. Asher's six made field goals this season ties him with Abram and two others for seventh place on the season leaders list. Asher averaged 40.1 yards per punt this season with a long of 54 against Benton. Five of his punts have been downed inside the 20-yardline. Forty-one of his 52 kickoffs resulted in touchbacks. For the second consecutive season, Murray was a First-Team All-District selection. Murray signed with Texas A&M on Dec. 5. He plans on graduating at mid-term, enrolling at A&M in time to join the Aggies for spring football practice.

The Injury Bug Bites Byrd Hard

The injury bug bit Byrd hard this season. Against Haughton, starting guard Jordan Wilson was lost for the season with an injury to his foot. Starting tackle Trenton Morris, who was already banged up, missed the last two games with a lower leg injury. Wing back Peter Santiago was injured in the Huntington game and had to undergo season-ending surgery. Starting quarterback Jackson Davis and backup Jonathan Harris suffered injuries in the Natchitoches Central game as well. Fullback Collin Deere was lost for the remainder of the season with a knee injury against the Chiefs. Deere also had to undergo season-ending surgery. Starting corner back Azariae "Tigg" Barfield missed the majority of the season due to a hip injury. Tight end Duncan Rowe missed a number of games causing Malik Jones to move over to offense from defense. Linebackers Madden Cromer and Amaree Hayes missed time but both returned against Benton. Fullback Dominic Foy suffered a lower leg injury against Airline and did not play in the Shreve game.

Ja'Cari Just Made Plays

Senior safety Ja'Cari Williams really came on strong as a sophomore in 2023, and solidified his presence as a junior in 2024. He finished third on the team with 72 total tackles, including three tackles-for-loss, one interception and three forced fumbles in 2024. Two of those forced fumbles came against St. Paul's in the playoffs. Williams was a First-Team All-District selection and has emerged as the leader of the Purple Swarm Defense in 2025. Williams finished the season with a team-leading 47 total tackles, including a team-high 31 solo stops. He had two tackles-for-loss, five pass breakups, a fumble recovery and two interceptions, including a pick in the end zone against Benton. He's also was a great kick returner for the Jackets averaging 20.6 yards per return. A quiet leader but intense playmaker, Williams racked up 154 total tackles in his three-year varsity career.

JACKET JARGON**Offensive Lineman Love**

The guys in the trenches, particularly the offensive linemen, don't often receive the same love, attention and notoriety that skill position players do. Generally, the only time an offensive lineman is recognized is when his number is called after committing a penalty. Despite lacking experience and size, Byrd's 2025 offensive line was outstanding. The O-line paved the way for the Jackets' offense to average 359.8 yards of total offense and 28.6 points per game. The 2025 offensive line has allowed the Jackets to rush for over 300 yards in 7-of-10 games, including five straight during the season. Byrd had 290 rushing yards against Airline which snapped that streak. Byrd had at least one First-Team All-District offensive lineman for 14 consecutive seasons until 2025. Since 1993, 38 Yellow Jackets' offensive linemen have named First-Team All-District. For the second straight season, offensive line coach Craig Harris is selected a "Lineman of the Week" based on his grading system. For the fifth time this season, senior Mason Kinley was chosen as the Lineman of the Week for his efforts against Captain Shreve. "Kinley was the lineman of the week against Shreve," said Harris. "To me, Kinley, was the best senior example on the team." Kinley was a Second-Team All-District selection.

In His Own Words, Harris Recaps Offensive Line Play

The 2025 season challenged the Byrd Yellow Jackets offensive line from the start, as key injuries before the very first official snap reshaped the room and forced rapid adjustments. With a small senior class and unexpected setbacks, the group leaned heavily on each other to navigate one of the most demanding seasons in recent memory. To help stabilize the unit, two tight ends—Duncan Rowe and Malik Jones—stepped in mid-transition from wide receiver and defensive end. Neither had significant blocking experience, yet both fully embraced the role change, learned quickly, and brought steady effort and great energy to the group. Their willingness to serve wherever needed was invaluable. This year's senior class featured Clark Harp, Malik Jones, Duncan Rowe, Jacob Martin, and Mason Kinley. Though smaller in number than past seasons, each senior contributed in meaningful ways as the line worked to find its footing. Clark Harp, undersized but determined, showed steady development throughout the year. He put effort into improving his technique and gained a stronger understanding of what consistent, varsity-level preparation looks like. Harp approached every challenge with a good attitude, worked to improve daily, and made noticeable progress as the season went on. Senior Jacob Martin, the lone returning starter, entered the year with the most playing experience. His preseason injury forced him to watch from the sideline—an unexpected setback that ultimately became a turning point. During his recovery, Martin chose to stay deeply involved, coaching his replacement, helping younger linemen with technique, and supporting his teammates every day at practice.

When Martin returned to action, he brought the physicality and presence expected from a veteran, and his performance improved week by week. His journey reflected a meaningful growth arc: understanding what true preparation requires and stepping into leadership when his teammates needed him most. Senior Mason Kinley set the tone for the offensive line from start to finish. Kinley is not loud, but he is relentless. A player who leads entirely by example, Kinley showed up every day willing to out-work anyone—dragging younger linemen to offseason conditioning, finishing first in post-practice sprints, and refusing to let effort ever become negotiable. He brought toughness, focus, and a competitive edge to a unit that desperately needed stability. In games, his impact was constant: anchoring the middle, playing through injury without complaint, and springing runners for extra yards with blocks that often didn't show up in the box score but were obvious on film. His standard, his consistency, and his attitude earned him the title of Offensive Lineman of the Year.

Kinley became the heartbeat of the line—it's most dependable worker and the player others followed when times got tough. The offensive line grew significantly as the season progressed, especially once the group settled into roles midyear. Even as injuries continued to impact the backfield, the line's improvement showed through better communication, sharper execution, and a willingness to fight through adversity. This group embraced a core belief repeated often in our room: "We do not seek comfort." We do not point to injuries, depth challenges, or opponents loaded with recruited talent as reasons to feel better about falling short. We expect to be physical, relentless, technique-sound, and committed to the standard—regardless of circumstance. Many of the most important lessons—about preparation, focus, and daily work habits—were learned later in the year than anyone would have preferred, but the growth was real and meaningful. And with six linemen returning who now carry substantial varsity experience, Byrd enters next season with a stronger foundation and a much clearer picture of what it truly takes to succeed. The message to the returning group is simple: nothing is given. Six of this year's losses came by a single score, and the margin between winning and losing will come down to the details—every drill, every technique rep, every coaching point. We have a choice:

commit to doing things the right way and give us the best chance for success, or allow the opportunity to slip away. The 2025 offensive line weathered early setbacks, grew through adversity, and—thanks to the leadership of Kinley and the late-season emergence of Martin—finished the season tougher, tighter, and far better prepared for the future.

Nothing Runs Like A Deere

Fullback Collin Deere had an outstanding 2024 season, rushing for 743 yards and six touchdowns while splitting time with Desmond Simmons, who rushed for 1,033. That's nearly 1,800 rushing yards from the fullback spot, which is crucial for Byrd's offensive success. Simmons graduated making Deere the No. 1 fullback, and he has picked up where he left off in 2024. Against the Haughton Buccaneers, Deere rushed for a career-high 253 yards on 35 carries and he scored four touchdowns, also a career-high. Deere's 35 carries were one tote shy of a single-game record of 36, one in which he shares (vs. Benton in 2024) with Duan Maiden, who did it against Fair Park in 1992. Deere also had an incredible two-point conversion reception making him accountable for 26 of Byrd's 35 points. His 26 points scored were the most by a Jacket since 2023 when Malachi Johnson had five rushing touchdowns and 30 points scored against the Huntington Raiders. His 253 rushing yards against Haughton was the ninth best single-game performance in school history. Against Parkway, he rushed for 228 yards which was the 15th-best single-game performance in program history. In his two-year varsity career, Deere has 291 carries for 1,734 yards and has scored 16 touchdowns. Deere also has two receptions for 13 yards and a touchdown in 2025. In 17 career games, he has averaged 6.0 yards per carry and 102.4 yards per game, showing that nothing runs like a Deere.

Shiny Cromer

Byrd lost its three starting linebackers from 2024, including District 1-5A Co-Defensive MVP Sam Greer, who set a school record for tackles in a season with 136. It's not easy to step in and try to fill the void left by such an outstanding player as Greer. After overcoming some nagging injuries, senior Madde Cromer shined when he was on the field. Despite missing two games, Cromer finished second on the team with 46 tackles, one behind Ja'Cari Williams. He had three tackles-for-loss and two fumble recoveries.

Gray Matter

Senior Ian Gray was the anchor of Byrd's defensive line. On the season, he tallied 32 total tackles, including 19 solo stops, 8.5 tackles-for-loss, 2.5 sacks and a fumble recovery. Gray was Byrd's lone defensive player chosen to the First-Team All-District team. In his two varsity seasons, he has registered 72 total tackles, 15.5 tackles-for-loss, four sacks and two fumble recoveries, proving that having Gray on the defensive front really mattered for Byrd.

Hilliard Had A Solid Season

Junior defensive end Conrad Hilliard had a solid season in 2025. Against John Ehret, Hilliard finished the night tied Madden Cromer with a team-high six tackles. He had a season-best 3.5 tackles-for-loss for negative 16 yards and registered 1.5 sacks for minus seven yards. The junior followed that performance up by recording a team-high eight tackles, a tackle-for-loss and a fumble recovery against Parkway. Hilliard finished the season tied with Abram Anderson with 40 total tackles. He led the team with 12 tackles-for-loss and four sacks. He also had two fumble recoveries on the season.

Once a Citizen, Always a Citizen

C.E. Byrd High School is Shreveport's oldest public high school, and is often referred to as the "City of Byrd." 2025 marks the 101st season of Byrd Yellow Jackets Football. The Byrd Alumni Association boasts that it is one of the largest alumni organizations in the nation. In addition to head coach Stacy Ballew (1996), there are six other members of the coaching staff who are citizens of the City of Byrd and played football for the Yellow Jackets. They are as follows: Craig Harris (1997), Ronnie Birmingham (2004), Rahkeem Mitchell (2009), Jalen Bowers (2013), Carlos Doss (2017) and Shimorye Hampton (2017).
